

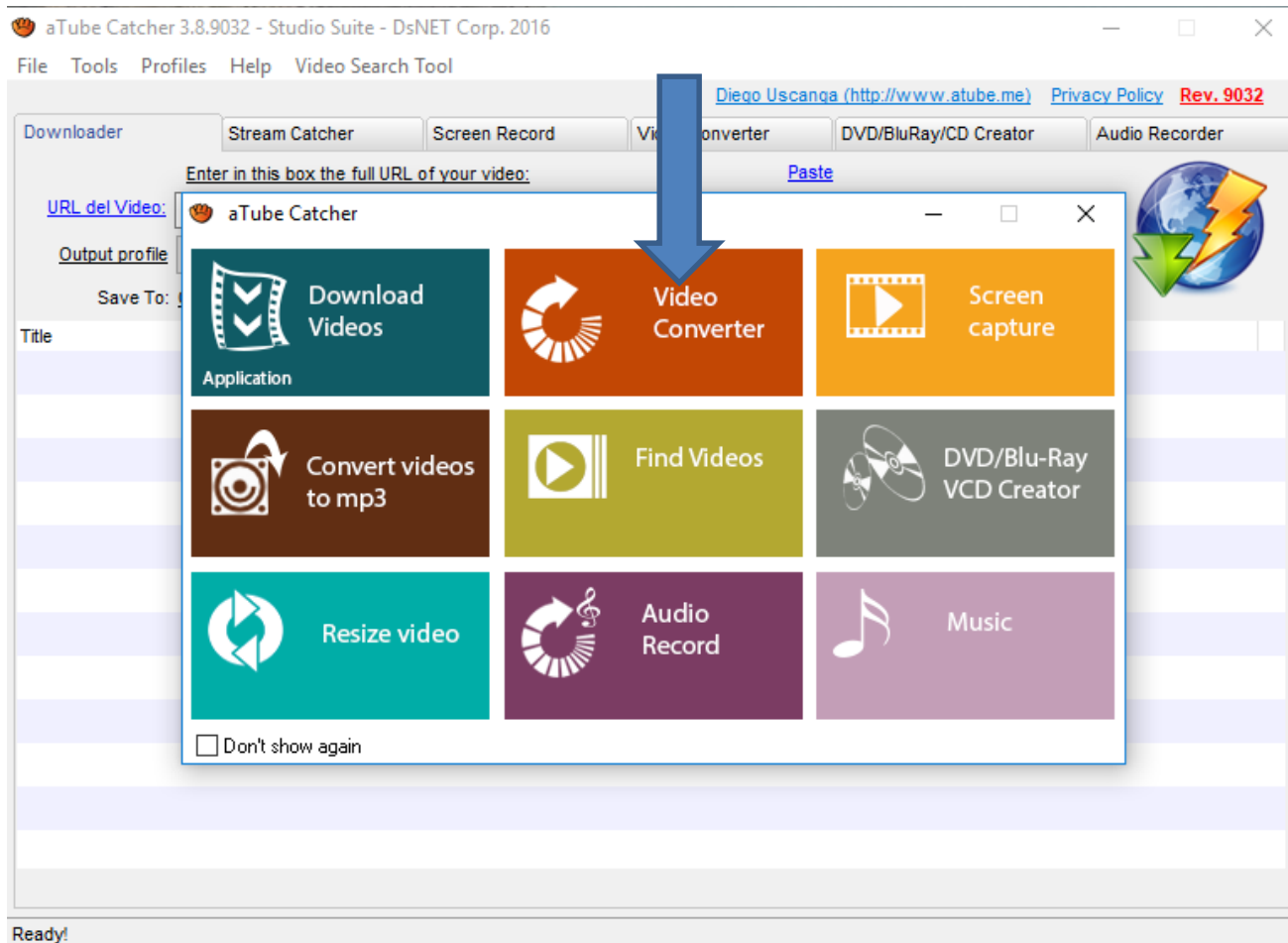
Tip – How to convert a Video file to a WMV file

