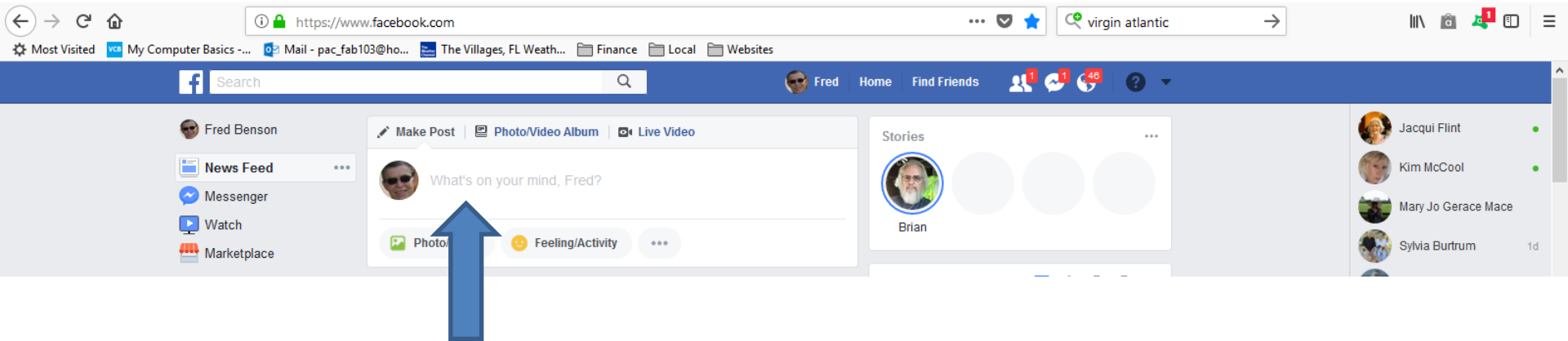


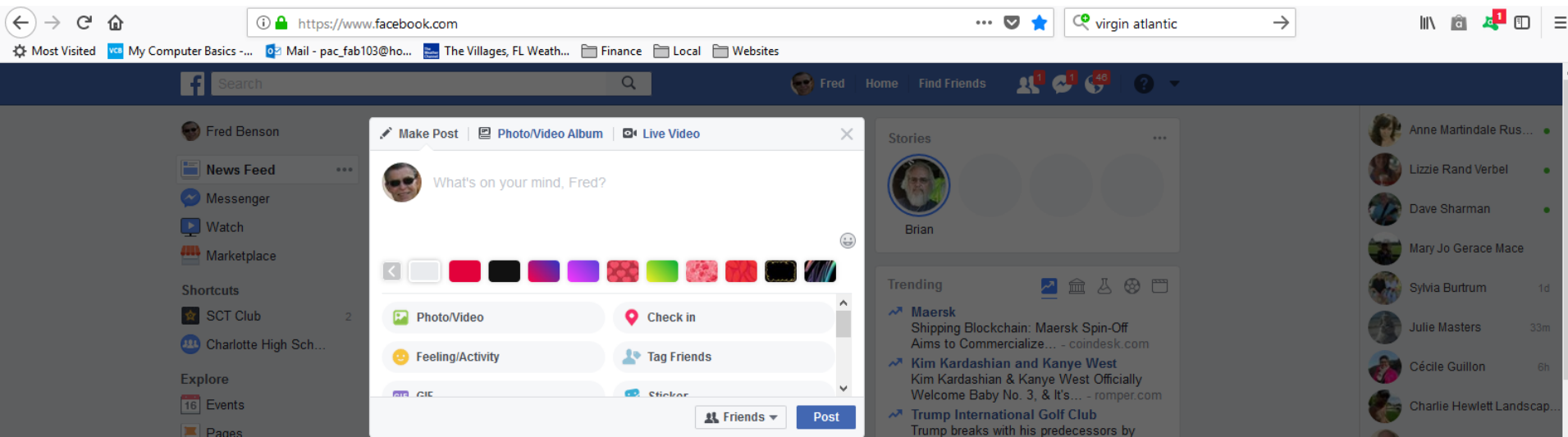
Step 14 – Part C – Share a Video on Facebook

- Here is my Facebook account. It is typically on the Home page. You then click on the What's on your mind Fred? Next is what happens.



