

Step 1 – How to download new Browsers

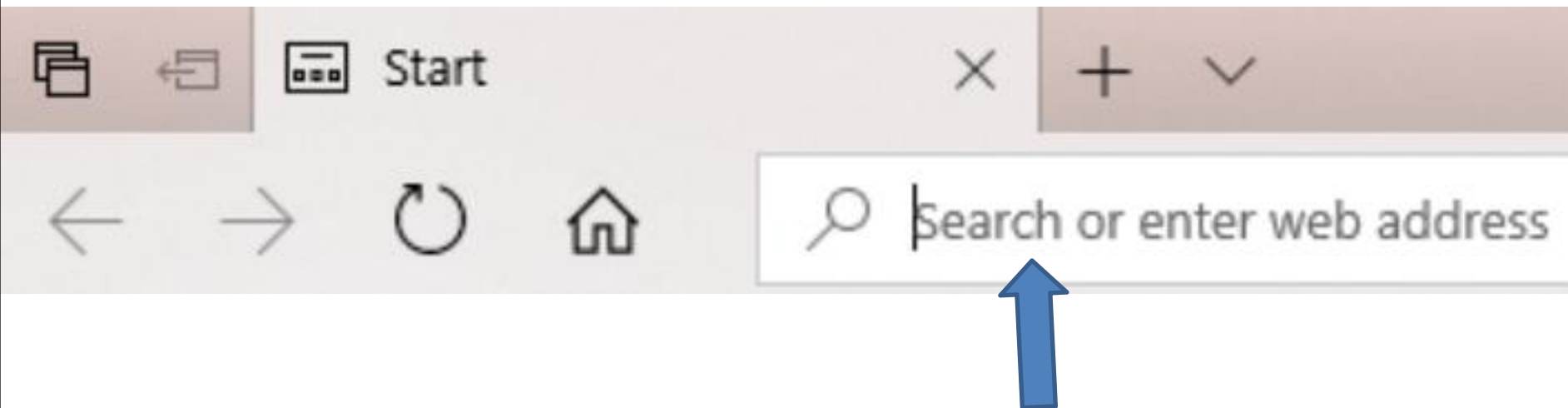
- If you have Windows 10, I will show you how to download new Browsers with Microsoft Edge Browser. Windows 10 also comes with Internet Explorer Browser, but you have to find it. As I mentioned in the Introduction, the Tip shows you how to find it and open Internet Explorer and Pin to the Taskbar. The new Browsers are Mozilla Firefox, Google Chrome, and Opera.**
- If you don't have Windows 10 and you have Vista, or Windows 7 or Windows 8, and you use Internet Explorer, page 9 in this PDF file shows you how to download new Browsers with Internet Explorer.**
- Next explains the download website.**

- **I will show you how to download new Browsers with the ninite.com website. Ninite is a very safe website with a lot of free downloads. If you have Windows 8 or 10, as I mentioned before, I recommend you download Classic Start Menu. I will also show you how to download Classic Start Menu. The second option as I mentioned in the Introduction, in my website there is a Ninite page under Courses that has a Video that shows how to download Browsers and Classic Start Menu and more downloads.**
- **Next is to open Microsoft Edge in Windows 10 and how to open ninite.com.**

