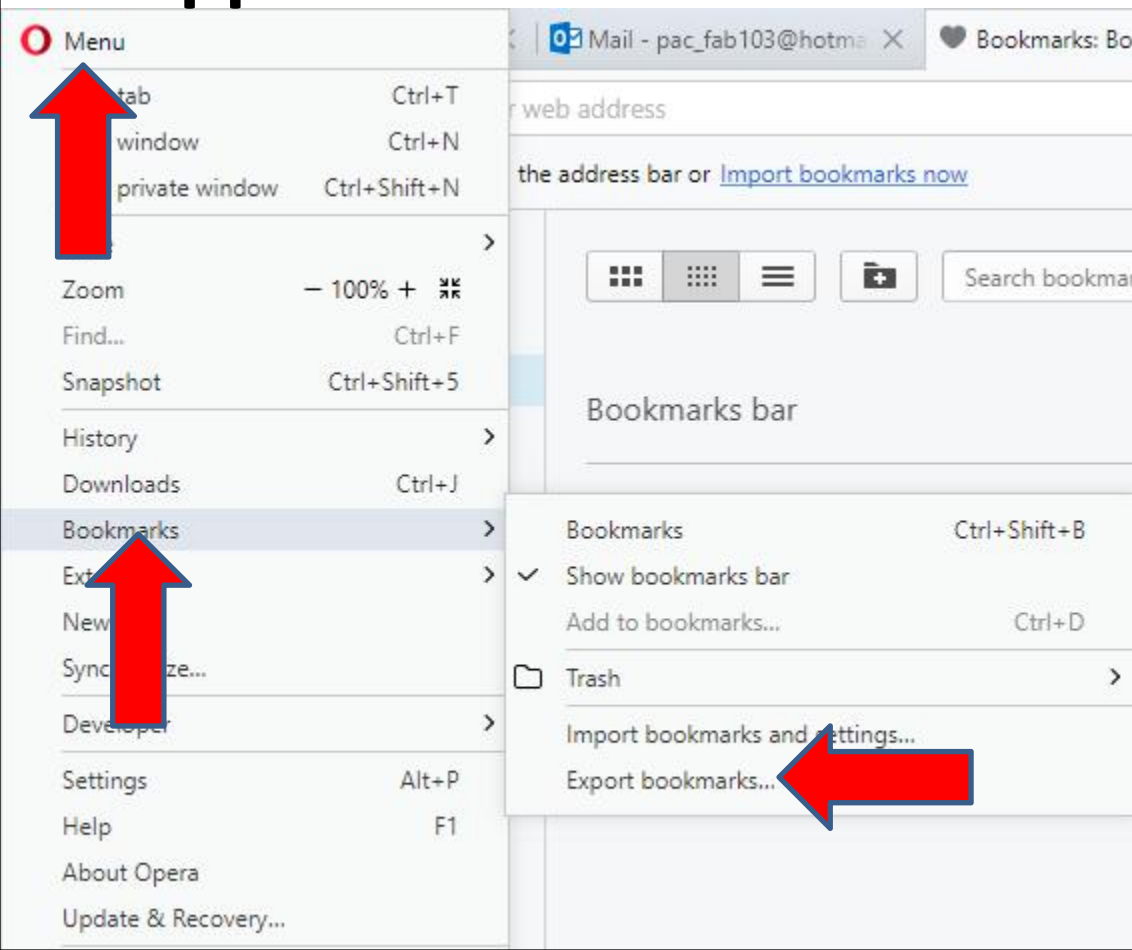


Step 6 – Part 5 - How to backup bookmarks and import them with Opera.

