Games for Windows 10



 You click on it and next is what happens.







When you click on it, a new window opens called Microsoft Store. To find Games, click on Games in the upper left and next is what happens.









 When you click on OK, window changes and you have to type in your password. Once you do that, click on Sign in the lower right and next is what happens.




 If you have a Pin on your Windows 10, like I do, a new window opens and you have to type in the Pin and next is what happens.




 Window closes and you see it is Working to download the game. Once it is complete, next is what happens.



 Once it is complete, you see This project is installed. You then can click on Play to open it. When you close the Microsoft Store and want to play that game again, next is the options to open it.








- Next is what happens when you download the Classic Start Menu.

- When you download the Classic Start Menu, it is the same Icon on the Taskbar as the Start Menu on Windows 10.
- You can change the Icon. To do that, right click on the Icon and next is what happens.




 When you right click on the Icon a new window opens with a list and you see Classic Start Menu at the top of the list. Then click on Settings and next is what happens.




 When you click on Settings the window closes and a new window opens, like File Explorer. I recommend you click on the Box left of Replace Start button and next is a sample.


You see the Box highlighted and you see the Icon has changed. To close the window, click on X in the upper right and next is what happens.




 A new window opens and I recommend you click on yes and next is what happens.


 When you right click on the Taskbar a new window opens and hover over Contana, like I did and then click on Hidden and next is a what happens.




- Window closes and you don't see the search on the Taskbar.
- You click on the Classic Start Menu Icon to find how to search the Simple Solitaire, which is next.








 If you did not close Microsoft Store, like I did not, you can then follow the same process to Search other Games and download them. I will do a second one. You click on Search again and next is what happens again.

 You then see it is Downloading, because I already got to the Microsoft account. Next is what happens when it is complete.




