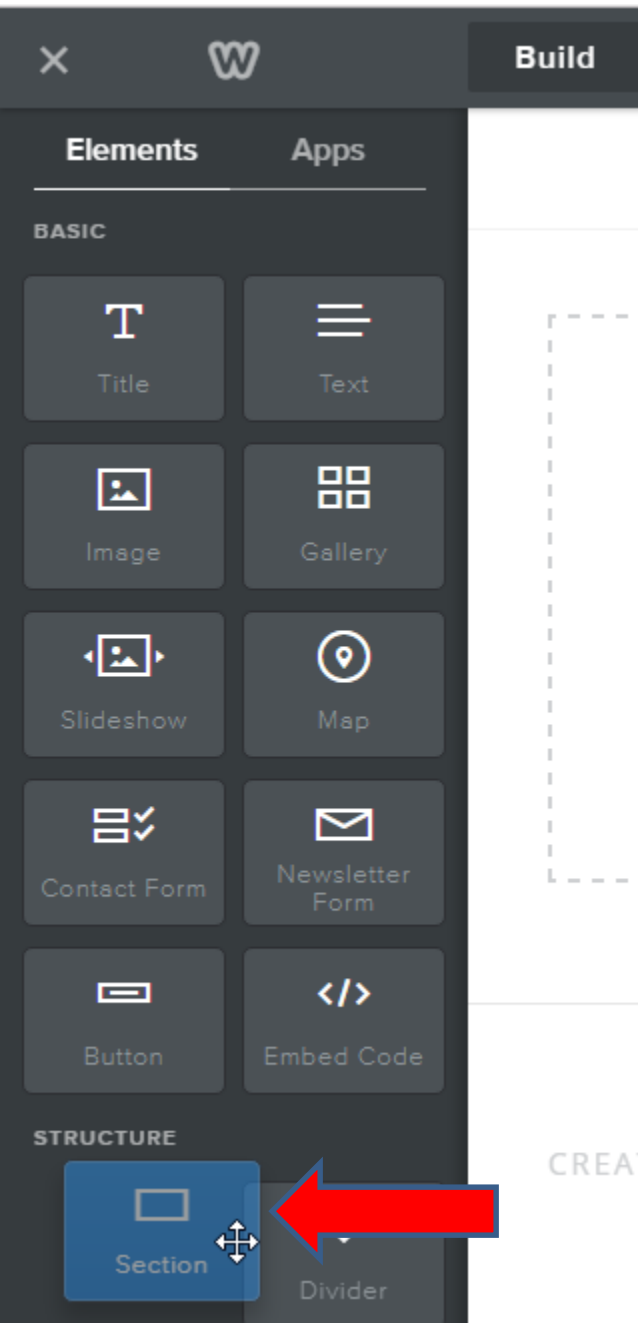
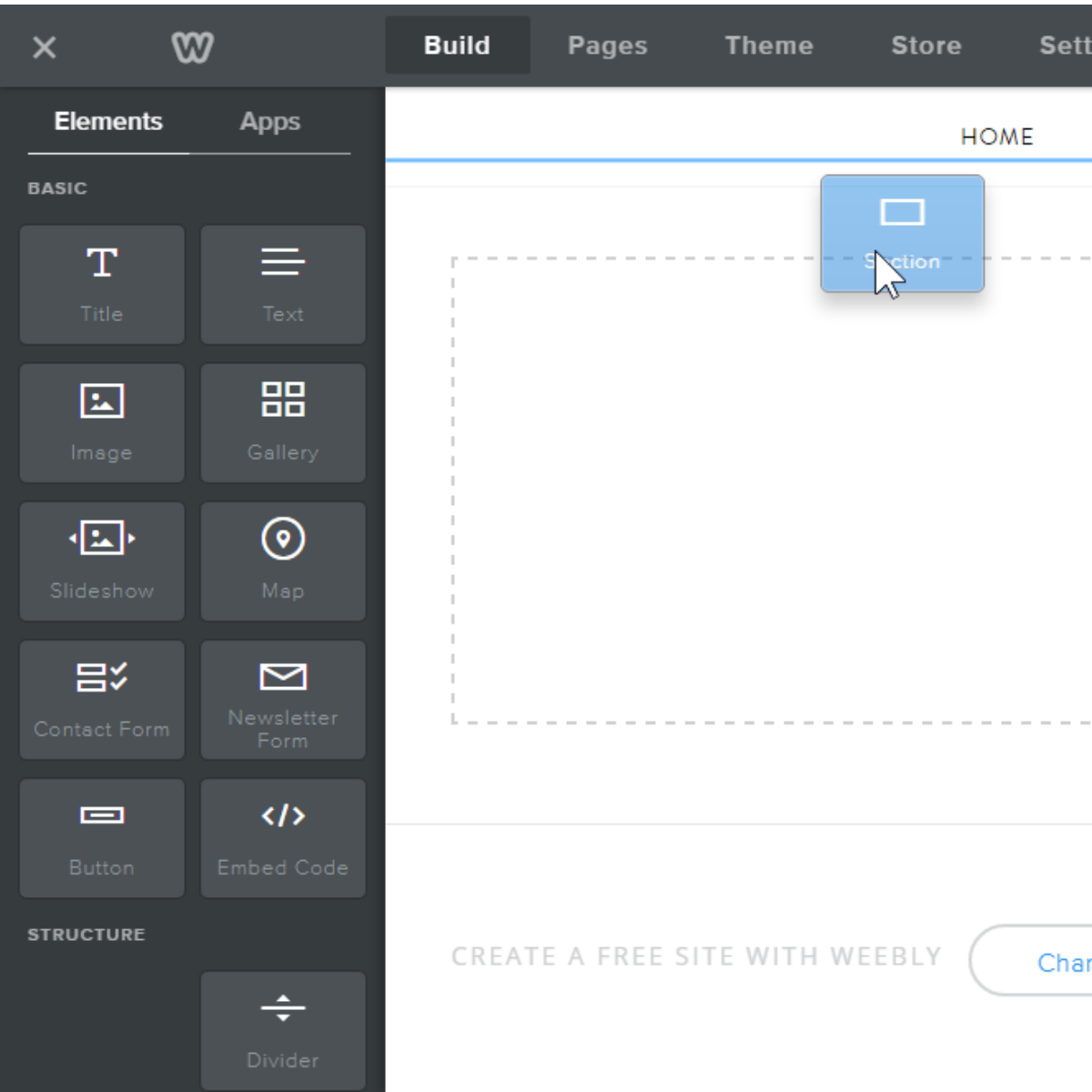


Tip – Add your own Header with Section Element.

- **First go to the Test page or another page with No Header.**
- **If you don't have a page with No Header, change a page from Header to No Header as I showed you before.**

