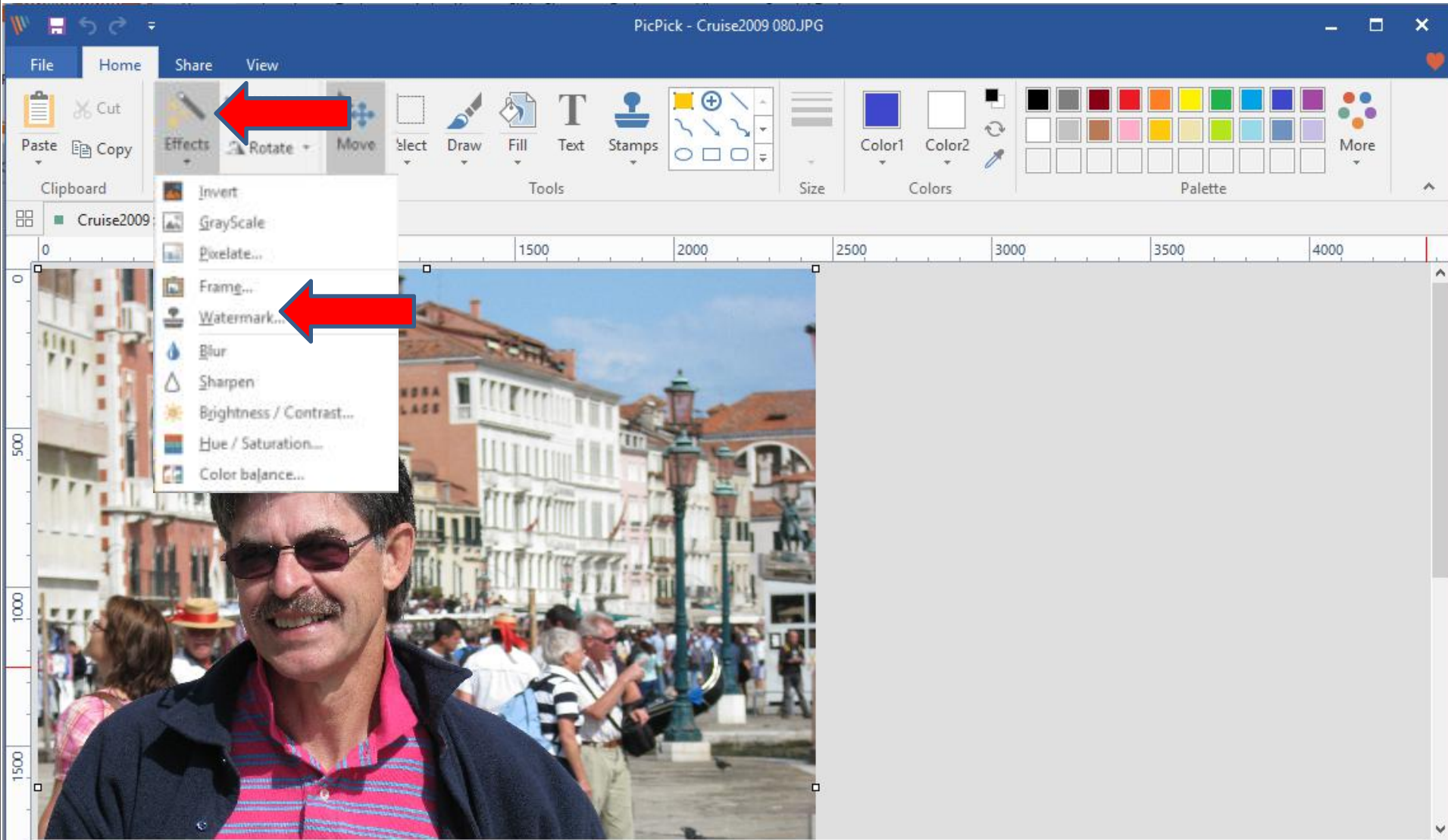


Part 3 – Add other Items.

