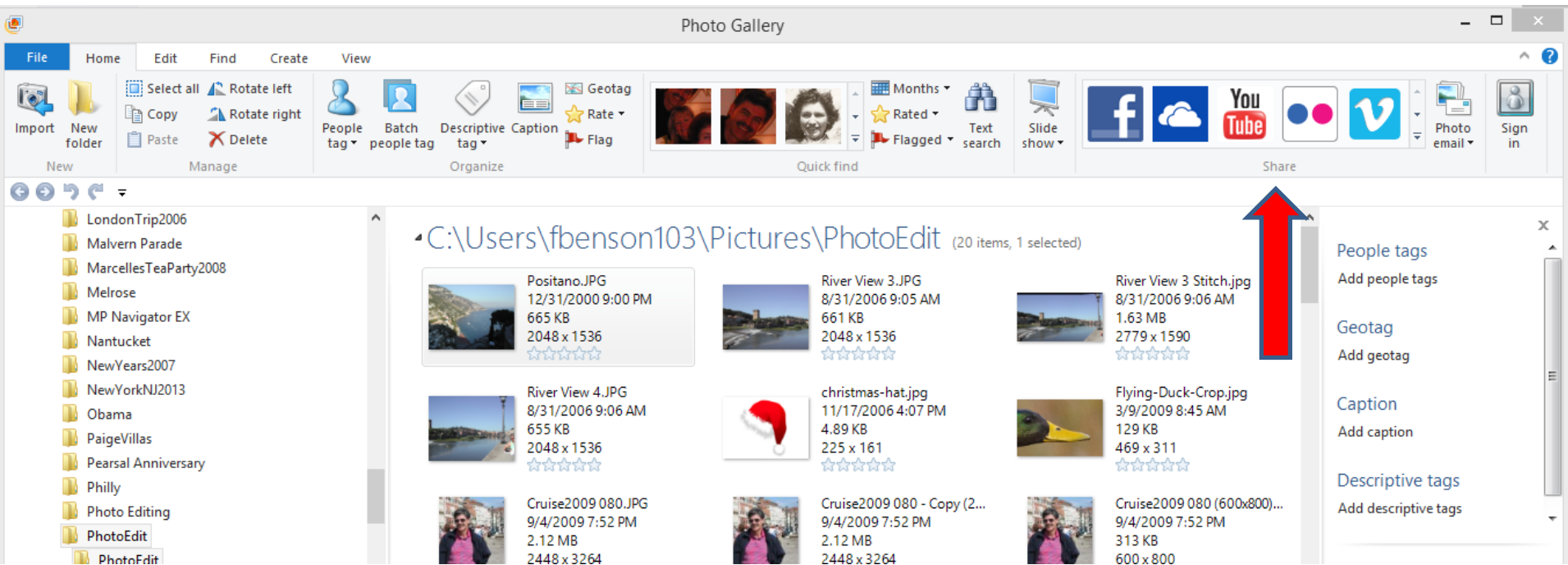


# **Step 9 – Publish/Share Photos and Videos**

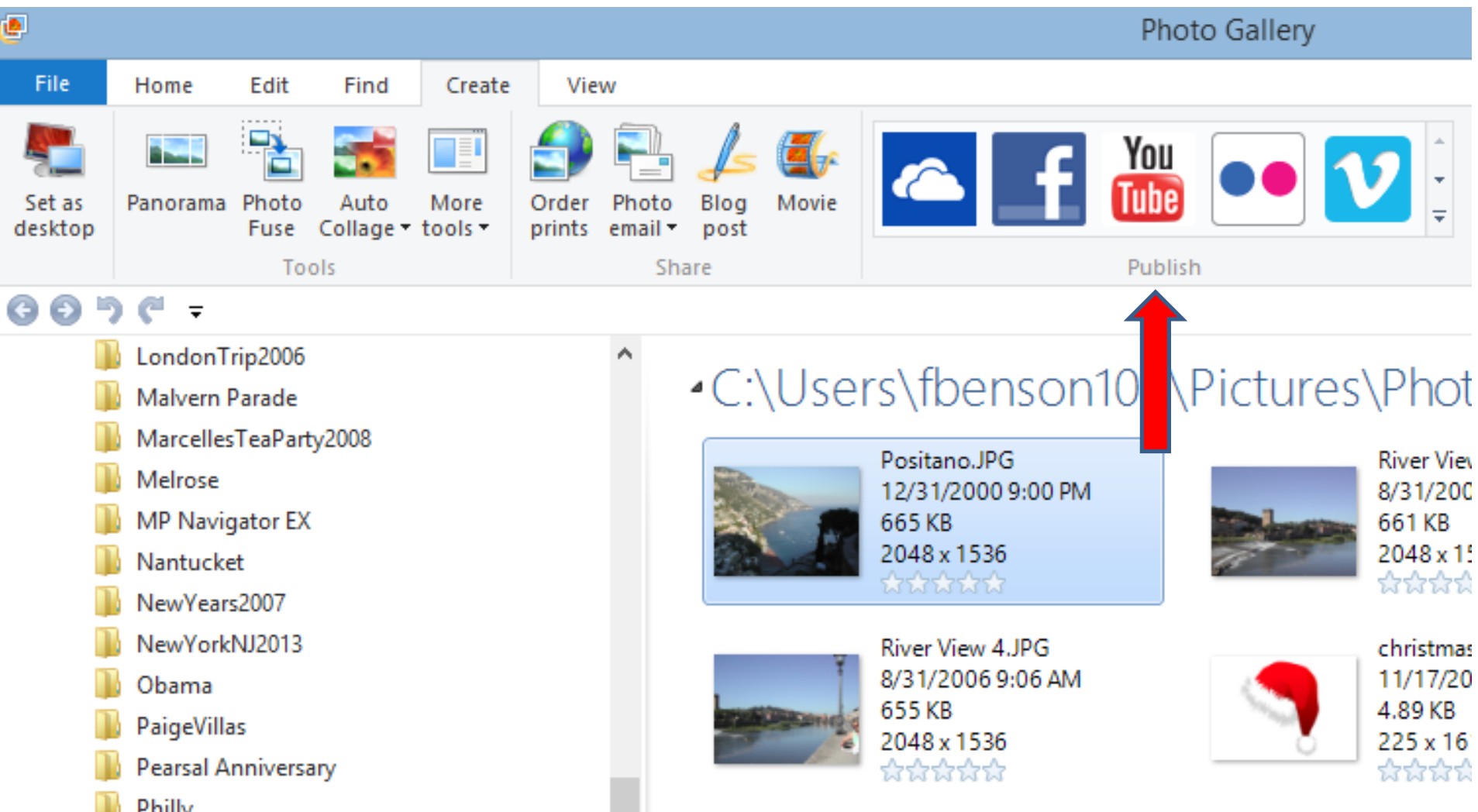
## **How to Publish/Share Photos and Videos?**