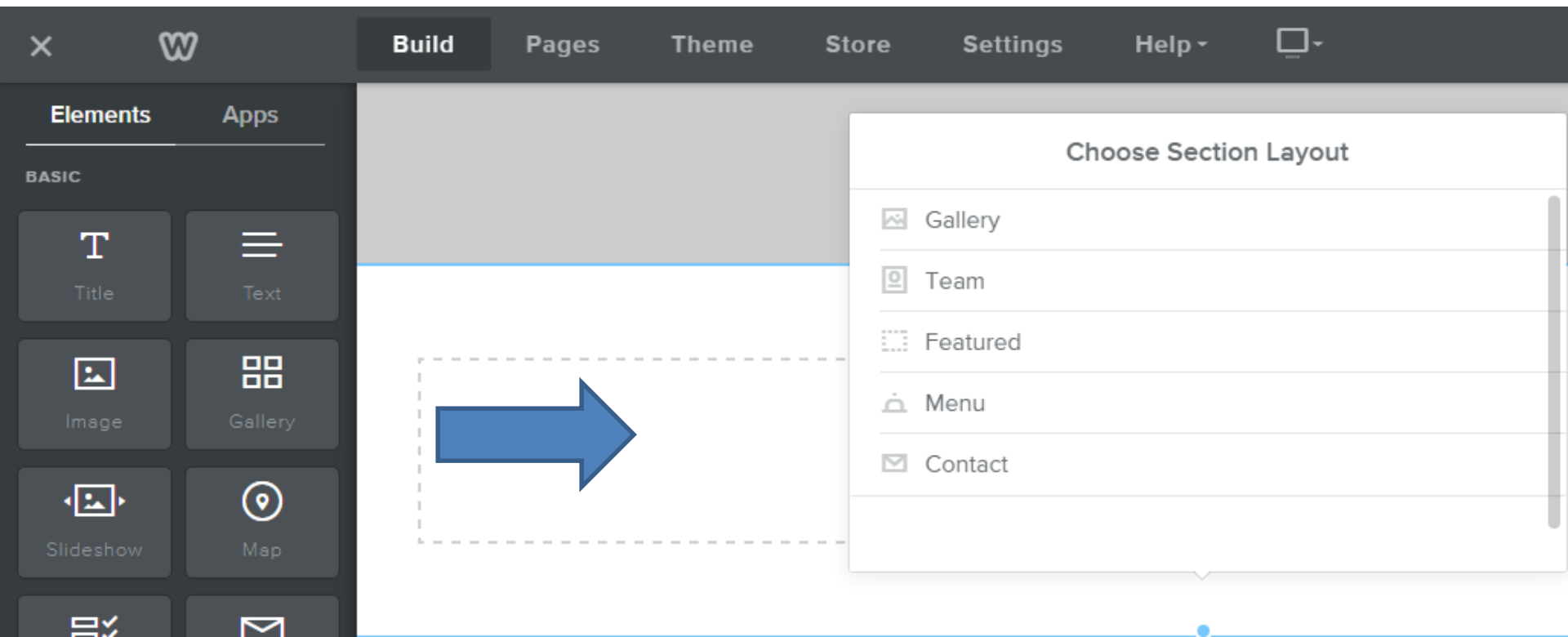


- Make sure you are on the Build tap and drag and drop the Section element that is under STRUCTURE.
- Next is where to drop.
- Note – If you don't see it, you have to change to a new Theme.

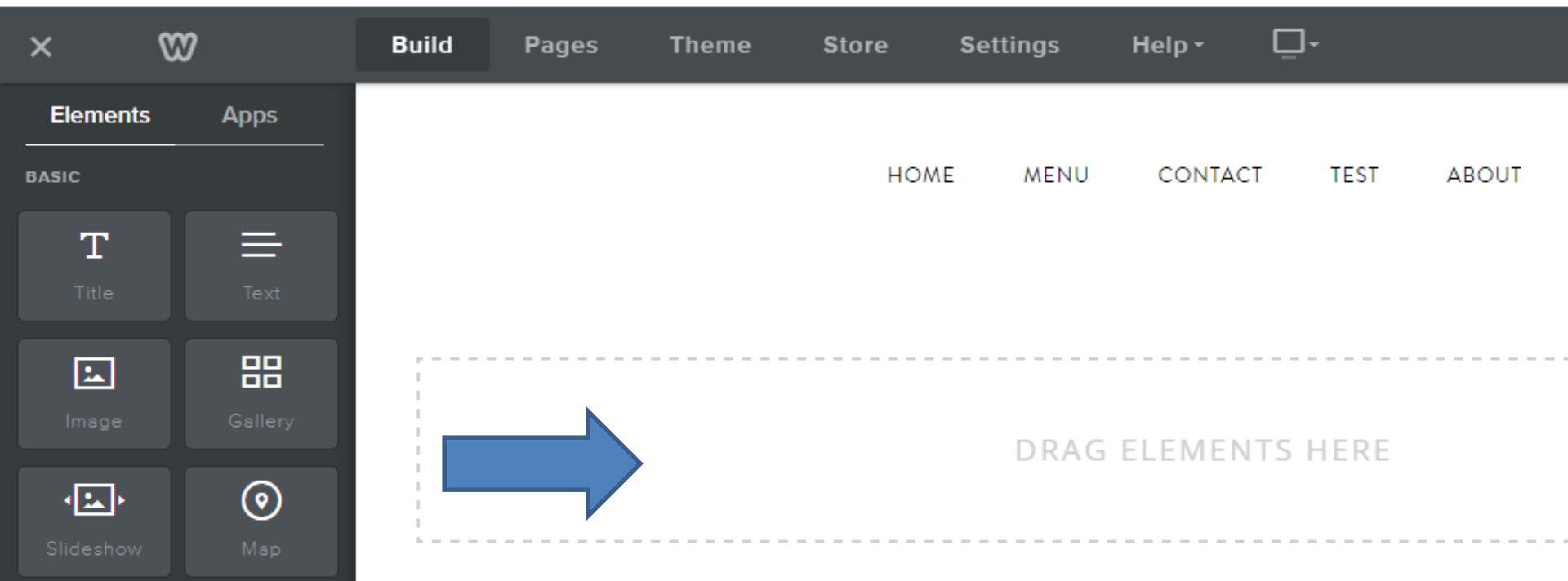


- When you drag at the top, you see the blue line and that is where to drop.
- Next is the results.

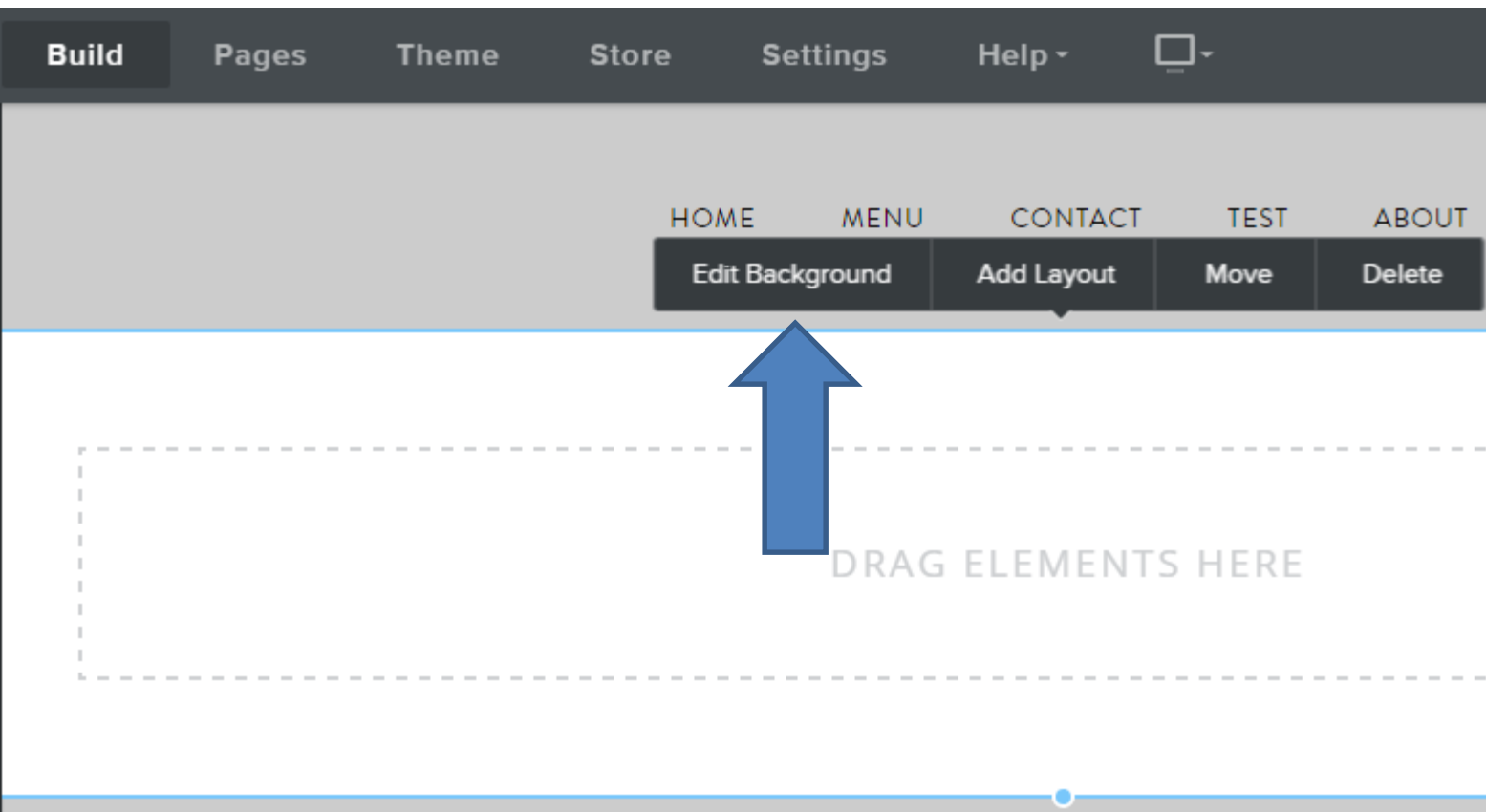
- A new window opens with a list of Layout options. I recommend you just click on the white next to the new window, so you can add your own Header.
- Next is what happens.