- I found that Smilebox does not allow a MP4 Video file. But, it accepts a WMV Video file**
- So, I decided to convert the MP4 Video file to a WMV Video file using a free program called aTube Catcher that has a lot of features.**
- Next is a link to a website to download it. After that I will show you how to convert a Video file.**

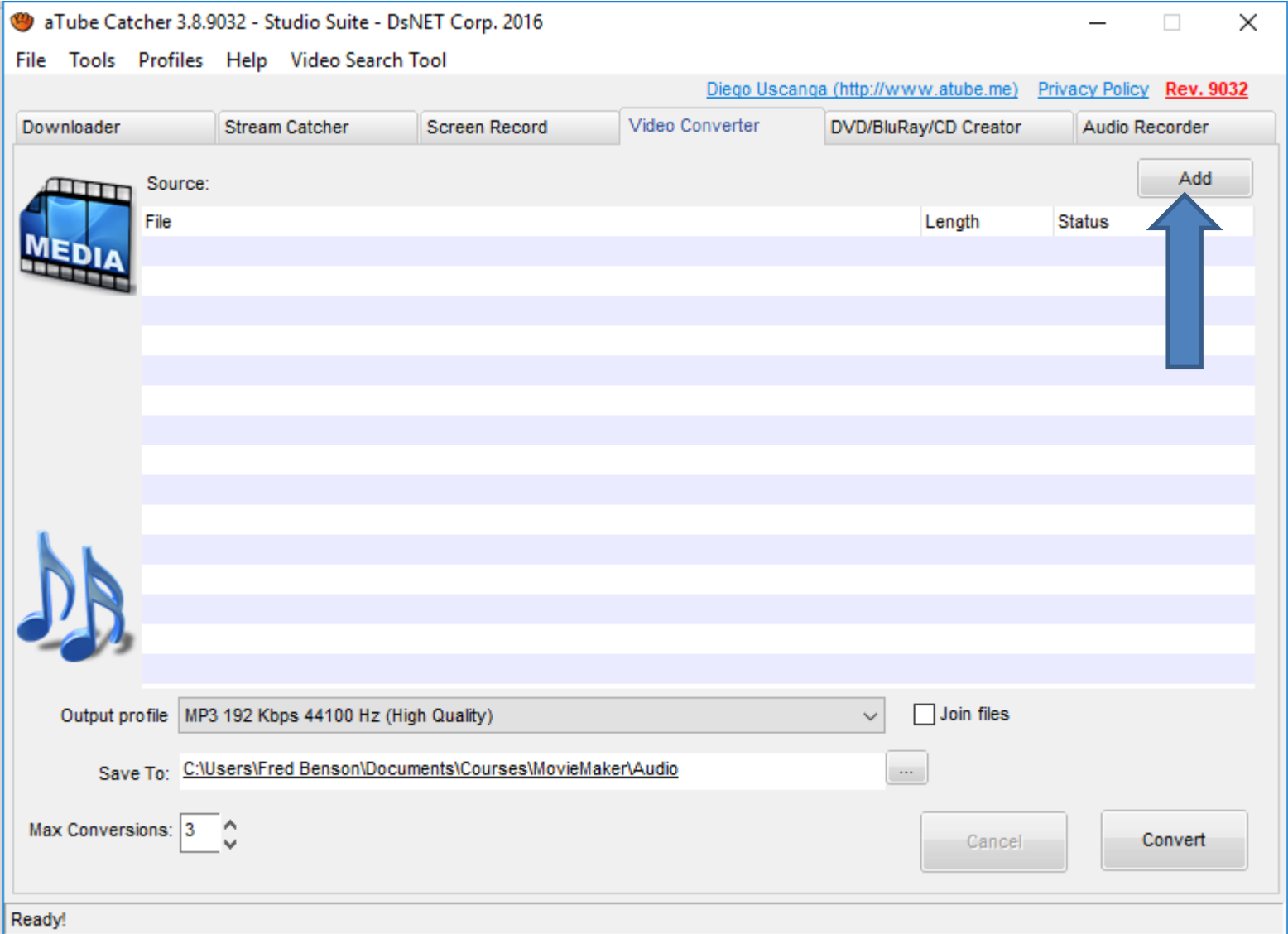
- Download aTube Catcher from this site

- Once you download it, you will see this icon on your desktop. Double click on it to open it.
- Next is what happens when you open it.