- In Photo Gallery home page there are share options, but they are the same as publish, which is in the Create page.**
- The other option is to Share inside a slide show. I will show you that later.**

- This is the Home page that shows Share. Next is Create page.



- This is the Create page that shows Publish. Next I will explain each one.

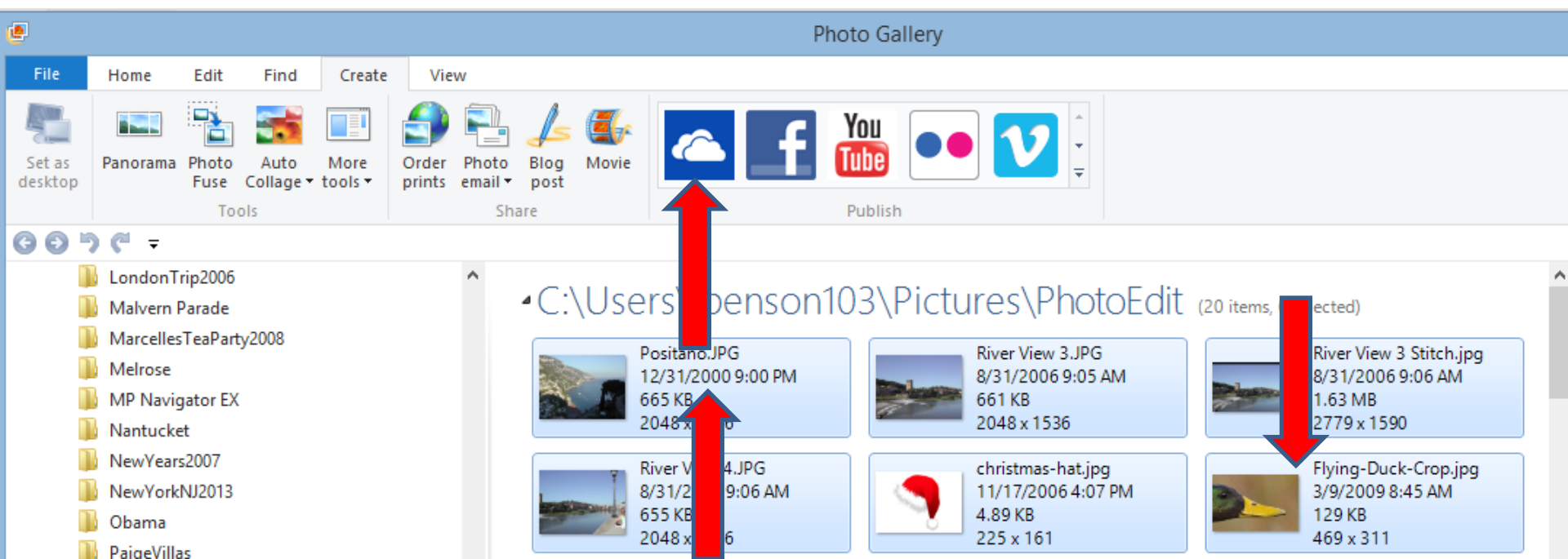





- Click on dropdown to see them all.
- You then see them all.
- The icons are OneDrive, Facebook, YouTube, Flickr, Vimeo, Groups.
- I will show you OneDrive, Facebook and YouTube.
- Next, is a link to use Flickr and information for Vimeo and Groups.

- To learn how to do Flickr, click [HERE](#), which is a link to a website page that walks you through how to use it.
- Sorry, I don't use Vimeo and there is no websites or videos to explain how to publish to Vimeo from Photo Gallery.
- The Groups does not work anymore.
- Next, I will show you OneDrive.