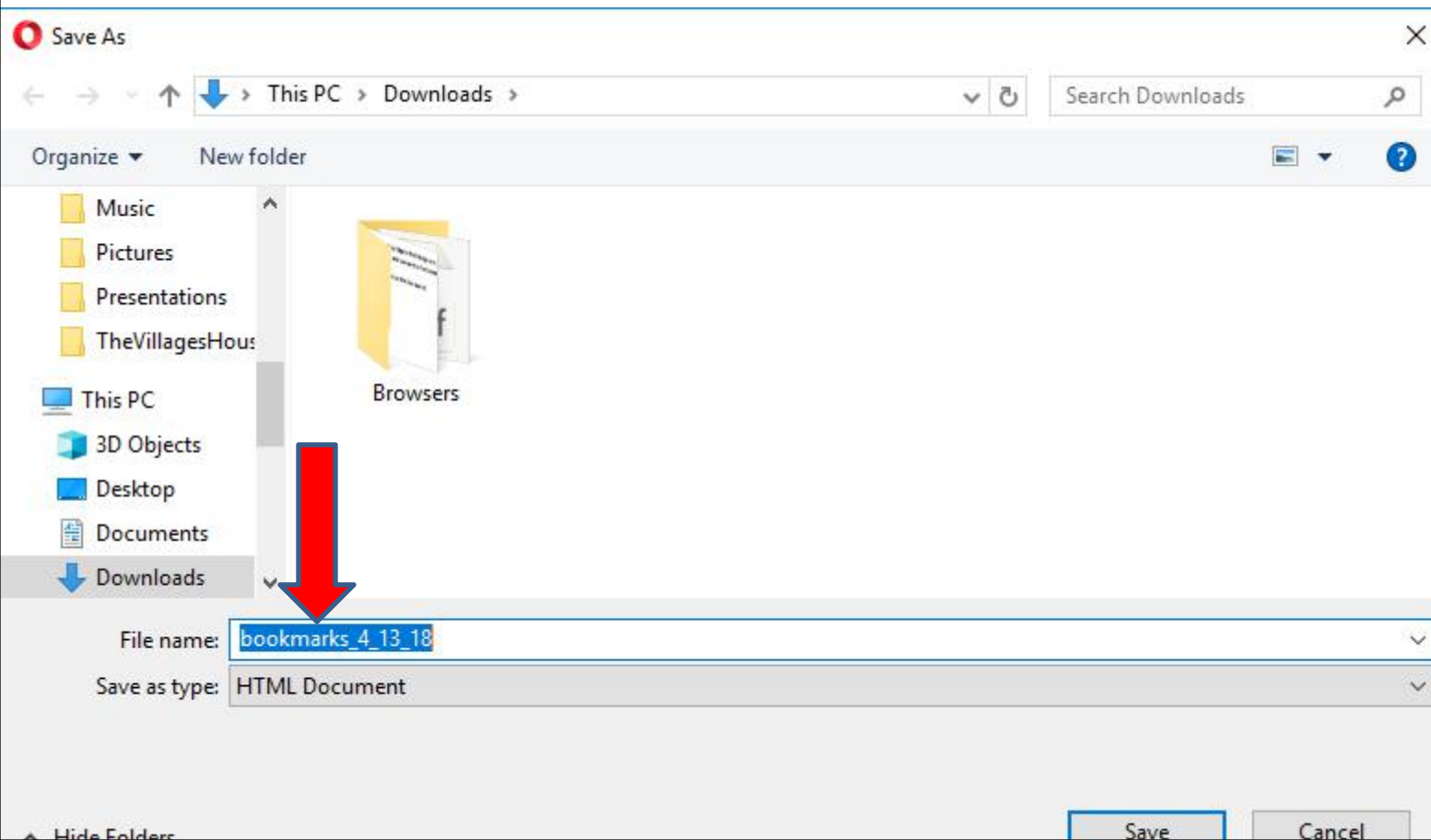
- As I mentioned in the other Parts, once you backup Bookmarks HTML file to your computer, I recommend you backup it and others to your external hard drive or another backup. The reason to backup is if your computer doesn't work and you have to buy a new computer. You then add from your external hard drive or another backup to your new computer. Once you do that, you can import the Bookmarks HTML file to Opera on your new computer.**
- Next explains more.**

- **As I mentioned before in other Parts, I recommend that you first set up a new Folder on your computer, that I showed you in Step 6 – Part 1. If you have not done Step 6 – Part 1 and you don't know how to add a new Folder, I recommend you view Step 6 – Part 1 first. If you know how to add a new Folder, you add a new Folder, like BookmarksBackup Folder under Documents.**
- **Next is to open Opera.**

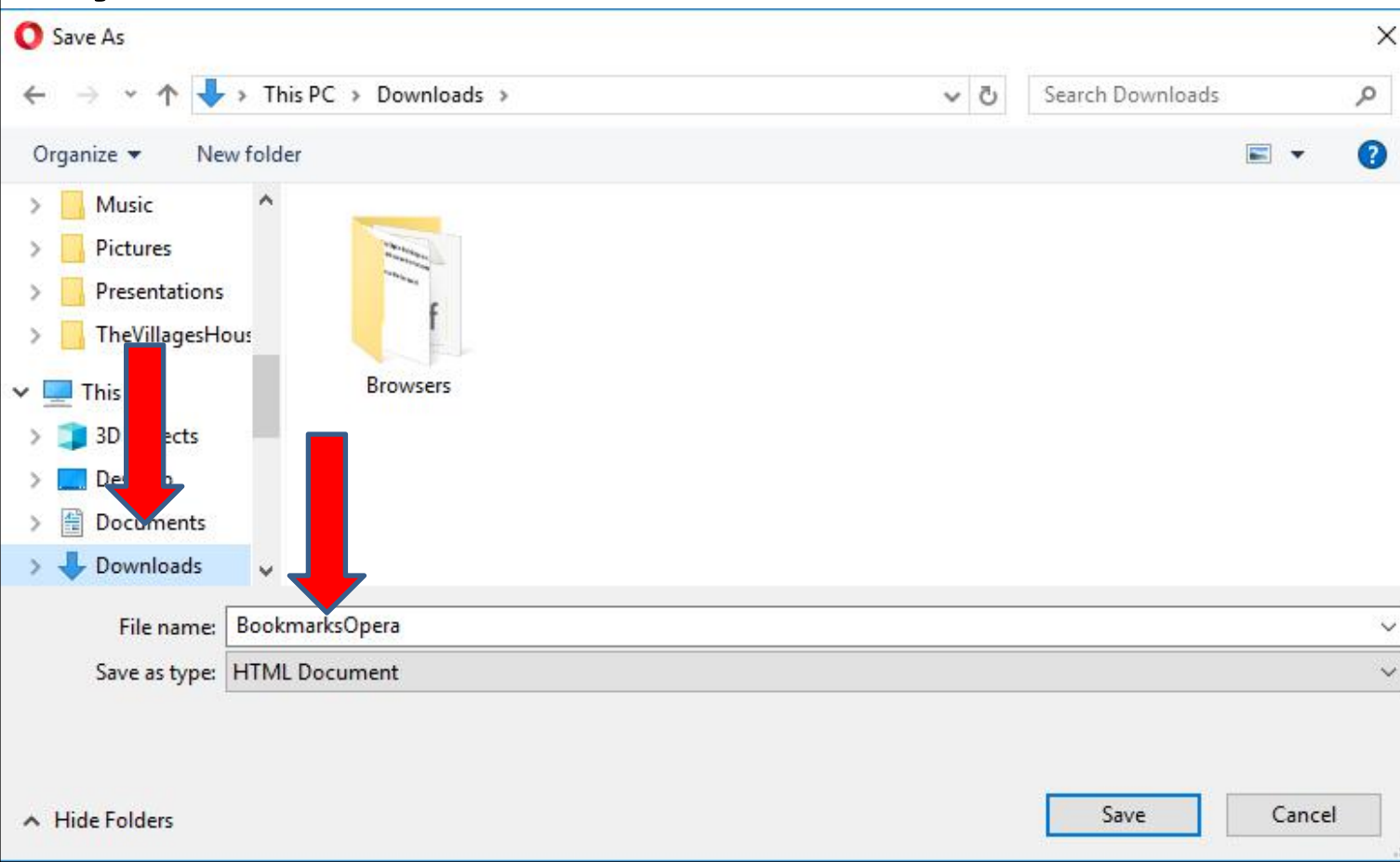
- **When you open Opera, click on the Menu again in the upper left and you see a list and hover over Bookmarks and a new window opens and click on Export Bookmarks at the bottom and next is what happens.**



