

# **Step 9 –Animation & Transition Effects**

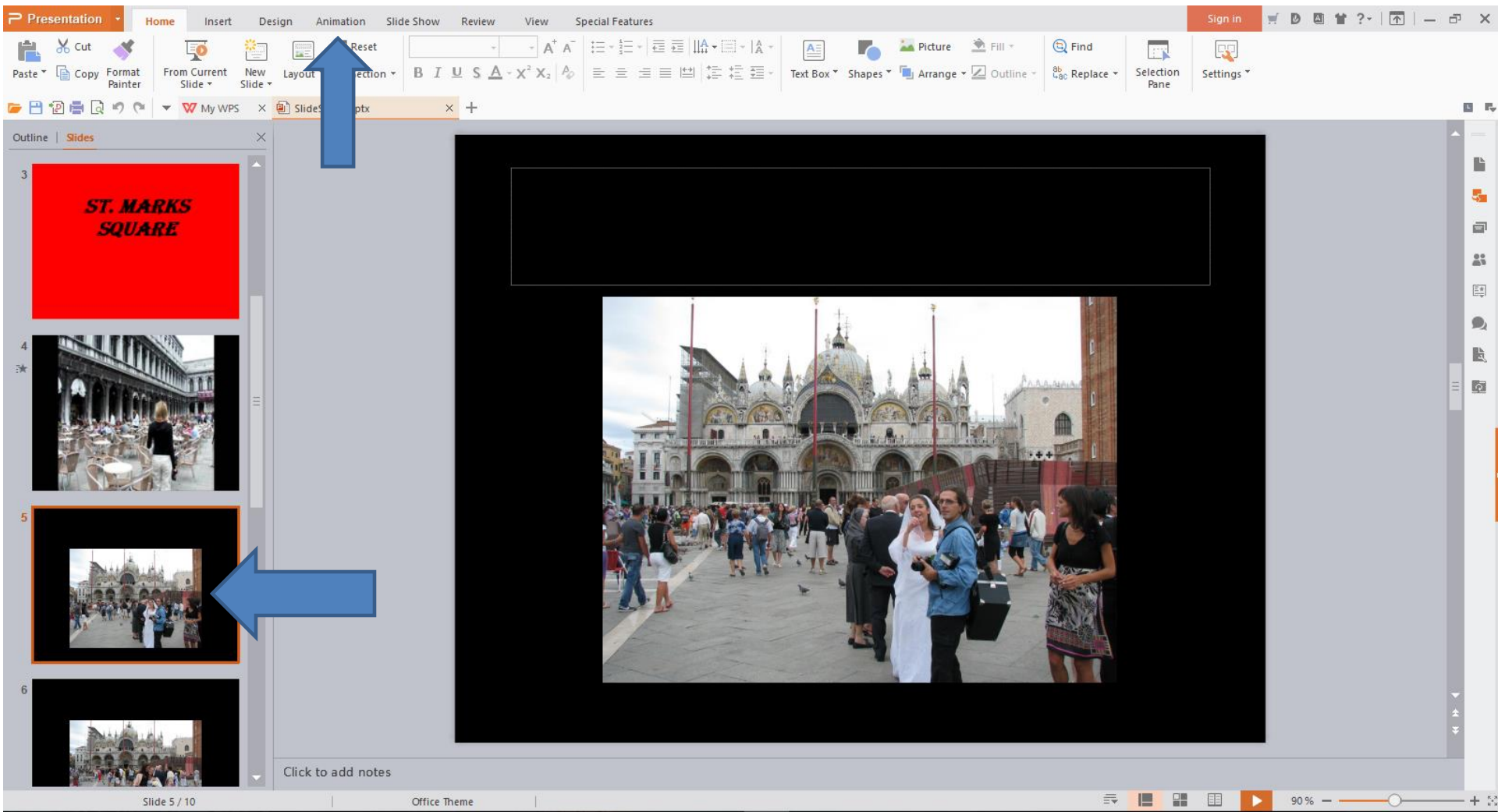
- Transition Effects have the same as Animation, but the list names are different. The reason for Transitions Effects is it allows to change the Speed and Apply Animation to all slides.**
- I recommend Transition Effects vs. Animation, because it is easier to practice the Animations.**
- Next explains Animations.**

