

Step 3 - Part E – How to change Seconds.

- The default is 7 seconds on every slide, like Movie Maker. To change it, first click on Slide Show Tab and then click on Slide Transition. Next is more.

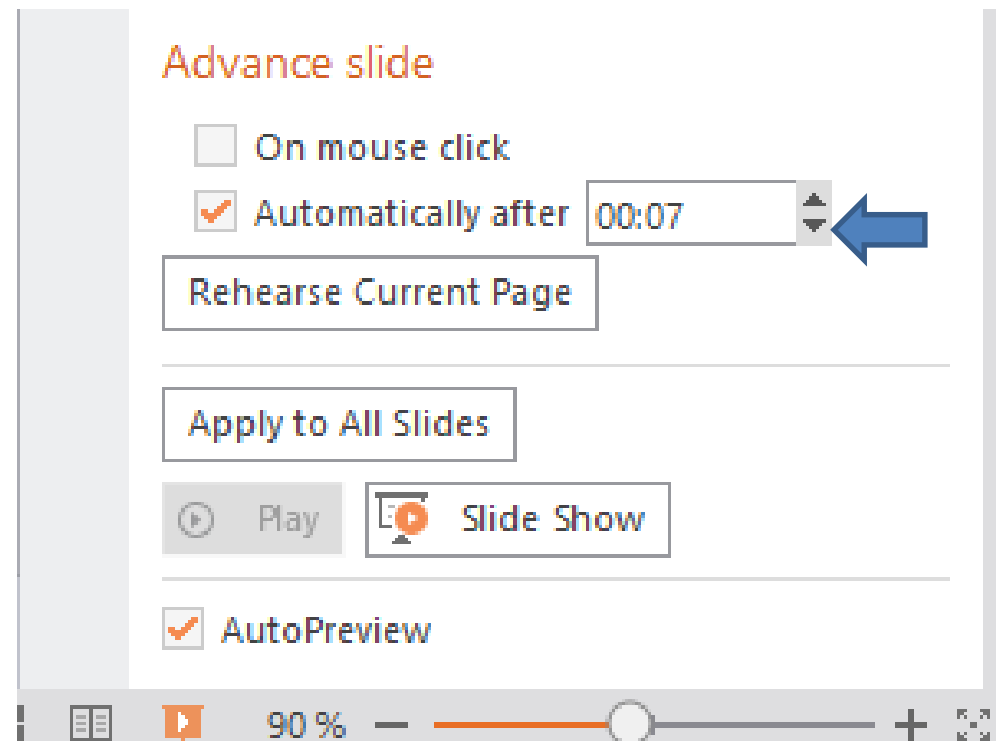