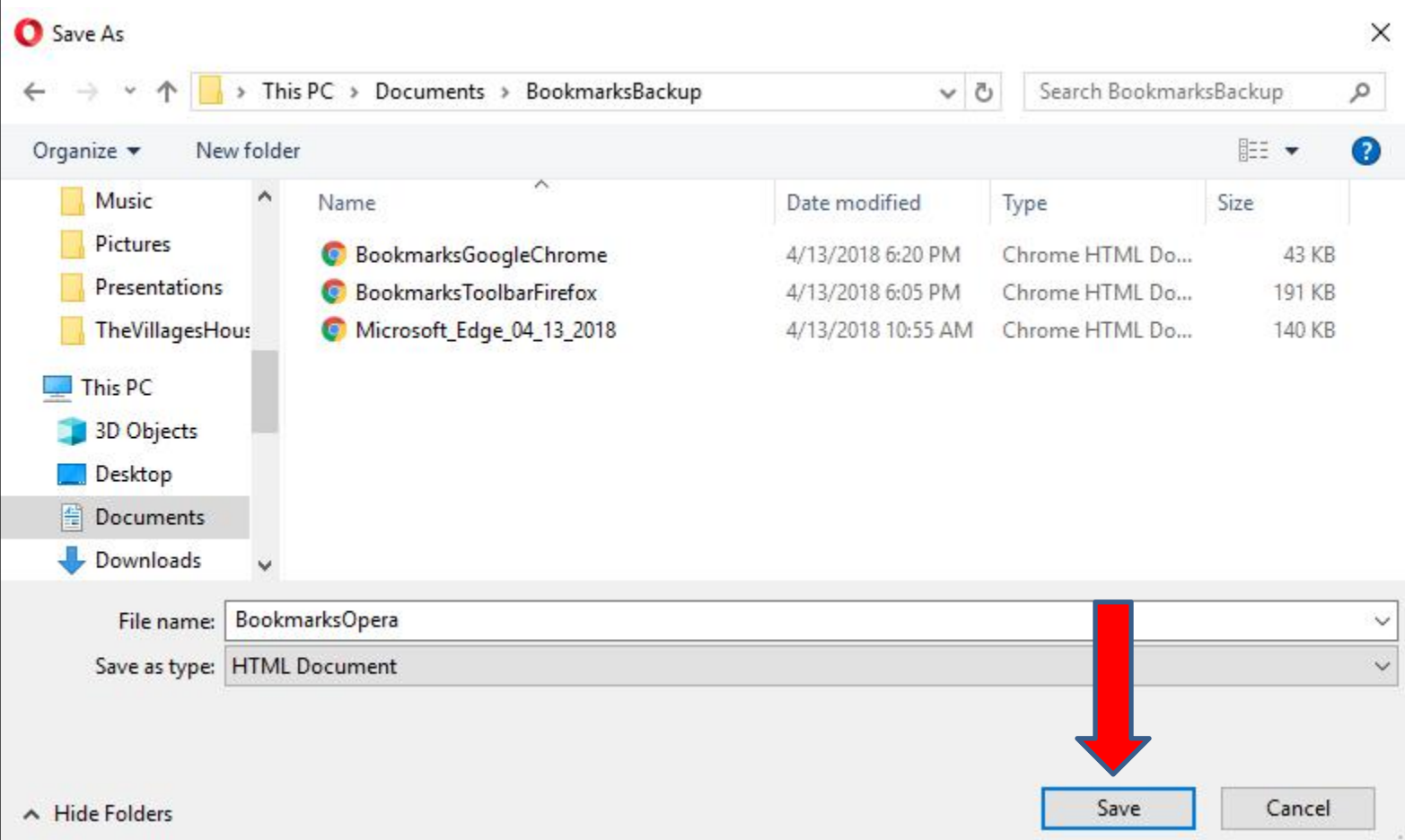
- **Windows closes and a new window opens like File Explorer. If the name is not highlighted, click on it to highlighted and type in another name. Next is a sample.**