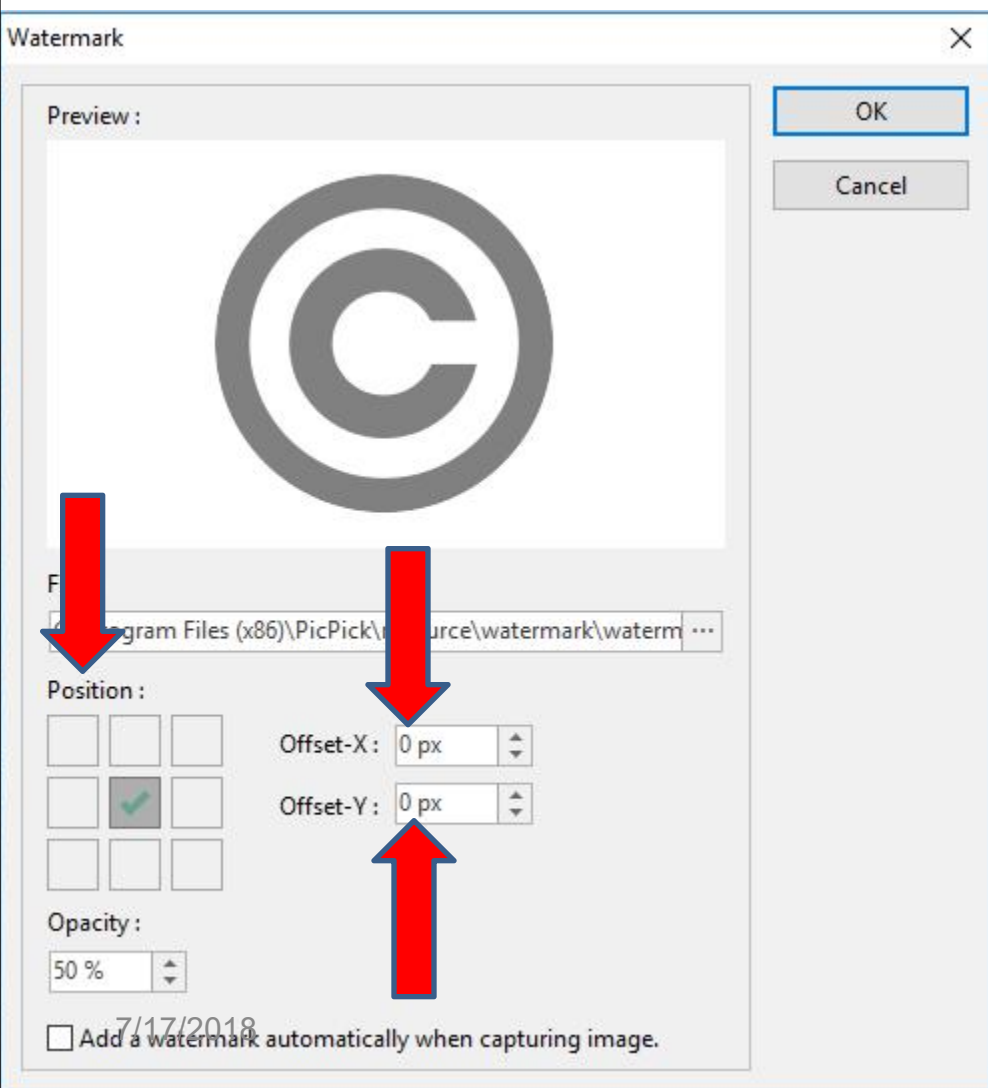
- There are lots of options to add other items on a Picture. I will show you samples.**
- You can use the same Picture on PicPick, or add a new one as I showed you in Step 2 - Part 1.**
- As I mentioned before in Step 2 - Part 1, if you don't have PicPick, hover over Courses again and click on Screen Capture Page and Step 1 shows you how to download PicPick and open PicPick. If you don't have Pictures on your Computer, I recommend you do a Screen Capture and it opens an Image in PicPick. Next is more.**

