

- You first click on Photocards at the top and next is what happens.




 Page changes and you see Upload a Photo and Send it as an Ecard. You then have to scroll down, which is next.




- When you scroll down, you see Upload Photo from your system (like computer) and you also see Import Photo from facebook.
- Next is what happens when you click on Upload Photo.




- A new window opens, like File Explorer and you find a folder with the Photo you want to add.

- Next is what happens.






You click on Import Photo and next is what happens.



Page changes and click on Authorize and next is what happens.




 A new window opens and you have to type your Email and Password and click on Log In. Next is what happens.

Next is the third option.










- Window changes and click on OK.
- Next is what happens




 Window closes and you see albums if you have them. Next is a sample when you click on one.
