

- Next is what happens when you Download DVD Styler.

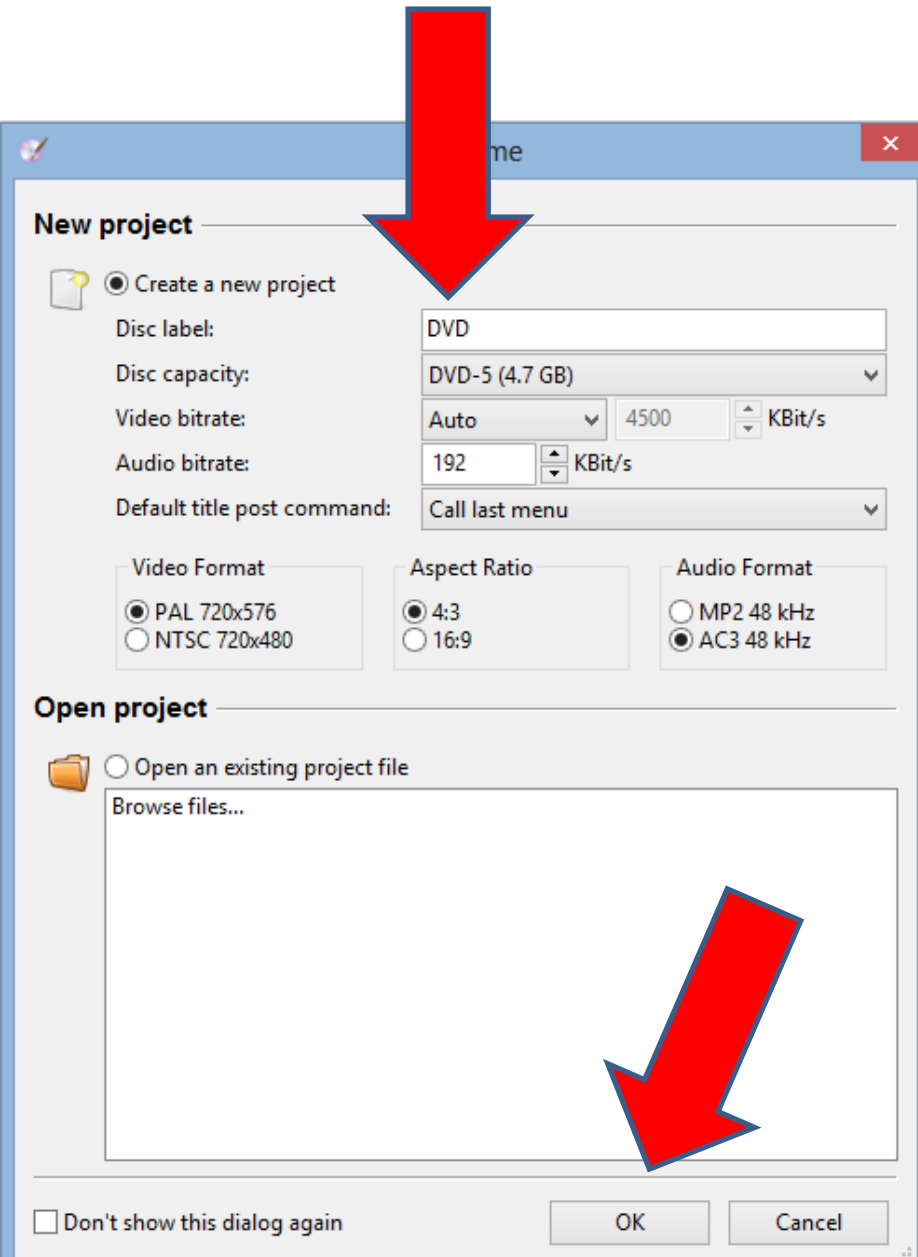

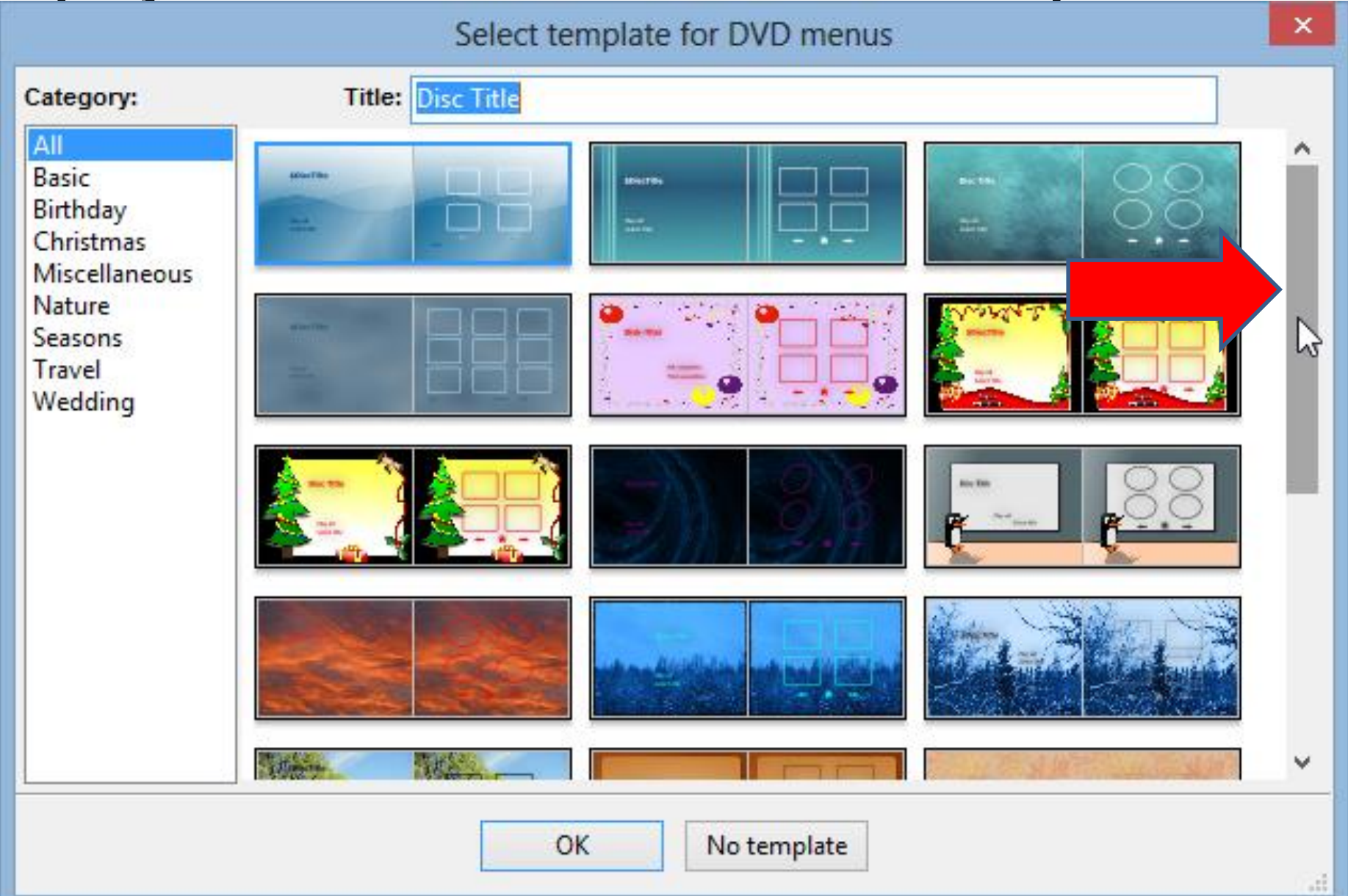
- **When you download it, you will see this Icon on your desktop.**