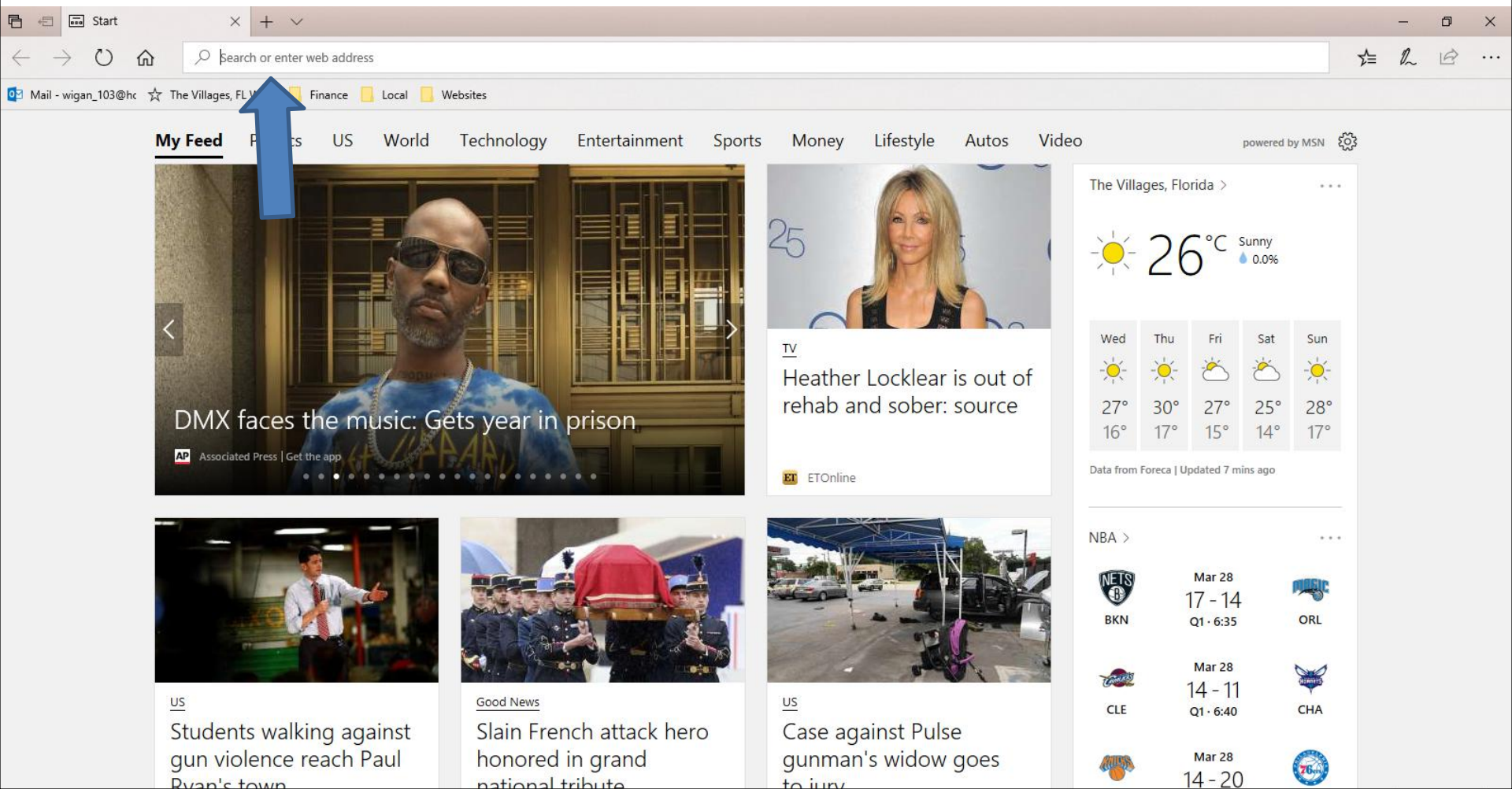
- If you have Windows 10, Microsoft Edge Icon is on the Taskbar close to search. Sometimes the Icon is different. You click on it to open it and next is a sample.



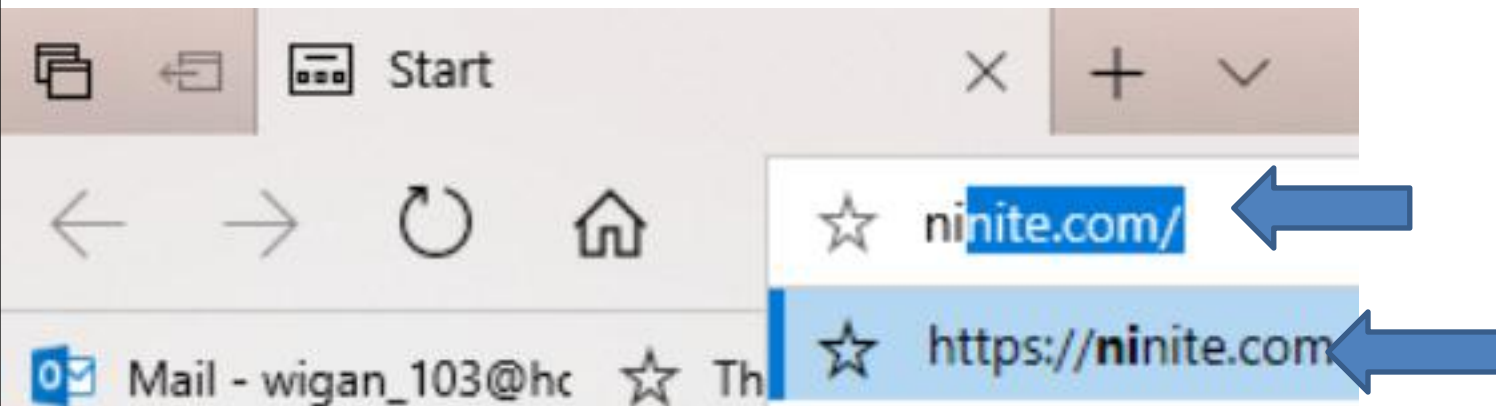
- You see Search or enter web address. You then type in ninite.com and next is a sample. If you set up another Home page, it does not show Search. It just shows the URL of your Home page. If you have to click on the URL to highlight it and type in ninite.com.