- **First click on the first photo, then press and hold Shift key and click on the last one or press and hold Ctrl key and select the ones you want to Publish/Share. Then click on the One Drive icon.**

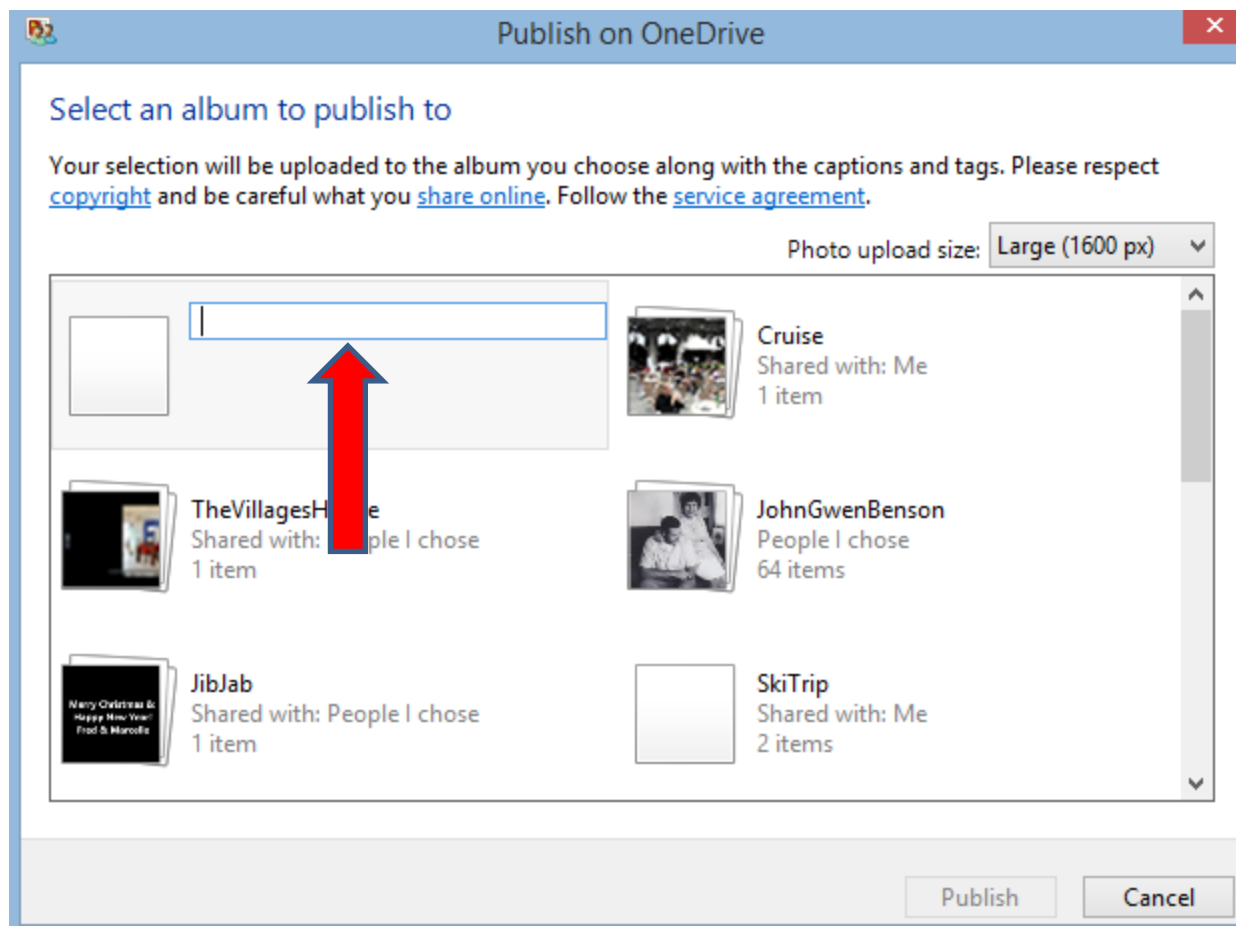