- **Once complete, I recommend you Save As vs. Save, so you keep the original photo. As I mentioned before, Step 1 - Part 1 shows you how to Save As.**
- **Next is the first sample with the same Picture in Part 2 in the new version of PicPick. Note - I Undo everything in Part 2.**

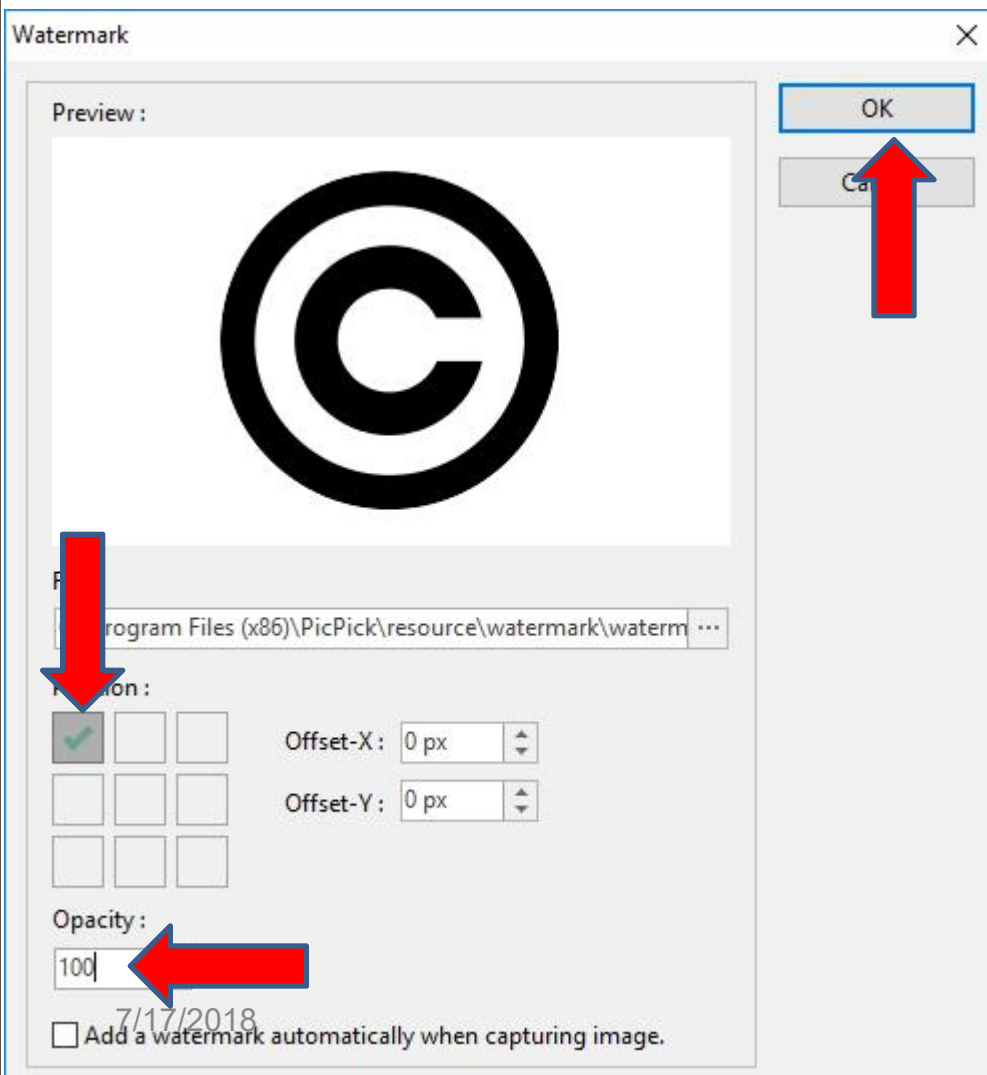
• You click on Effects again as I showed you before and then click on Watermark and next is what happens.



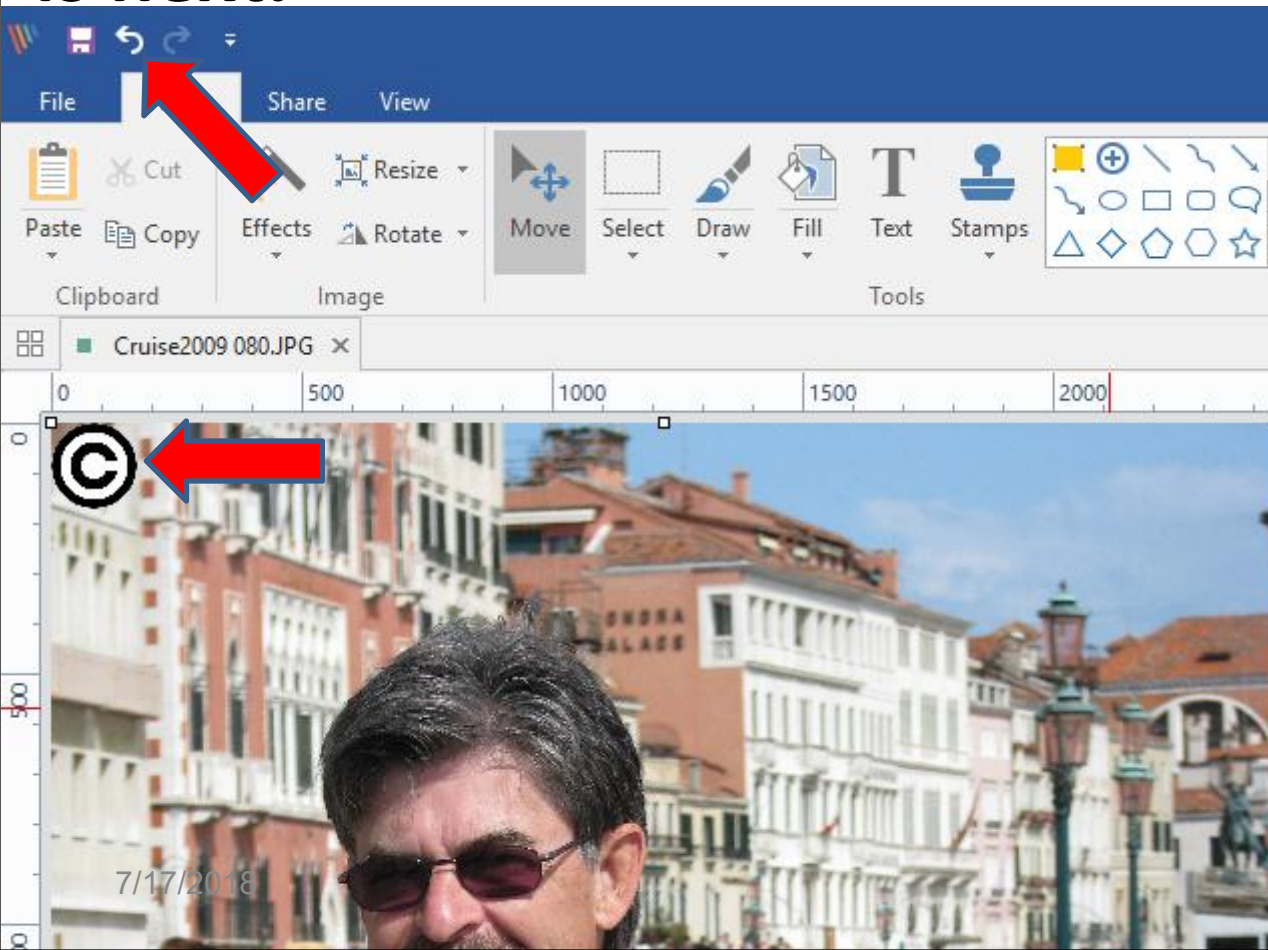
- Once you click on it, a new window opens.
