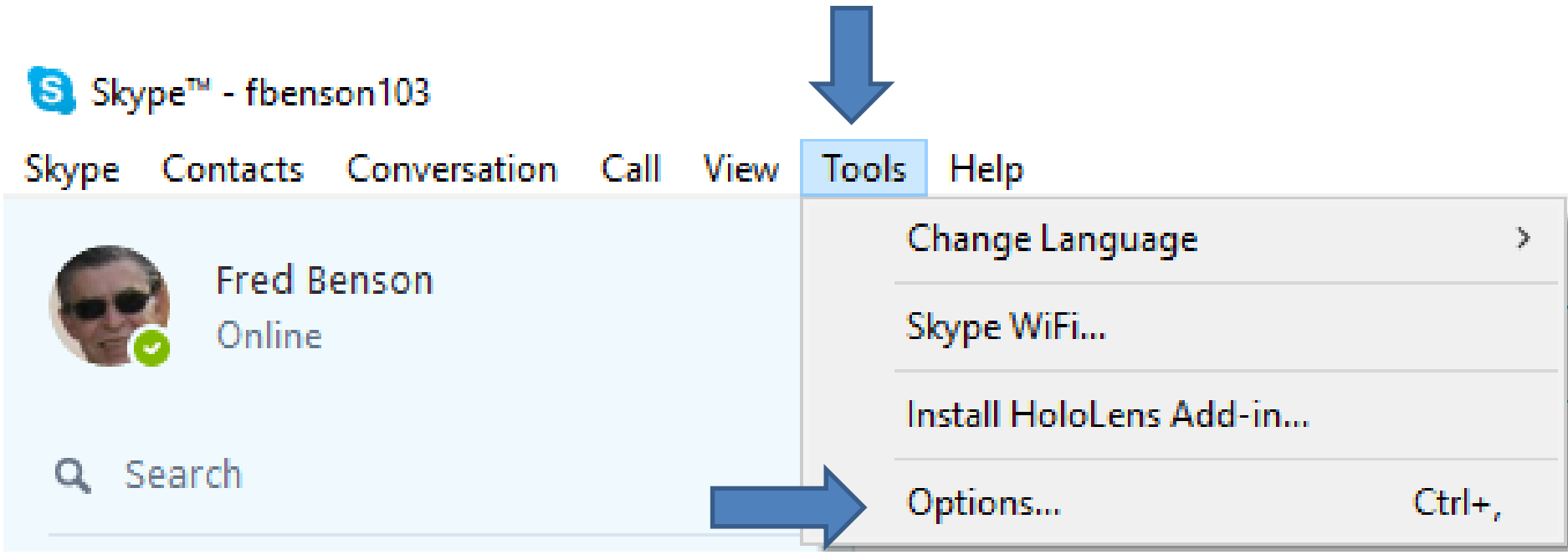


Step 5 – How to use ManyCam with Skype

- If you have Skype, you may want to try ManyCam with Effects.**
- If you don't have Skype, you may not want to use this Step.**
- Next explains about Skype and ManyCam.**

- **How to set-up Skype to have ManyCam as the default webcam?**
- **Note – if you don't have Skype and download ManyCam first and then download Skype, it asks you what webcam you want.**
- **If you have Skype and download ManyCam, sometimes Skype has ManyCam as the default webcam. I recommend you go to Skype to Tools to see if ManyCam is the default webcam. If not, change default to ManyCam, which is next.**

- **When you open Skype, there is a Tool tab and you click on it and you see a list and you click on Options.**
- **Next is what happens.**