- **When you start typing in ninite.com, you see a list of it below. You can click on it, or click on the Enter Key and next is what happens.**

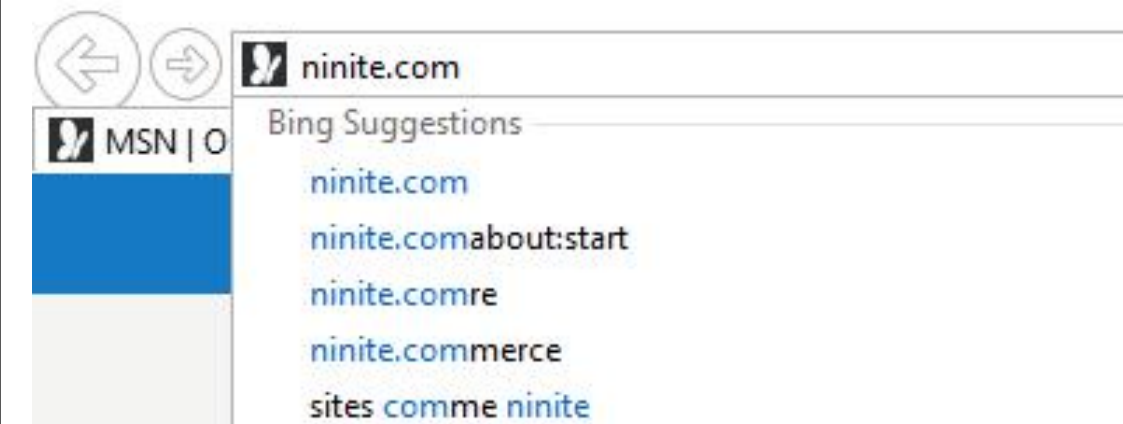

Get Your Ninite

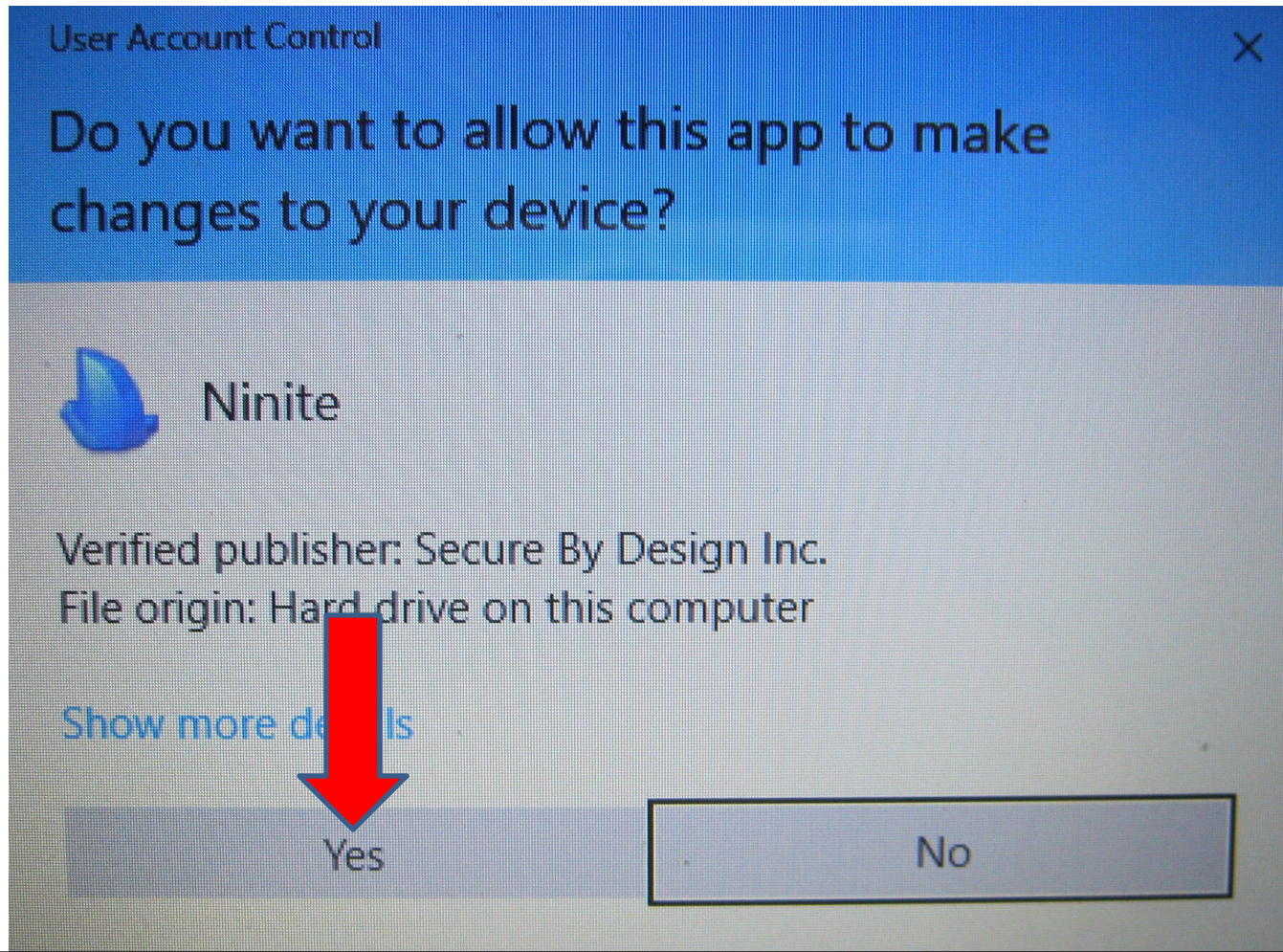
- If you click on **Get Your Ninite with Microsoft Edge Browser**, a new window opens at the bottom. I recommend you click on **Run** and next is what happens.