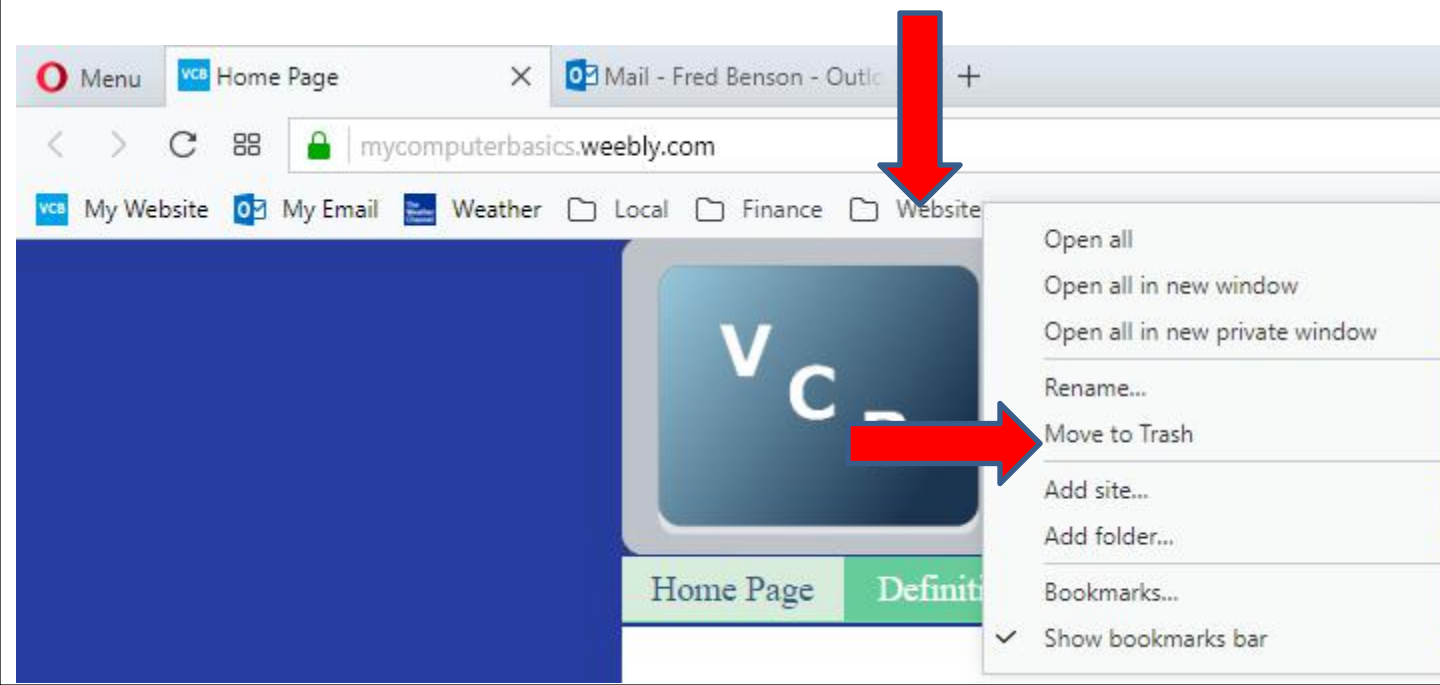
- Here is a sample of the new name. You then find the new Folder that you added. Like double click on Documents and double click on your Folder. Next is a sample of finding the one that I showed you before.