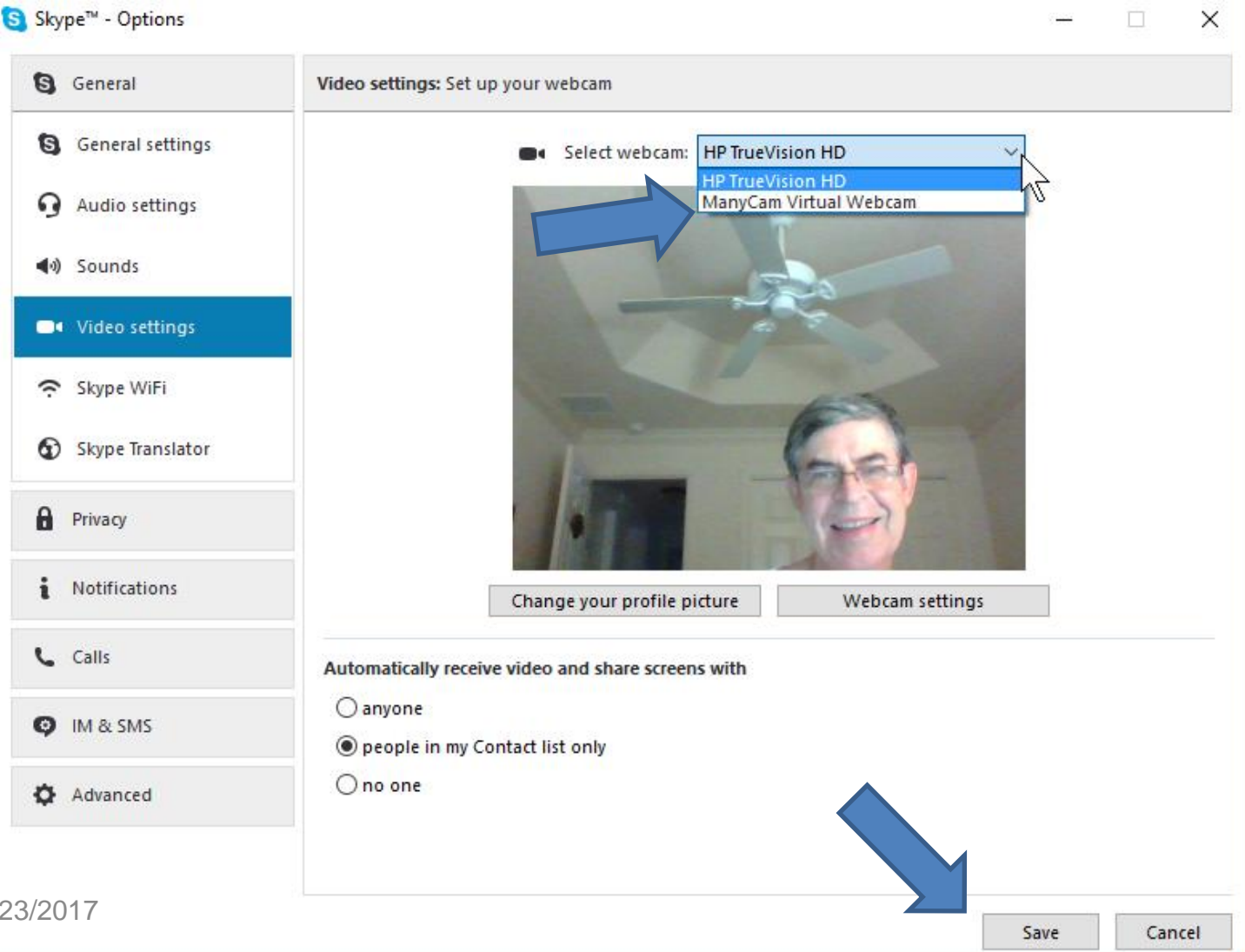
- **A new window opens and you click on Video Settings. Next is what happens.**