- You have options to change Position, Opacity.
- Offset – X, allows you to move it slightly to the right.
- Offset – Y, allows you to move it slightly below.
- Next is a sample of change.



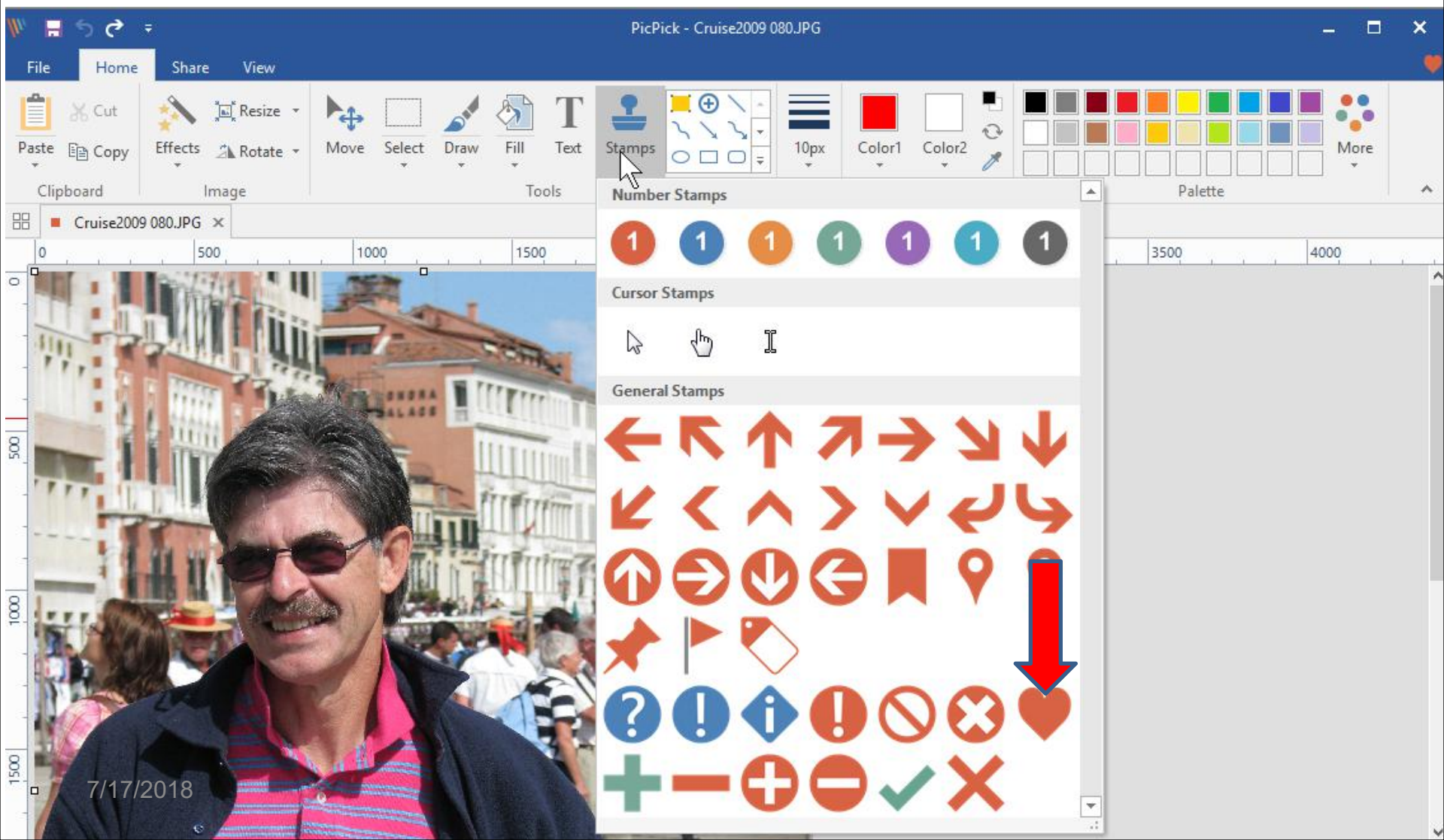
- I change Position to upper left.
- I clicked on the line under Opacity and typed in 100 and you see the color is more black.
- Once complete, click on OK in the Upper Right and next is what happens.



