

Step 4 – How to create other Effects

- Next is a sample of open it.


• Here is a sample. You click on Effects Icon on the right as I showed you in Step 2. Next is what happens and how to get the website to create other Effects.




- To create other Effects, you click on in the upper right first as I showed you in Step 3.
- Next is what happens.




- You see two things. Click on Get more effects as I showed you in Step 3.

 It opens in your default Browser and you click on Create Effects and next is what happens.




 Page changes to Create Effects and then you Scroll down and next is a sample of Scrolling down.




 Here is a sample of Scrolling down. The Category default is Objects. You can change it if you want by clicking on it. Next is a sample of clicking on it.




• When you click on it and you see a list. I decided to click on Face Accessories, because I have a Photo of a person I wanted to add. Next is a sample of clicking on it.




 Here is a sample of clicking on it. The default of the Sub-category is Eye Accessories. You can click on to change it. Next is a sample of clicking on it

 I decided to change it to Masks, because it will be under Masks Effects when you download it. Next is a sample of clicking on it.






 A new window opens, like File Explorer and you find the Folder with the image you want upload.
 Next is a sample. Note – if you don't have a Photo on your computer, Page 25 shows you the other


option.




Here is a sample of finding on, like my friend



 When you click on Download in Opera Browser, a new window opens in the upper right. It shows the file. You then double click on the file and next is what happens.




- When you click on Open in Google Chrome

 Effects. You click on Effects Icon on the right as I showed you before. Next is what click on it.




 You see Categories list and it shows that there is an Icon next to Face Accessories, which is a new one. Next is what happens when you click on Face




 When you click on Face Accessories, you see a list and then you have to Scroll Down. Next is a sample of Scrolling Down.

- Next is what happens when you click on it.




• When you click on it, it goes over my face. Next is the other option.



- Next is a Google Search sample for Christmas Photos.


- Here is a Google Search sample for Christmas Photos.
- You then click on Images to the right of All and next is what happens.




 It then shows a lot of images. You can scroll down to find the one you want. Next is a sample of scrolling down.



 Here is a sample of scrolling down and I liked this one in the middle. You then right click on the one you want and then click on Save image as and next is what happens.