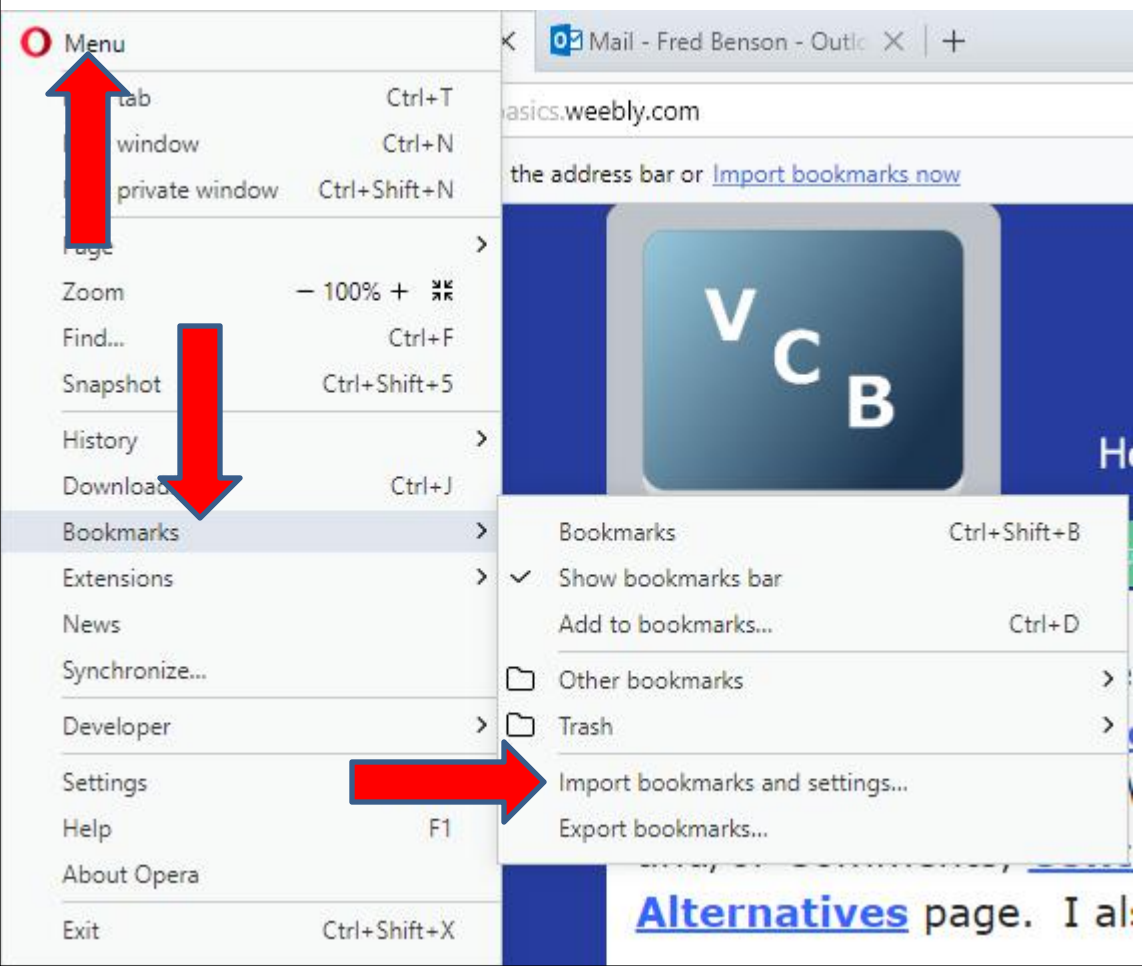
- Here is the Folder. Once you go to your Folder, click on Save at the bottom and next is what happens.



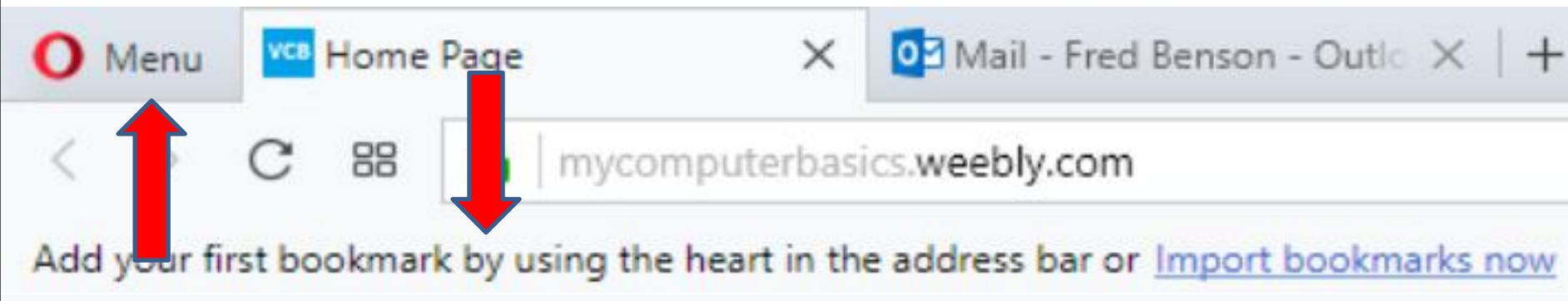
- **Window closes and it saved it on the Folder. I decided to delete all of them on the Bookmarks bar to Trash, so they look like it on a new computer to import the HTML file from your backup. Next is a sample of move all of them to Trash.**