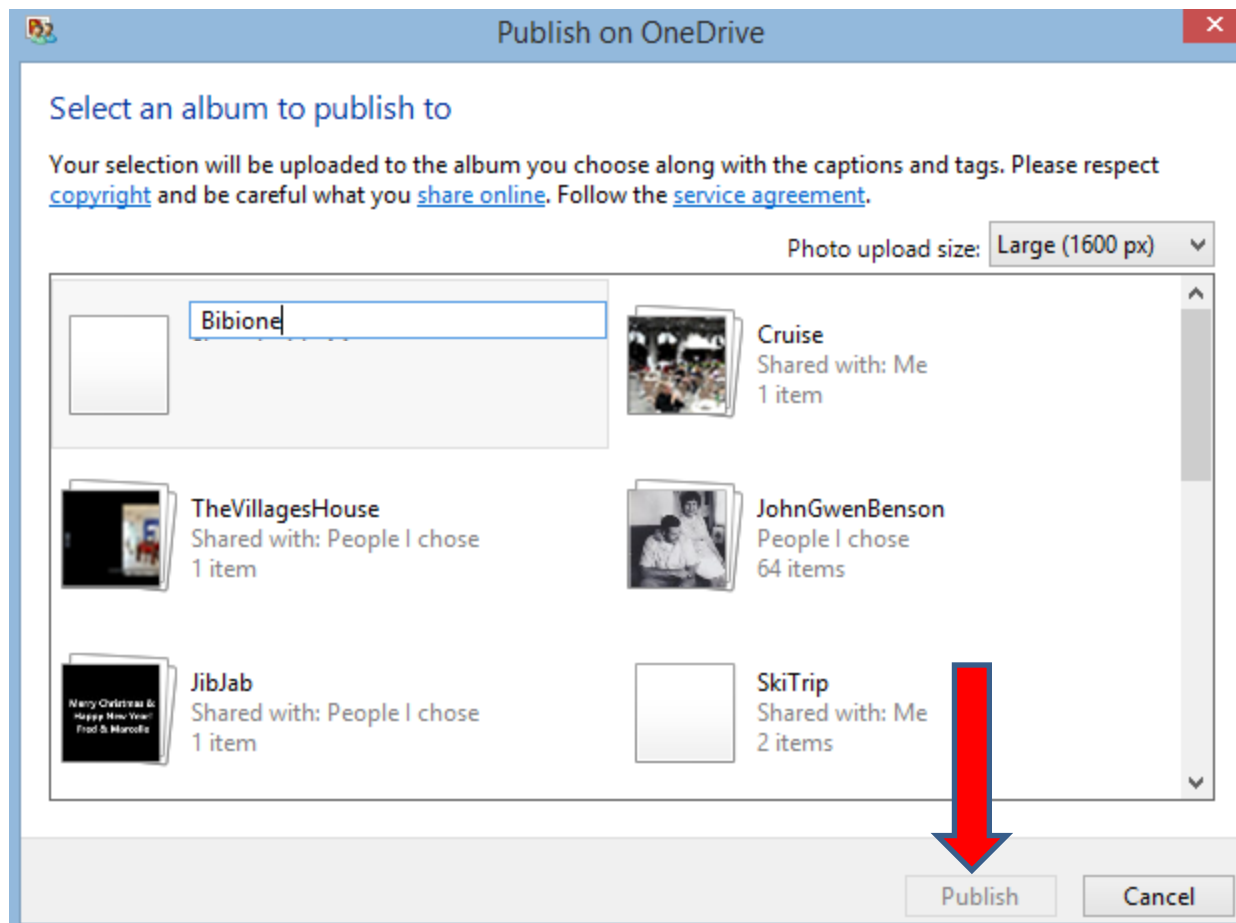

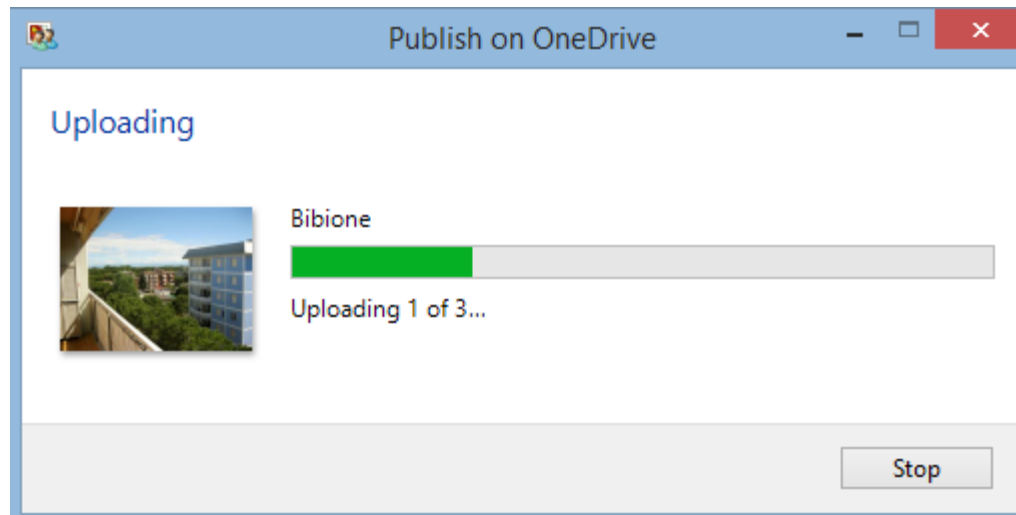
- Once you sign in, a new window opens. You can select a folder, or create a new folder.
- Next is a sample, like Bibione.