- **The Animations are different than Movie Maker. Kingsoft Presentation also does not have Visual Effects, like Movie Maker.**
- **The Animations are the same on Title Slide, Picture Slide, and at the beginning of a Video Slide.**
- **It used to work when you hover over an Animation, like Movie Maker, but now you have to click on each one to view them. You can always click on None to not show Animation again.**
- **Next is what slide to click on to practice Animations with Transitions Effects.**

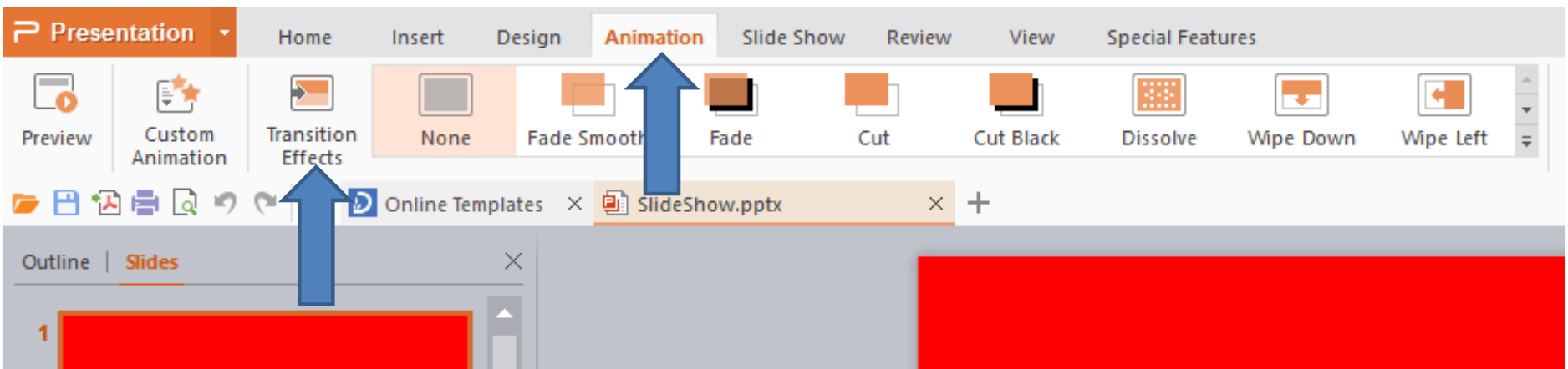
You can click on the first Slide with Title, or the second Slide with Video. You may have scroll down and click on a Slide with a Picture. Next is a sample of scrolling down and clicking on a Picture Slide.

- Click on the Animation tab at the top and you start to see a list of Animations.
- You also see Transition Effects. I recommend you click on it, because it is easier as I mentioned before.
- Next is what happens when you click on Transition Effects.



- Once you click on Transition Effects, a new window opens on the right. Next I will zoom in, so you can see it.

- Next is to practice one.

- You also see Modify transition. It shows default Speed. You can change it on the Animation you selected. I will show how to do it later.
- It also shows No Sound default, but you can add a Sound on the Animation, but when you save as Video the Sound does not play. Next explains Apply to All Slides.

AutoPreview

- **If you like Animation on the Picture Slides and don't like the Animation on the Title Slide and/or the Video Slide, you then click on the Slide you don't want the Animation and click on No Transition. It just removes the Animation on that Slide and keeps it on the other Slides.**
- **You follow the same process to remove the Animation on other Slides.**
- **Next explains the Speed and how to change it.**

- **The Speed default is about .50 seconds on the Animation when you play the Slide Show.**
- **When you change it to 2 seconds, it only changes on the slide you selected.**
- **I tried clicking on Apply to All Slides, and did not change 2 seconds on the other Slides.**
- **It is not easy to change Speed on each Slides.**
- **If you want just an Animation on one Slide, you may want to change the Speed.**
- **Next is how to change the Speed.**

- To change the Speed longer to 2 seconds, you click on the top one 6 times.
- Next is a sample of clicking on it 6 times.