- **If you have Windows 7, just use Part A.**



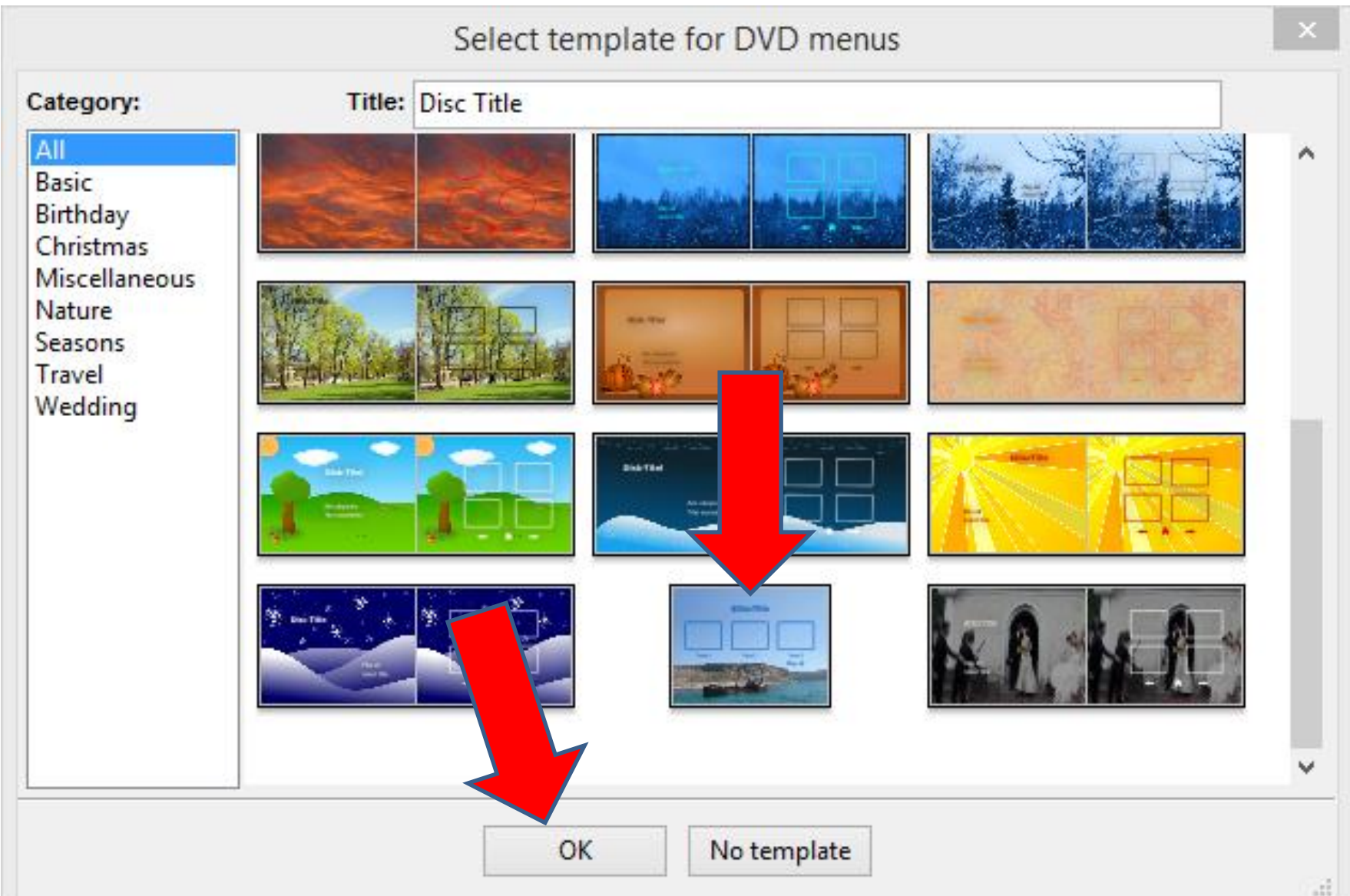


- **When you start it, it shows new project and you can change the label if you want.**
- **Then click on OK on the bottom and next is what happens.**