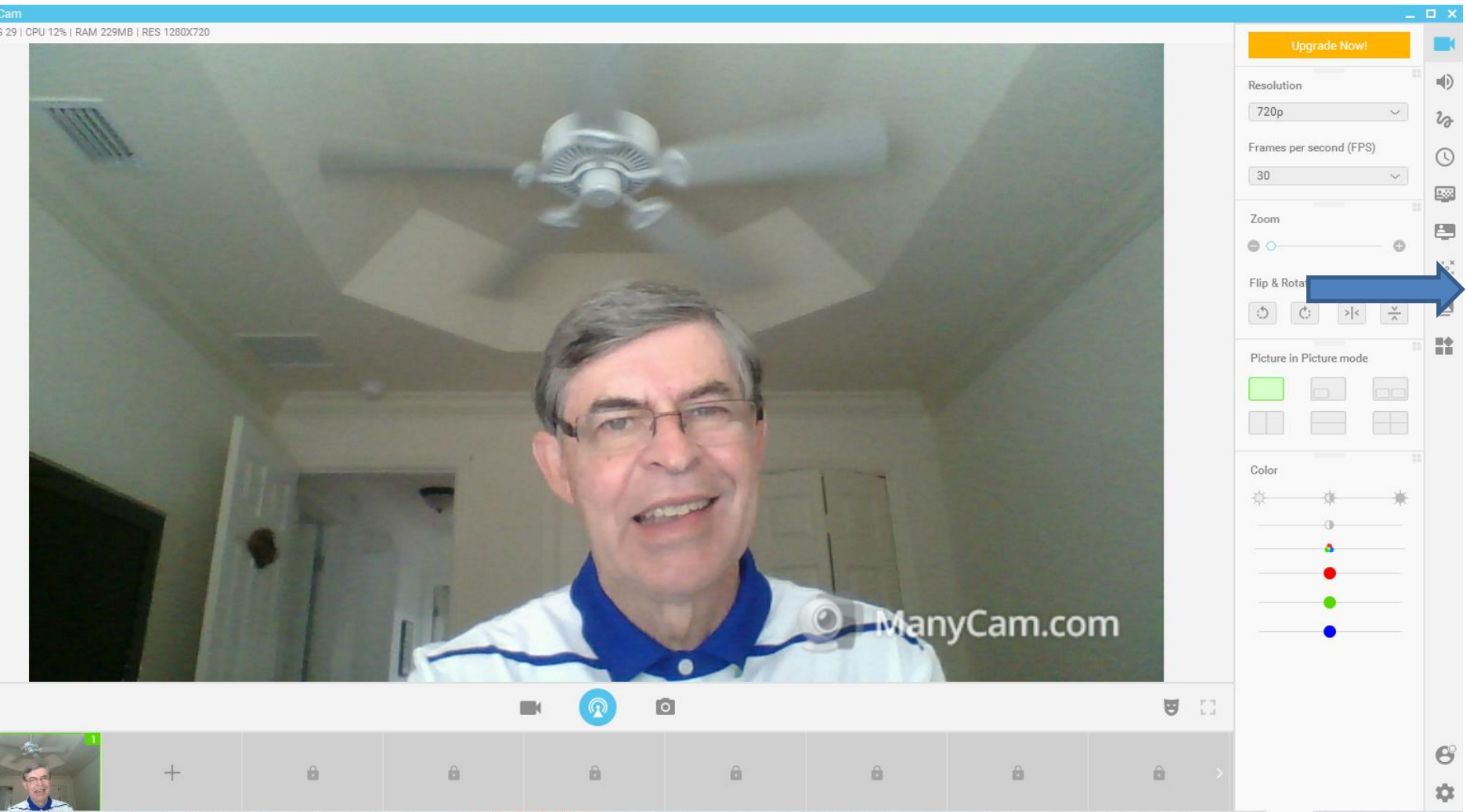

- You see the default. If it is not ManyCam, click on the drop down and click on ManyCam and then click on Save. Next is ManyCam effects.

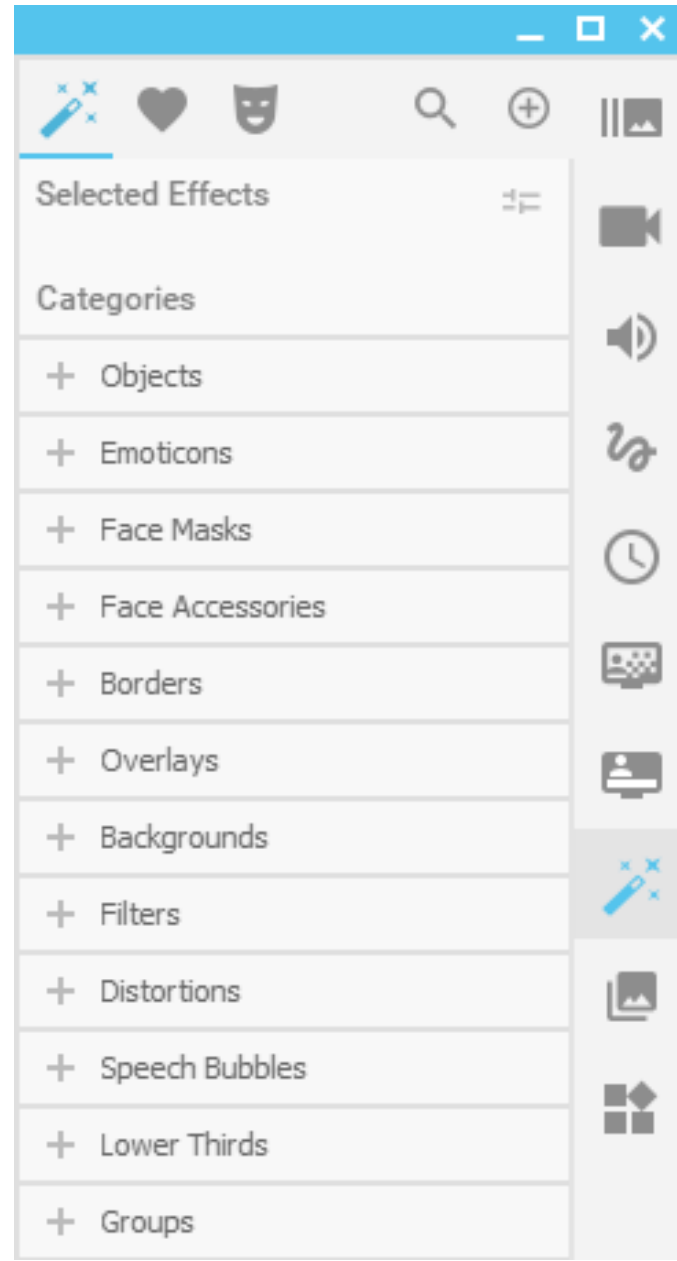



- **You can use the ManyCam effects on Skype.**
- **You first open ManyCam as I showed you in Step 1.**
- **Note – you need to have it open it to add effects when you are using Skype.**

- You click on  Effects Icon on the right as I showed you in Step 2 – Part A and next is what happens again.