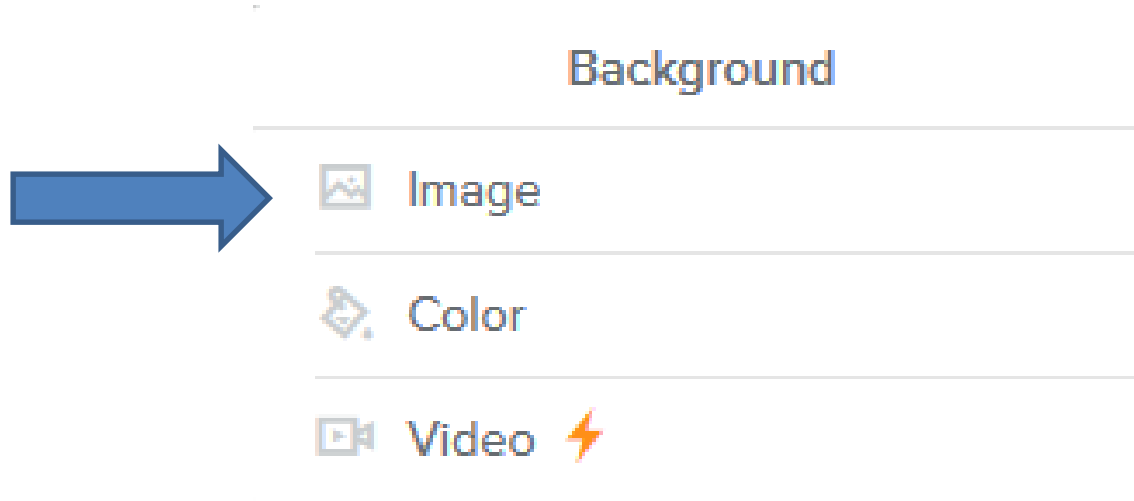
- You don't see the window. Click on the white again.
- Next is what happens.



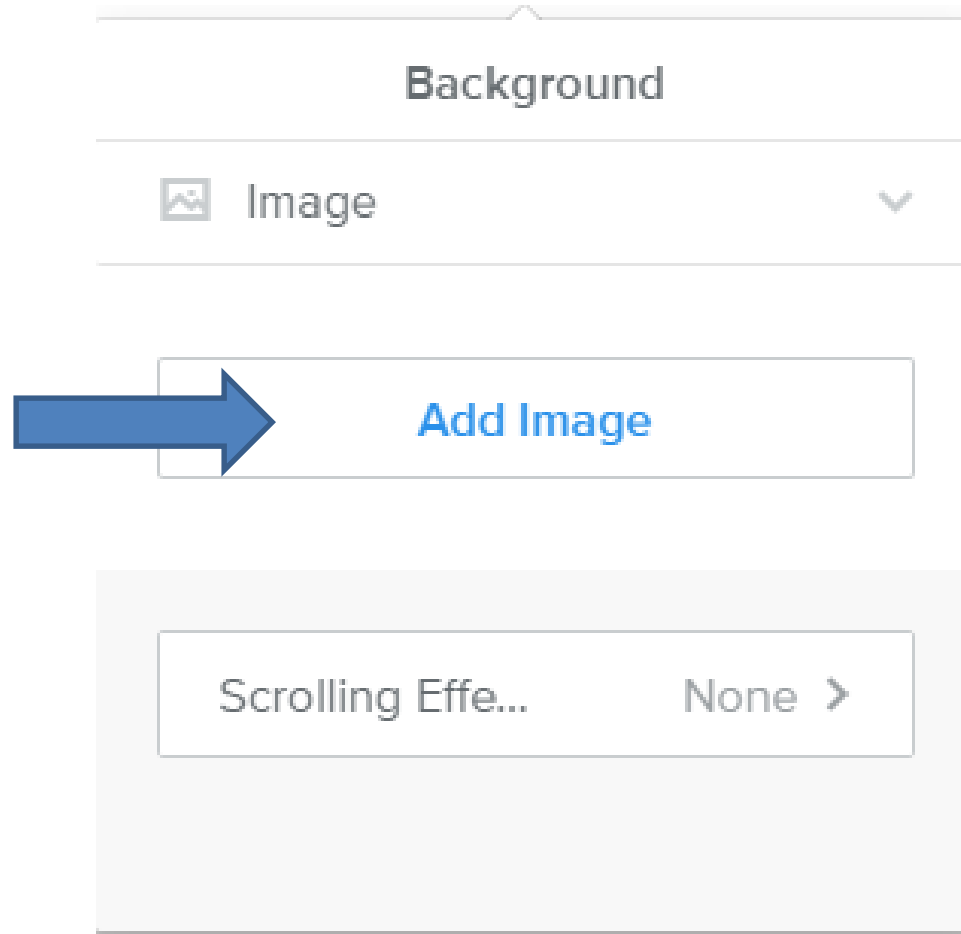
- You see Edit Background. Click on it.
- Next is what happens.



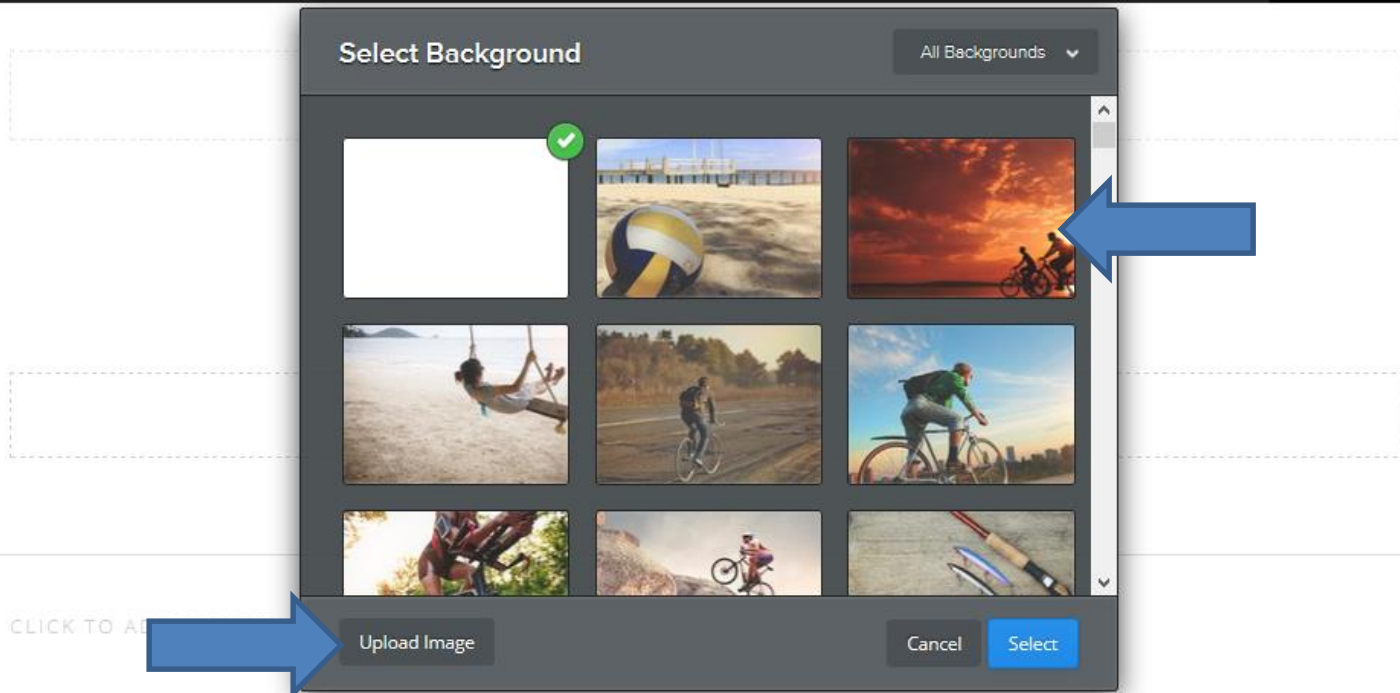
- **New window opens and you have 3 options, but you need the Pro Version to do Video.**
- **First is Image. Click on it.**
- **Next is the results.**