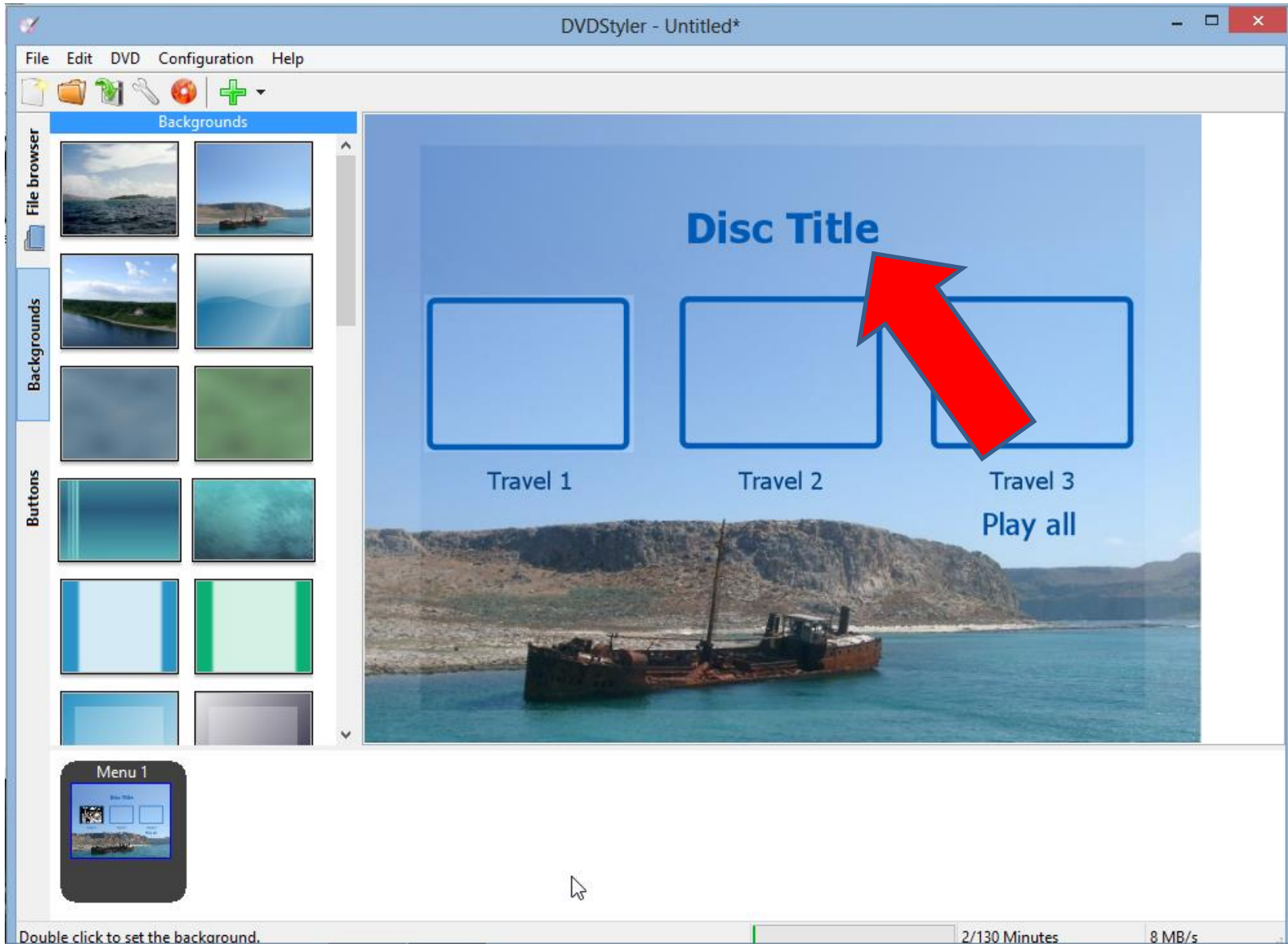
- A new window opens to select a Template for the project. Scroll down and next is a sample.



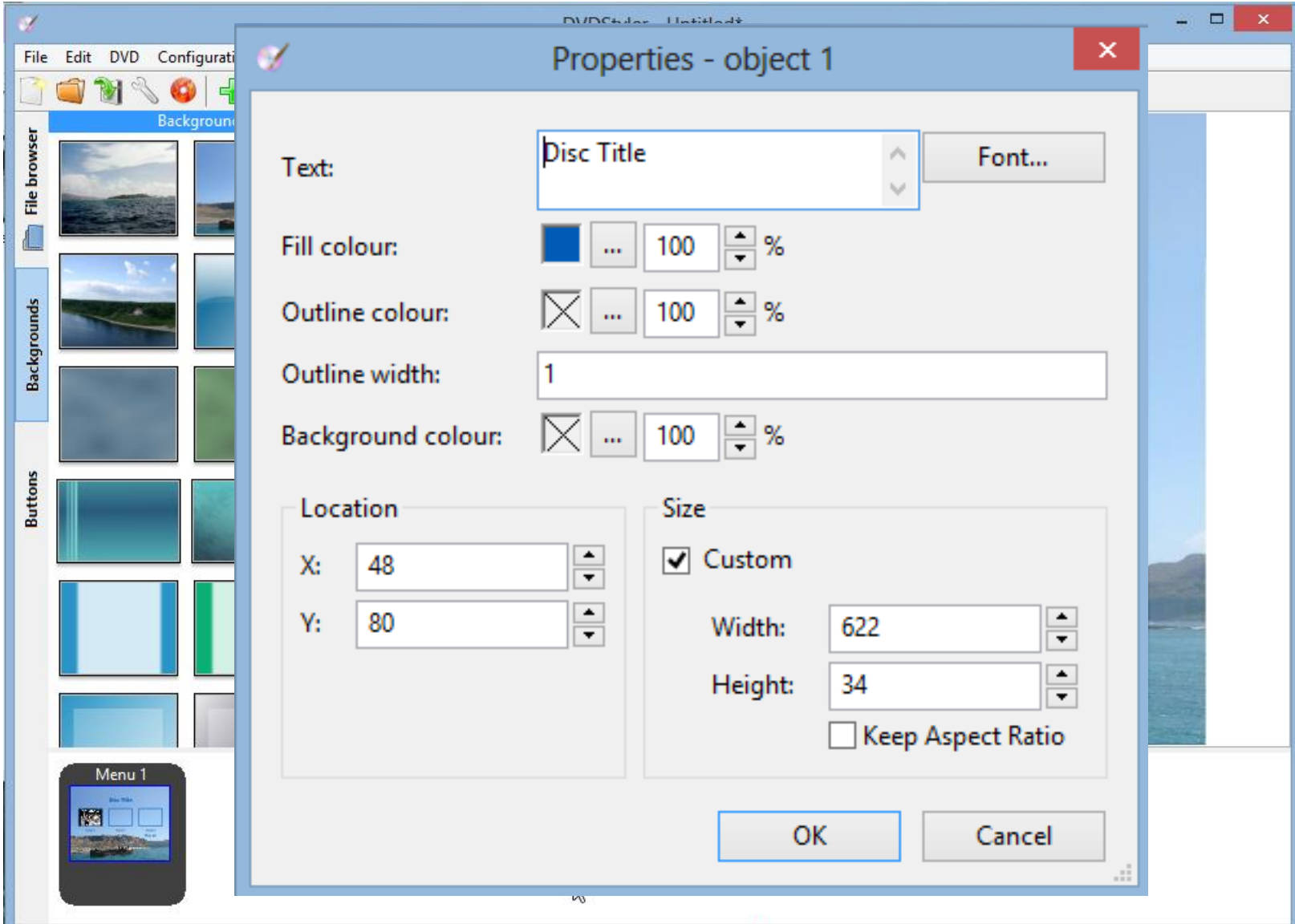
- Click on this one and then click on OK and next is what happens.



