

Step 8 – Part B – Photo Fuse

What is Photo Fuse?

- For example, if you take two pictures of the same group, and one person on the first picture has eyes closed or leaning down and someone else on the second picture has eyes closed or not smiling and you want to fix it.
- Photo Fuse will select a face from one picture and put it on the second one.
- When you do a Create, you don't need to copy, because it is a separate photo.

Step 8 – Part B – Photo Fuse

- Highlight using same process as Panorama, Part A.

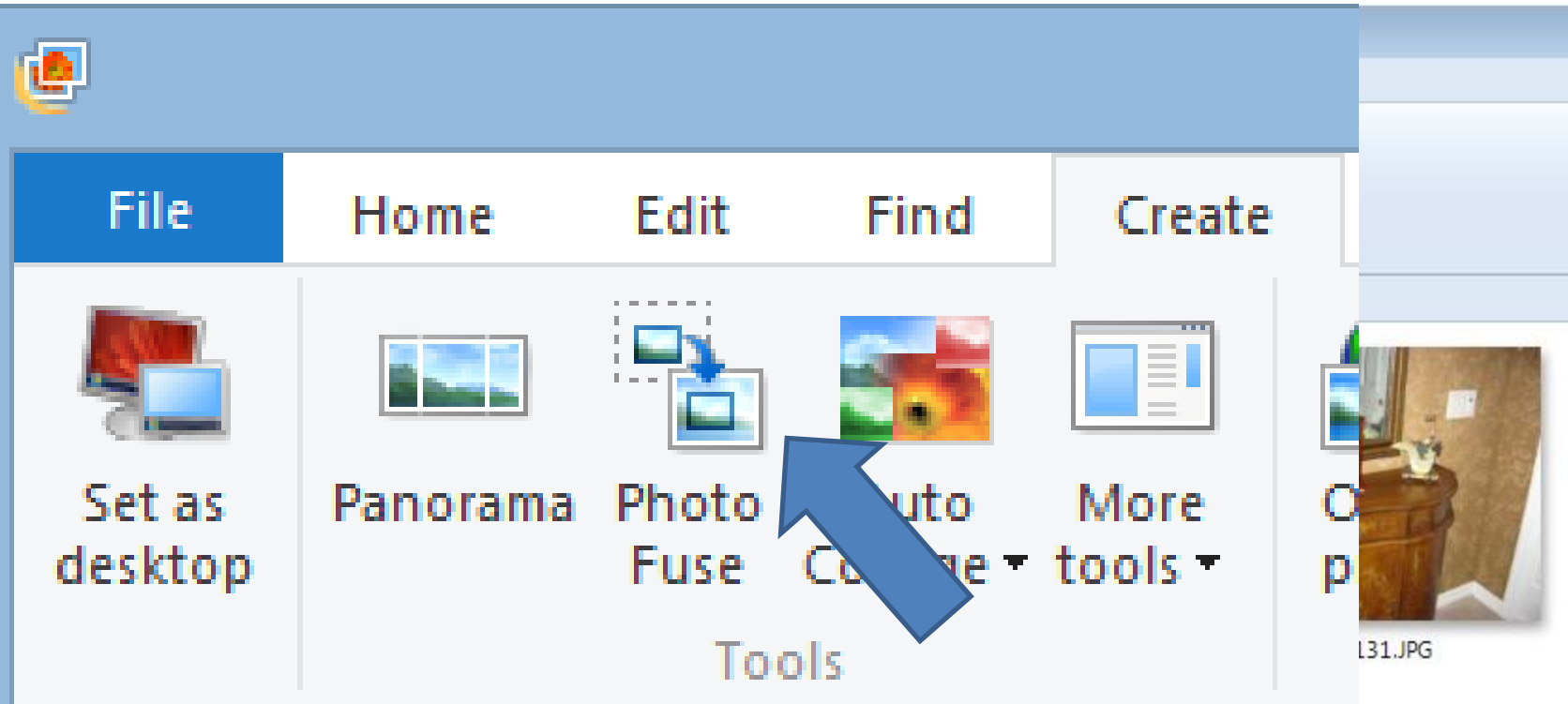

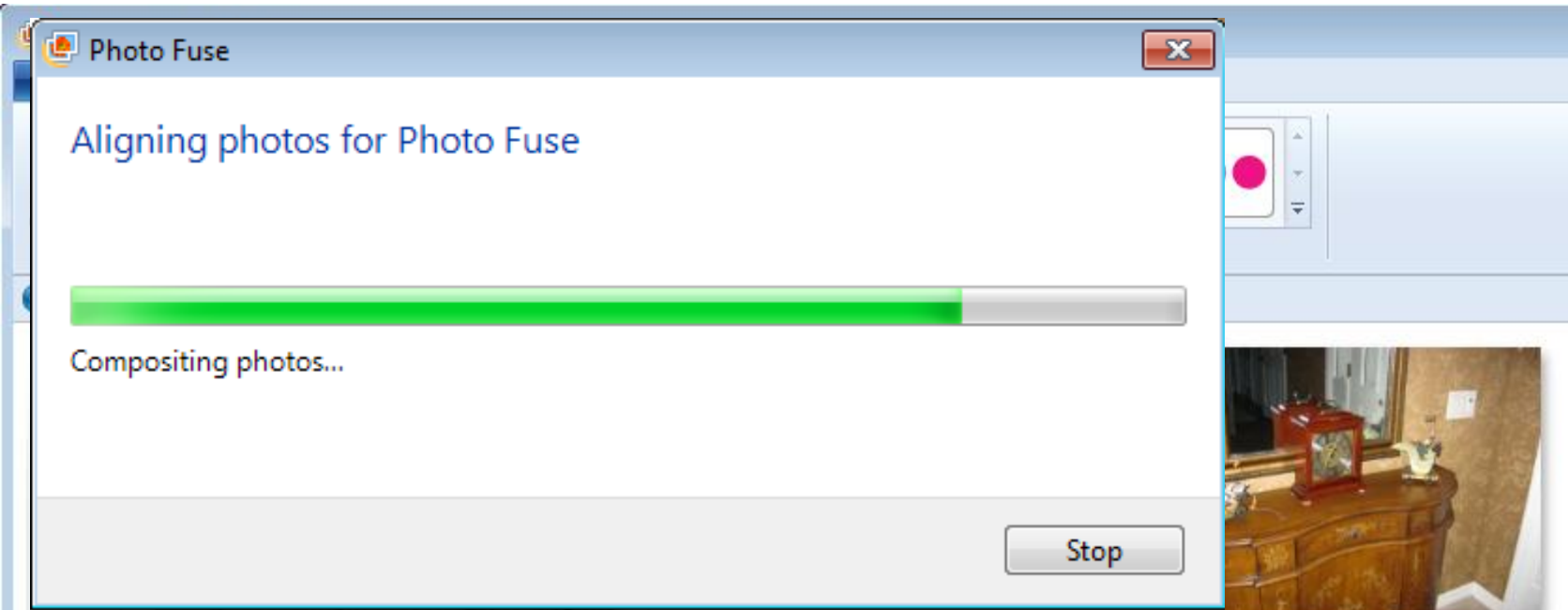