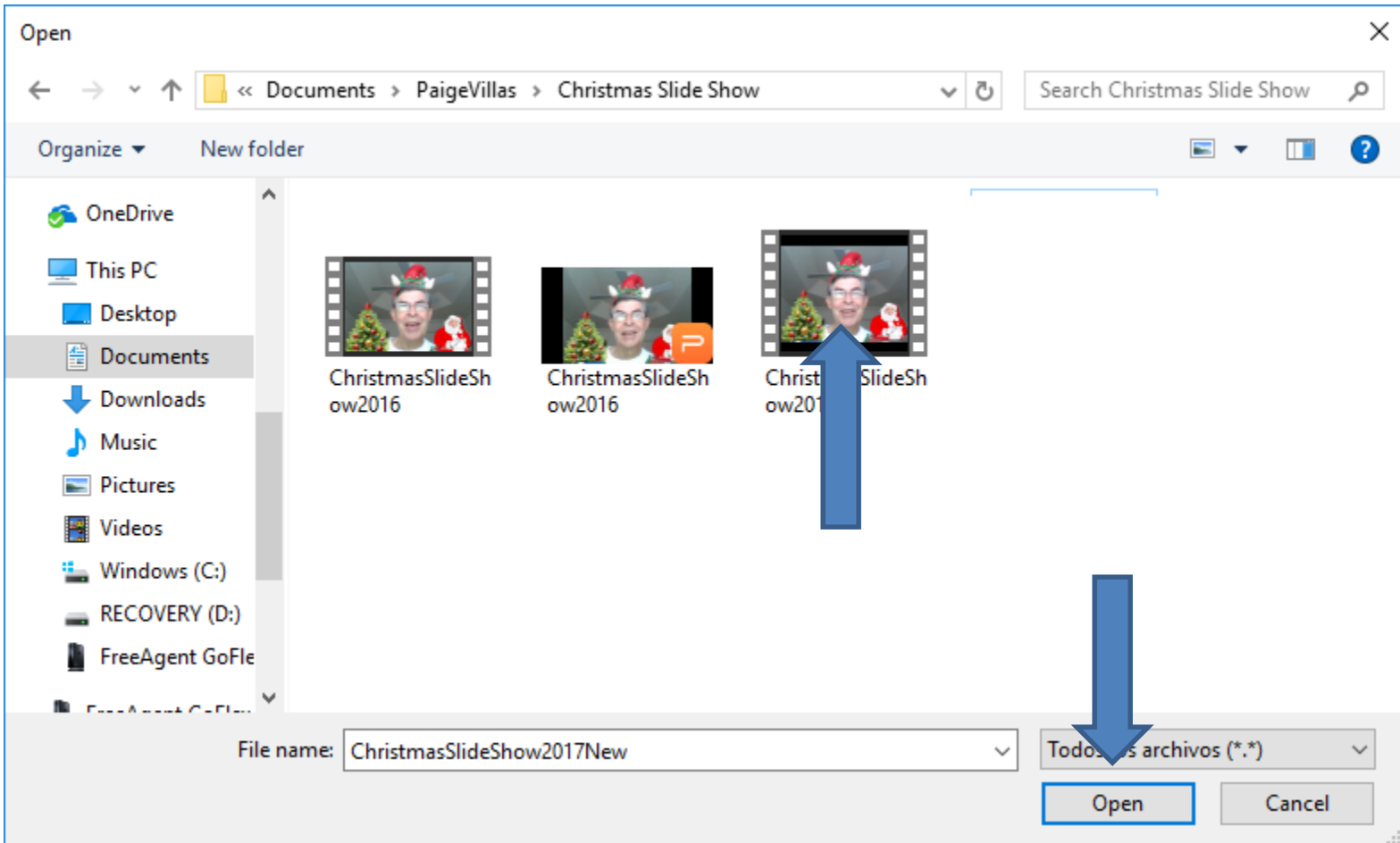
- When you open it, you click on Video Converter and next is what happens.