- If you click on **Get Your Ninite with Internet Explorer Browser**, a new window opens at the bottom. I recommend you click on **Run** and next is what happens.



- It starts in process and once complete, a new Window opens on your Desktop, which is below. I recommend you click on Yes and next is what happens.



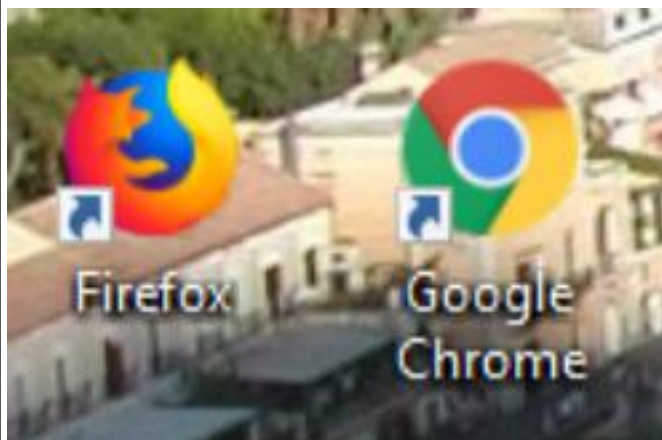
- It starts in process to install them and once it is Finished, you click on Close. The Icons on your Desktop.
- Next is a sample of the Icons on the Desktop and how to Pin to the Taskbar, that I recommend. After that is the Classic Start Menu.



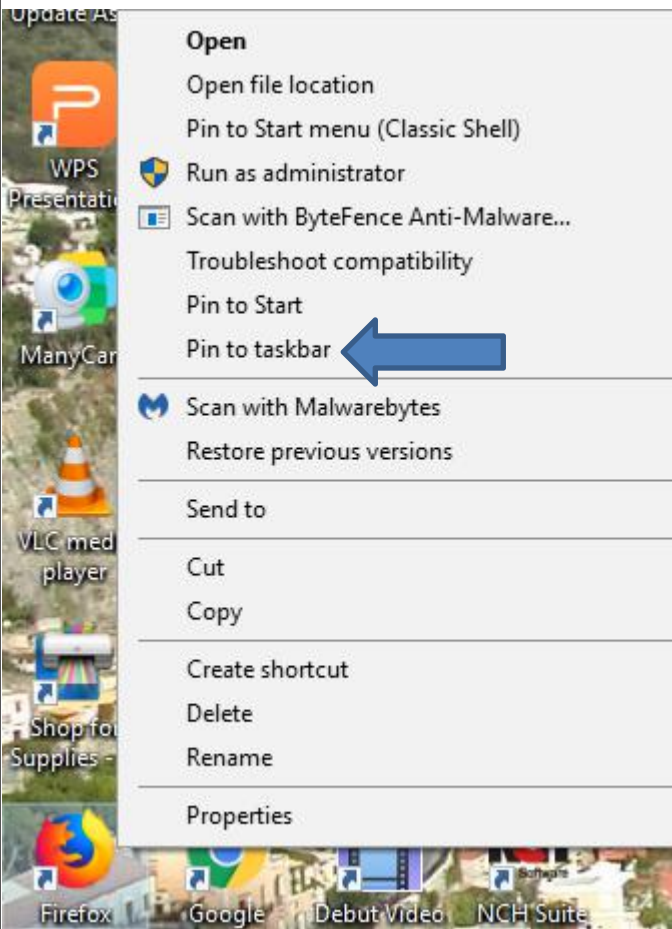
- **To get to the Desktop in Windows 10, you click on the far right on the Taskbar.**



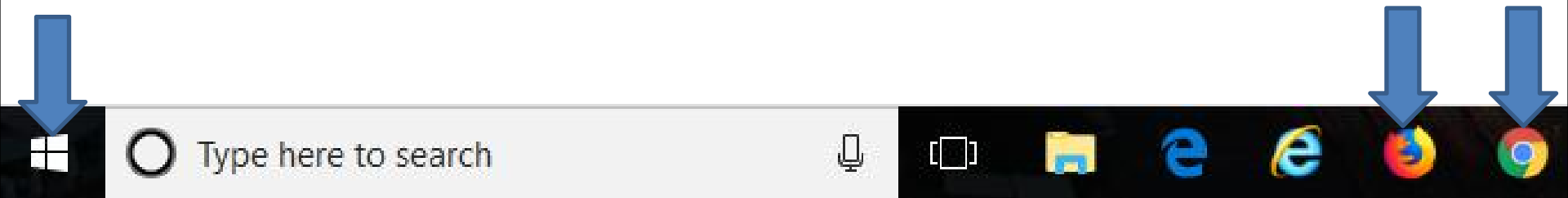
- **Here is a sample of the Icons on the Desktop and next is how to Pin to the Taskbar.**