- It then shows **Aligning photos for Photo Fuse.**



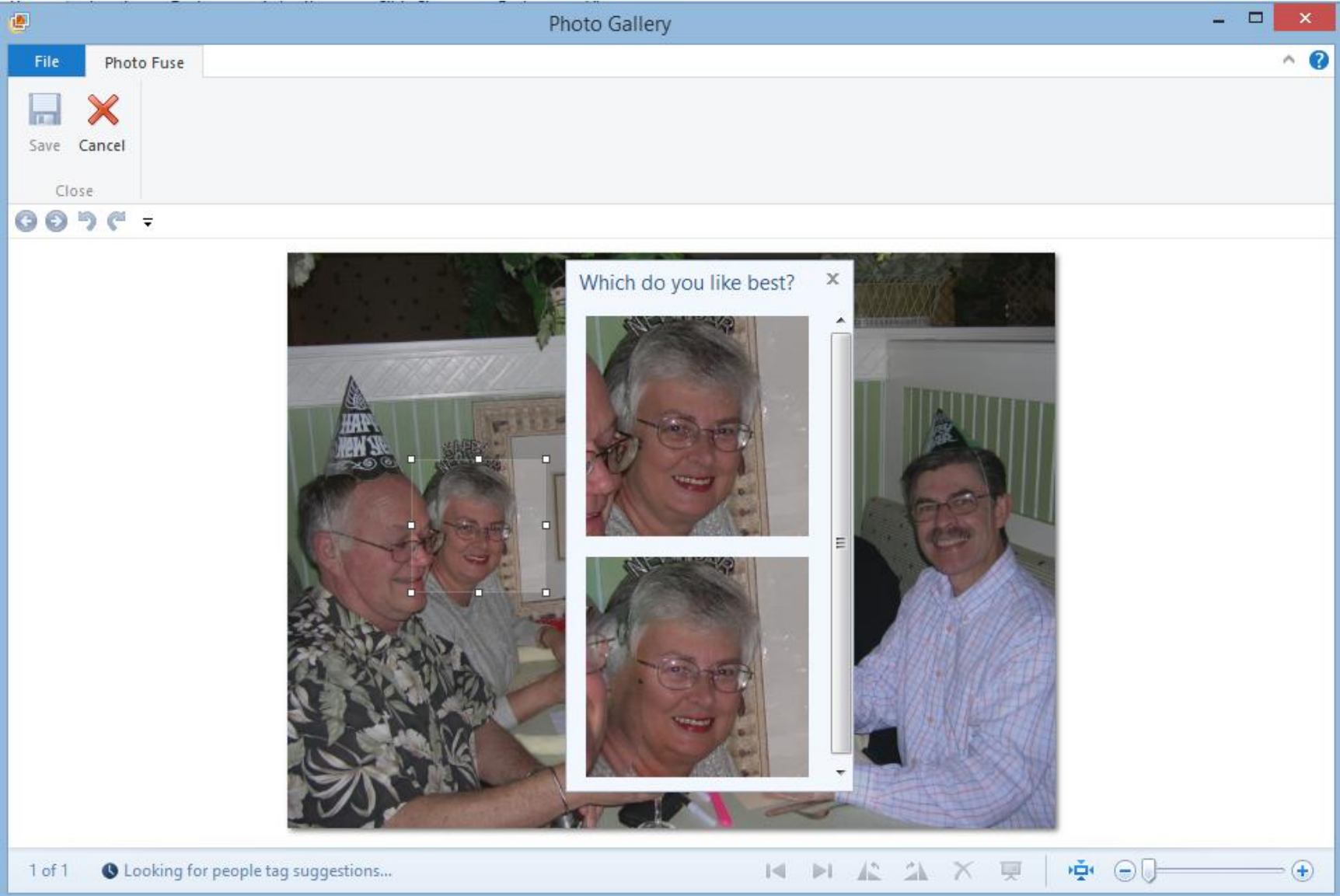

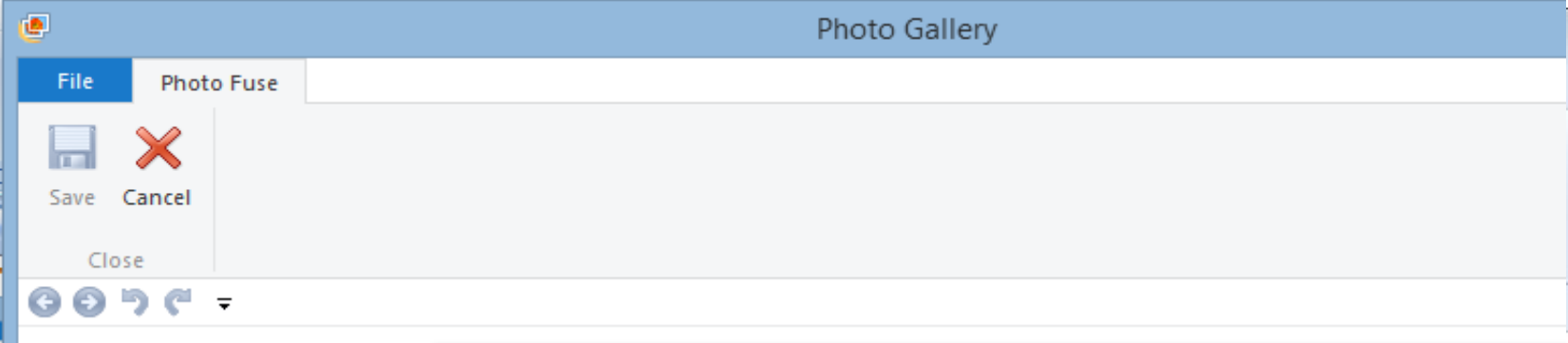

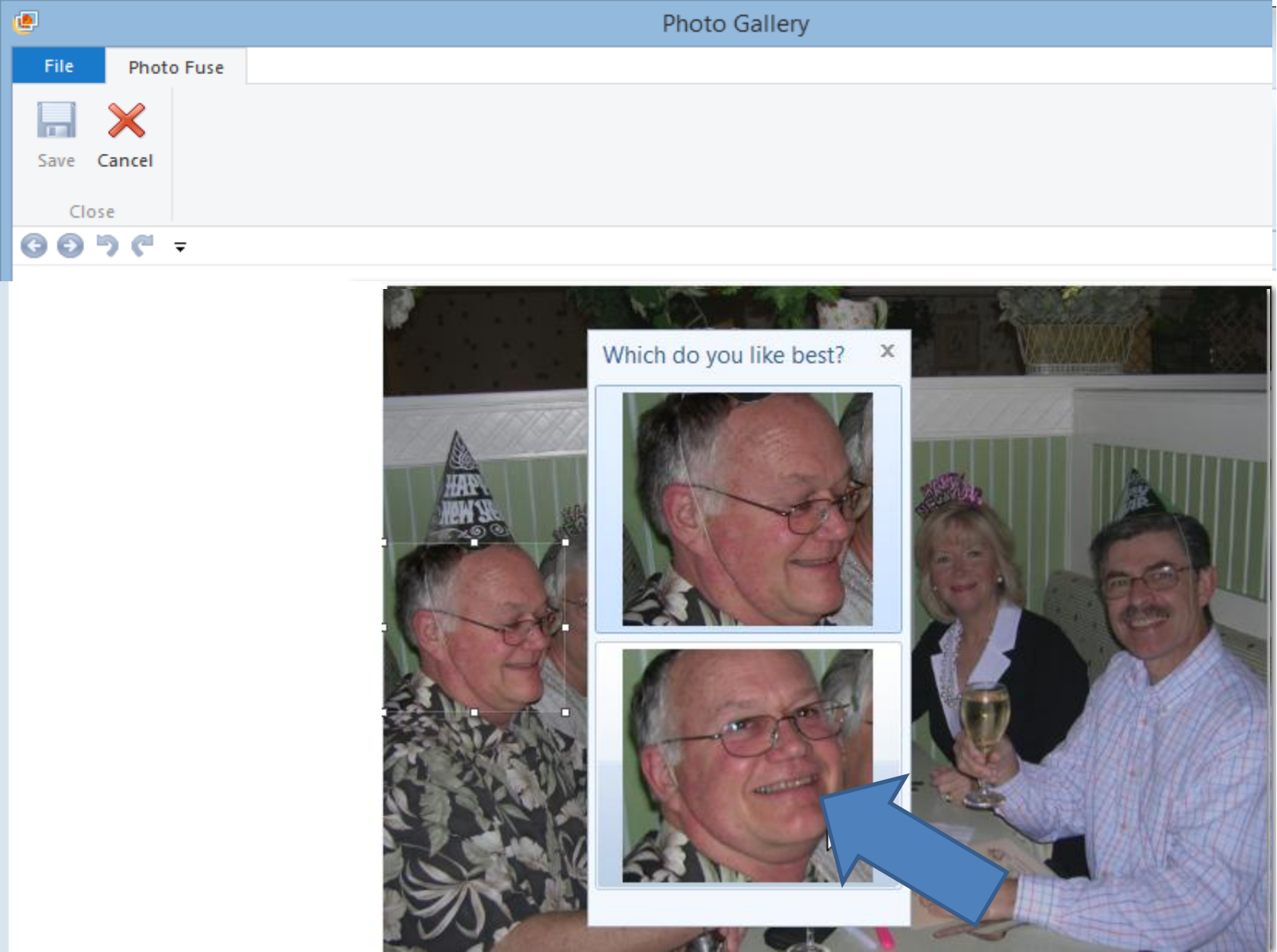
- A new window opens showing one selection.



