

Tip – Convert Video

- **Why?**
 - If you have a Video that is WMV and not MP4, you have to convert it to MP4. The reason is Photos App allows MP4 vs. WMV, etc. as I mentioned before
 - The program is aTube Catcher.
- I showed you before how to download aTube Catcher in Step 3. If you have aTube Catcher, open it and go to the 4th page in this PDF file.
- If you don't have aTube Catcher, go to the next page to download.

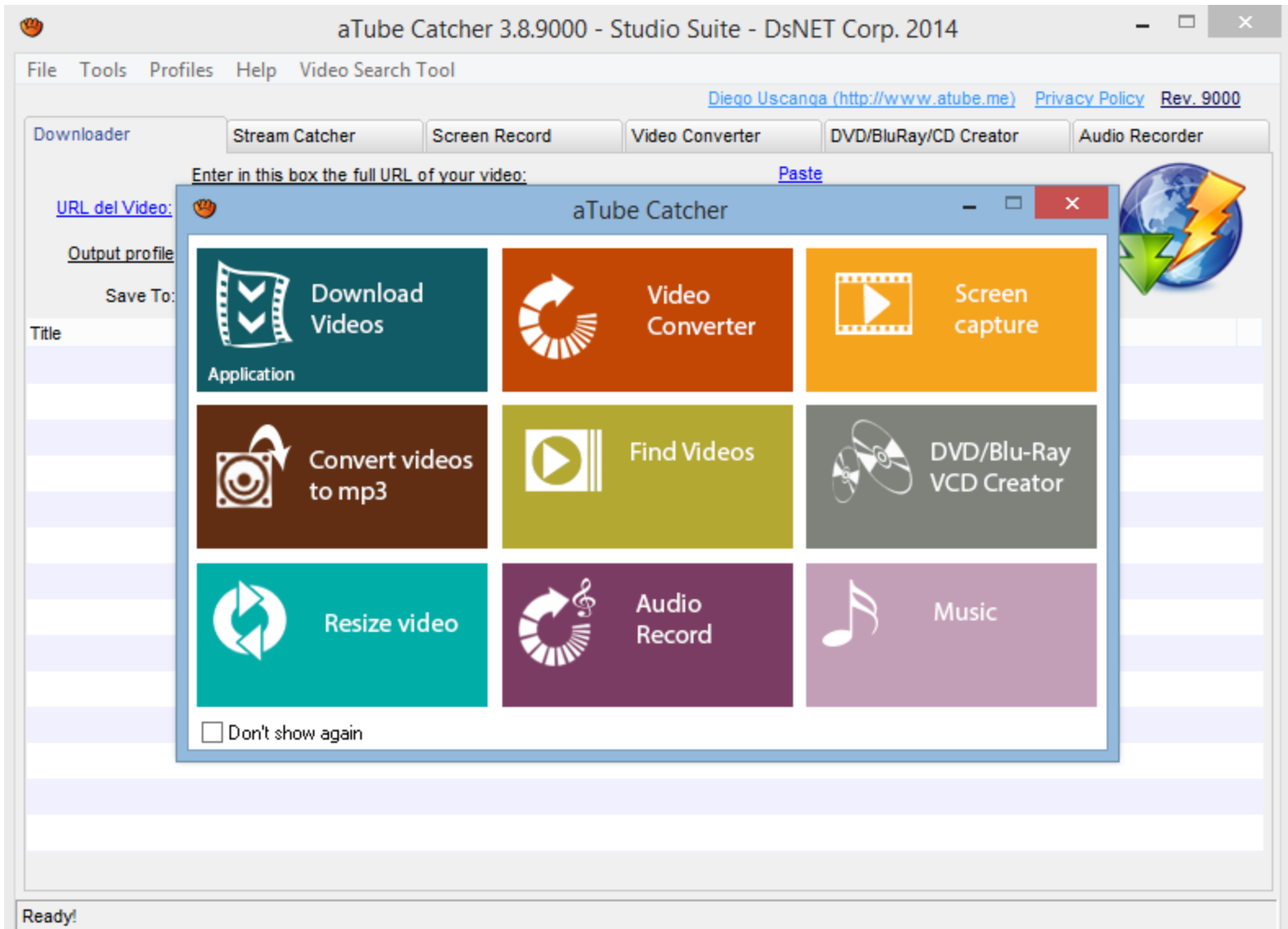

- Once you download it, you will see this icon on your desktop.