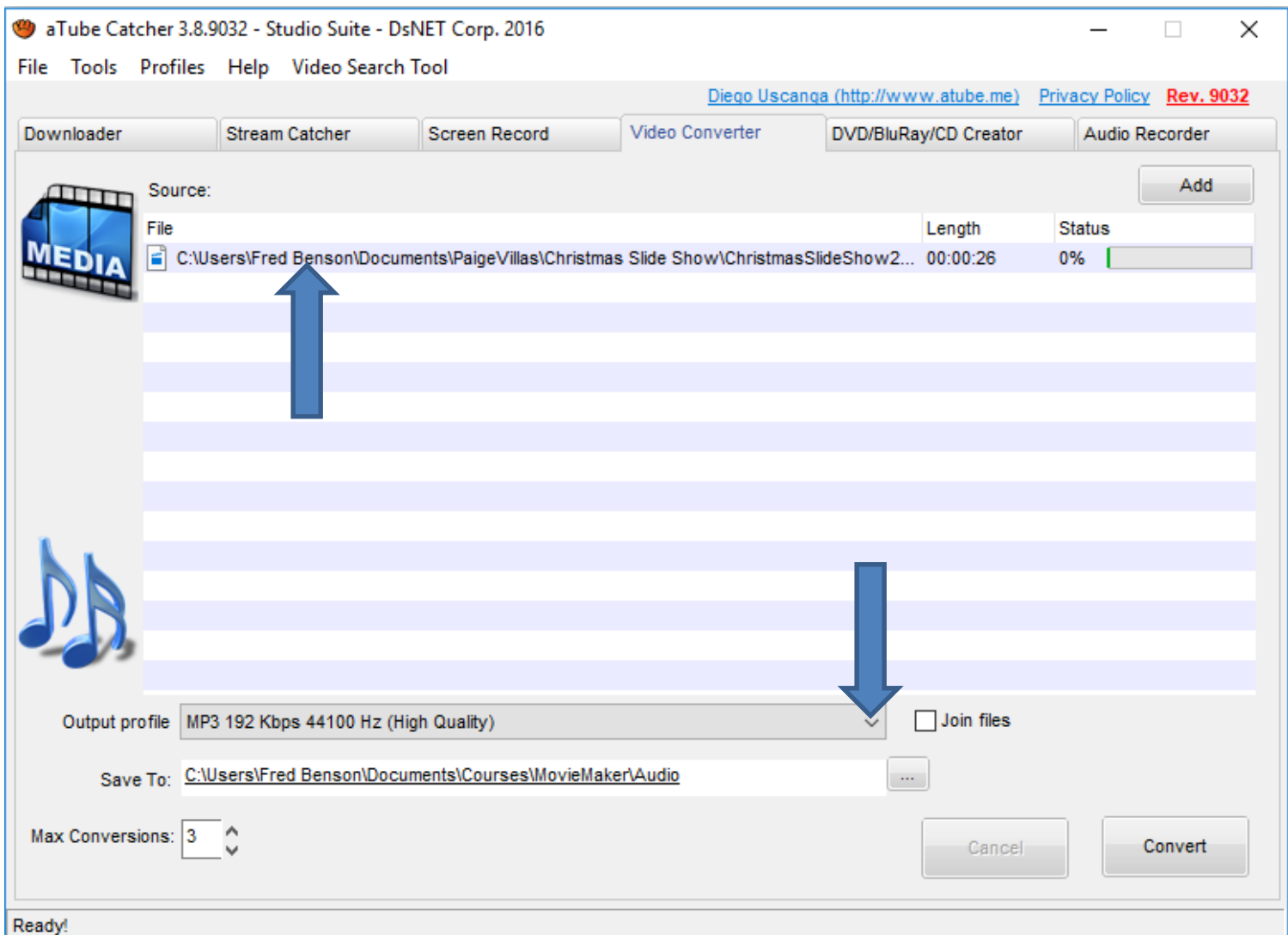
- Page changes and you click on Add and next is what happens.