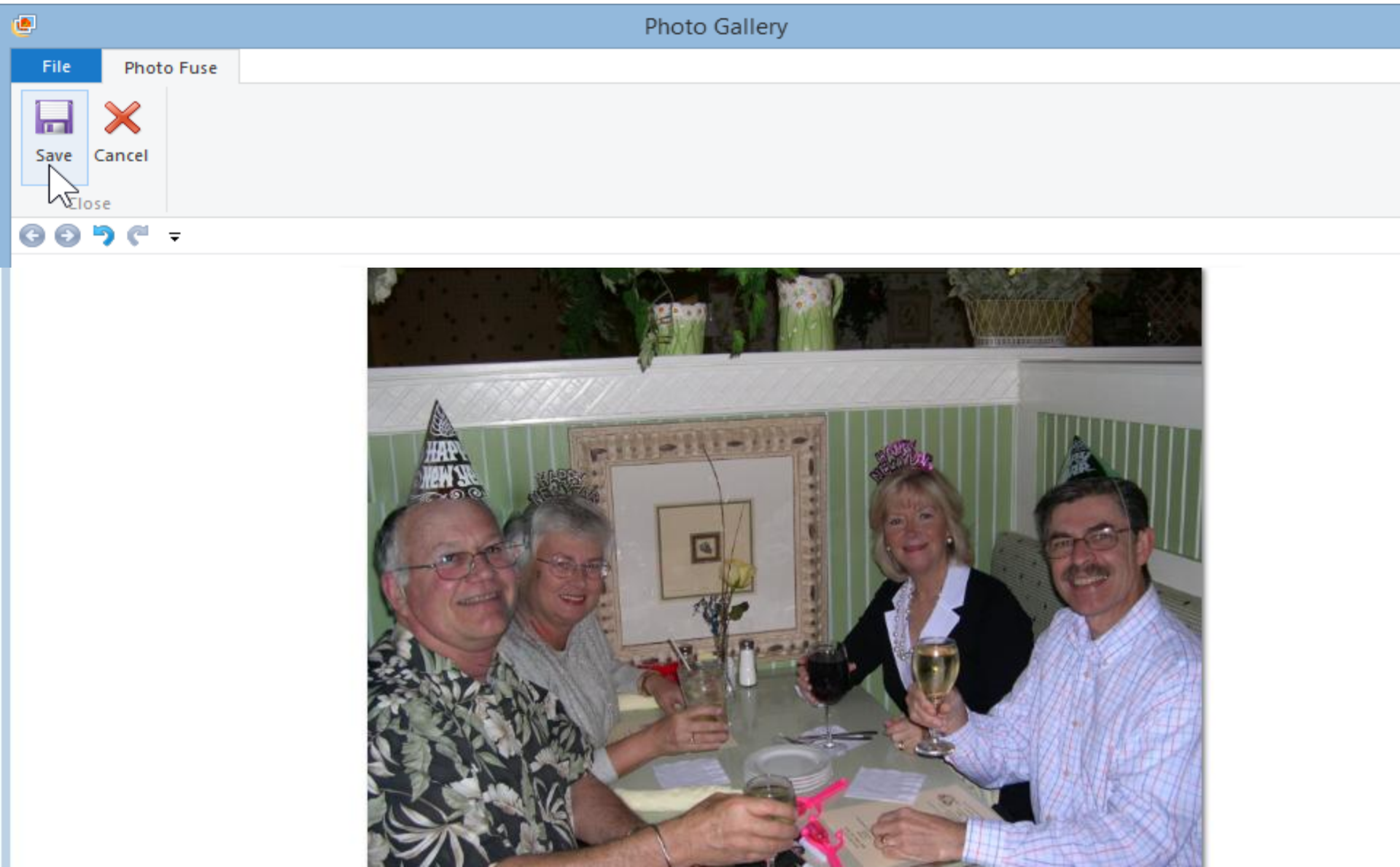
- You then drag it to an area you want to change, like the one below.