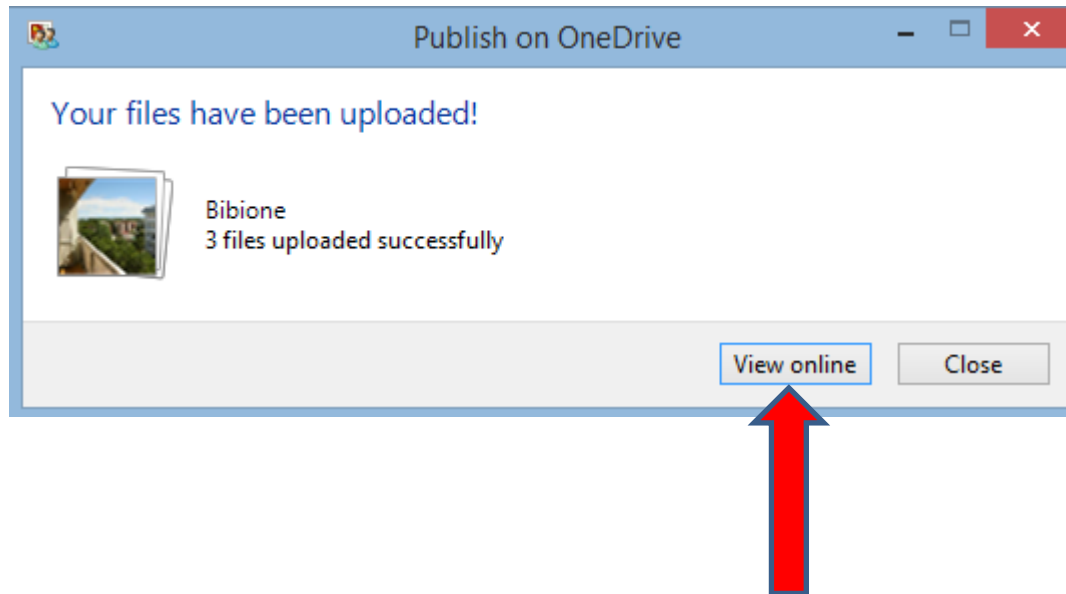
- Then, click on Publish.



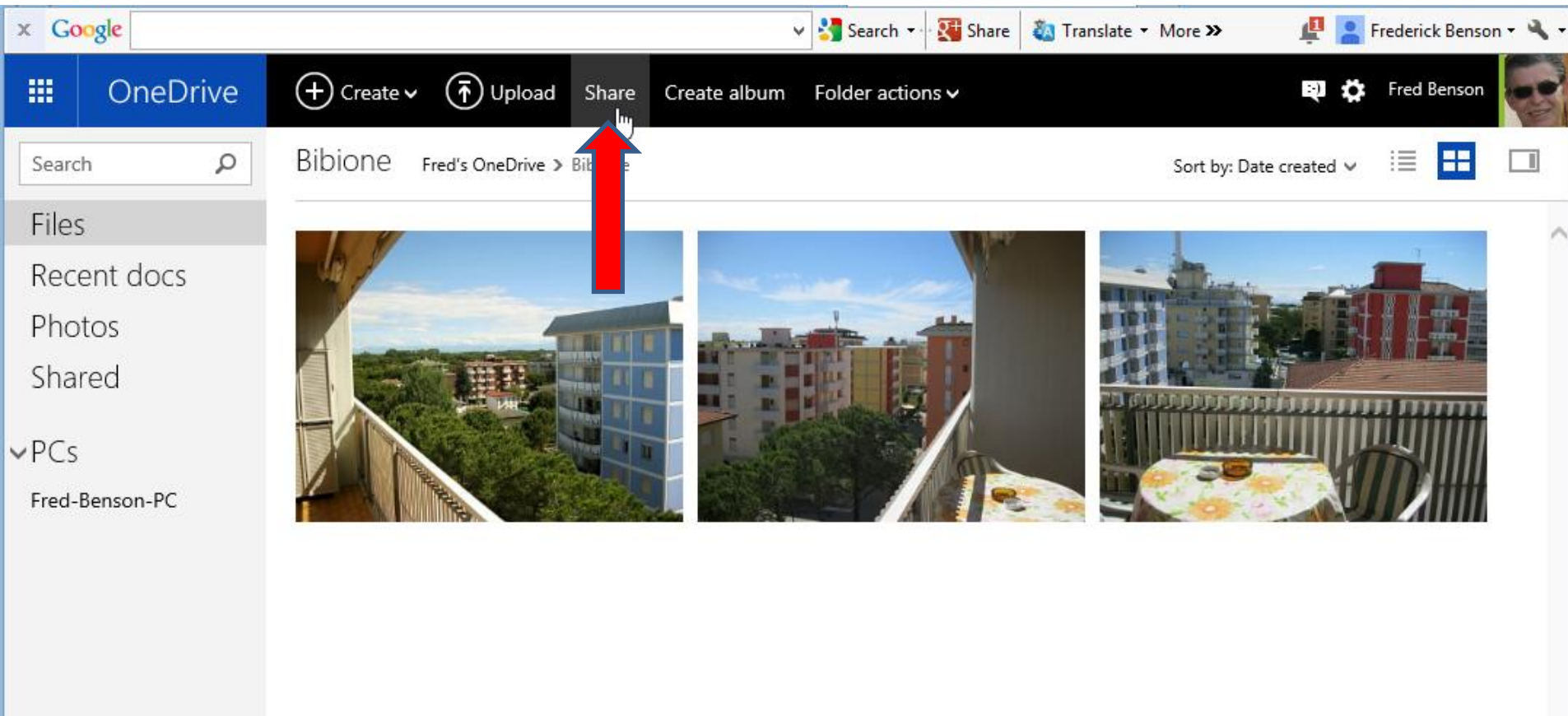
- **New window open showing it is Uploading.**