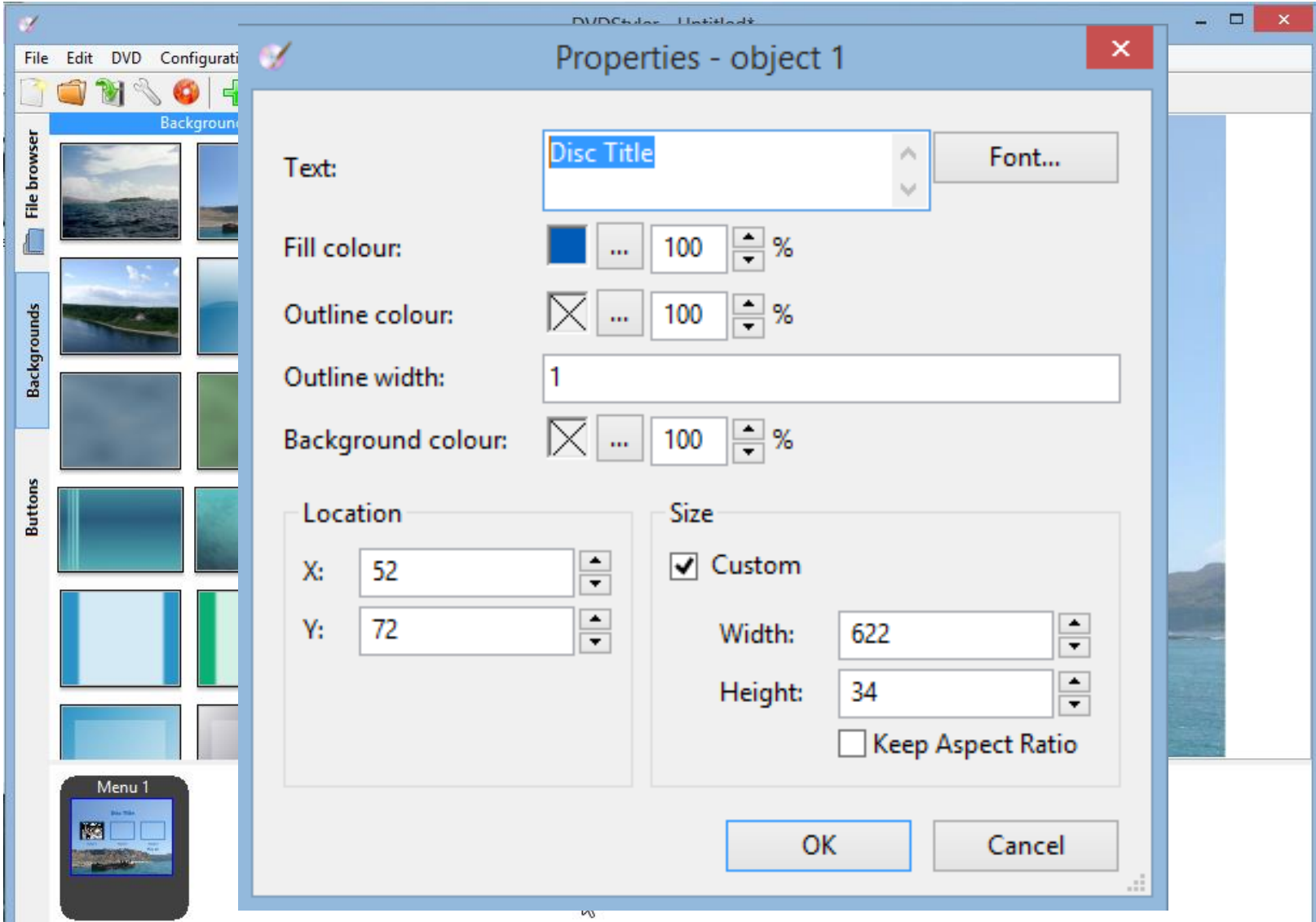
Once you select, it then appears. Here is a sample.
Double Click on Disc Title and next is what happens.



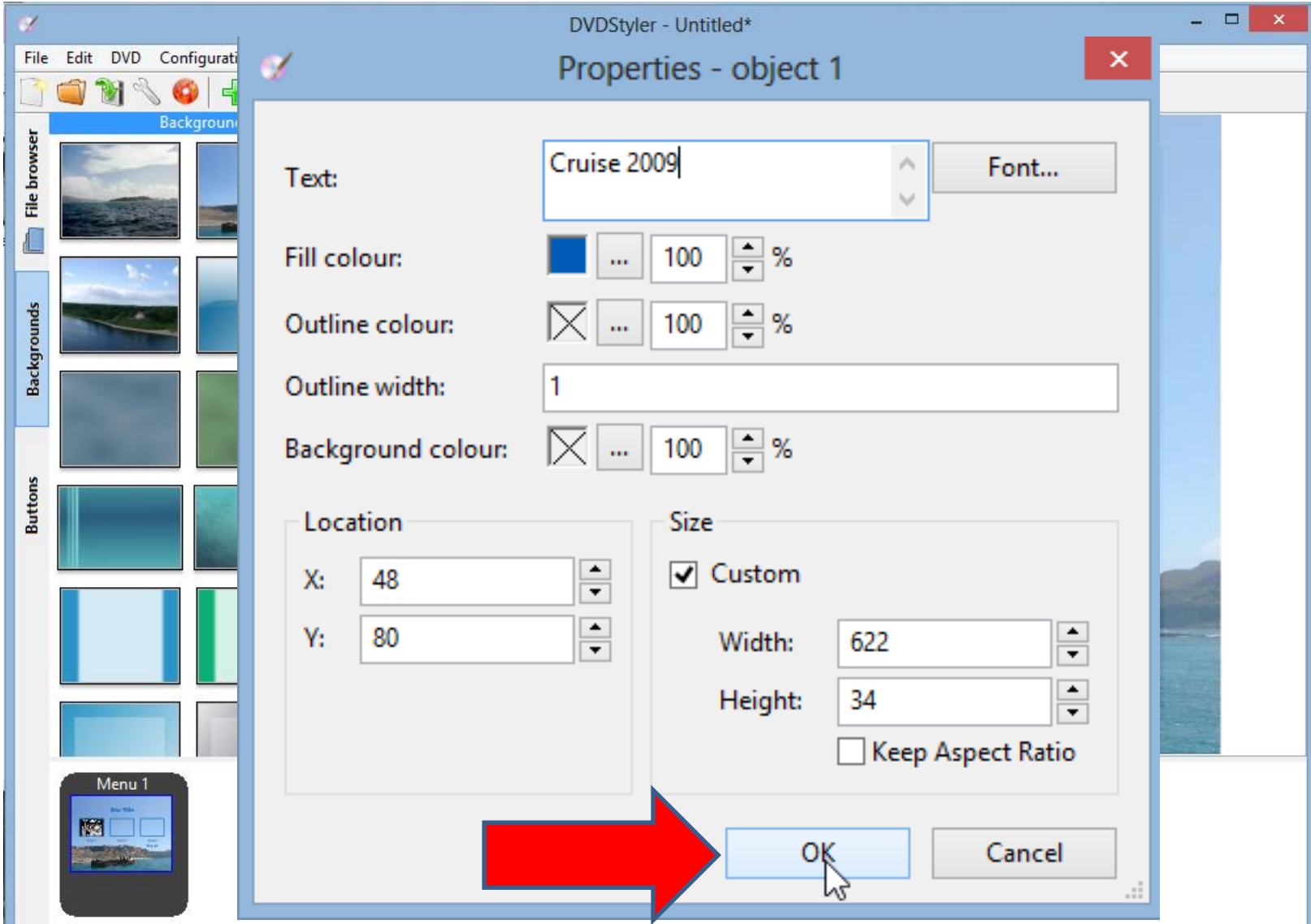
- **New window opens to change Title. Next is to Highlight it.**