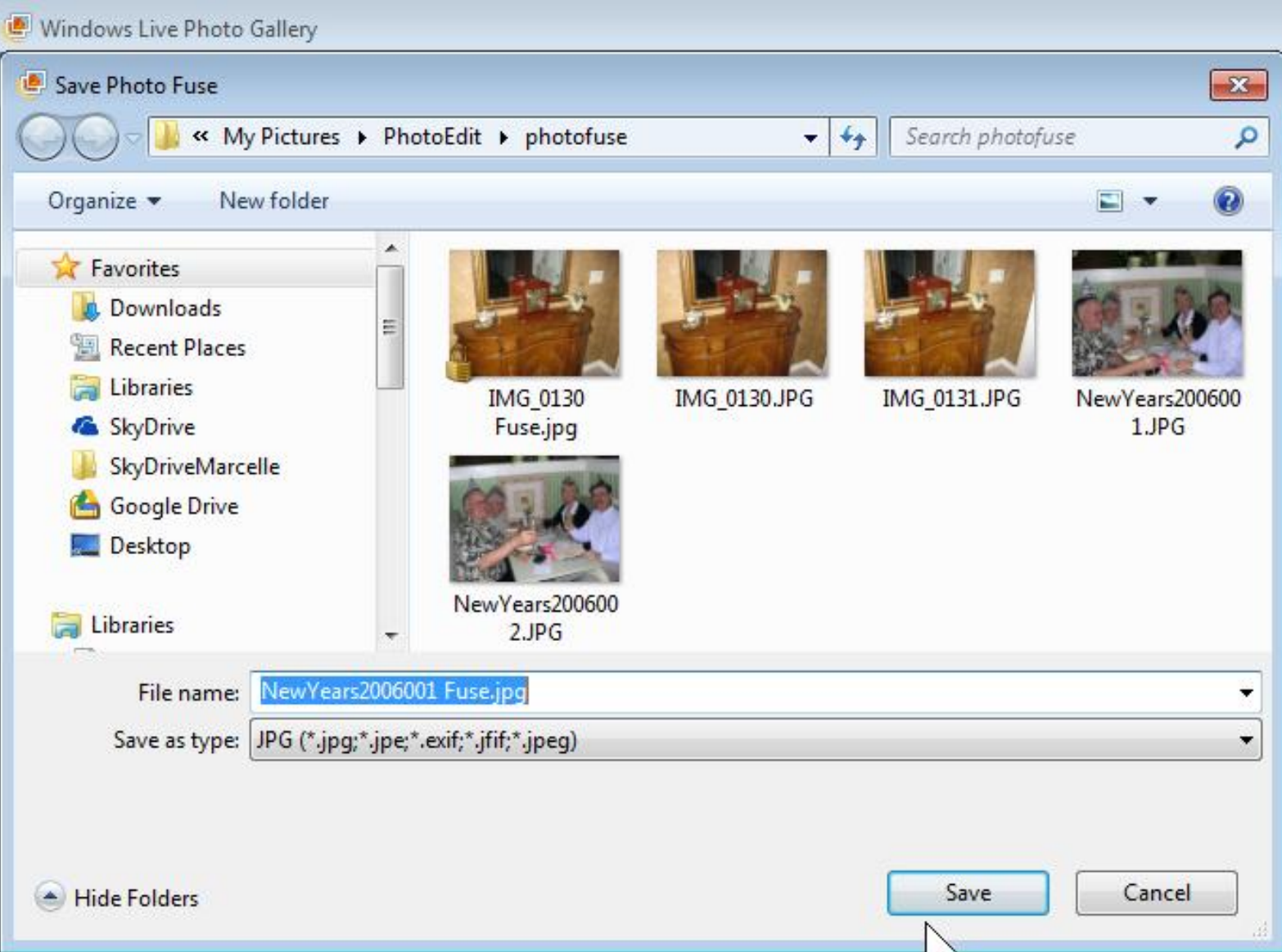
- You then can expand it or minimize it and then click on the one you want, like this one below.

Photo Fuse Tip?

- **Photo Fuse always uses the first picture as the major one and can add items from the second.**
- **If you want to use the second picture as the major, you will need to change the order. So, you first change the name of the first picture.**



I will Zoom in.

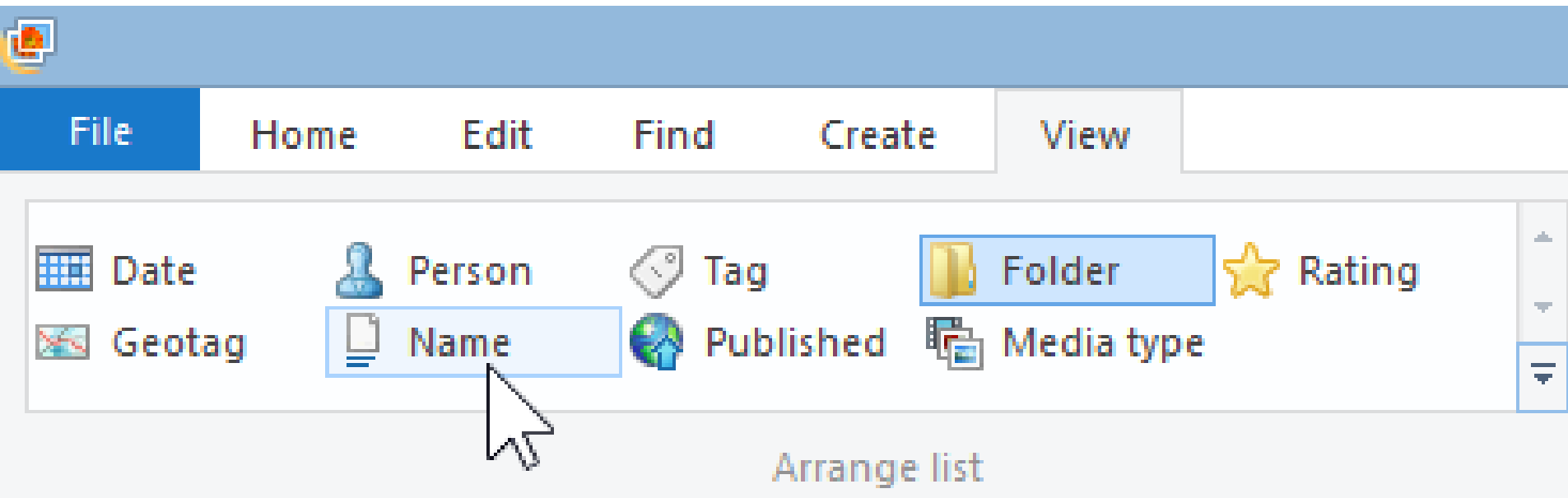
- Click on the name.
- Then change the end to something like 003