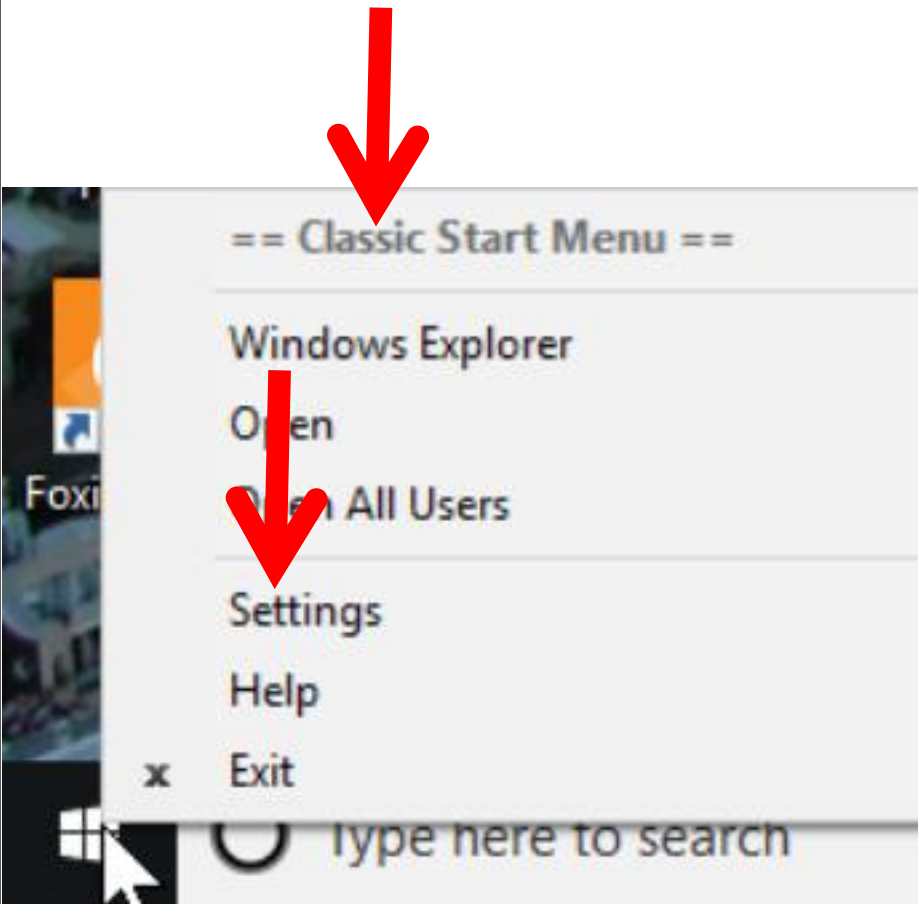
- You right click on the first Icon, like Firefox and you see a list and then click on Pin to taskbar. You follow the same process with Google Chrome Icon and next is a sample with Taskbar.