- Double click on it, to open it.
- Next is what happens.

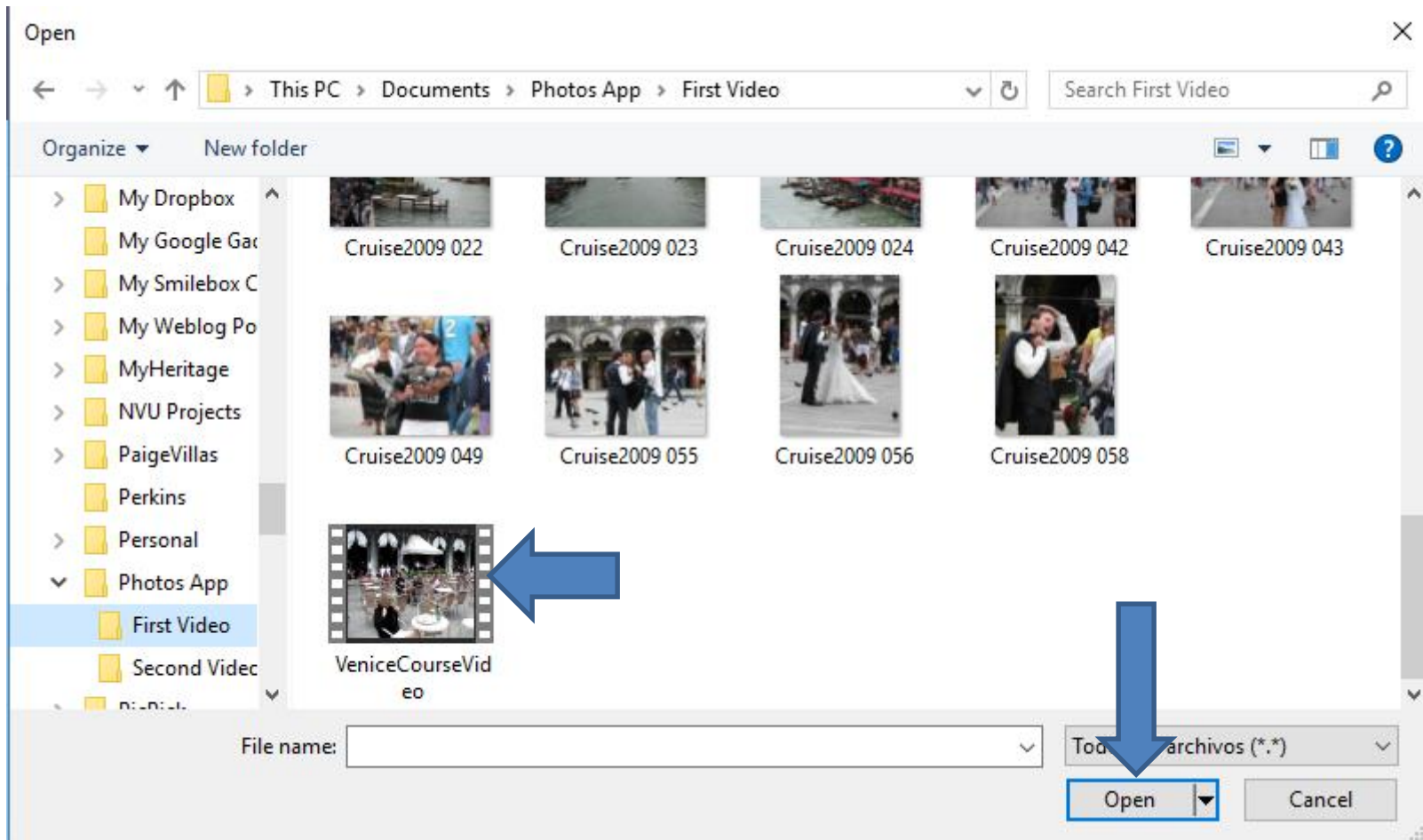
- You see it open with the features. Next is **Convert Videos to mp3**.