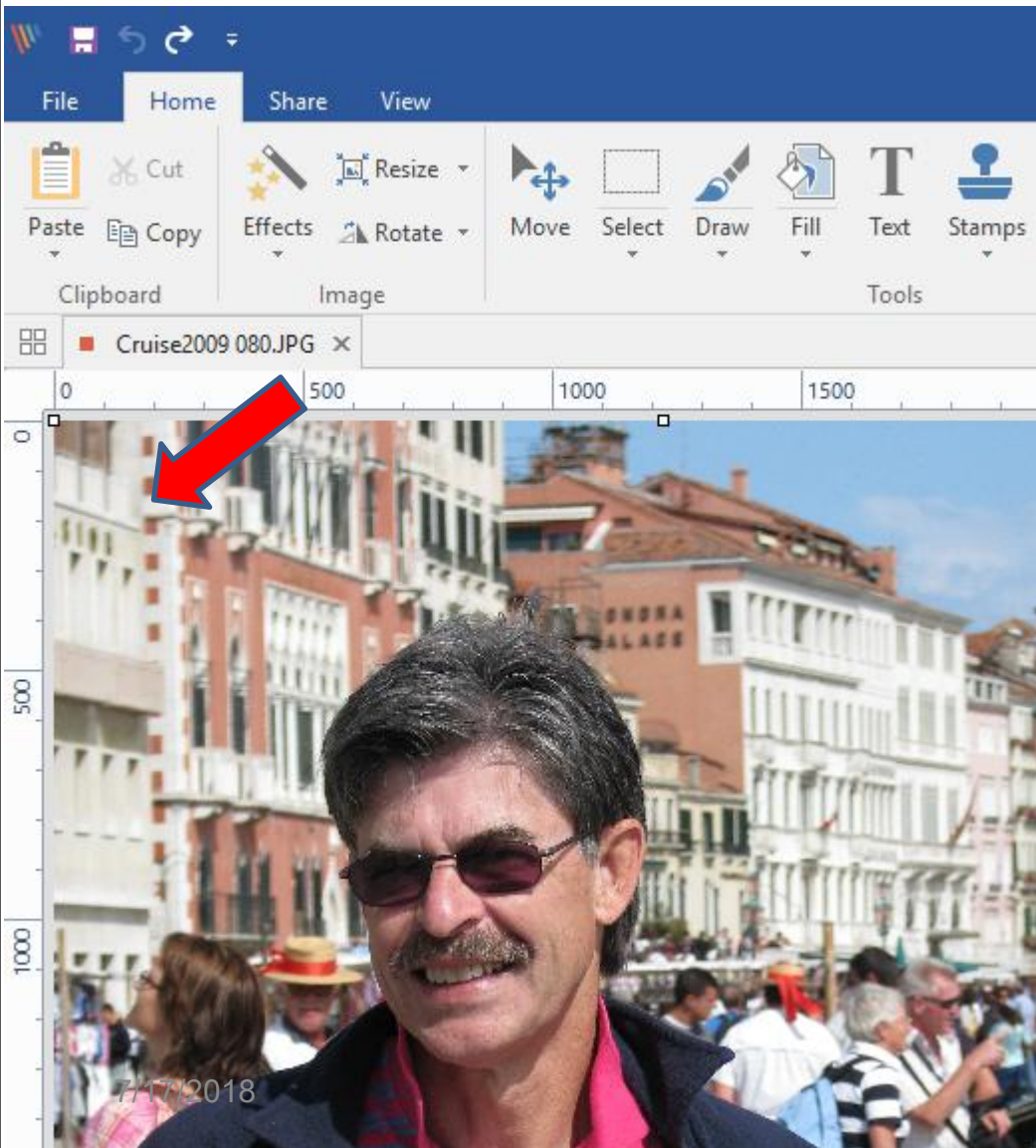
Once you on OK, the window closes and you see it in the upper left. I decided to click on the Undo in the upper left to remove it, as I showed you before. The reason is to show you other Stamps options, which is next.