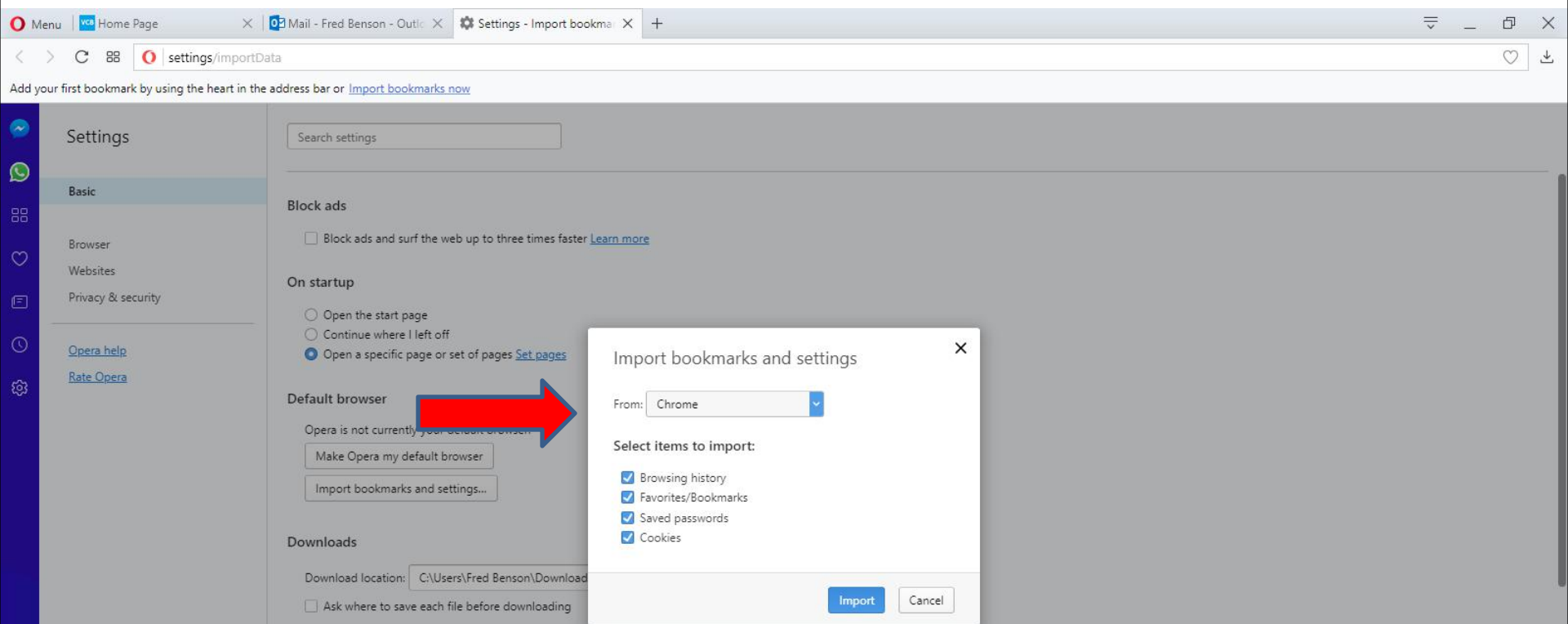
- You see the list again. Hover over Bookmarks again and a new window opens again and click on Import bookmarks and settings and next is what happens.



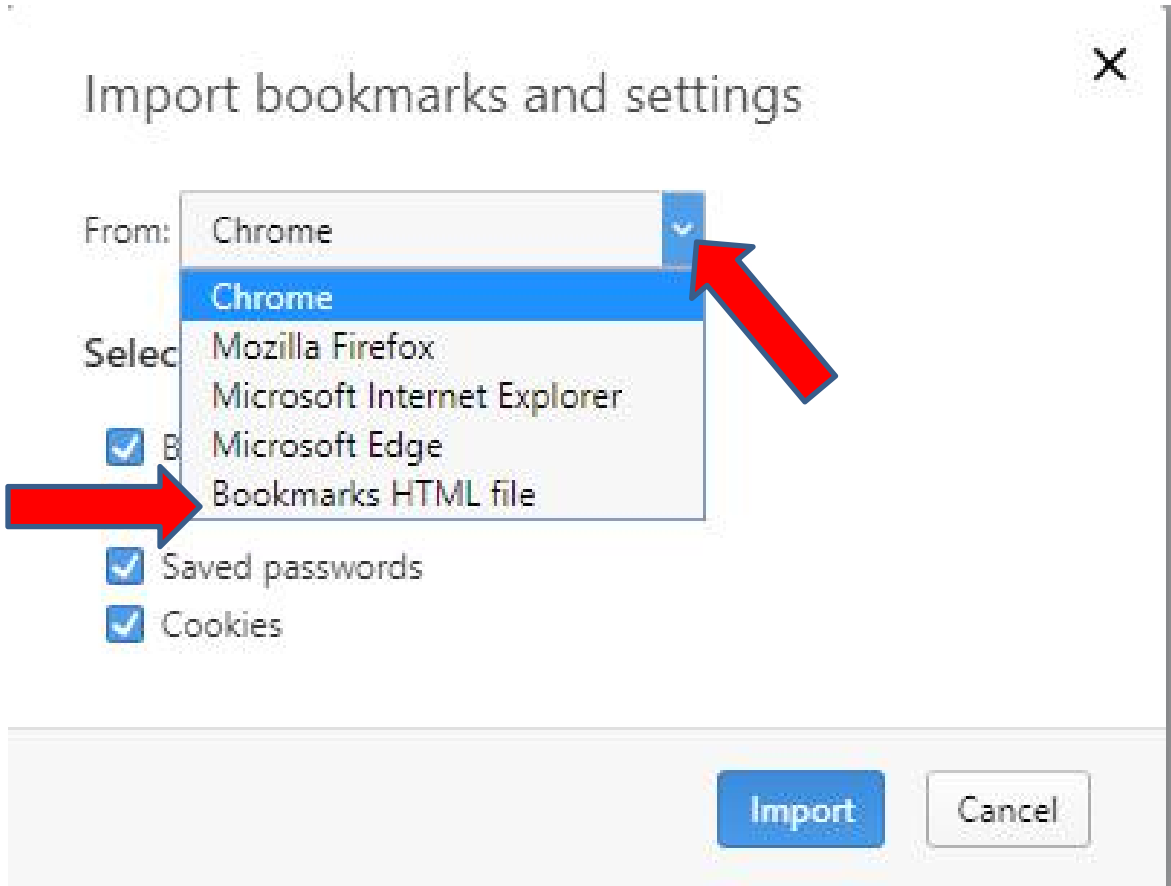
- You don't see them, like a new Computer when you set up the Bookmarks bar as I showed you in Step 4 – Part 5. You then click on Menu again and next is what happens again.