NewYears2006003

Click on View Tap

- Then Click on Name.



It then moves to "Second"

- When you Photo Fuse 002 is now the Major.

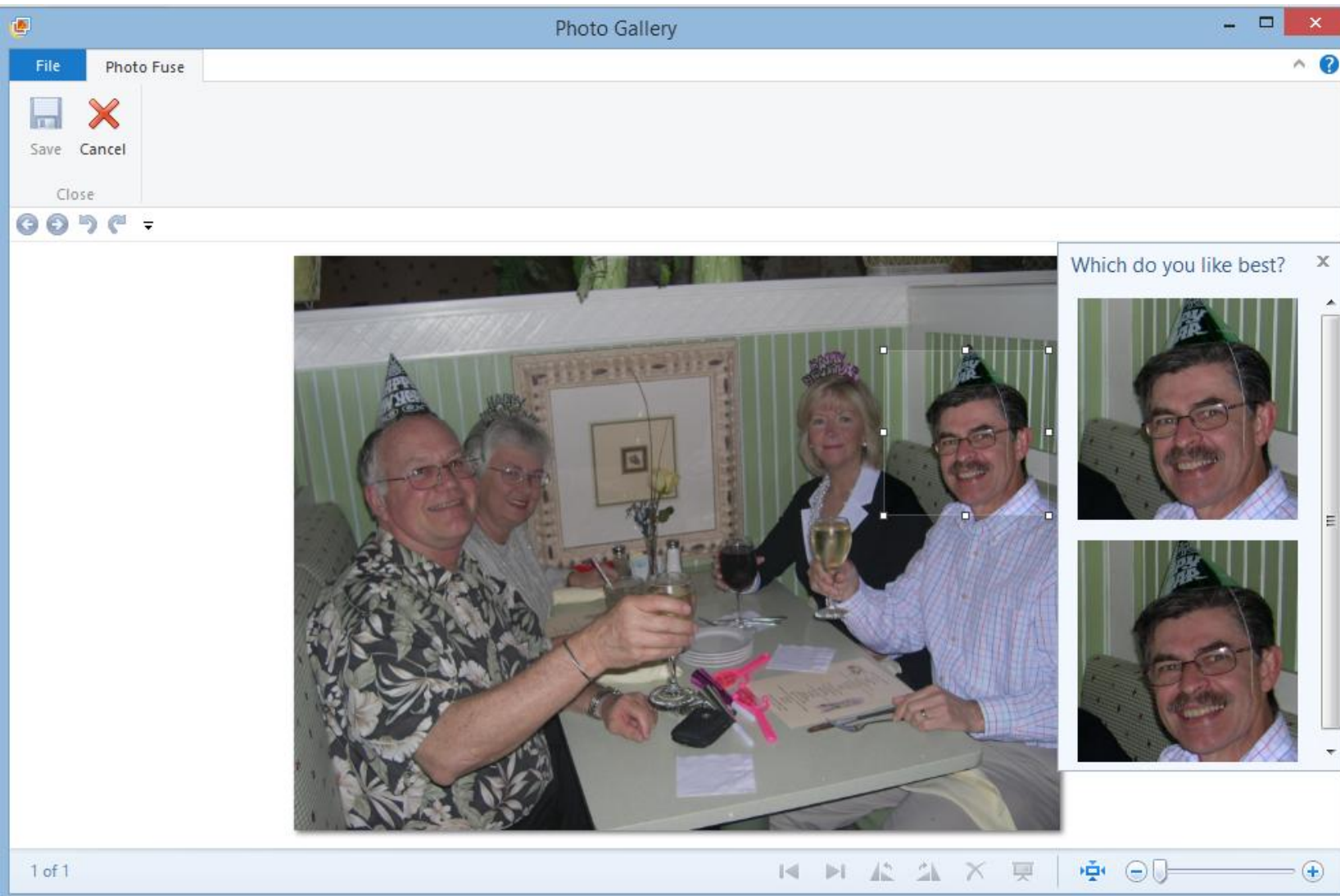

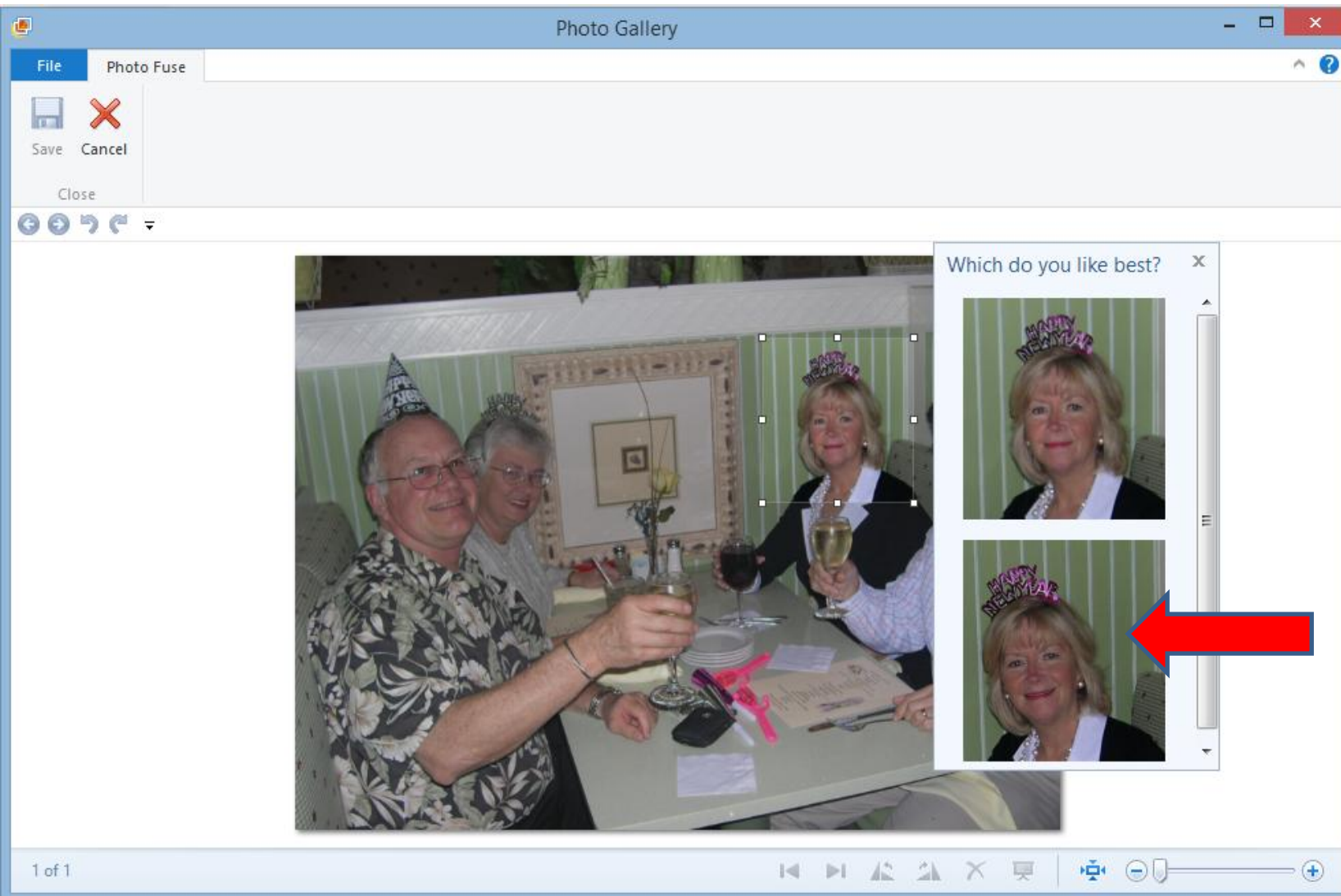