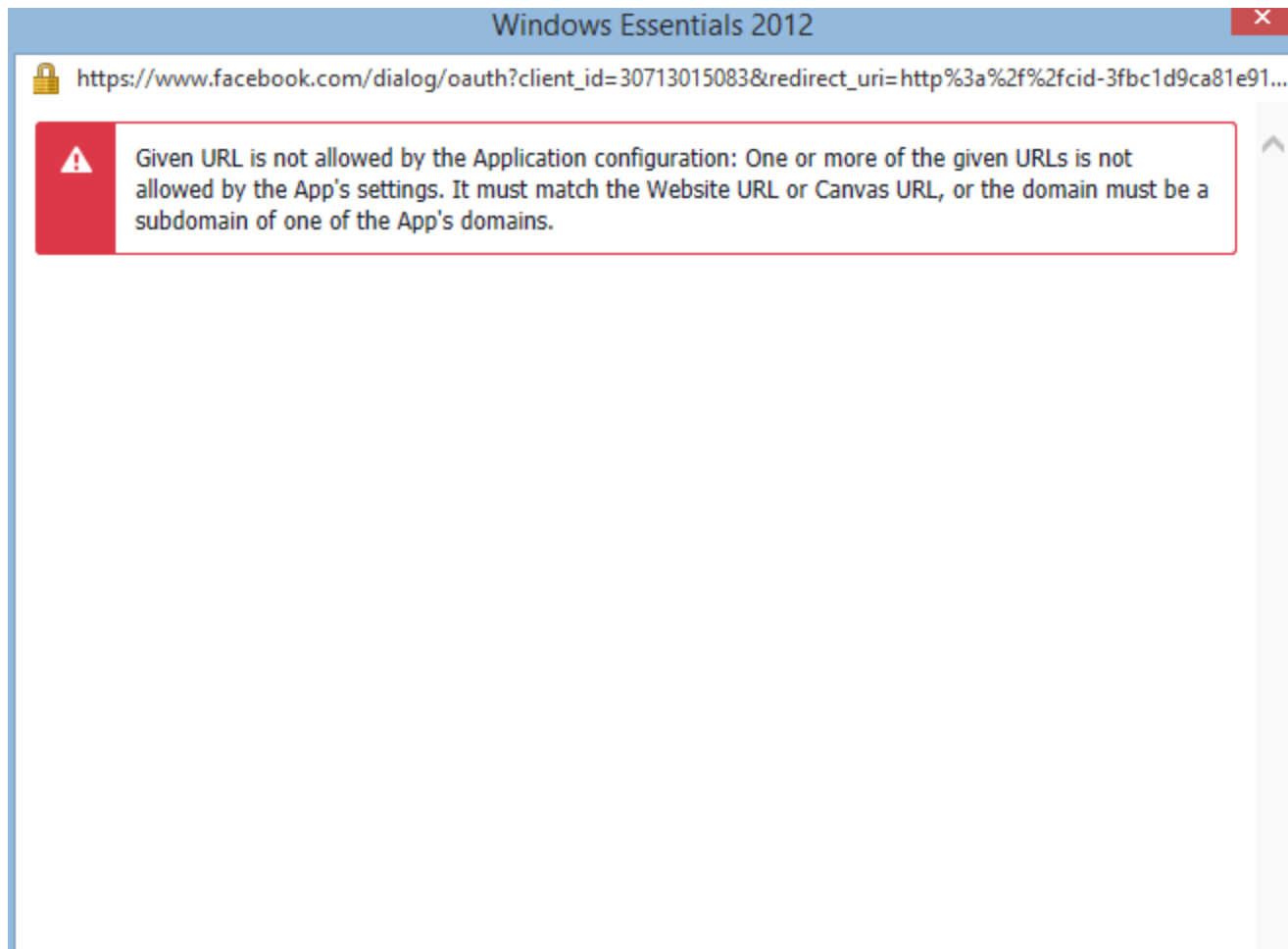

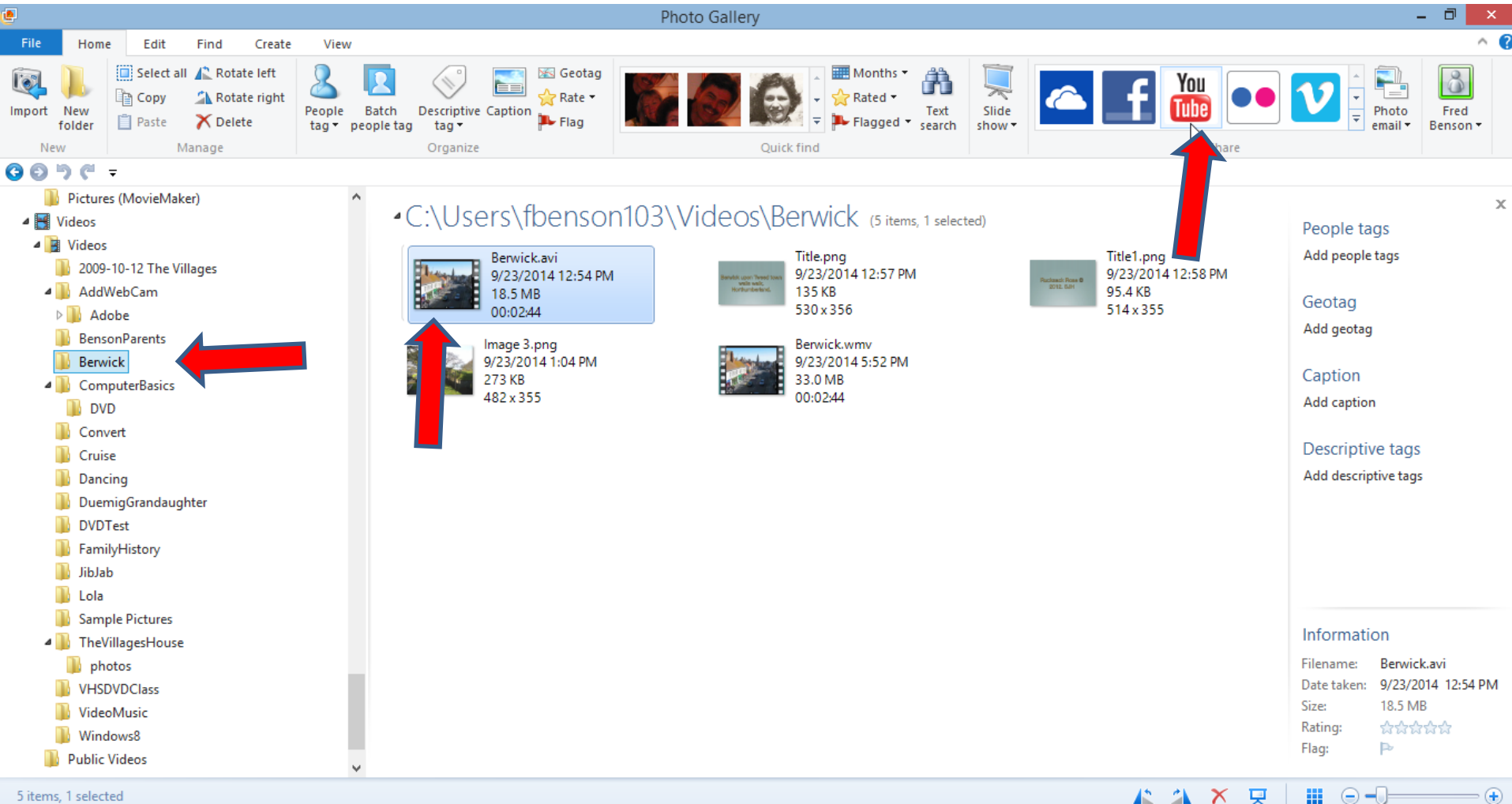
# New window opens.



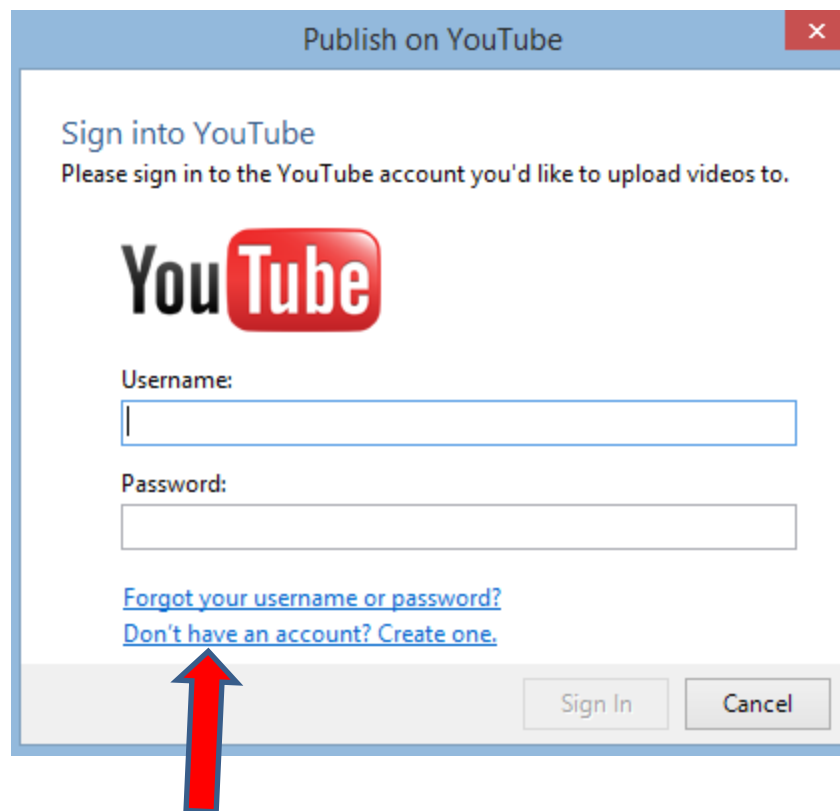
- Sometimes a new window opens with an error. I could not fix it. So, click [HERE](#) to go to a website page that walks you through it. Next is YouTube.