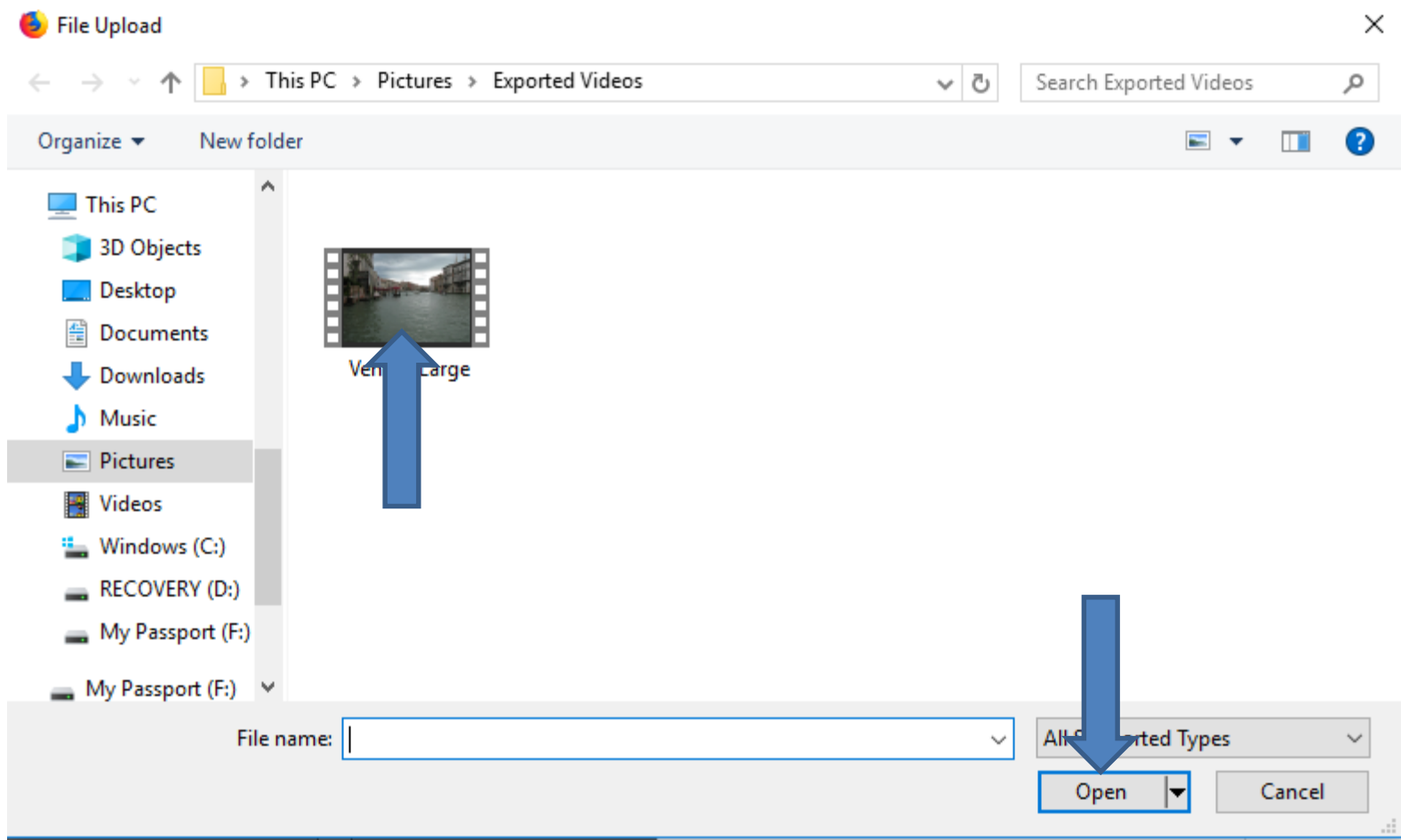
- You see it highlighted and then type in what you want. Next is a sample.

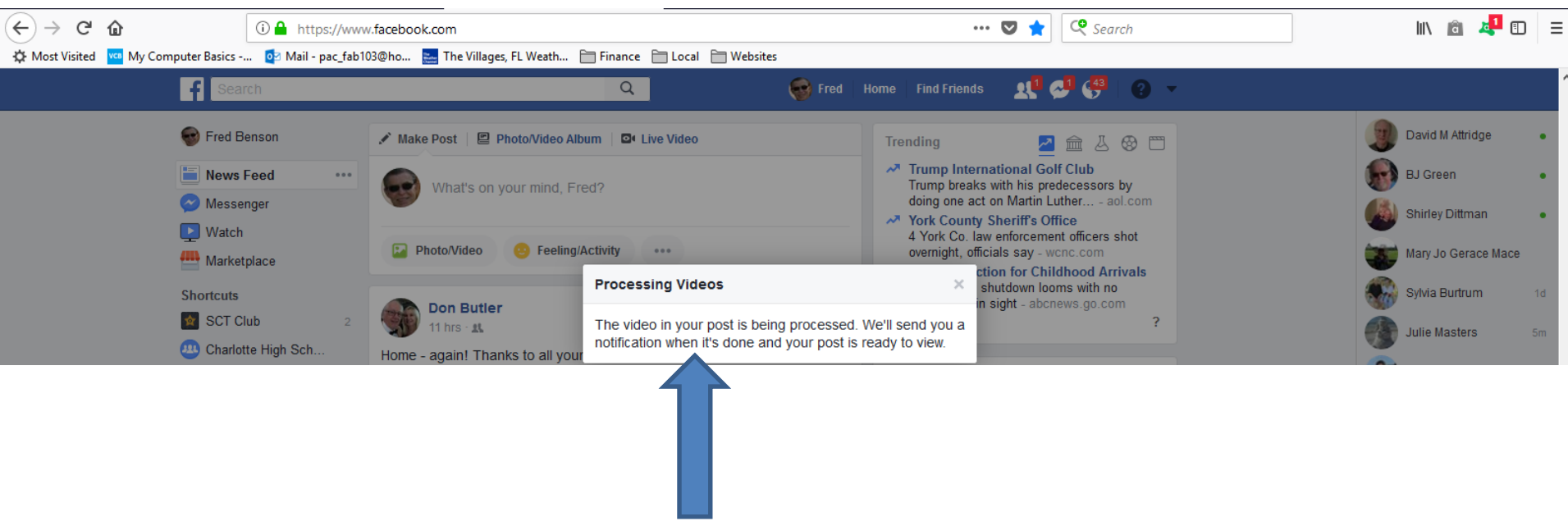