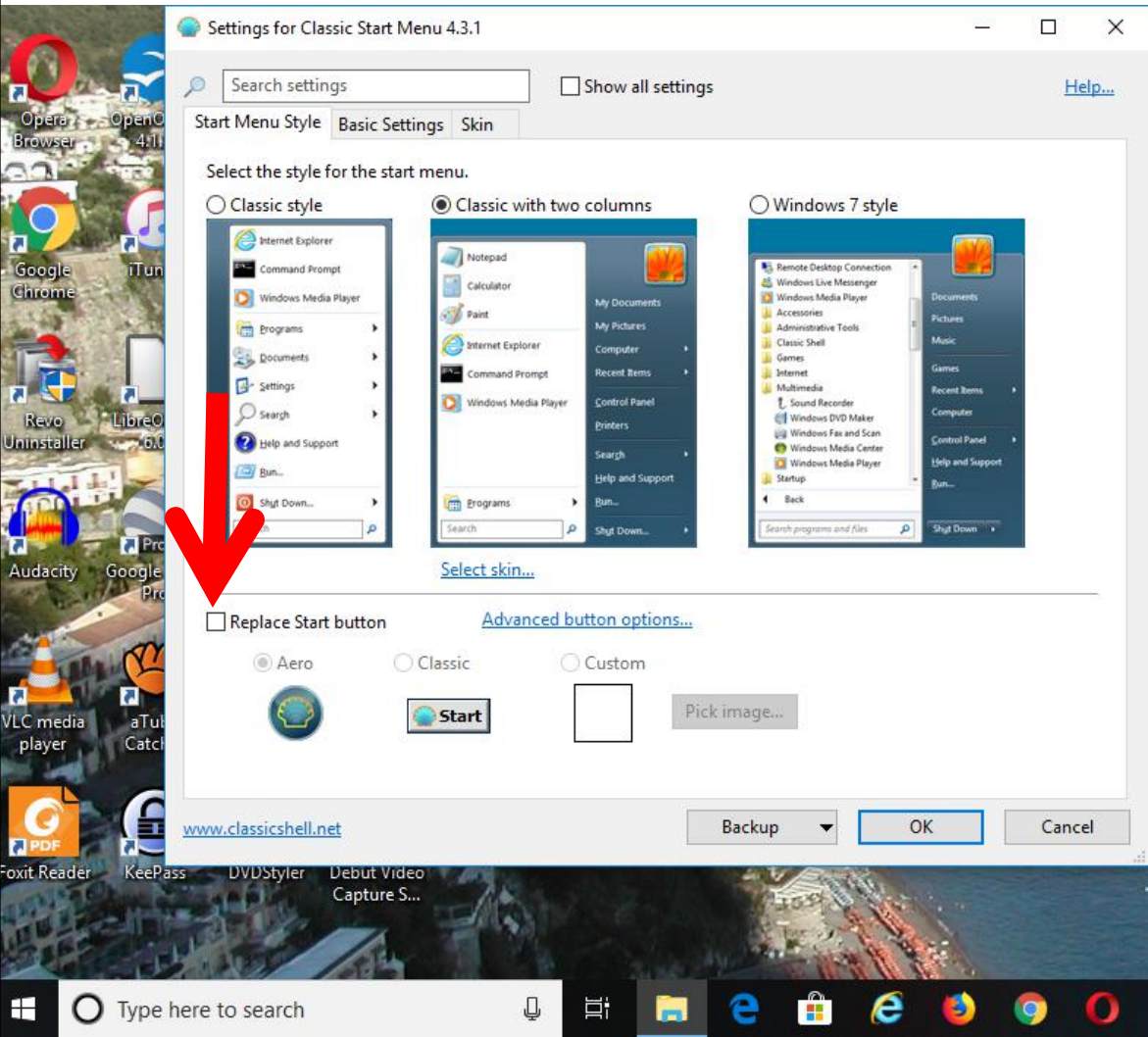
- Here is a sample of the Icons on the Taskbar.
Note - I decided to download Opera Browser also, so I can show it in the Browsers Steps.
- When you download the Classic Start Menu, it changes thw Windows 10 Start Menu, but the Icon is the same. You can right click on the Icon change the Icon, which is next.



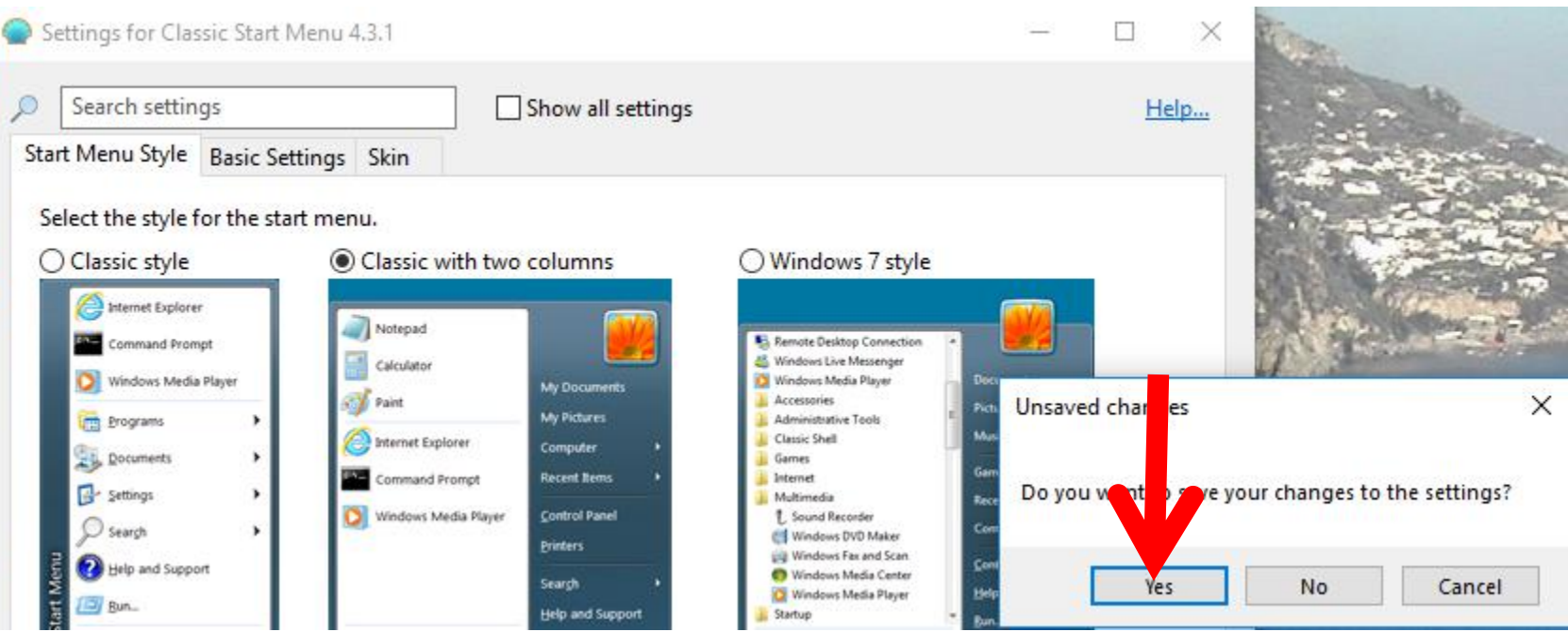
- When you right click on the Icon a new window opens with a list and you see Classic Start Menu at the top of the list. Then click on Settings and next is what happens.