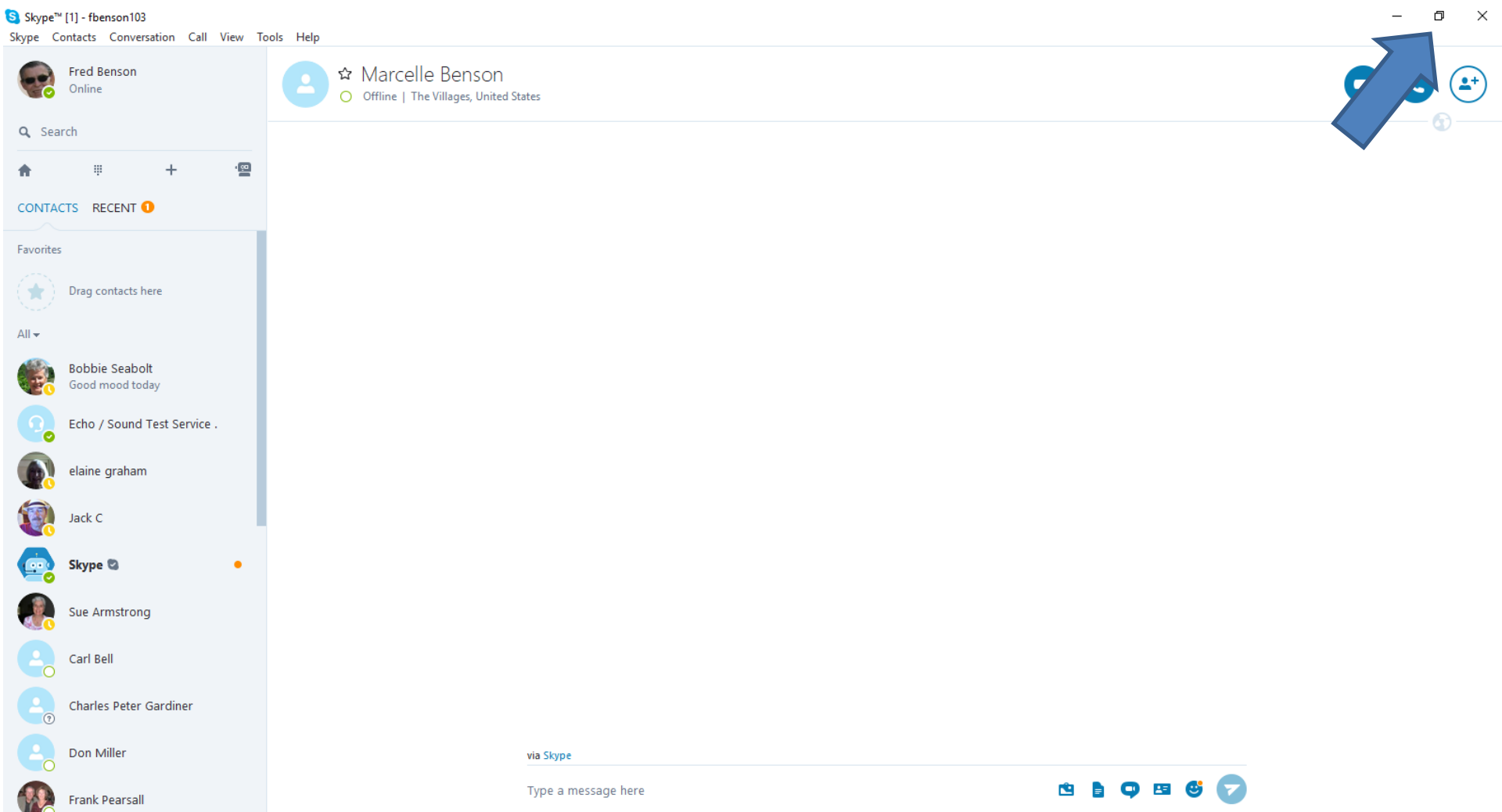
- It changes on the right to Selected Effects and you see a list under Categories.
- You click on one you want to find the Effects you want to add to Skype.
- Next is a sample as I showed you in Step 2 – Part A.



• Here is a sample. Next is how to go back and forth with Skype. If ManyCam is full screen, I recommend you click on the this Icon  in the upper right to resize it. Next is about Skype.



- **If Skype is full screen, I recommend you click on the this Icon  in the upper right to resize it. Next is a sample of resize Skype and Manycam.**



• Next is a sample of resize Skype and Manycam. You then go back and forth to them to add other Effects when you Skype someone. This is the End of Step 5.