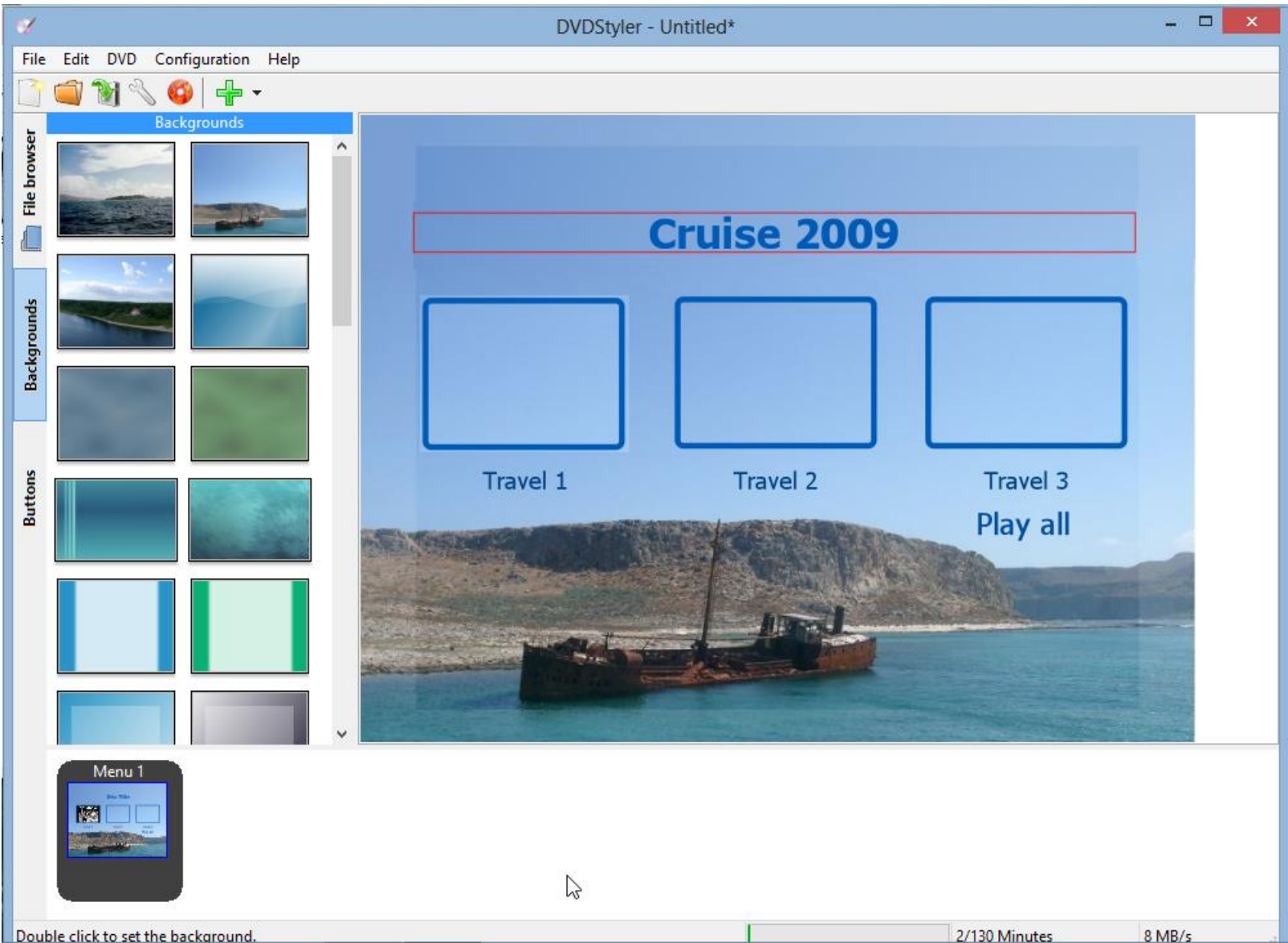
- **Highlight Disc Title and then type in a new Title.**
Next is a sample