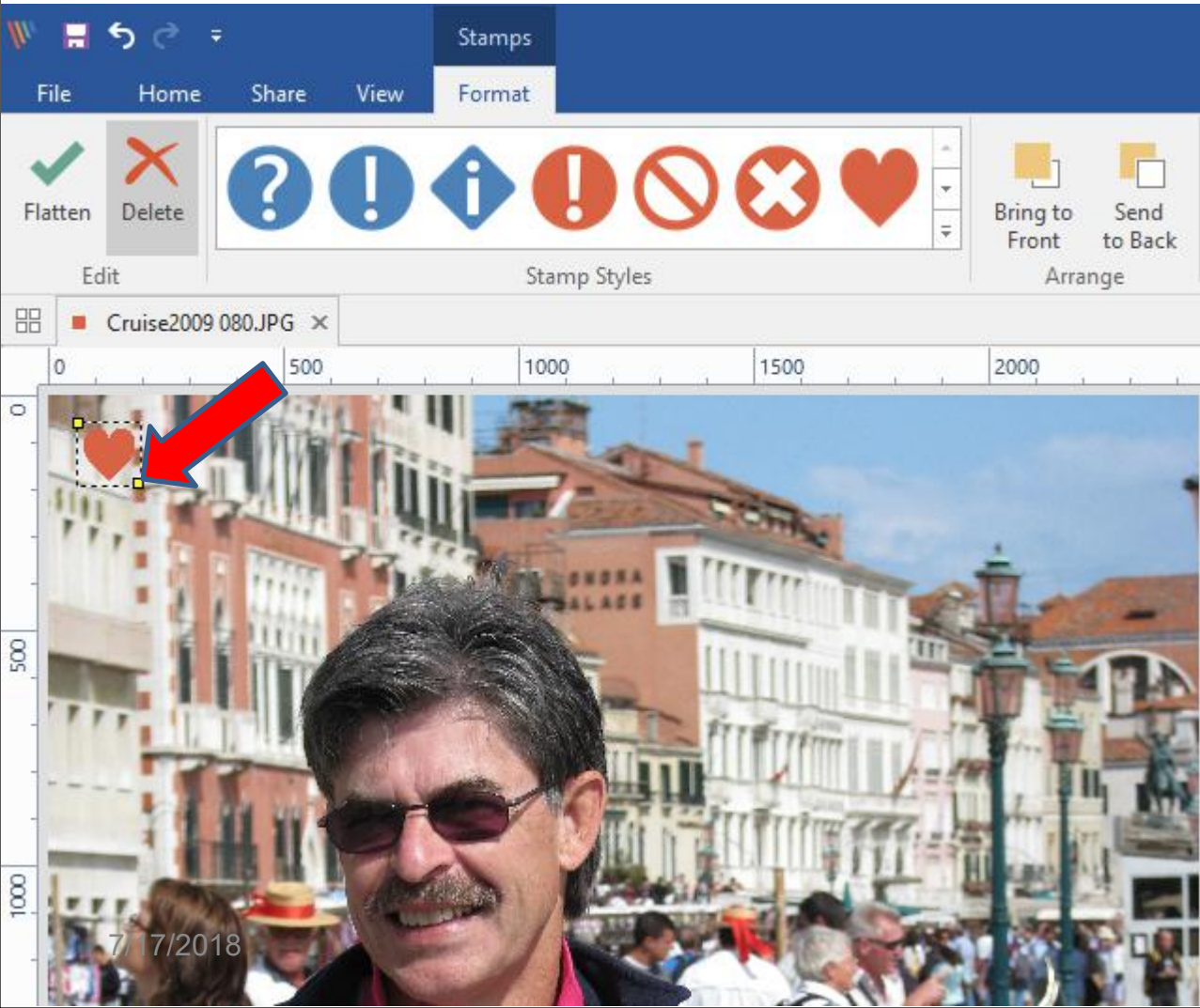
- First click on Stamps again and you see a list of options again. You click on one you want, like this one at the bottom, which is next.



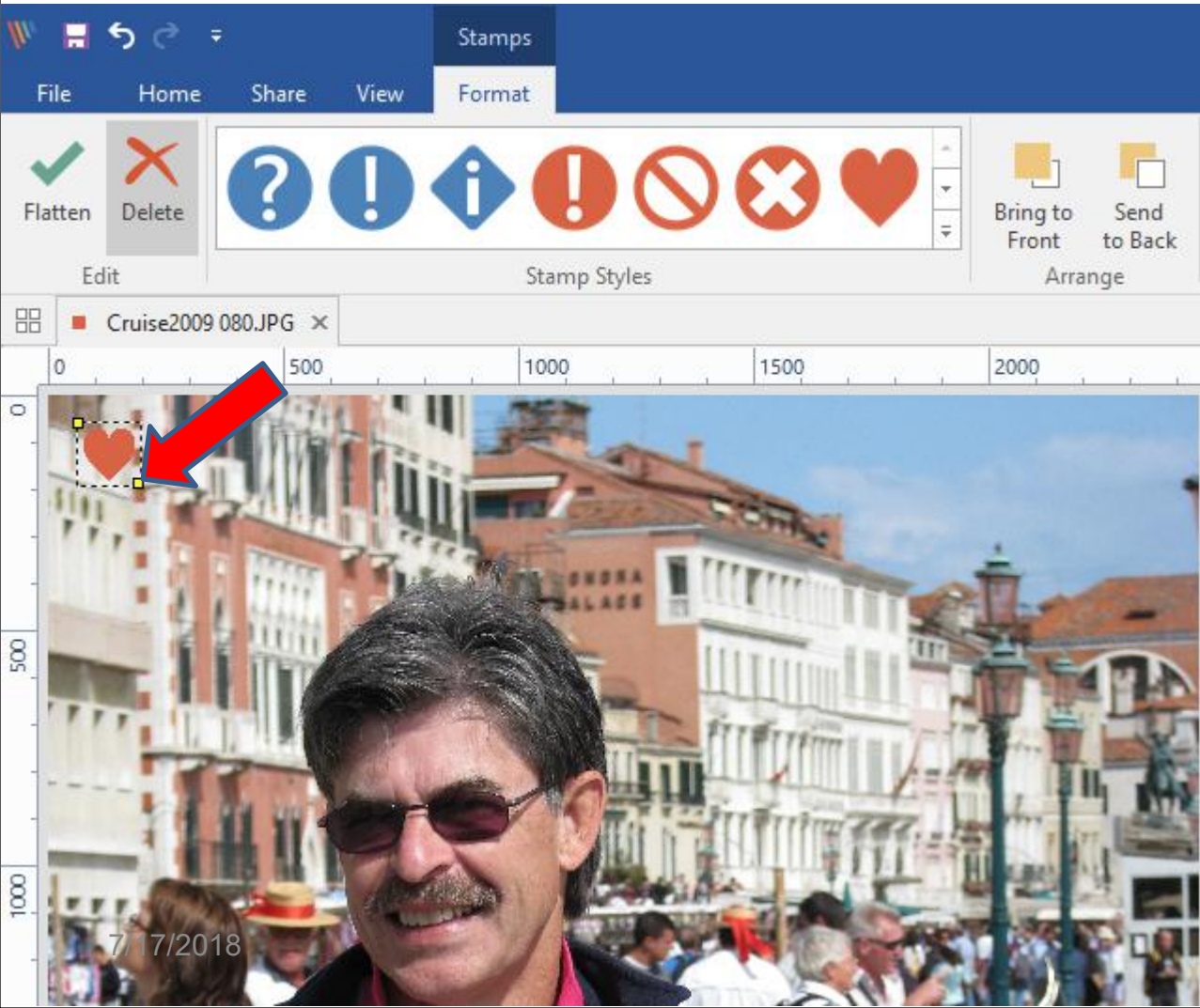
