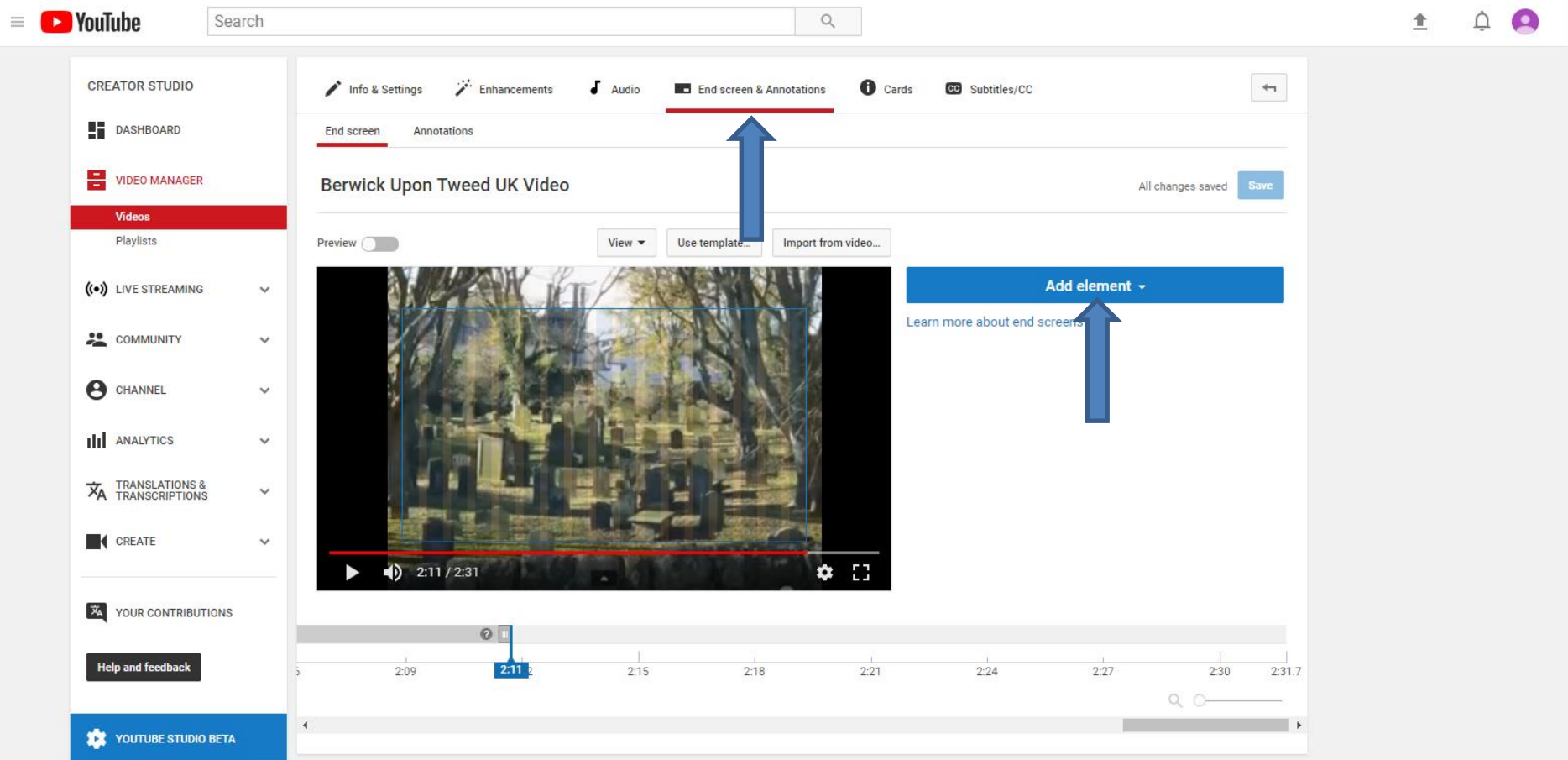


Step 4 – Part D - How to Edit Video on YouTube with End screen & Annotations

- You click on End screen & Annotations right of Audio and next is what happens.



- Note – The last one is Link, but it is Not enabled.







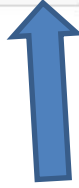