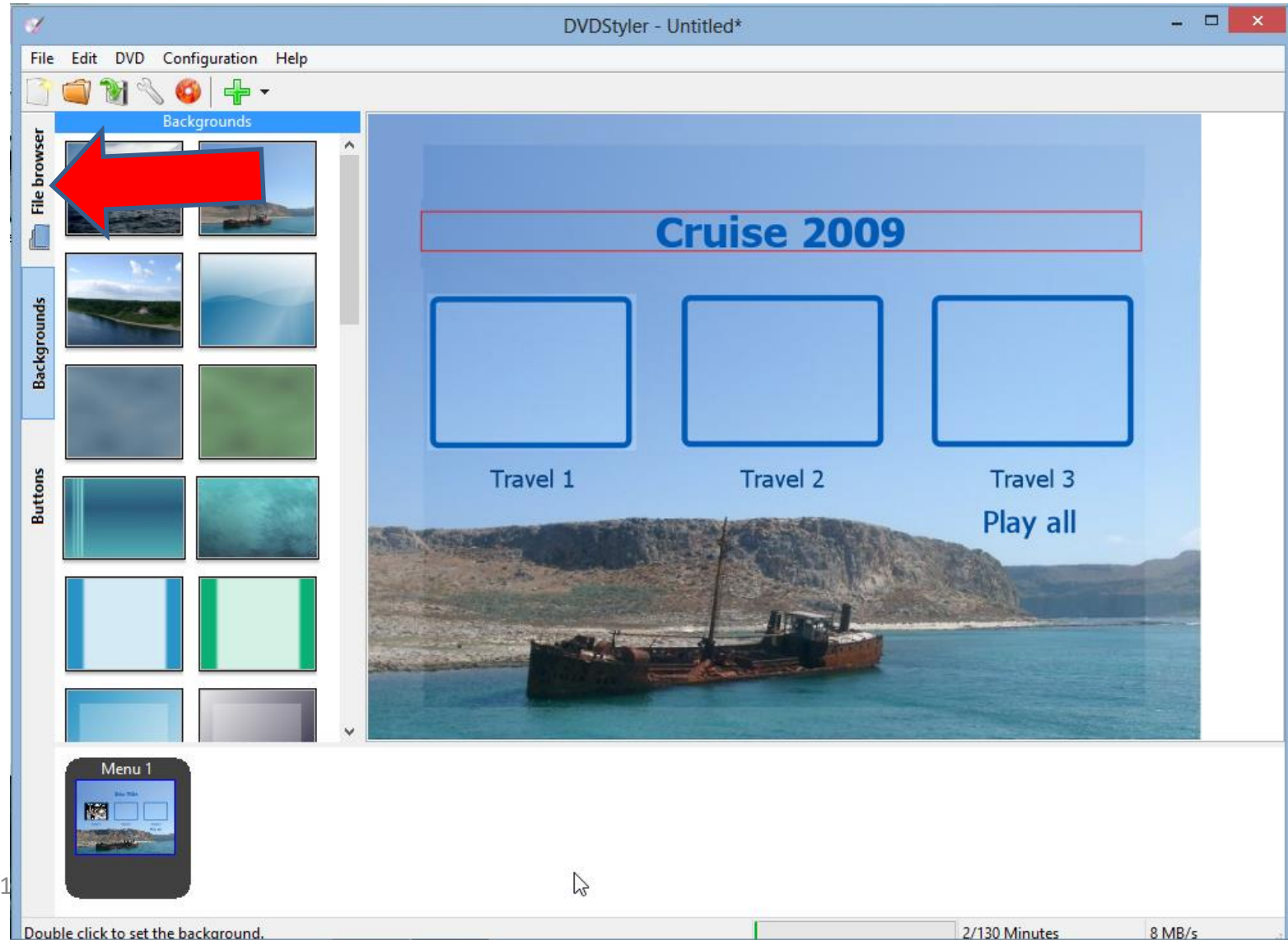
- Here is a sample of Cruise 2009 and then click on OK and next is what happens.



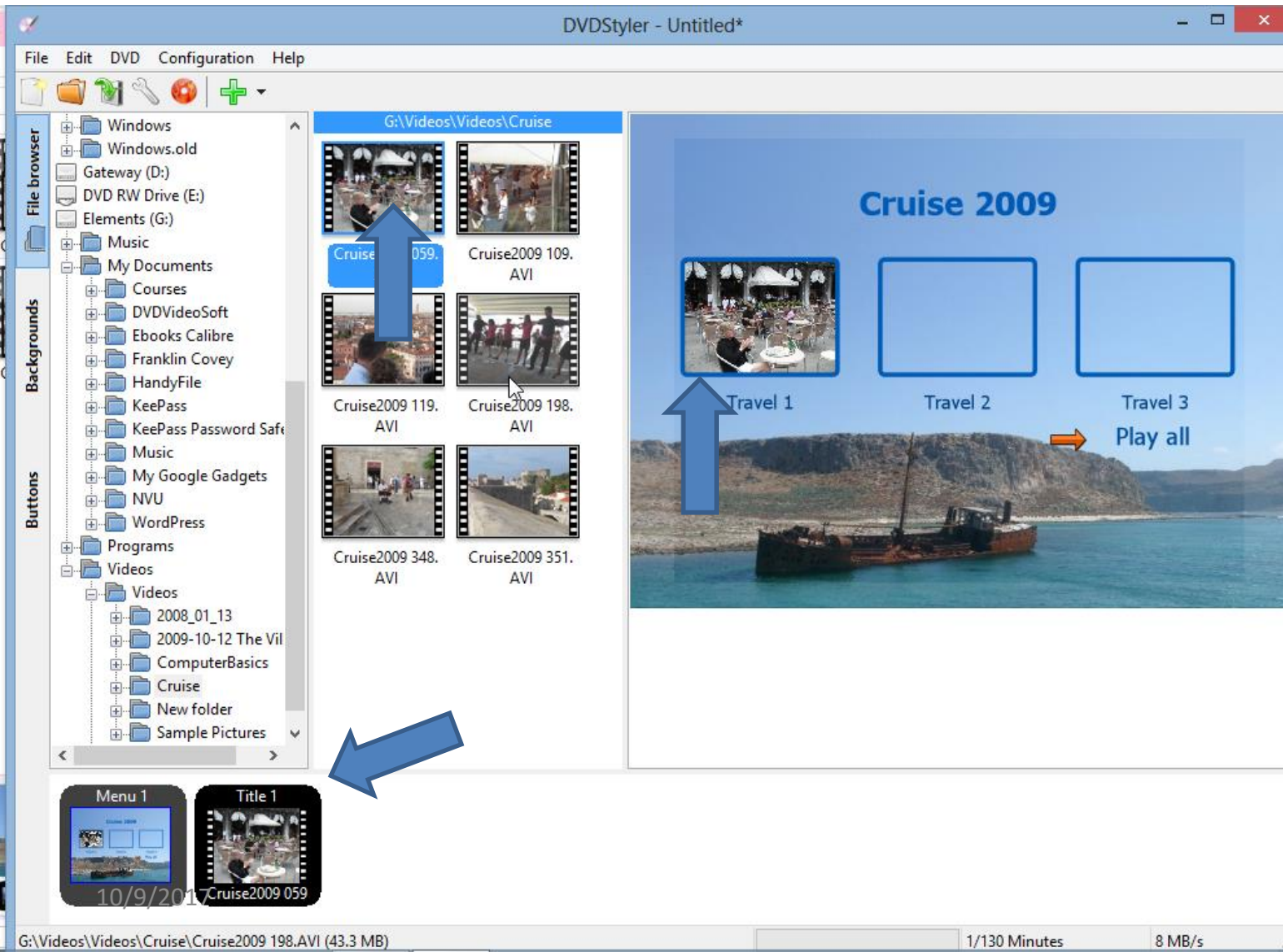
- You then see the change. Next is how to add a Video.