- Click on Video Converter and next is what happens.




- **File Explorer opens. Find the video that is WMV and double click on it or click on it and click on Open. Next is what happens.**



- You then see it and then click on the icon  on the right of Save To. The reason is to change the folder, which is next.

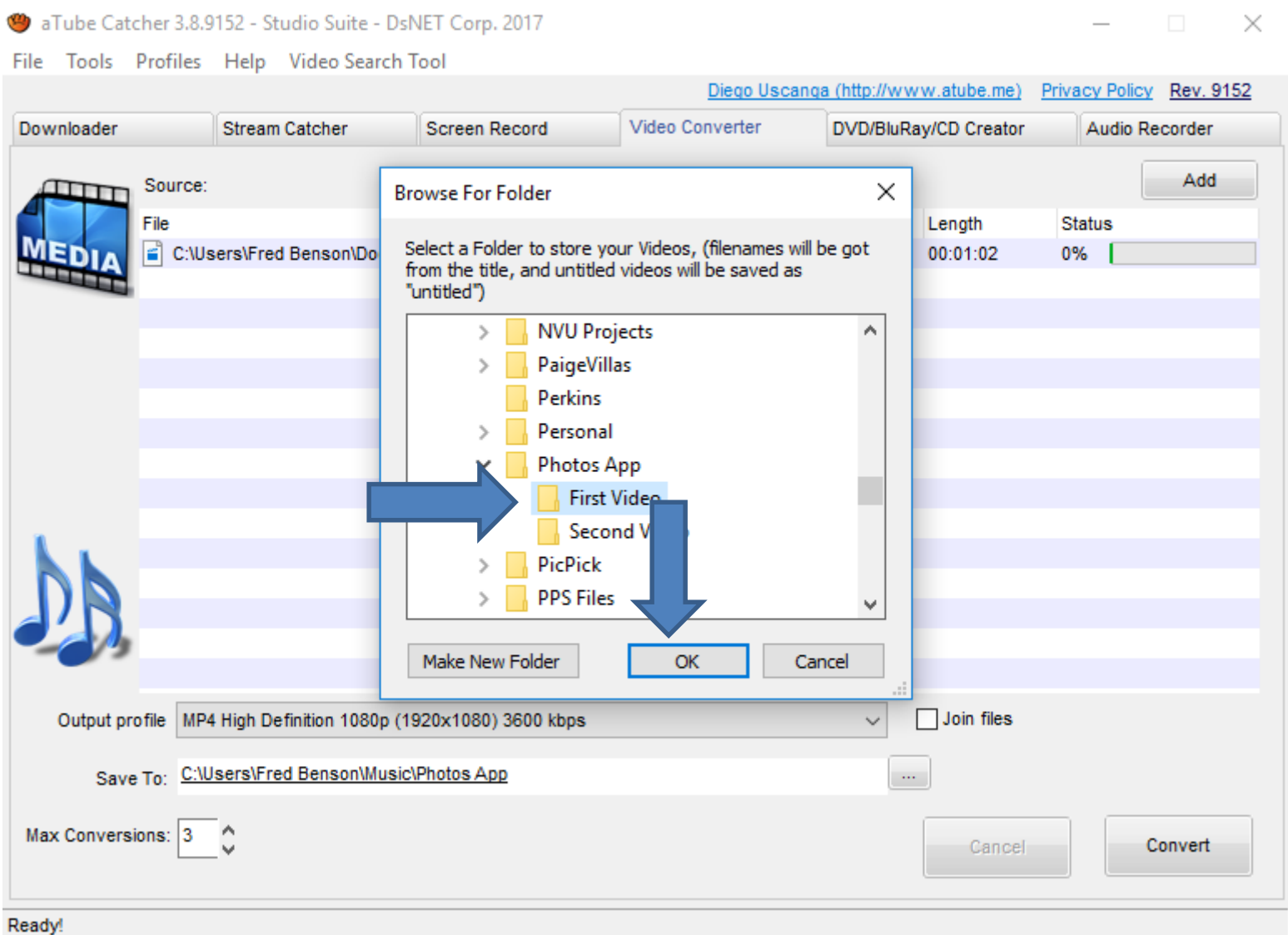

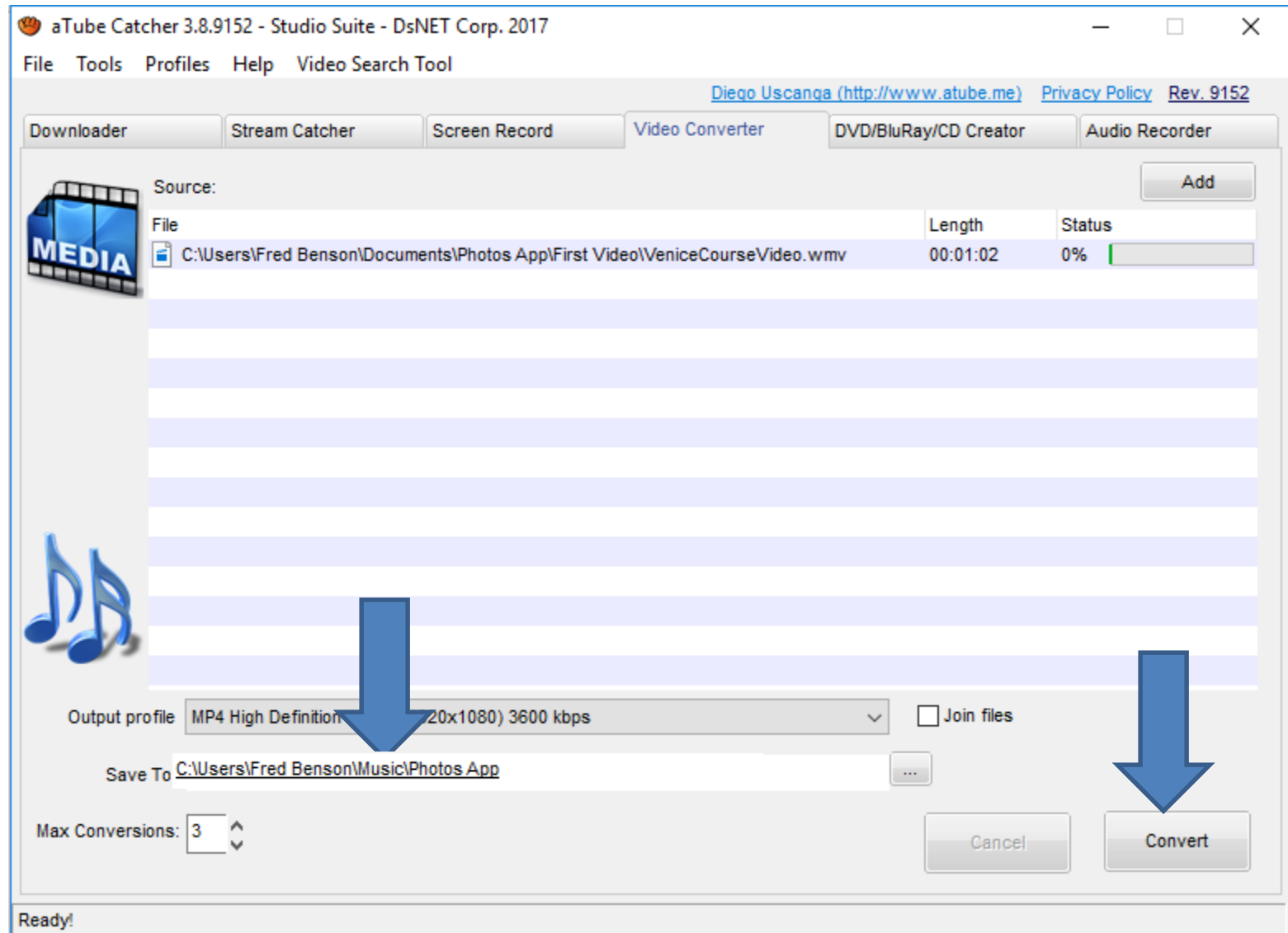

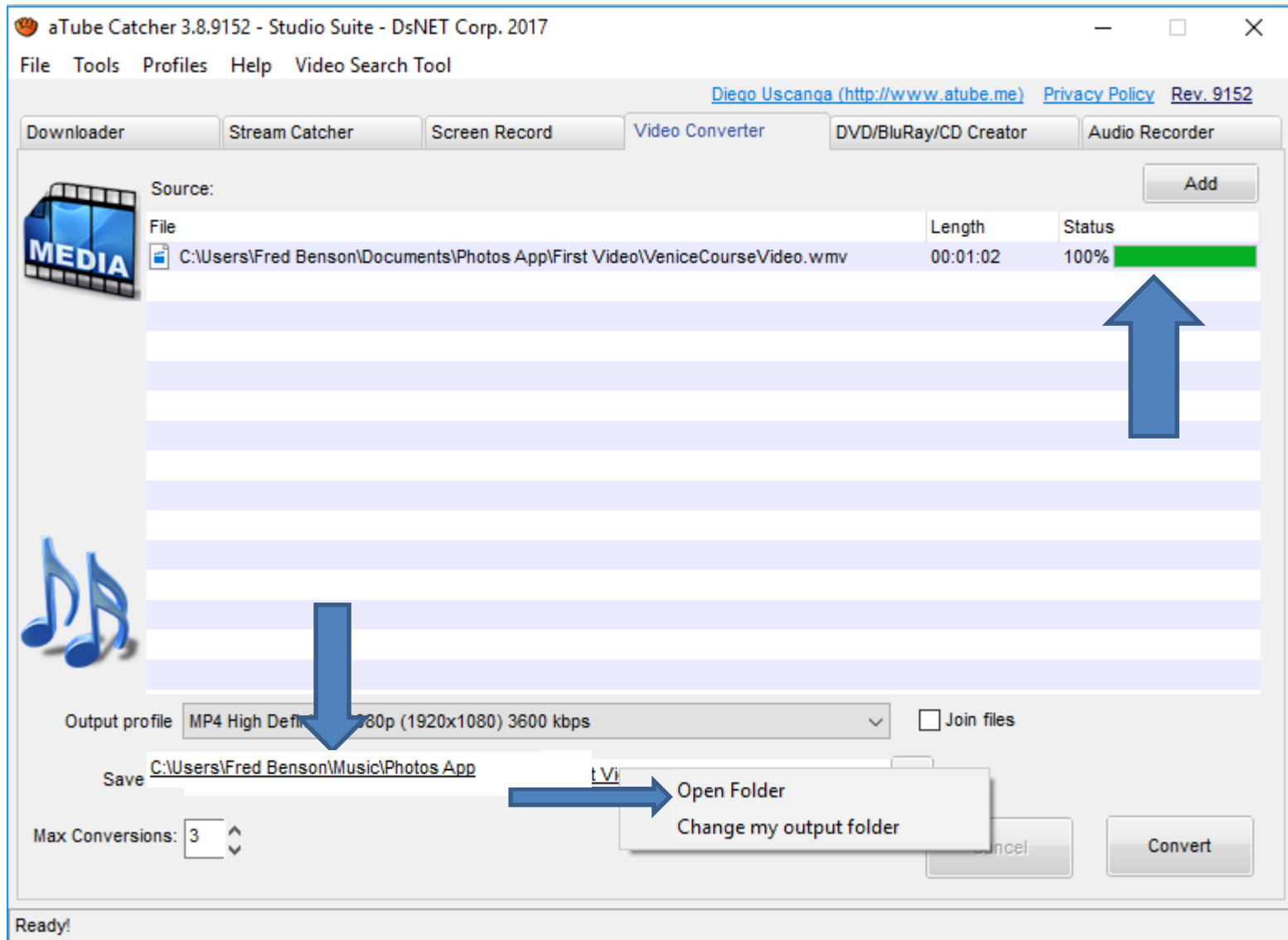
• Here is a sample and click on OK and next is what happens.
