## **Tip – Customize Themes**

- This Tip is the same process as the other Tip How to Change Background Color, except different location and different HTML / CSS.
- First is the first Theme we selected to change the width of the page to be close to the Header width. Also, how to change Button background color. After that I will show you the other Theme we did. As I mentioned in the First Course, you can't Customize the Second or Third Theme.
- Make sure you are on the first Theme.
- If not, click on Theme tap and then click on Change Theme. Then click on Recently Used and choose the first Theme we did.
- When it goes back to Build, click on Theme again, which is next.



- Click on it and next shows what happens.



- Next shows what happens.




- You then see White. You then have to scroll down to number 162 called Container.
- Next shows what happens.



- You then see Container and you see width of 960px. To change the width, highlight 960 and type in 1115 to make it the same width as Header.
- Next shows what happens.

- Next is to change Button background color.
- You scroll down to number 462, which is next.



- Once you scroll down to 462, you see wsitebutton and you see on 466 Background.
- Next is how to change the Background.
- Note you have to have code to do that. You can copy code when you change color on the background color page or header.





- Next is what happens.




- Once you type in the Name of your theme, click on Save.
- Next is what happens and how to find the Theme.




- Then click on Theme and then click on Change Theme again.
- Next is what happens and how to find the Theme.




- It goes to Theme Gallery again.

- Next is what happens.




- You then see FirstTheme.

- Next is Edit HTML/CSS again.









### Last Theme

- Next I will zoom in so you can see it and after that how to change image to color.




- You see the line. You then highlight it and type in code, like fff.
- Next I will show you highlight and after that what happens when you type in.



- You see it highlighted and I did not highlight the ;
- You then type in fff, which is Black.
- Next is what happens.








- You then see it Black.
- Next is to change the Width.
- It is 1100 and you make it larger, like 1300.
- Scroll down a little to 79 which is next and I will zoom in so you can see it.




- When you scroll down to 79, you see #wrapper.
- Under that is max-width with 1100px.
- Highlight 1100 and type in 1300.
- Next is what happens.



- You then see it larger.
- Once complete, click on SAVE in the upper right.
- You follow the same process, which is next.



- Once you click on Save a new window opens and you have to type in the Name of your theme.
- For example, type in Last Theme.
- Next is what happens.



- Once you type in the Name of your theme, click on Save.
- Next is what happens and it saves in the Custom Themes that I showed before. You can always make changes again.