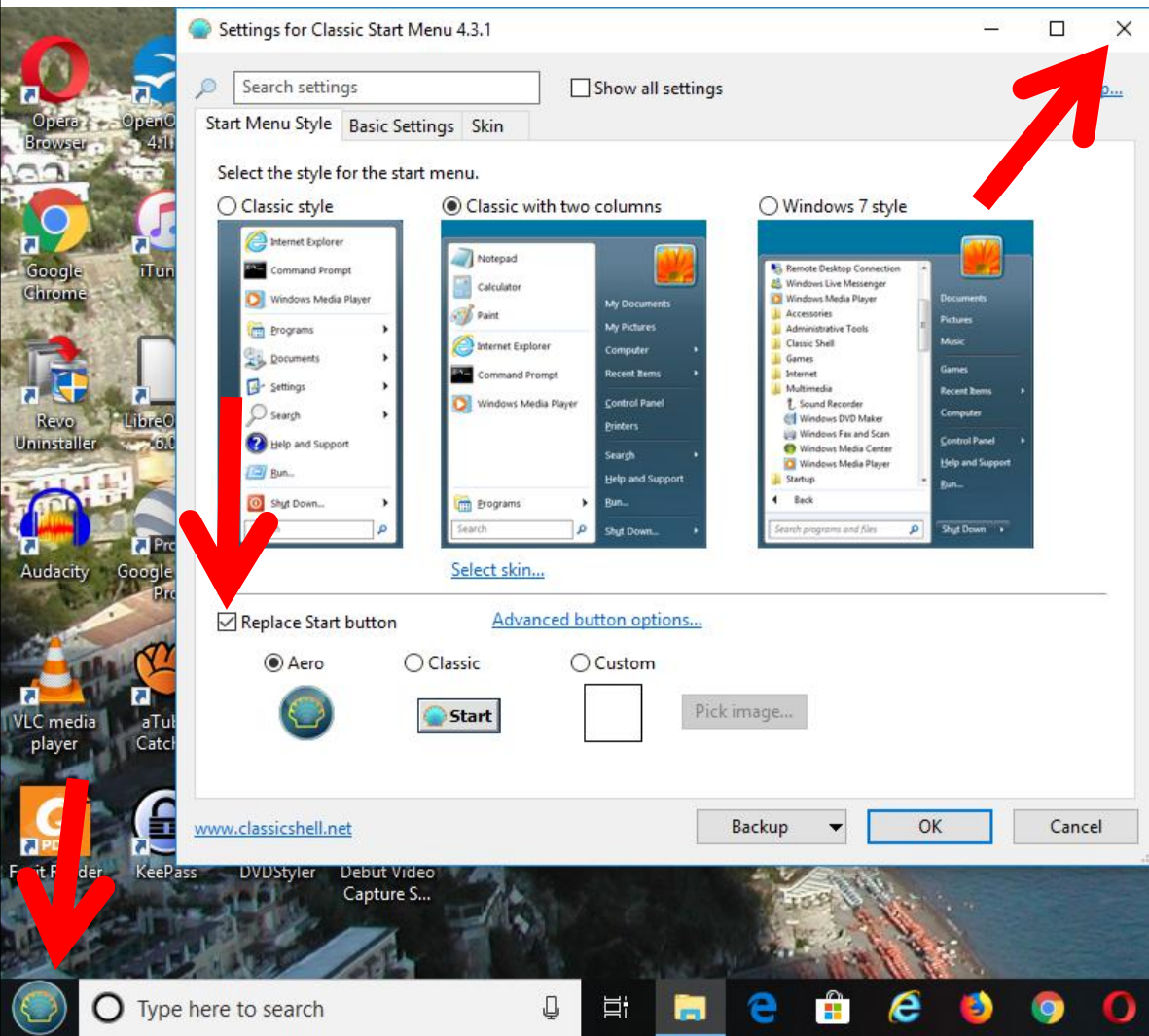
- When you click on Settings the window closes and a new window opens, like File Explorer. I recommend you click on the Box left of Replace Start button and next is a sample.