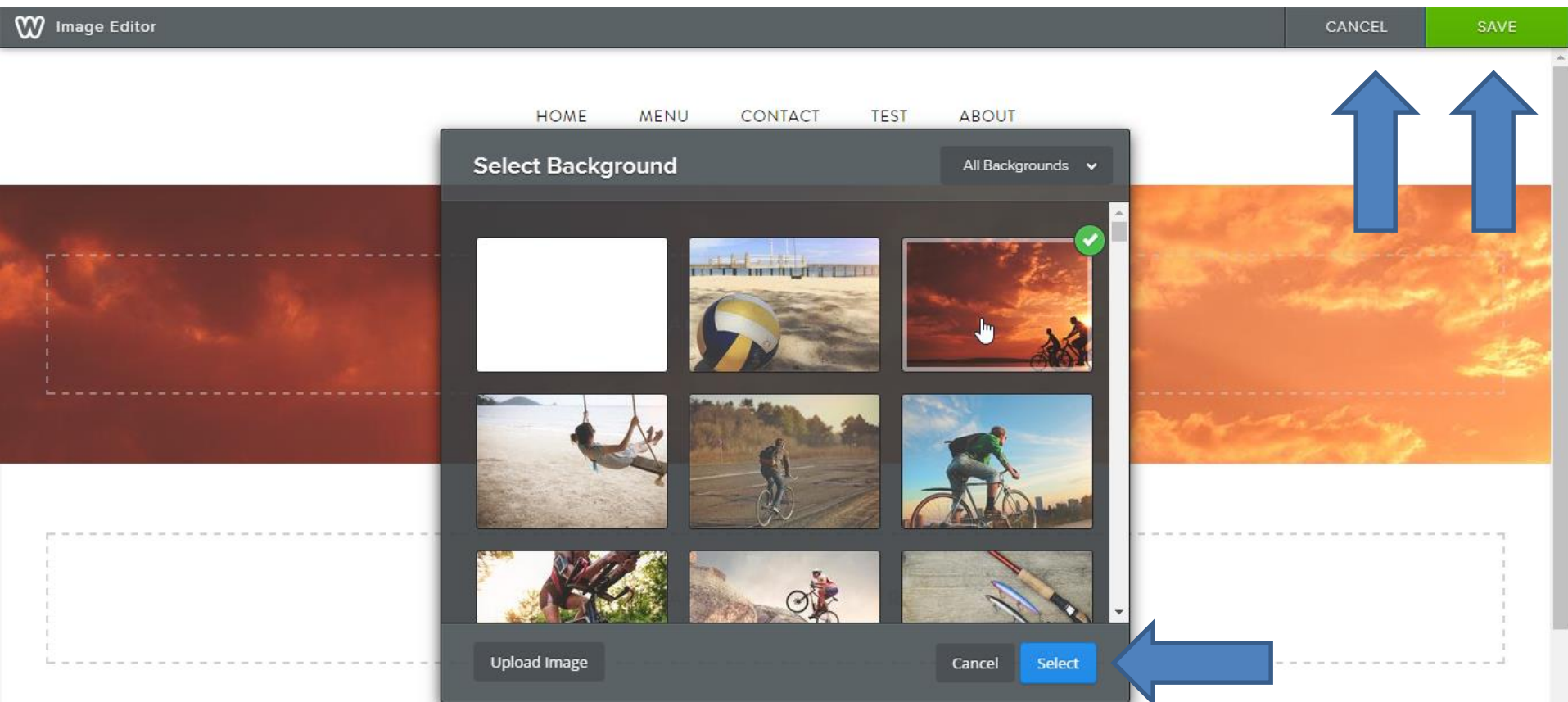
- **Window changes and click on Add Image.**
- **Next is the results.**



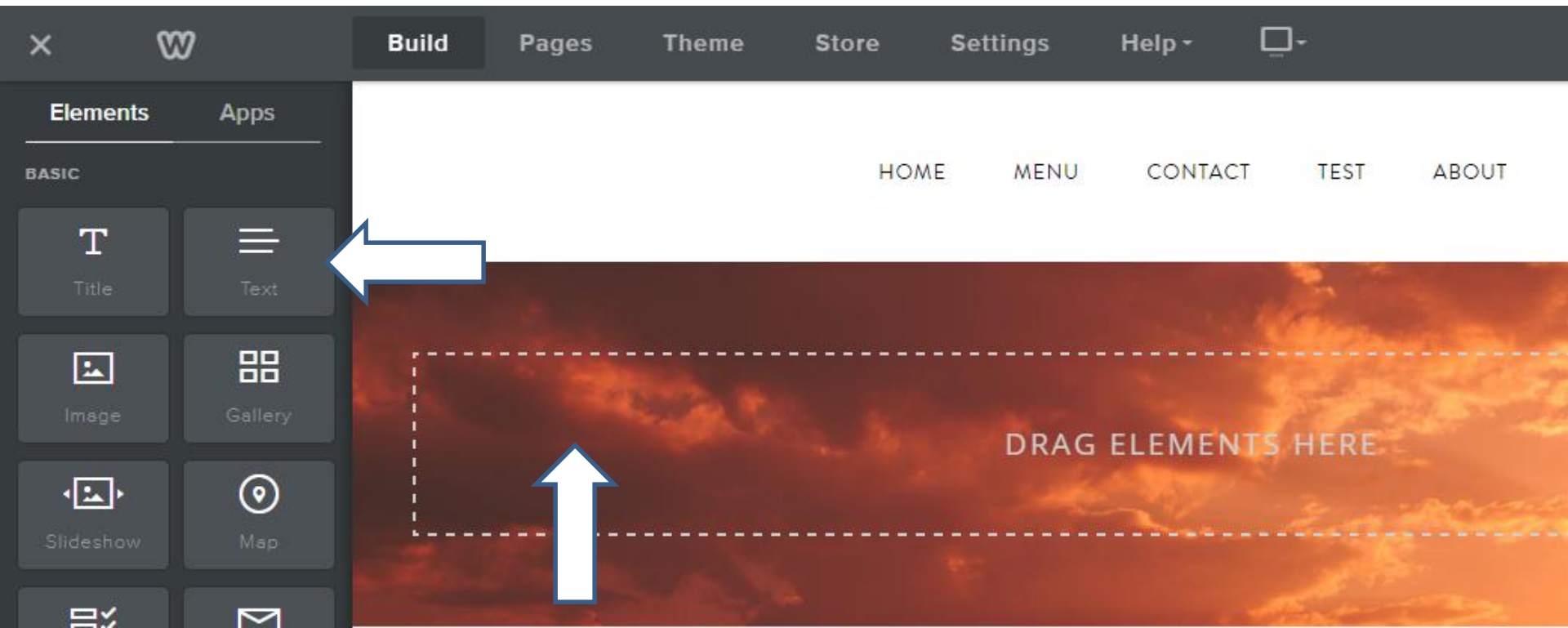
- Page changes that is same like some of a Theme header edit. You can select one or Upload Image from your computer.
- Next is a sample, when click on the third one.