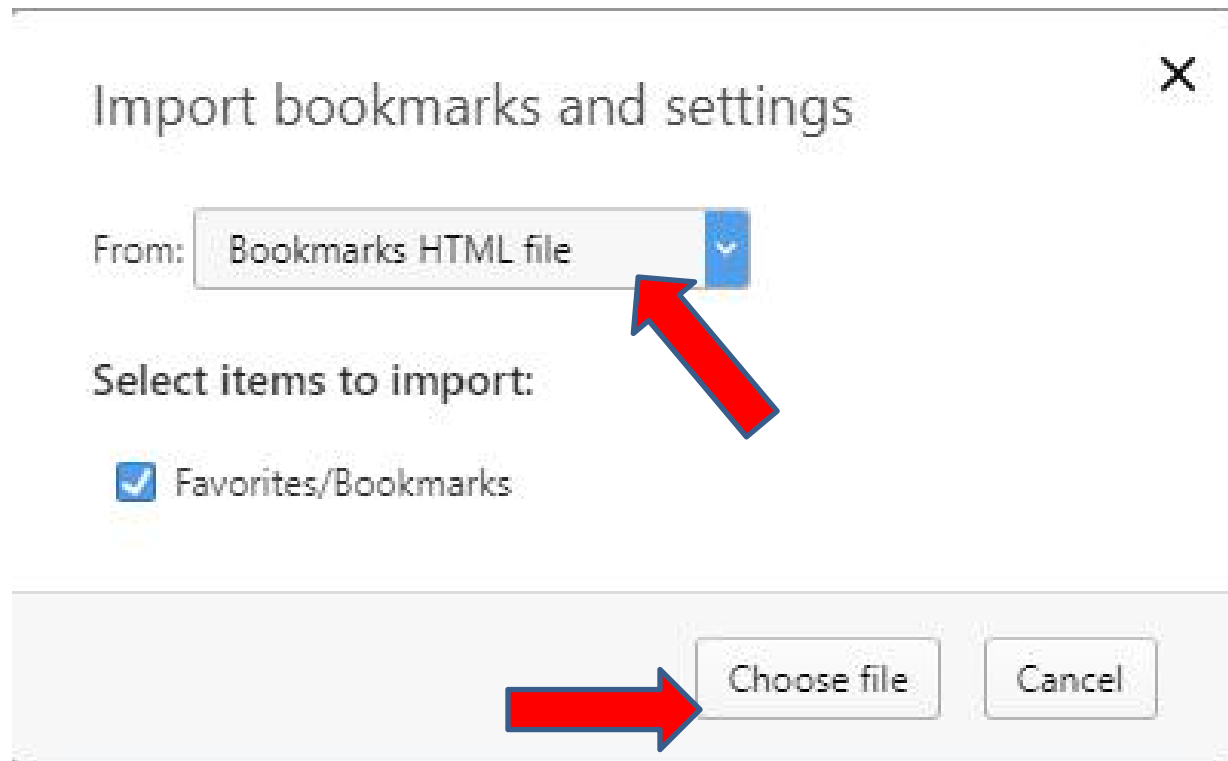
- **Windows closes a new Window opens in the middle. Next I will zoom in so you can see it.**



