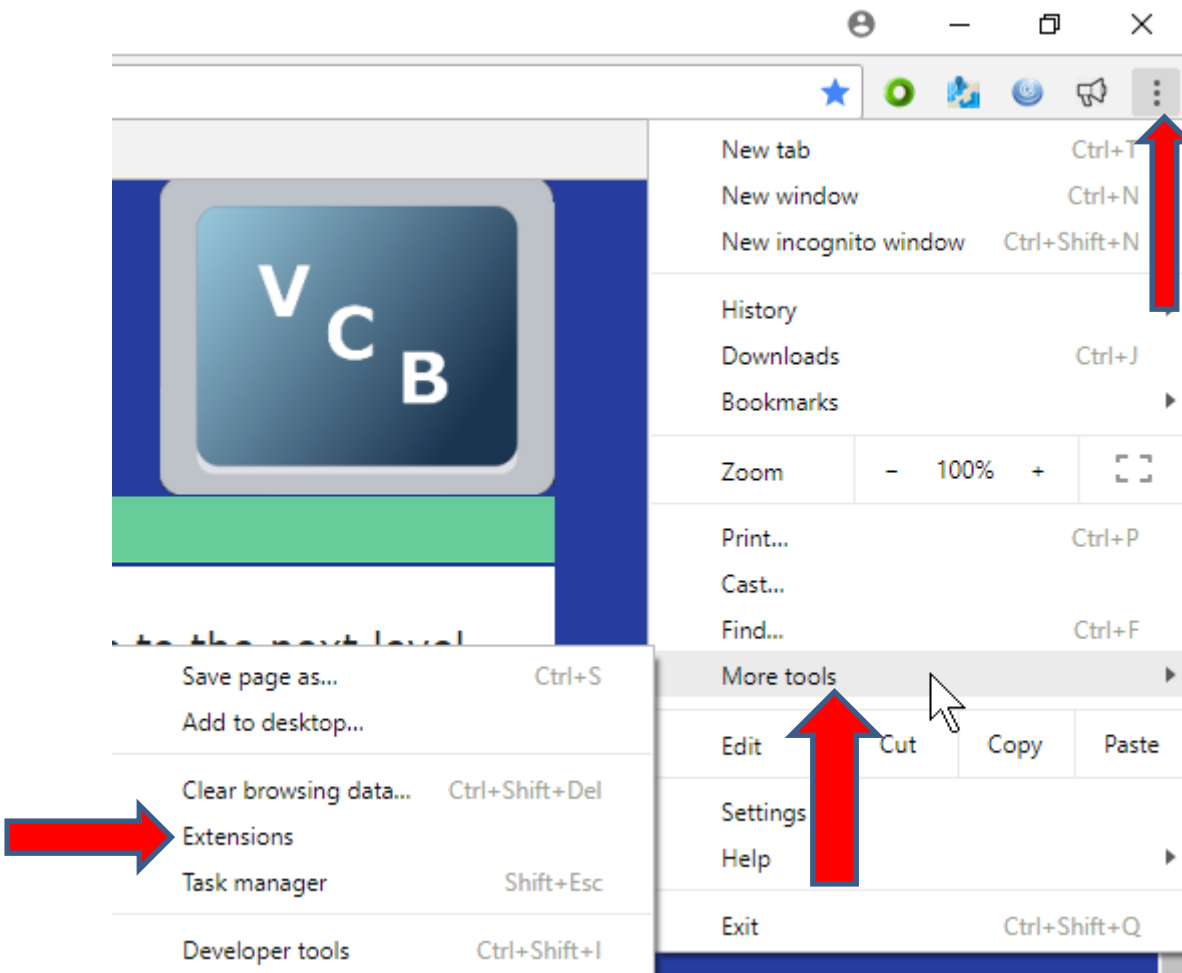


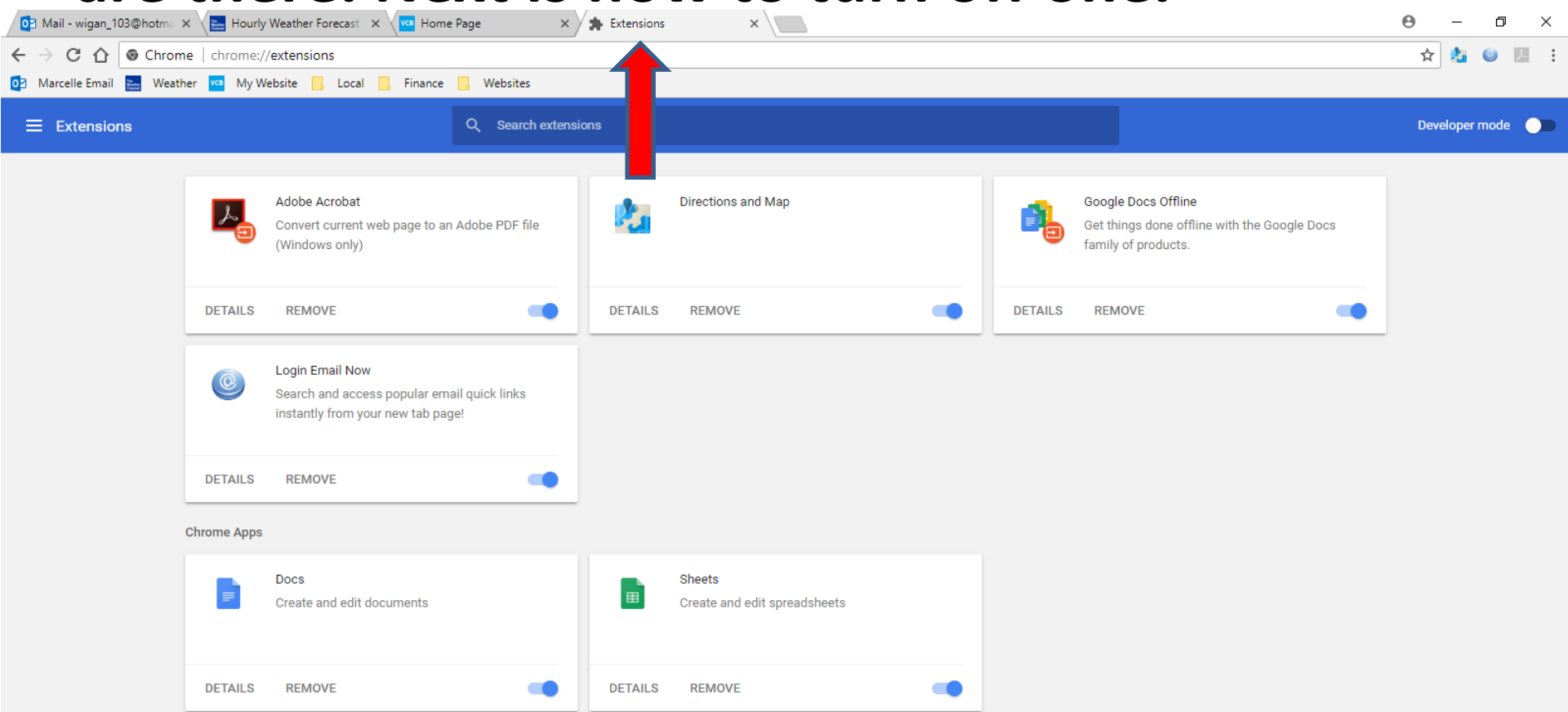
Step 5 – How to add and change Add-ons or Extensions with Google Chrome.

- As I mentioned in the Introduction, if you download a program from ninite.com, it is safe and it does not add Extensions. If you download a program from another website, sometimes it adds an Extension and it may not be safe. Also, when you click on a link in your e-mail or a website, sometimes it adds Extensions. That's why you should check the Extensions and check them again after you download a program.**
- Next I will show you how to get to Extensions and turn off them or remove them. Make sure Google Chrome is open.**