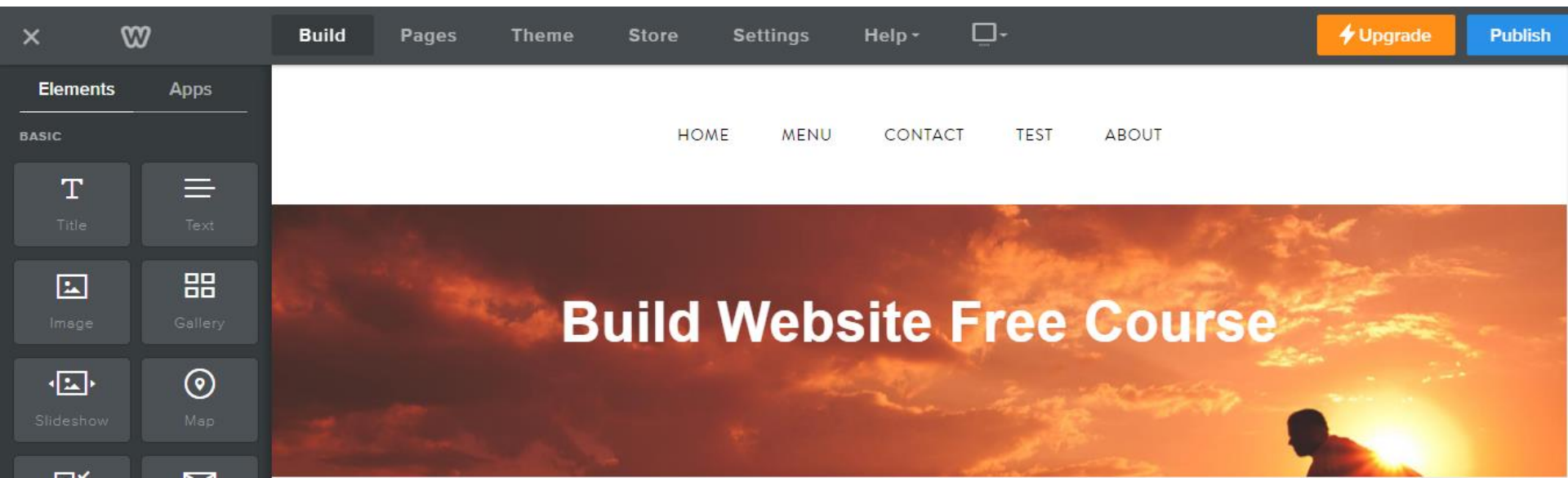
- When you click on it, it shows it on the section.
- Once complete, you can click on Select and then click on Save or Cancel.
- Next is what happens when you click on Save.



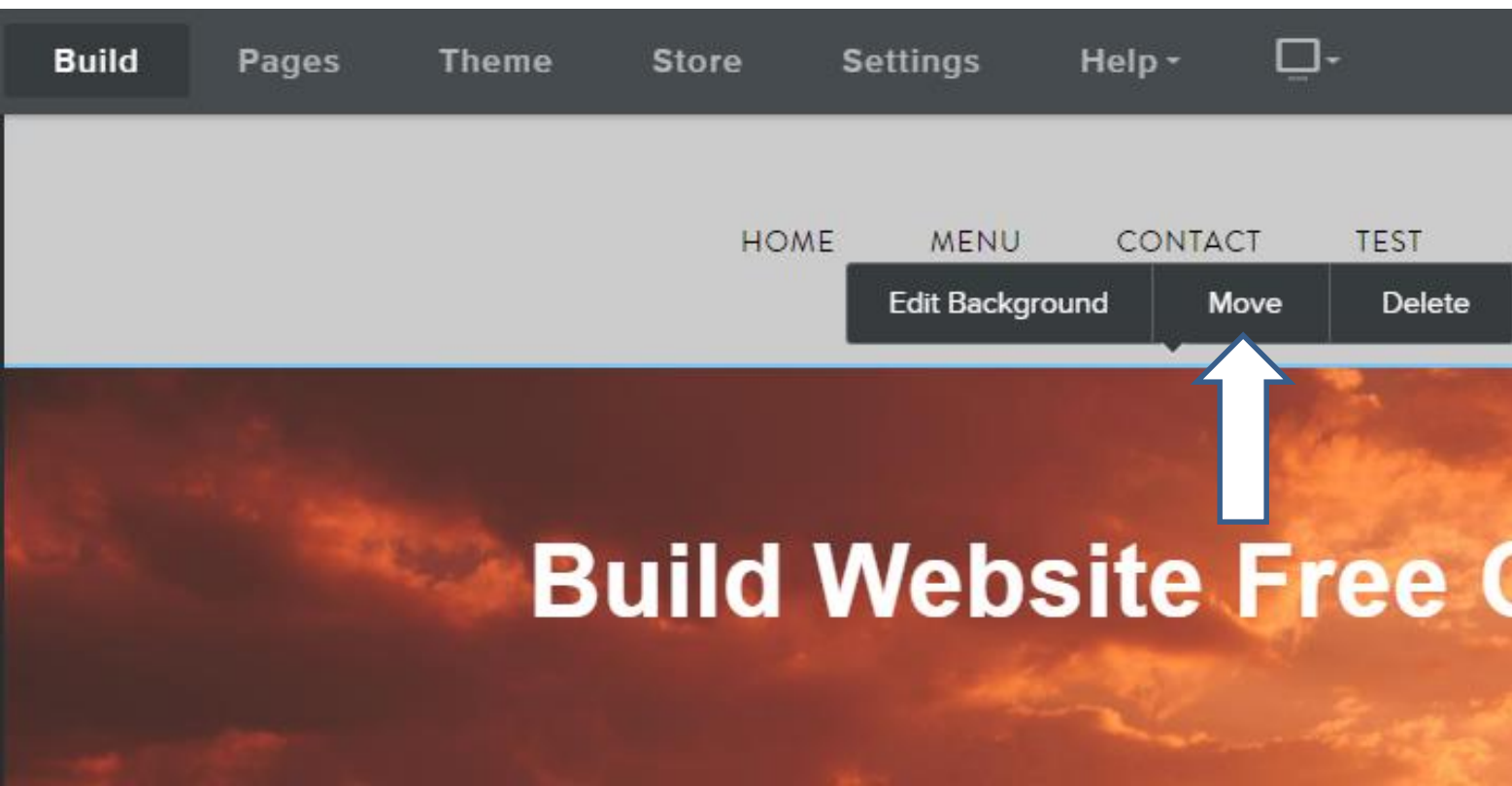
- Here is a sample.
- It is like adding your own Header.
- You can also add Text as I showed you in Step 5 – Part 2. You drag Text element to the Middle.
- Next is a sample dragging and adding some Text.