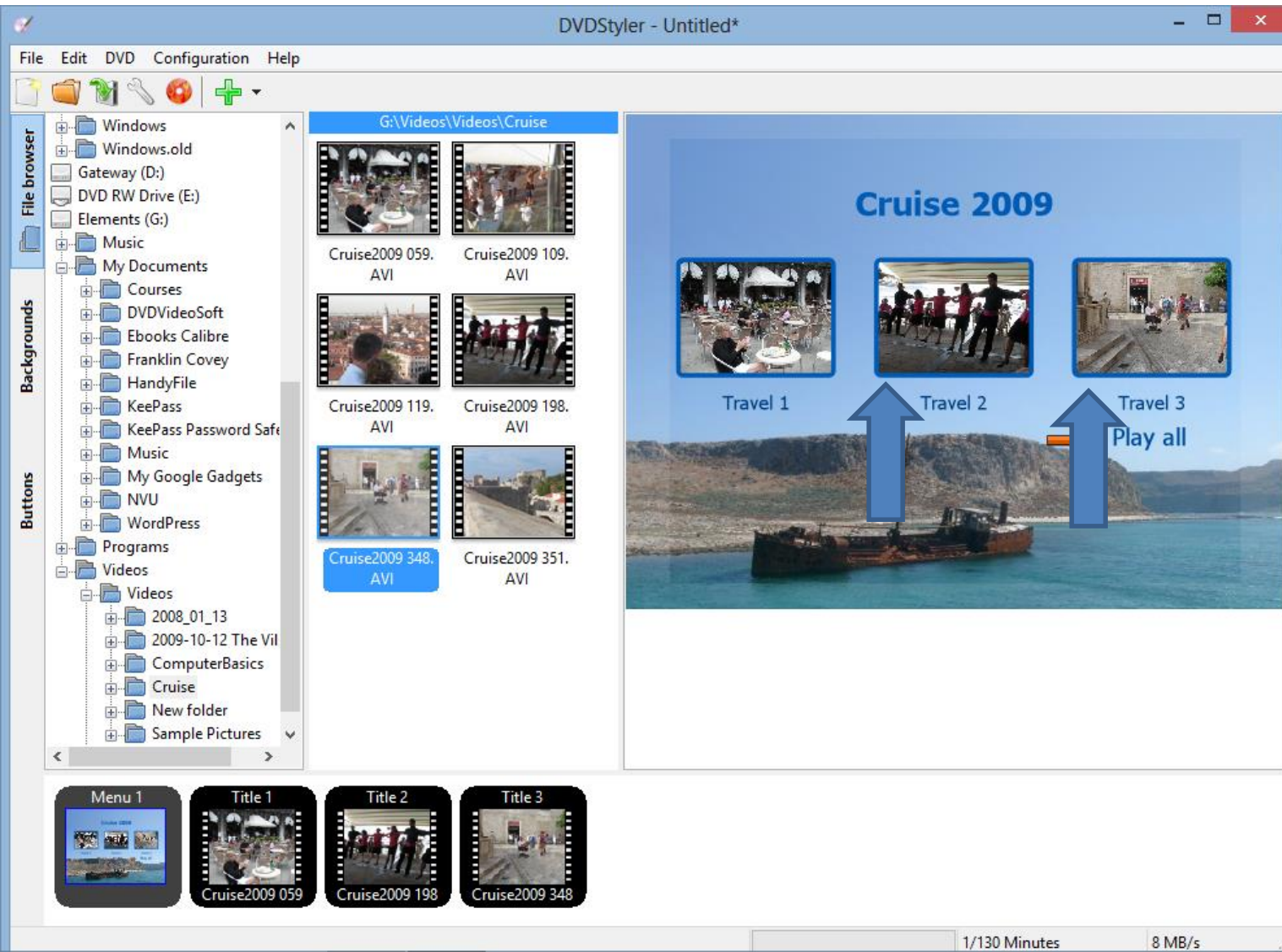
Then click on File browser on the left and next is what happens.



You then go to the folder that has the videos you want. Click on one of them and drag it to the bottom and you see it on the right. Next is to add others.