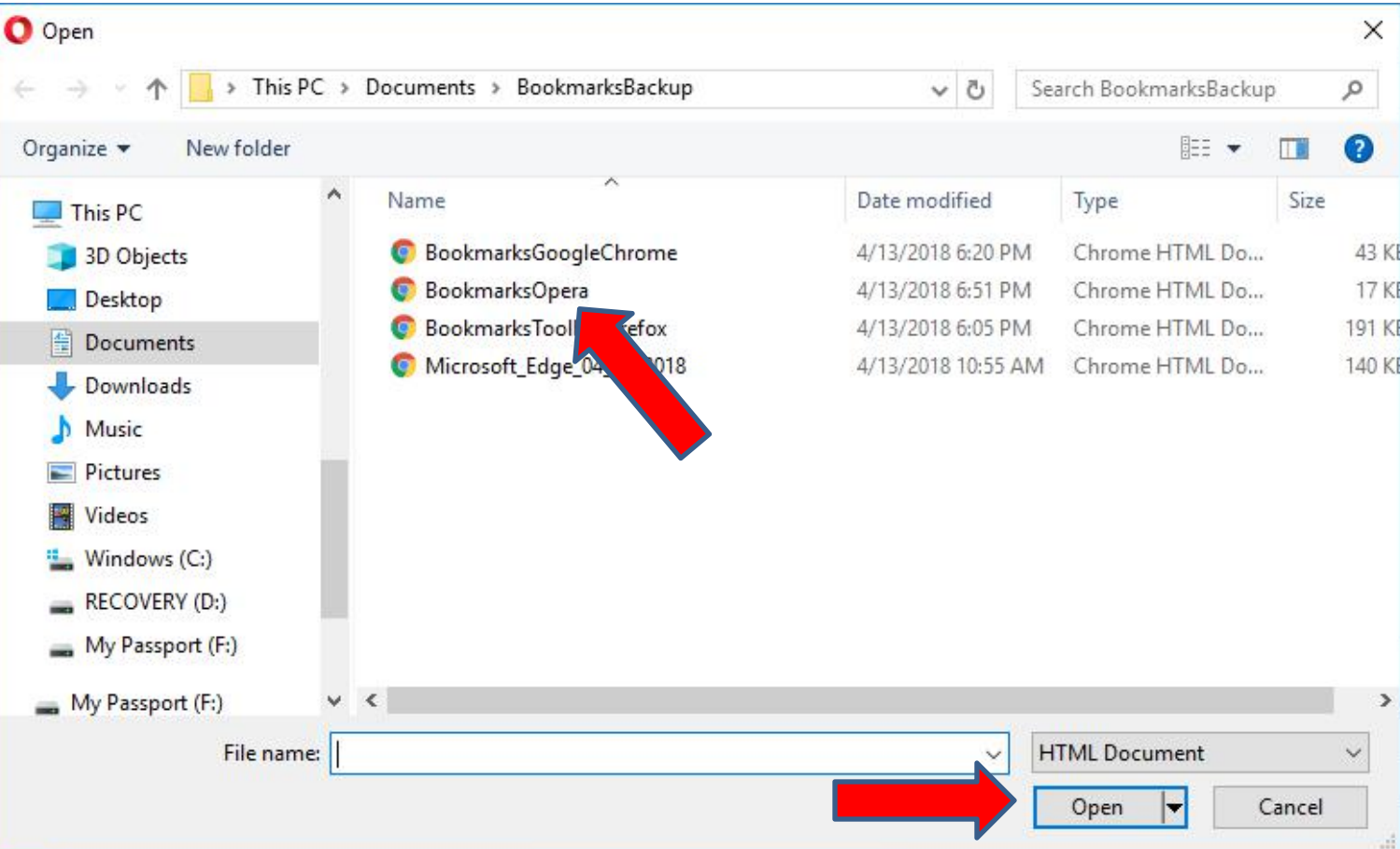
- You then click on the dropdown Icon right of Chrome and you see a list and then click on Bookmarks HTML and next is what happens.



- **Window changes and you see it. Then click on Choose file at the bottom and next is what happens.**



- A new window opens, like File Explorer. Find the Folder, like this one and Double click or click on it and click on Open and next is what happens.



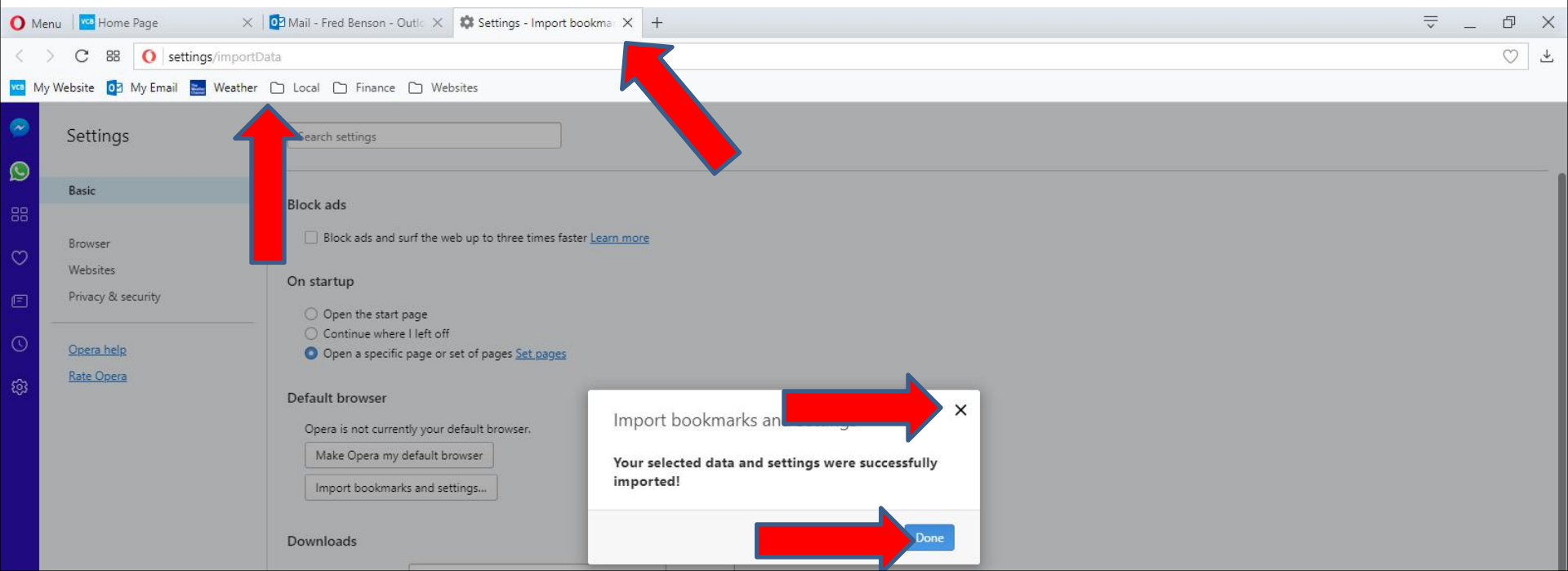