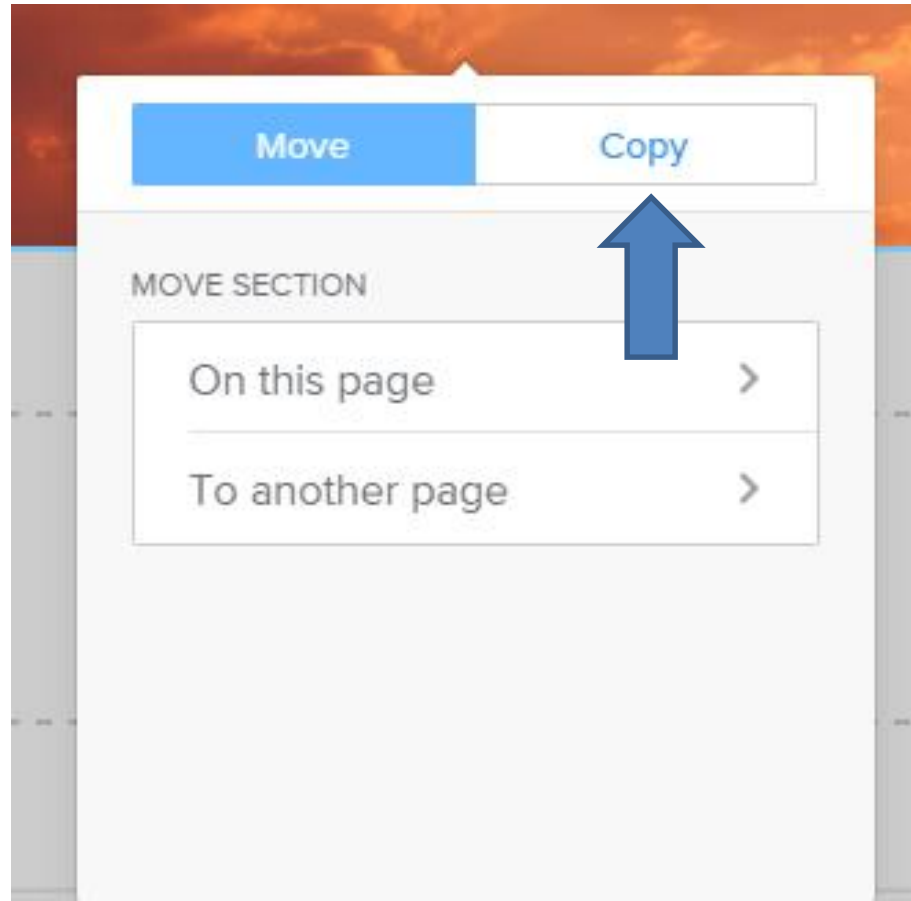
- Here is a sample of adding Text Element and typing in my Site Title and changed the color, the size and location. As I showed you in the Step 7.
- If you like it, you can Copy or Move to another page, which is next. First click on the Photo.



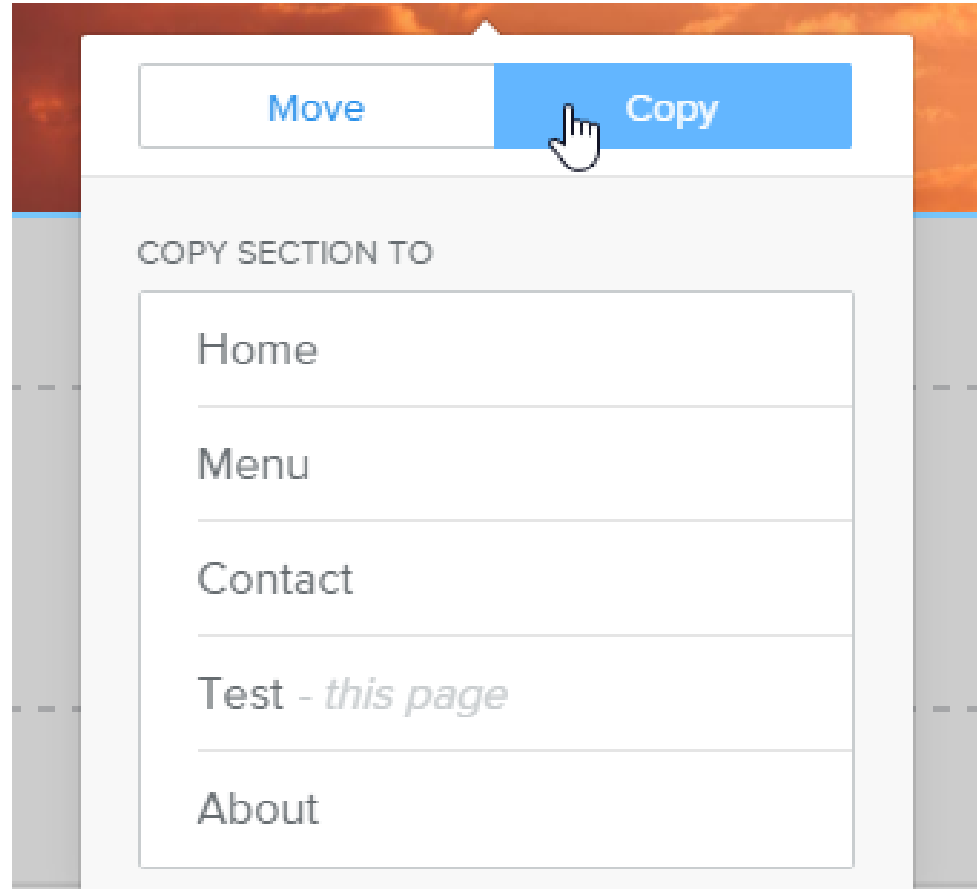
- **You see Move. Click on it.**
- **Next is What Happens.**



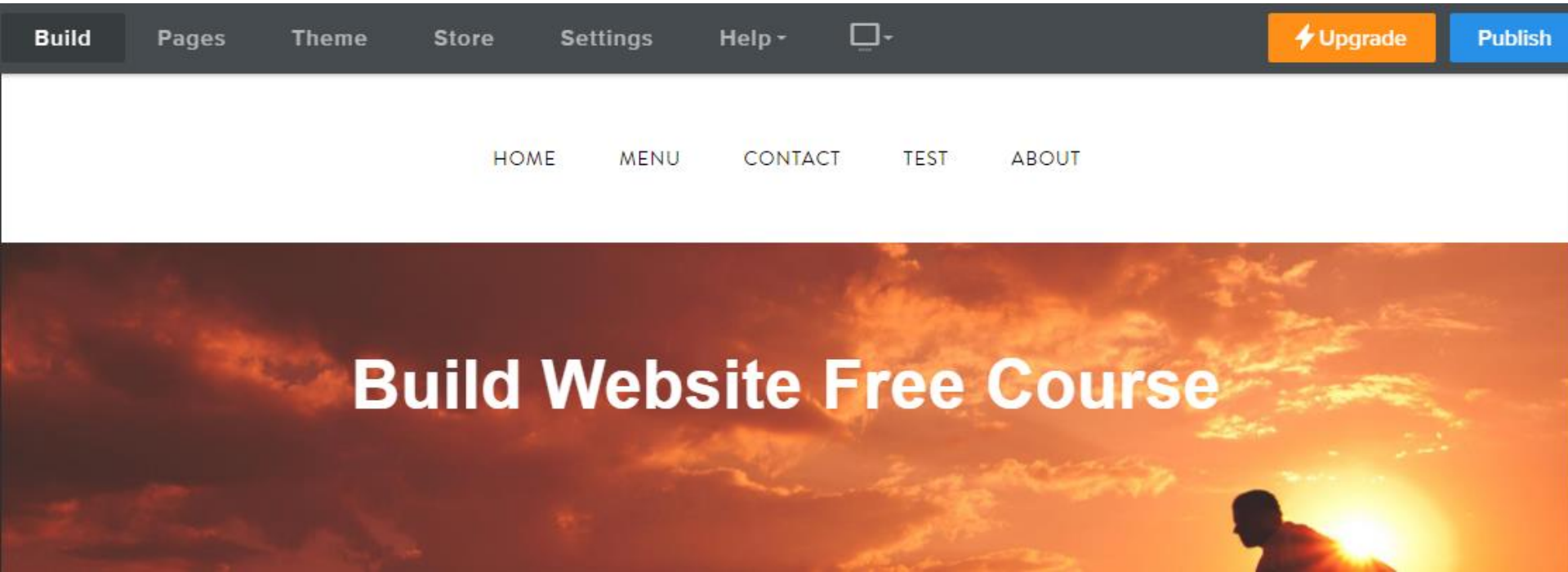
- **A New Window opens and click on Copy.**
- **Next is What Happens.**