- **YouTube only takes videos. First go to a folder with videos. Then click on a Video and then click on YouTube.**

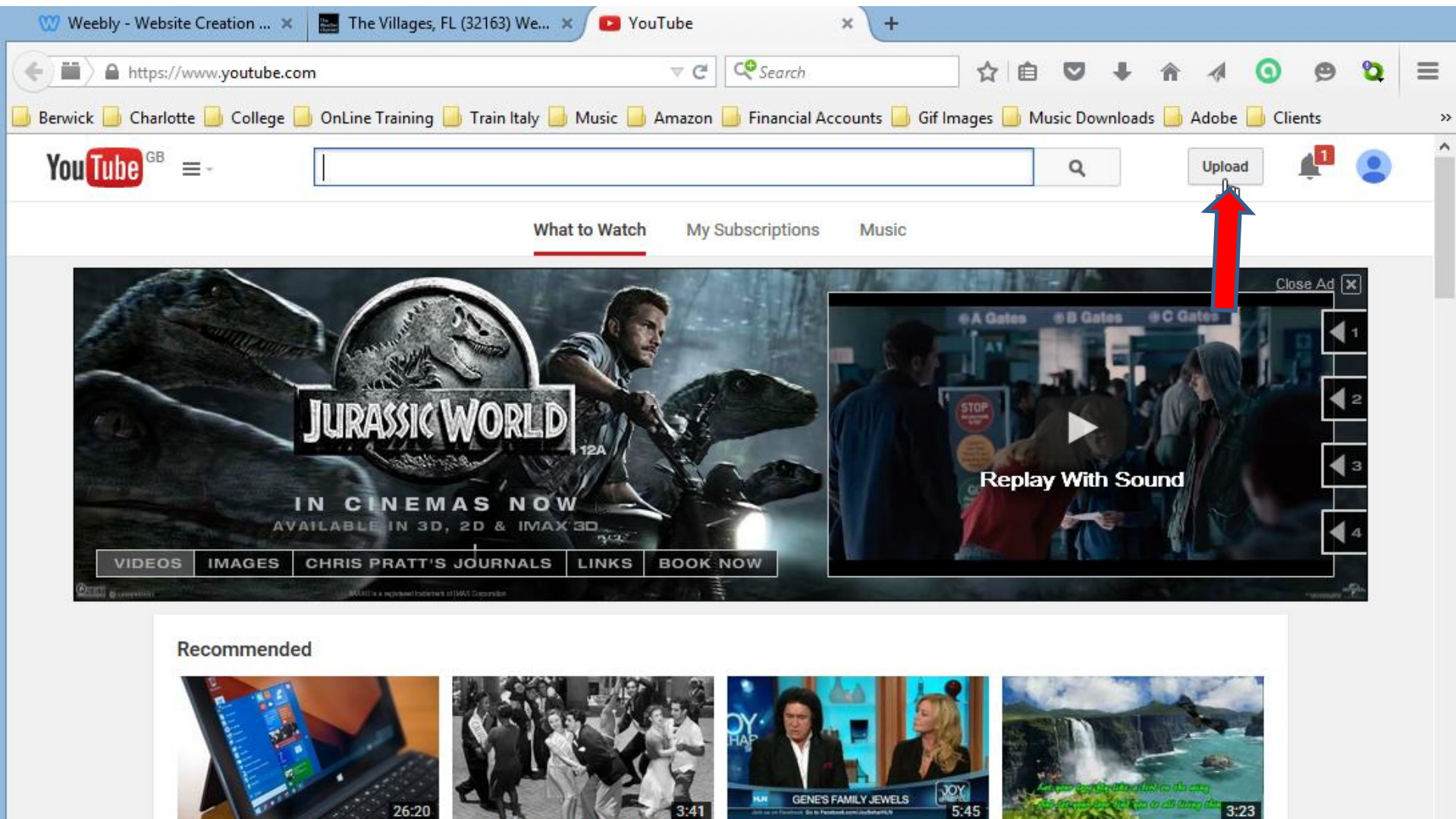


- **New window opens. If you have a YouTube account or Gmail, you can sign in. If not, you can Create one. Unfortunately, it did not work for some reason.**





- The other way is open a browser and go to you Gmail account and then go to YouTube and click on Upload.

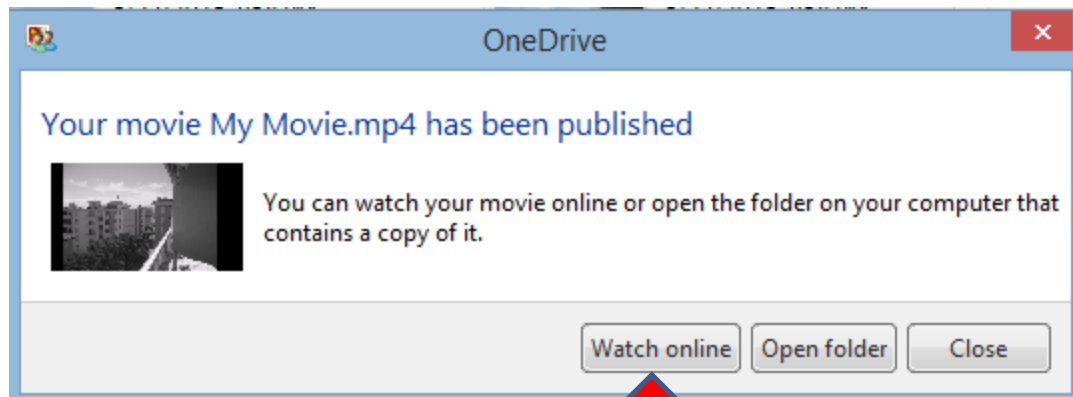


- Next option is Share slide show. Step 5 – Part C shows you Slide Show. Click on Share slide show and click on OneDrive.



# It shows process using Movie Maker.

- Reason is that it is creating a video.
- Once complete, you see that it is published, then click on Watch online.



- You then see it and you can play it.