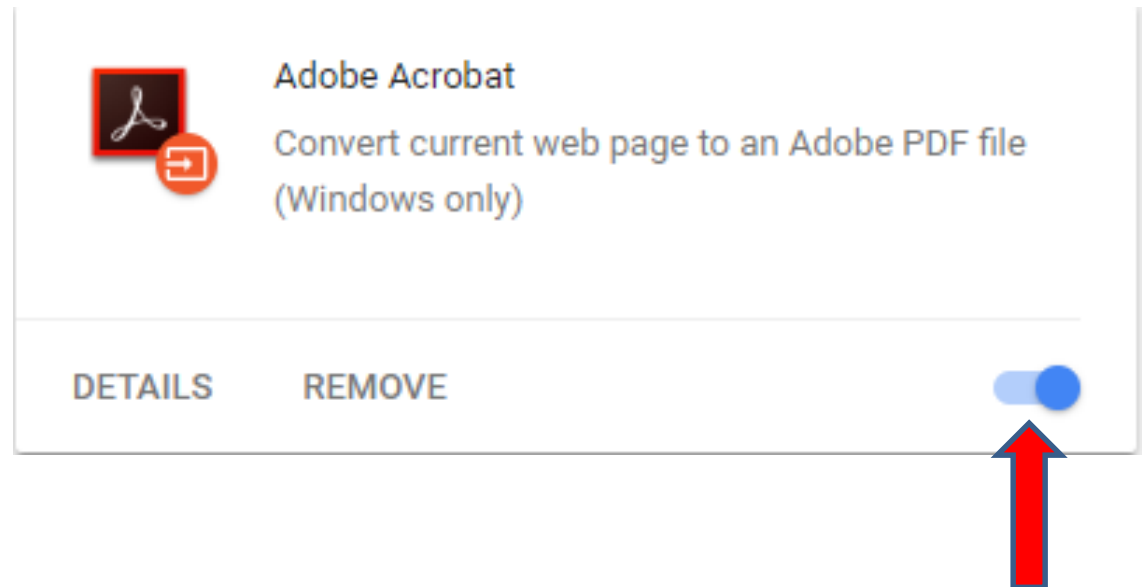
- You click on the Icon in the upper right that I showed you in other Steps and then hover over More tools or click on it and you see a list and click on Extensions. Next is what happens.



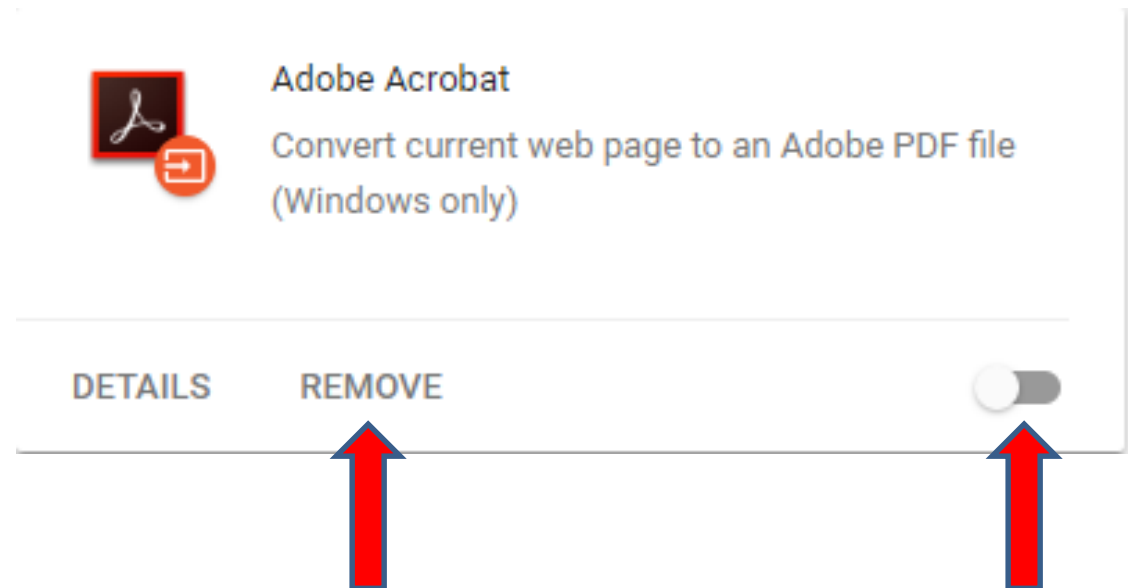
• When you click on Extensions, a new page opens and you see a list of Extensions if you have them. I have a Google account, that's why some of them are there. Next is how to turn off one.



- I zoom in so you can see one. You see an icon on the right highlighted, which is on. You click on it to turn it off and is a sample of clicking on it.



- Here is a sample of clicking on it and the color changed and it is off. As I mentioned before, when you download a program from another website or when you click on a link in your e-mail or a website, you may see a new Extension, which may not be Safe. To remove it, click on REMOVE at the bottom. Next explains what happens.



- **When you click on REMOVE, it removes it. Sometimes a new Tap page opens, depending on the Extension. If a new Tap page opens, I recommend you click on X next to it to close it. Note – I did not REMOVE one, because I did not have one that I downloaded. Next is how to add Extensions as I mentioned in the Introduction.**

- You click on the Icon left of Extensions in the upper left and next is what happens.