- **Window closes again and you move your cursor to where you want, like the upper left and then left click and next is what happens.**



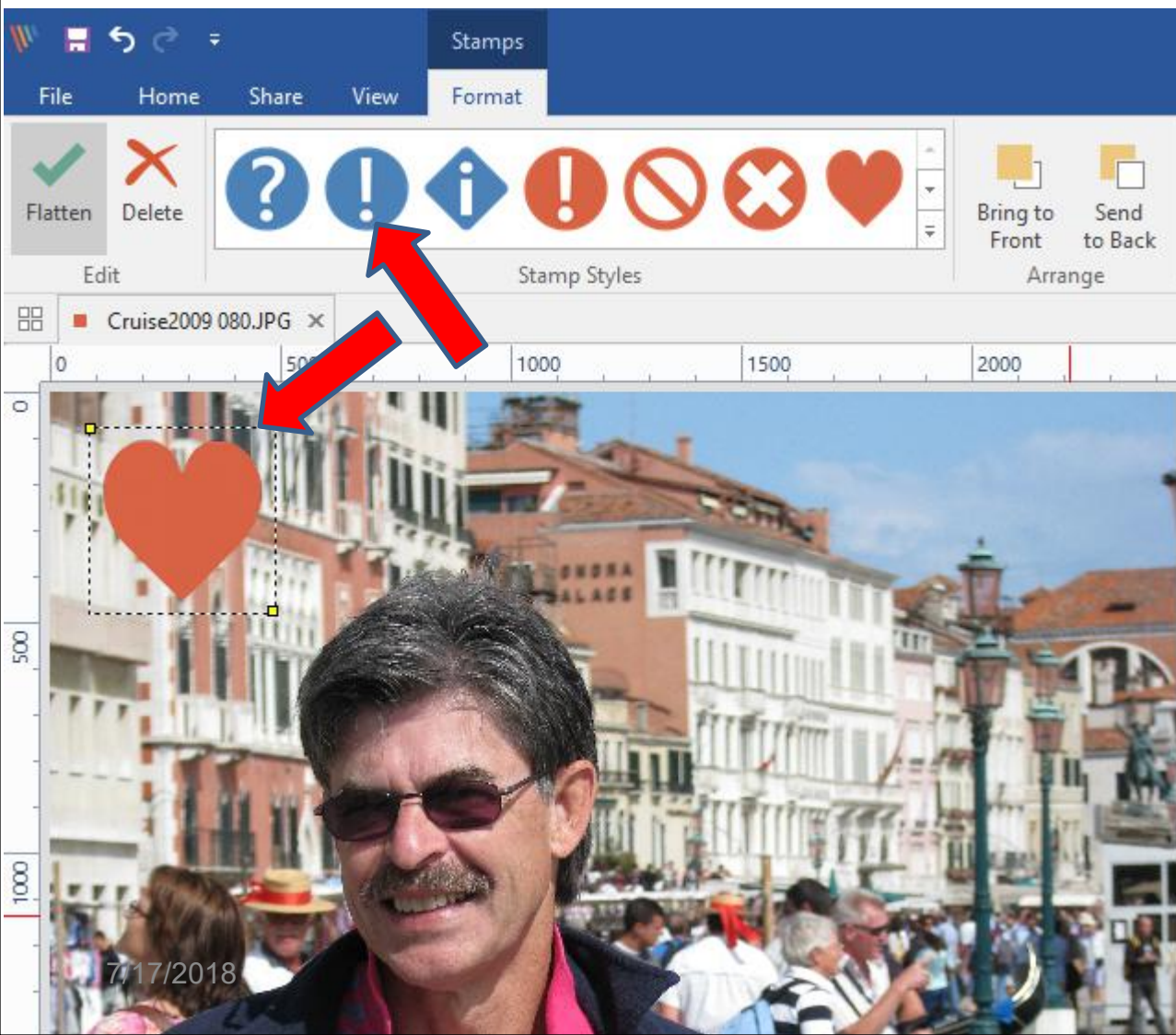
- You see it and it is small and a new Tab opens called Format. You can make it larger. Next is how to make it larger.