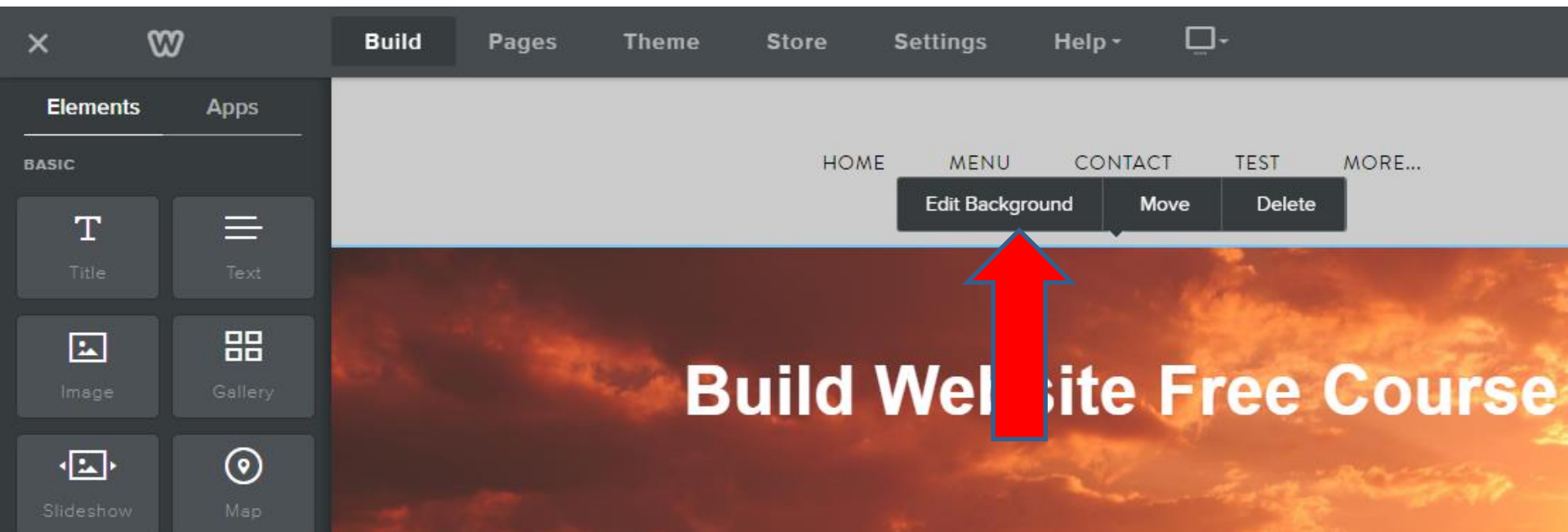
- Once you click on Copy, you see a list of pages and it shows what page it is on. Click on one, like Home. Note – if you already have a Header on a page, like I have on Menu, don't select it.
- Next is What Happens when you click on Home.



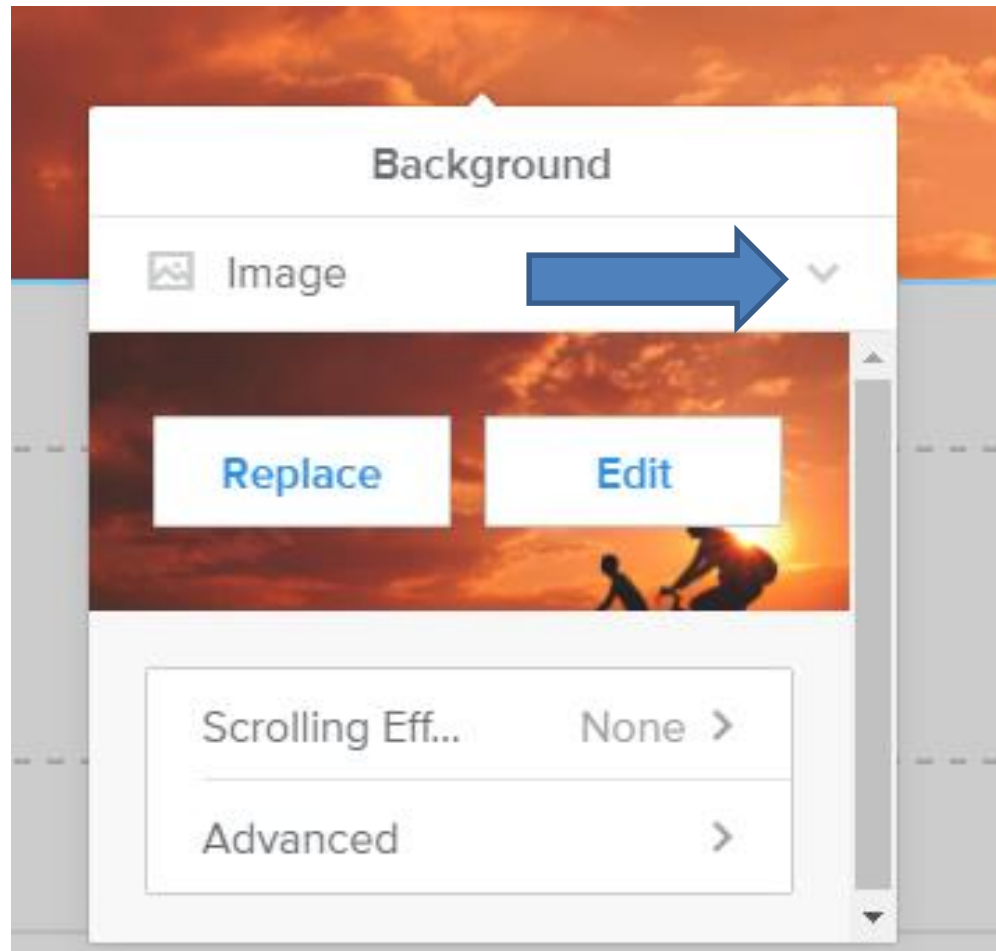
- It goes to the Home page with it. You can follow the same process to Copy to other page and do it again if you want it on every page.
- Next is how to change color vs. image as I showed you before in the Header in Step 3 – Part 3.



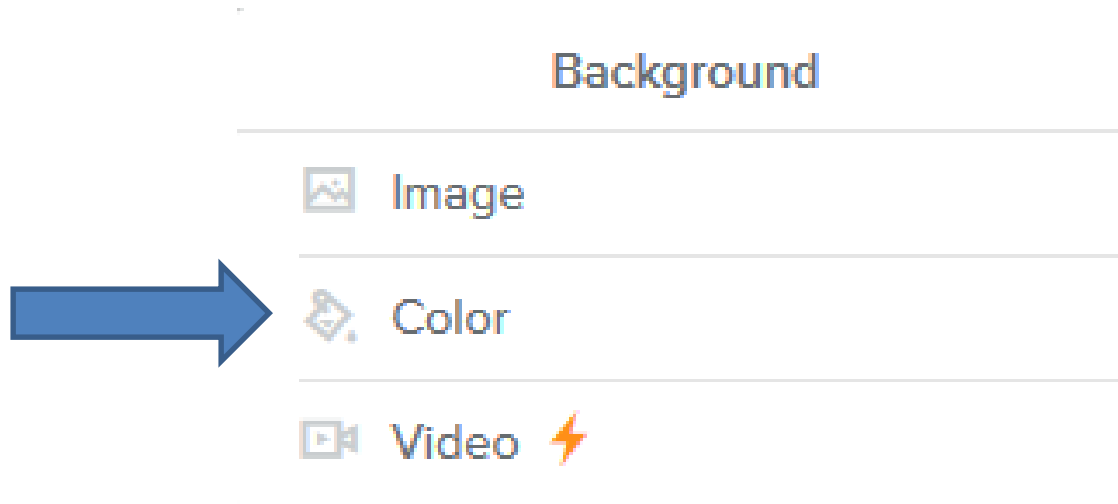
- **First go to the Test page or the page you added and click on the image and you see Edit Background again.**
- **Click on it and next is the same as before.**