- A new window opens and I recommend you click on yes and next is what happens.



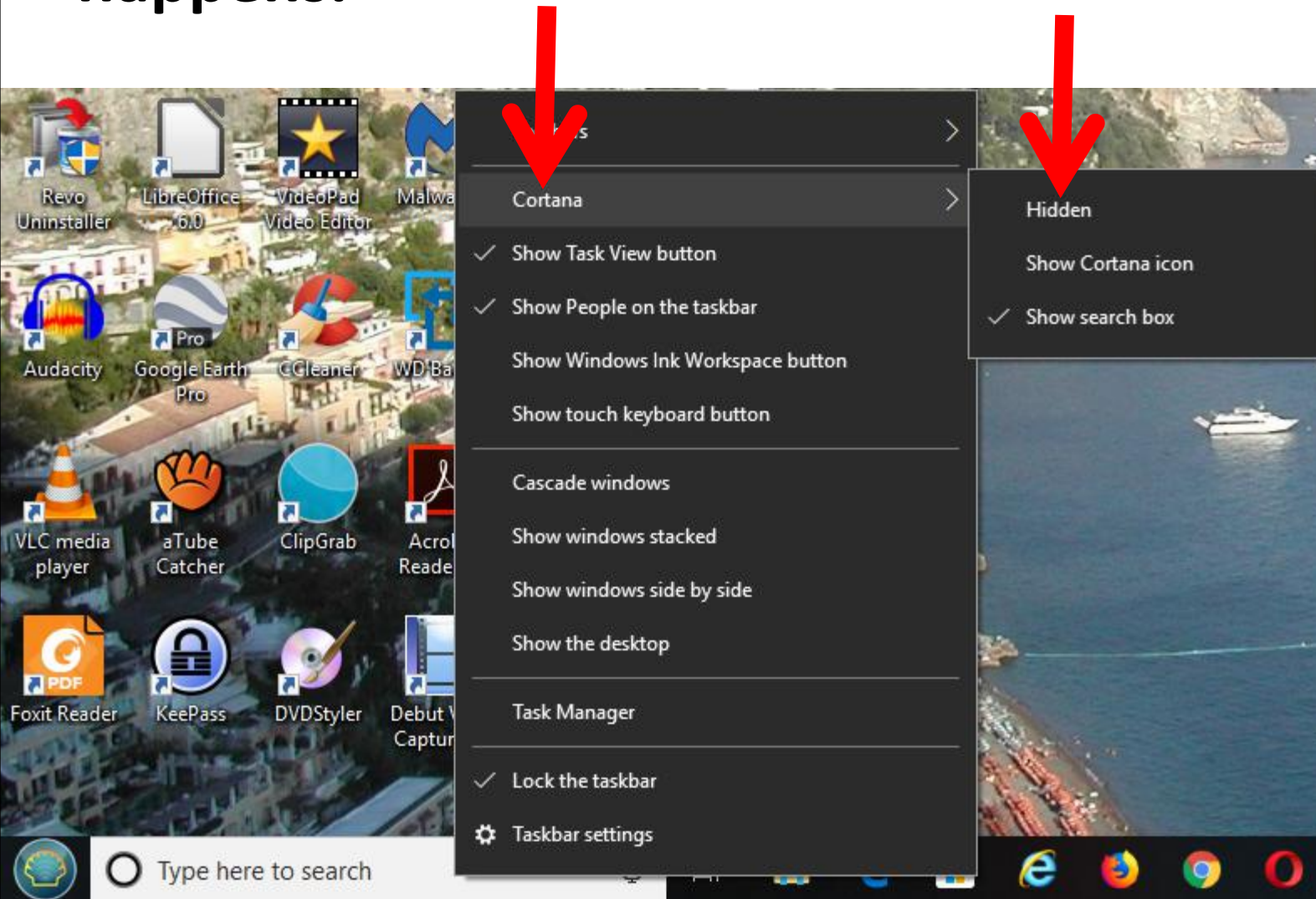
• You see the Box highlighted and you see the Icon has changed. To close the window, click on X in the upper right and next is what happens.



- **Window closes.**
- **Because the Classic Start Menu has a search, I decided to Hidden the search on the Taskbar, because I have a lot of Icons on my Taskbar. To Hidden it, you right click on the Taskbar and next is a sample.**



- When you right click on the Taskbar a new window opens and hover over Cortana, like I did and then click on Hidden and next is a what happens.



- **Window closes and you don't see the search on the Taskbar.**
- **This is the End of Step 1.**
