Step 4 – Introduction – How to print a website page.

- If you have a Printer, you can print a page on a website. If you have a PDF Reader, you can print a website page to a PDF file on your Computer. All PDF Readers allow you to print it, like your Printer. If you don't have a PDF Reader, I recommend you Download Foxit Reader from ninite.com In my website, there is a Ninite page under Courses that has a Video that shows you how to download Foxit Reader and other programs from ninite.com
- Next explains what happens when you print a website page.

- Most websites you can't print the full layout on the page. It doesn't show the Header. But, some Browsers allow you to show it. It doesn't show the Background color on the Navigation Bar and all Browsers don't allow to do that. If the page has links to PDF files or other pages, and you print, it shows a different links and the links don't work on the Printer.
- Facebook website allows to print the full layout, except the header, but as I mentioned before some Browsers allow you to show it. That's why I will show you how to print a Facebook page sample on each Browser in the Parts. Next explains more about the Parts.

- All Parts will show you how to print with a Printer.
 Also all Parts will show you how to print to a PDF
 Reader, like Foxit Reader. At the end of each Parts,
 it will also show Adobe Reader. The reason is
 some people have Adobe Reader vs. Foxit Reader.
- If you don't have Facebook and you want to print a page on another website. If you have a website page that doesn't print the full layout, the second option to Screen Capture the full layout and print it on your Printer.
- Next explains more about Screen Capture.

- To Screen Capture the page, there are different programs, like Snipping Tool or PicPick. Once you Screen Caption with Snipping Tool or PicPick, they allow you to print to your Printer. They also allow you to print it to PDF file. That's why I recommend doing Snipping Tool or PicPick to print the full layout page with your printer or print to PDF file vs. Browsers. There is a Tip – How to Screen Capture a page and Print it with Snipping Tool and PicPick. If you don't have PicPick, the Tip explains how to download it. Note – Snipping Tool comes with most computers.
- Next explains more about links on a page you want to print.

- If you have a website page with links, and you have a PDF Reader, you can print to PDF file.
 When you print to PDF file, Google Chrome and Opera Browsers are the only ones that the links work on the PDF file printer.