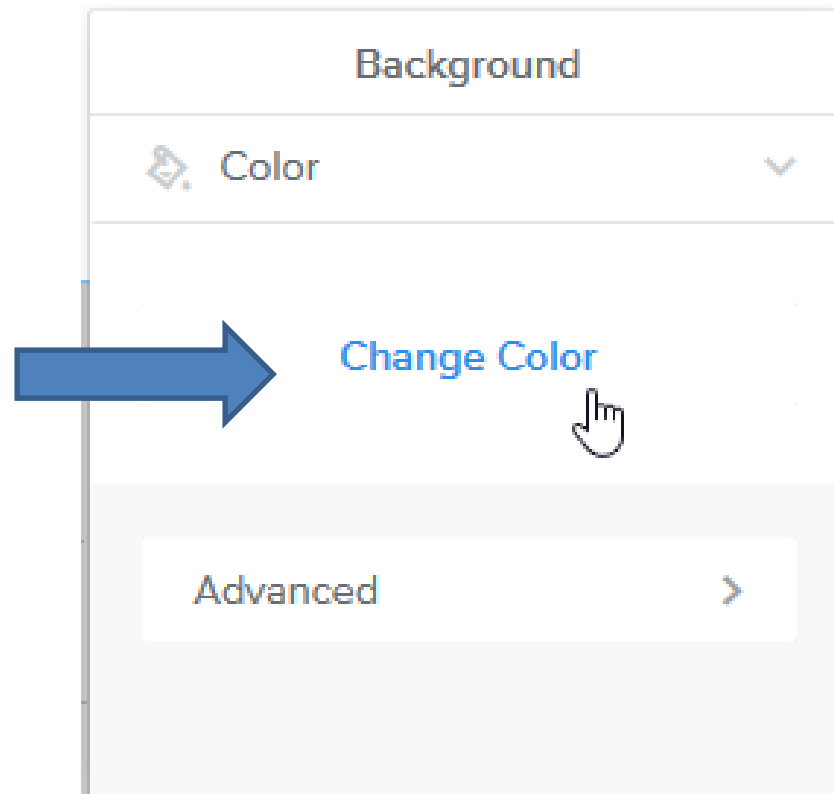
- **New window opens and you see Image options.**
- **First click on the Drop down next to the Image.**
- **Next is the results.**



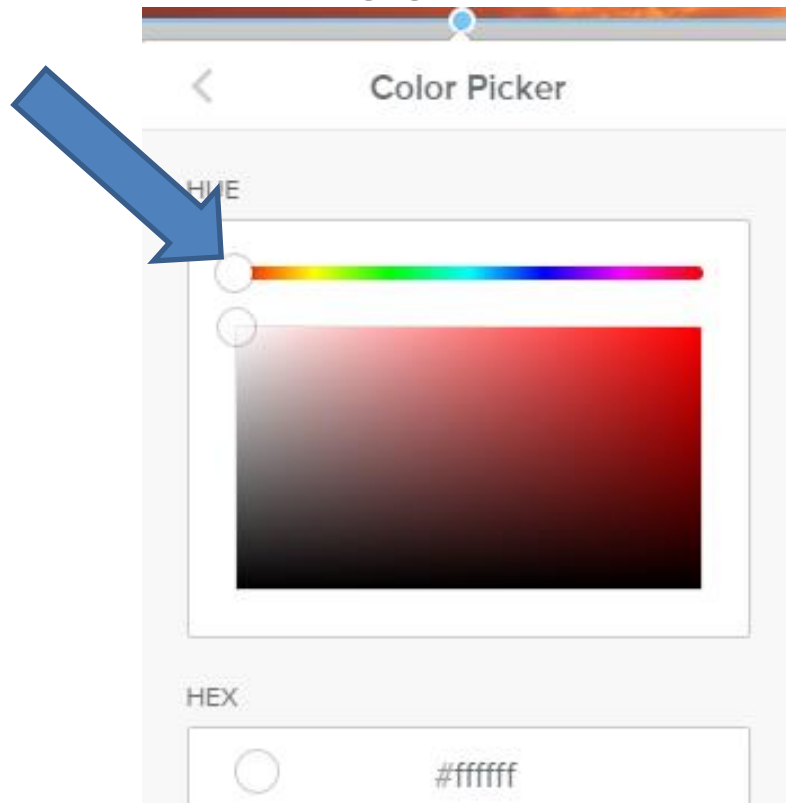
- It goes back to what we did before.
- Then click on Color.
- Next is the results.



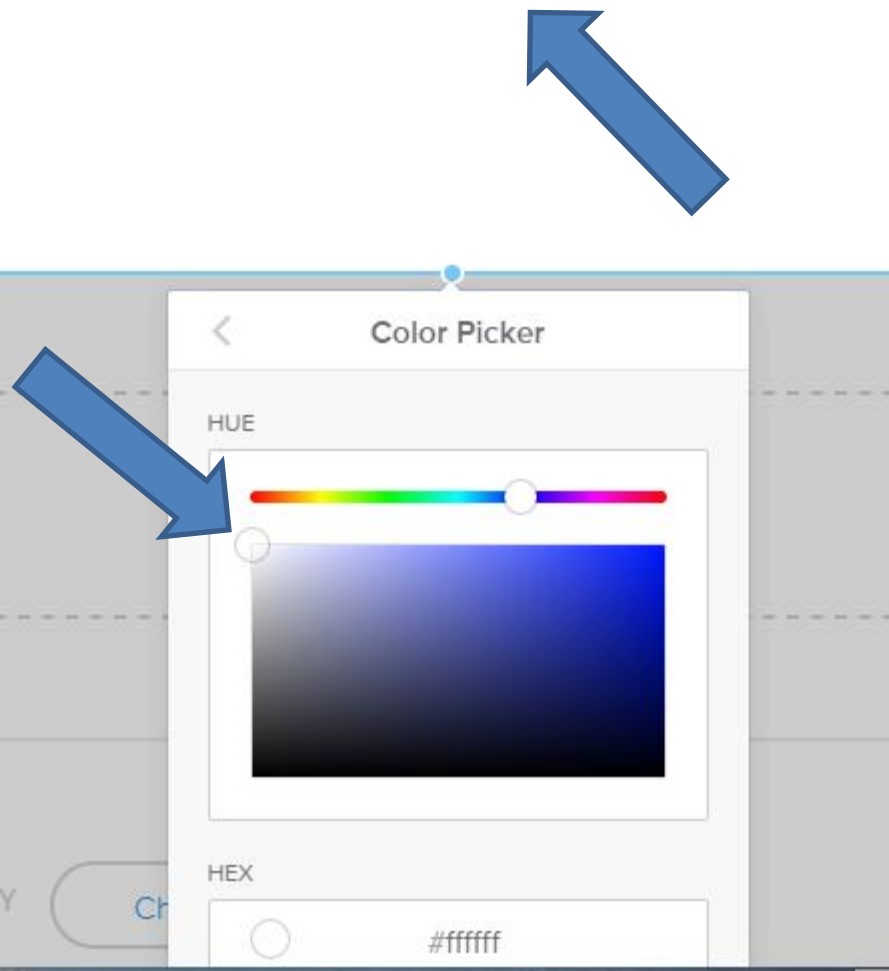
- **Window changes, and click on Change Color.**
- **Next is what happens.**



- **Window changes and you can change color or under HEX is code you can paste in, which is in the Tip – How to Pick your own color in the Part 2 on-line training.**
- **First click on this icon and drag it to a color, like blue. Next is what happens.**

- It removes the Image and you don't see the Text because the color is white.
- Then click on this Icon and drag it to the color you want.
- Next is what happens.

- Once you drag it, you see the background color and the Text. Also you see the new Code. Next is a Sample of adding a Image Element.
