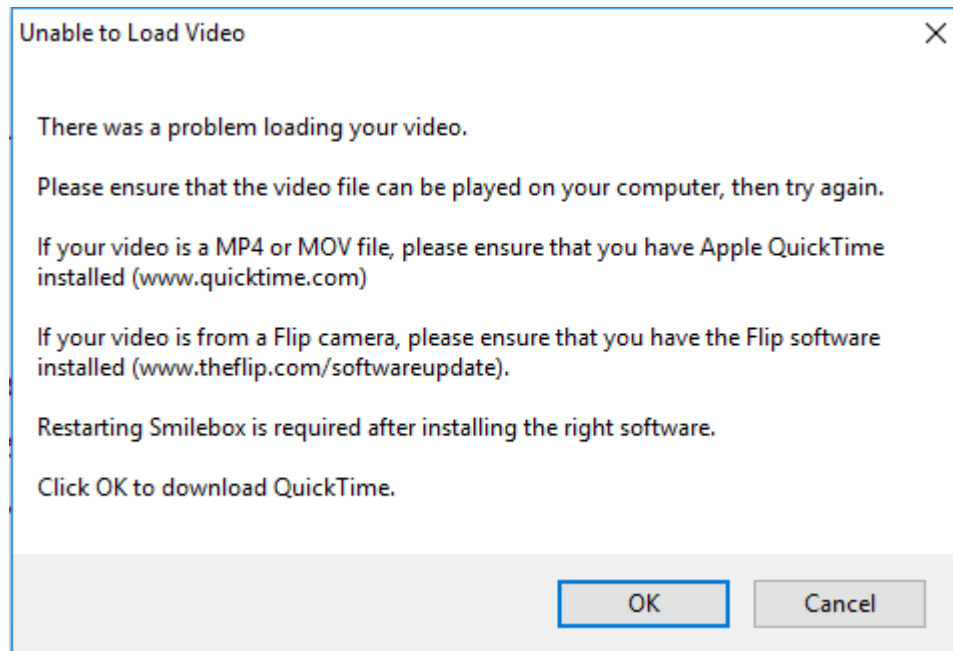

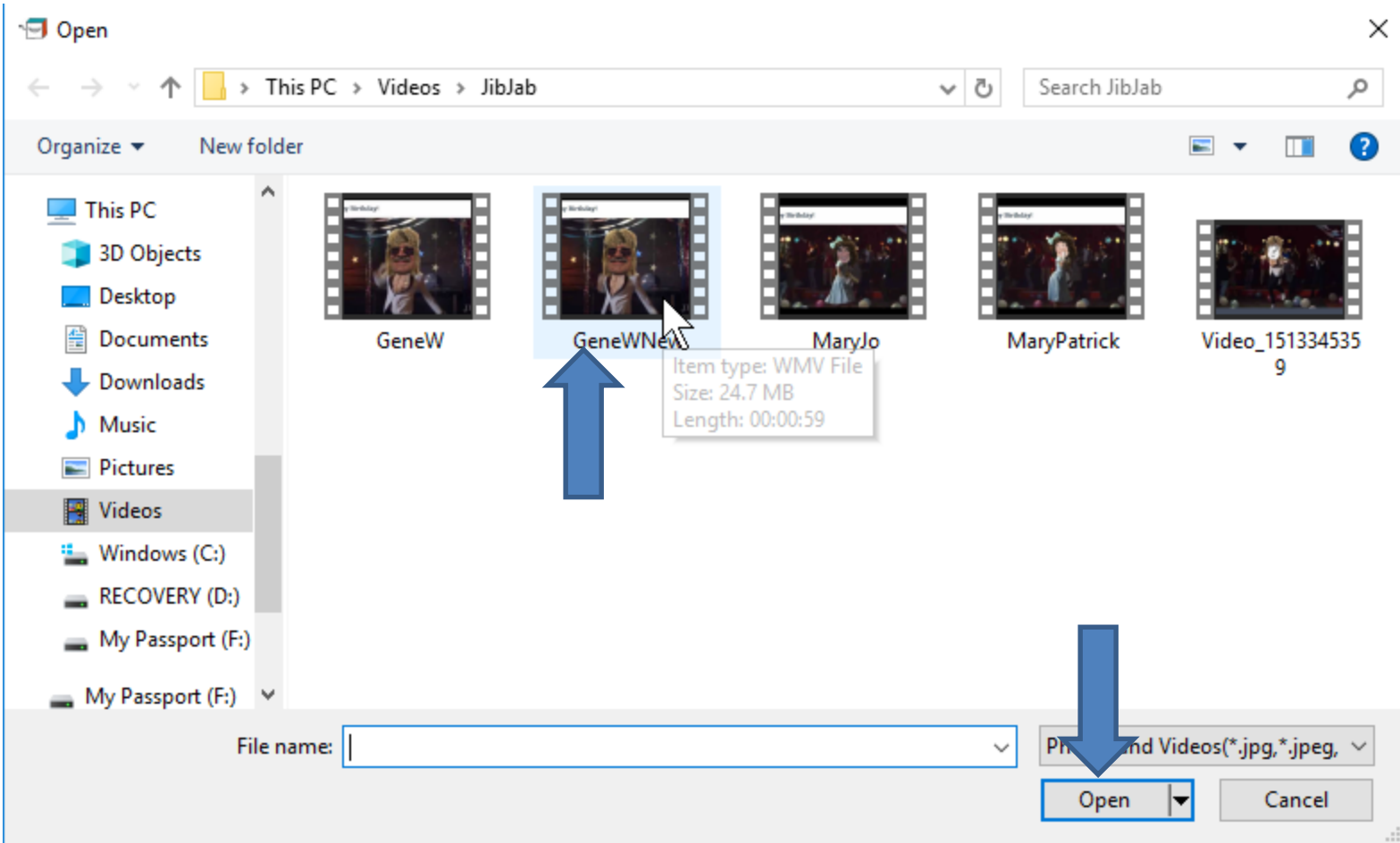
Here is a sample of finding one. You double click on it or click on it and click on Open. Next is what happens.

- Here is a sample of converting the MP4 file to the WMV file. As I mentioned before, you double click on it or click on it and click on Open. Next is what happens.