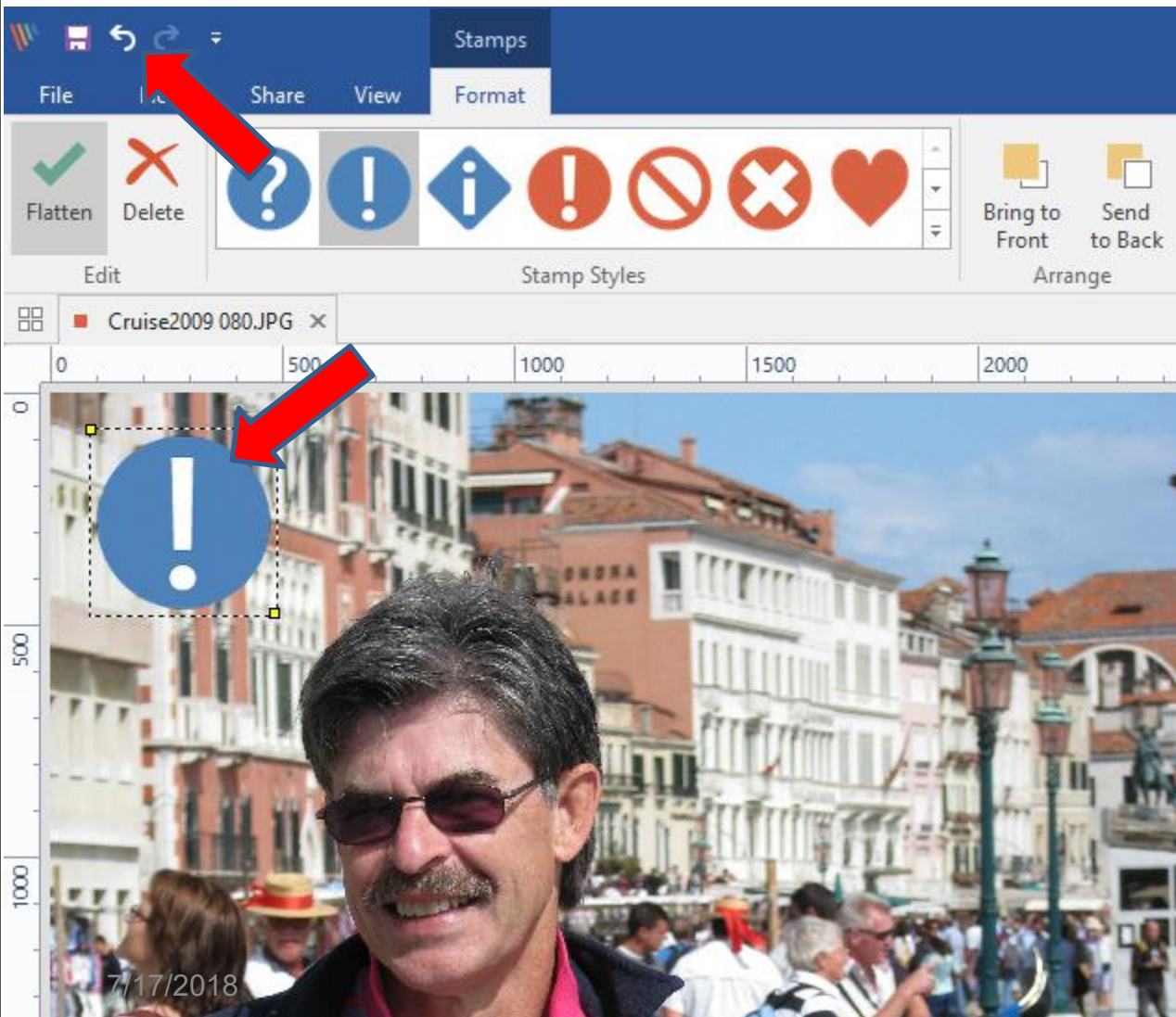
- You left click on the line of it on the lower right and hold it down and drag it to the right and down and let it go. Next is a sample.



- You then see it larger. You then can click on another one under Format, like this one and next is what happens.



- It changes to the new one and the size is the same. You then can click on any other one you want. If you don't like anyone, click on Undo Icon again. If you like one, next is what to do.



- **If you like one, you can Save or Save As. As I mentioned before in Part 1 and Part 2, Step 1 - Part 2 shows you how to Save and Step 1 - Part 1 shows you how to Save As. In the Screen Capture page there is a link on Step 10 with a PDF file that shows how to Copy and Paste and Print.**