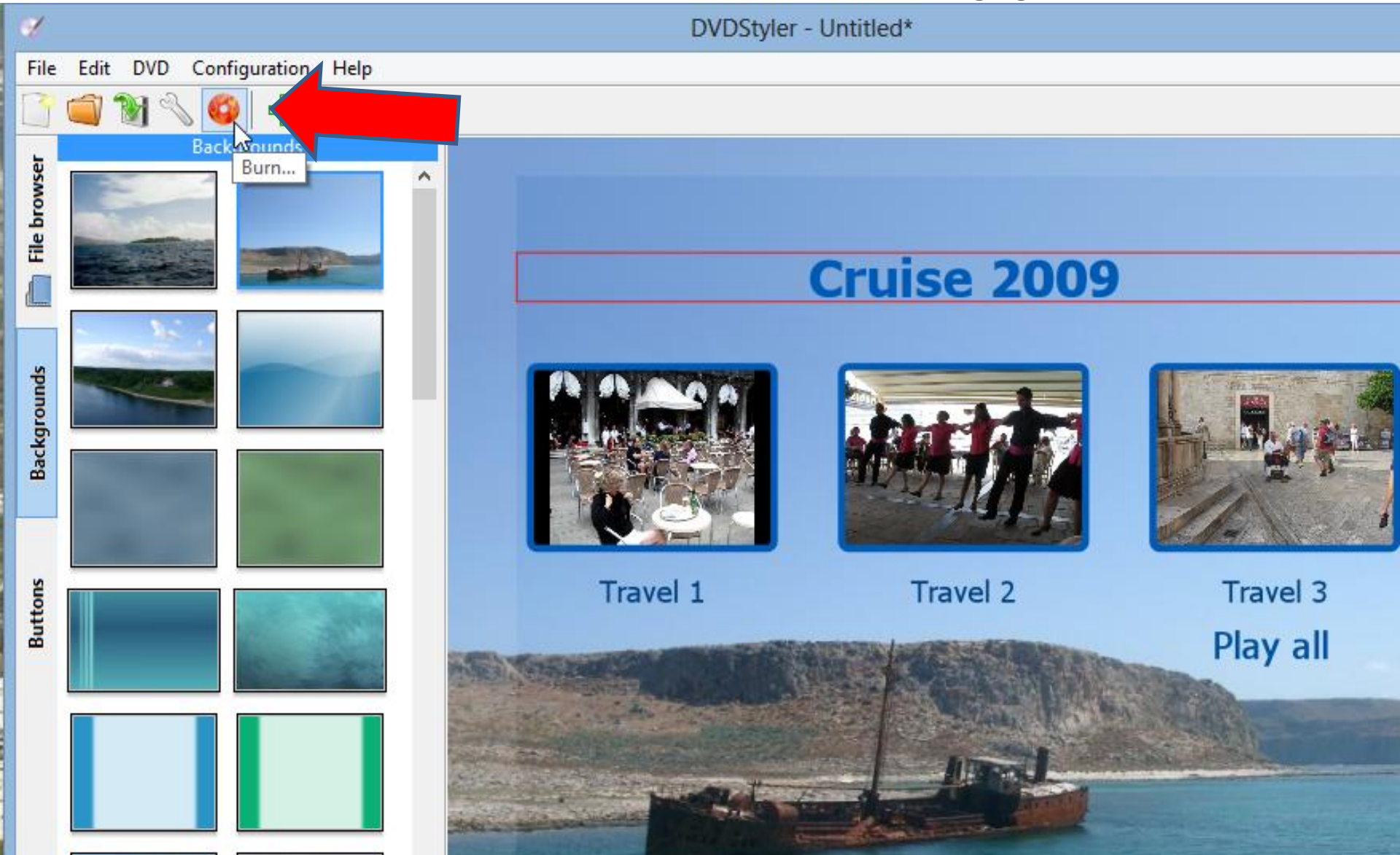
Repeat with two other videos. Note – to drag, you left click and hold it down and then drag it and let it go You then see them on the right. Next is how to add buttons



You can add buttons. Click on button tab on the left and then click on a button and drag it to the right, like the arrow one. Next is how to Burn.



Next click on Burn Icon in the upper left and next is what happens.



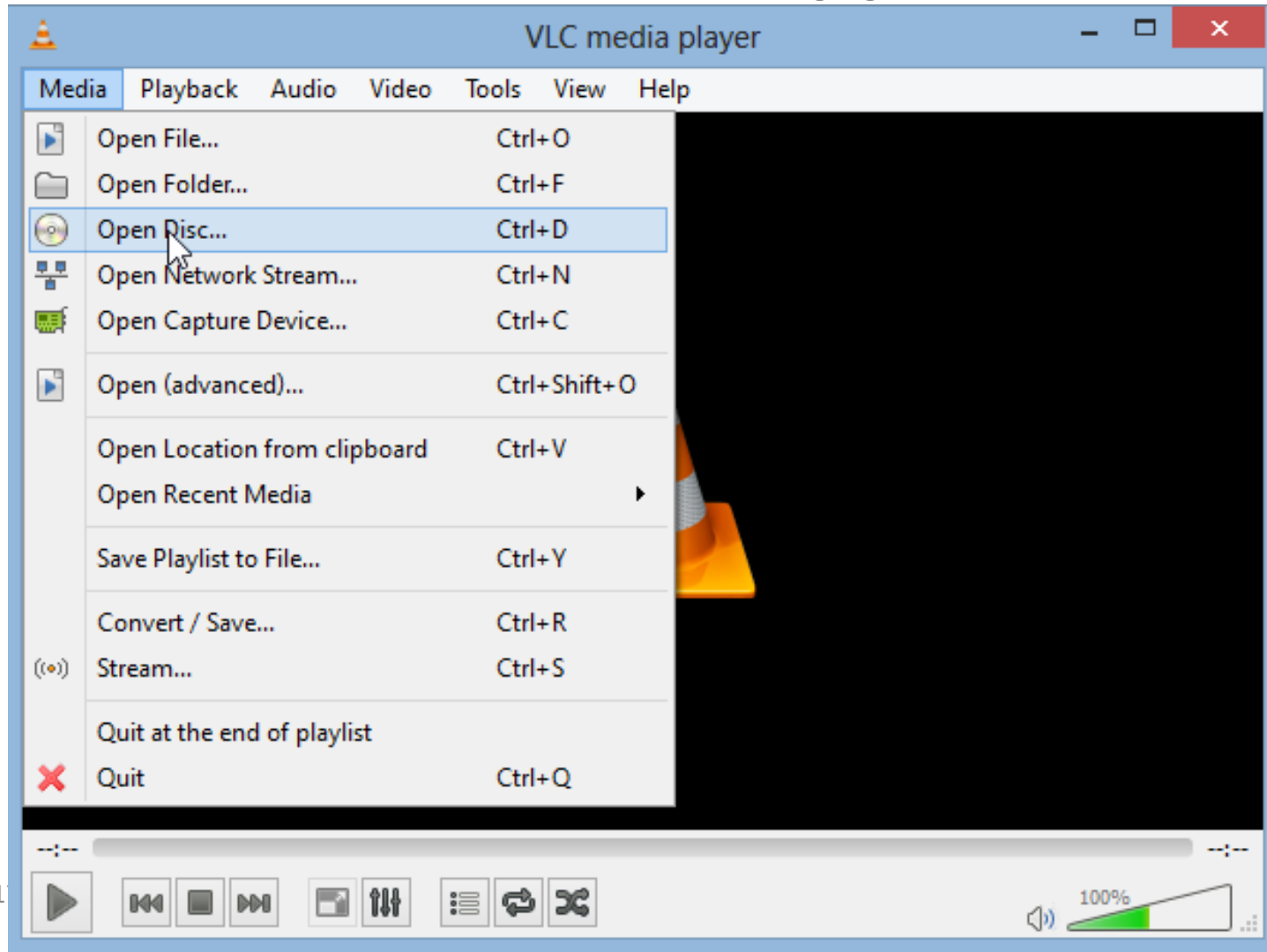
Note – you have to have a DVD inserted, then you see it is in process and next is what happens when it is complete.