- **A new window opens, like File Explorer and you find the folder with the Video you want to convert, like I did. Then double click on it or click on it and click on Open. Next is what happens.**



- **Window closes and you see the File. You click on the drop down at the right of Output profile to change it and next is what happens.**



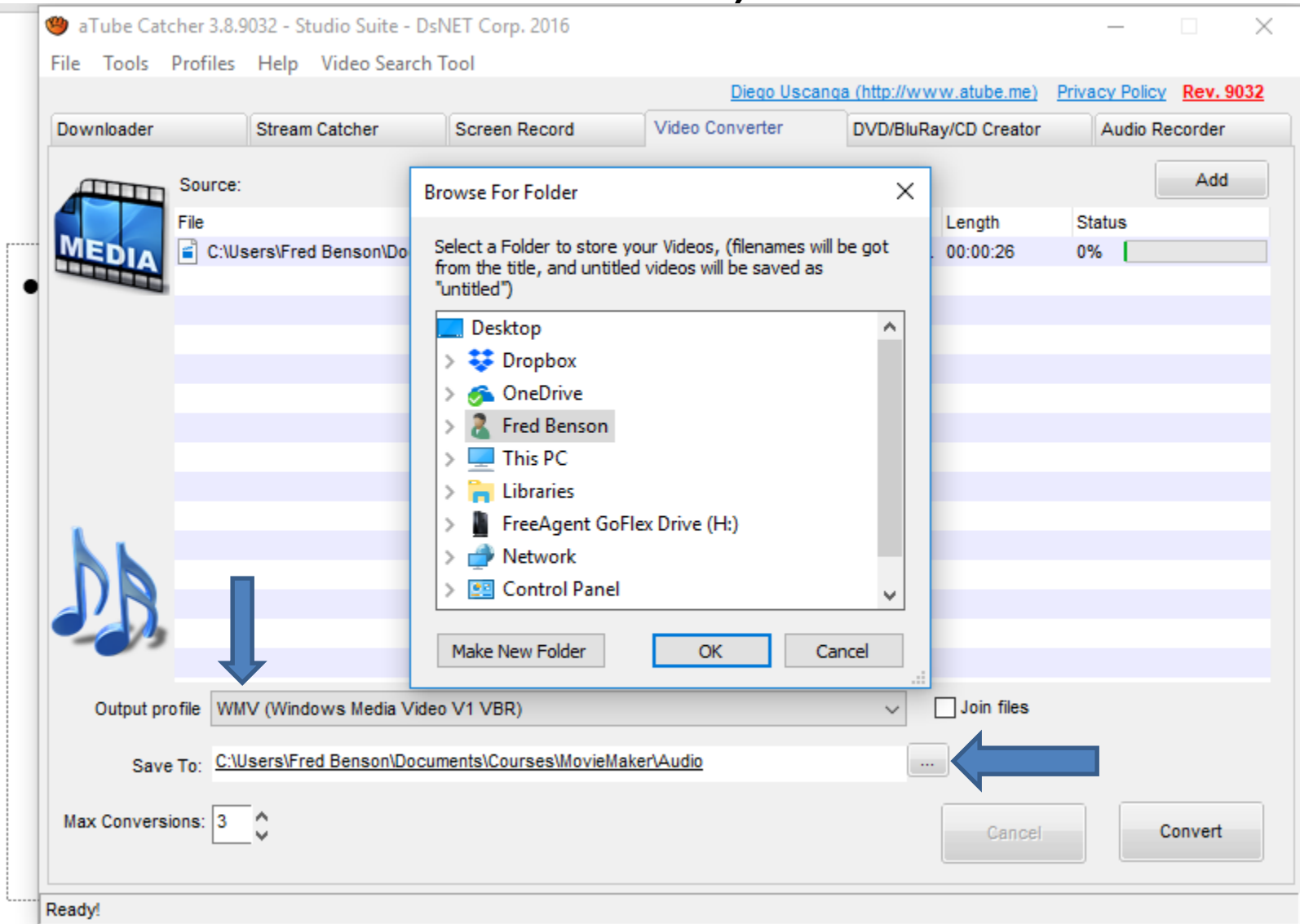
- A new window opens with a list and I recommend you click on WMV and next is what happens.

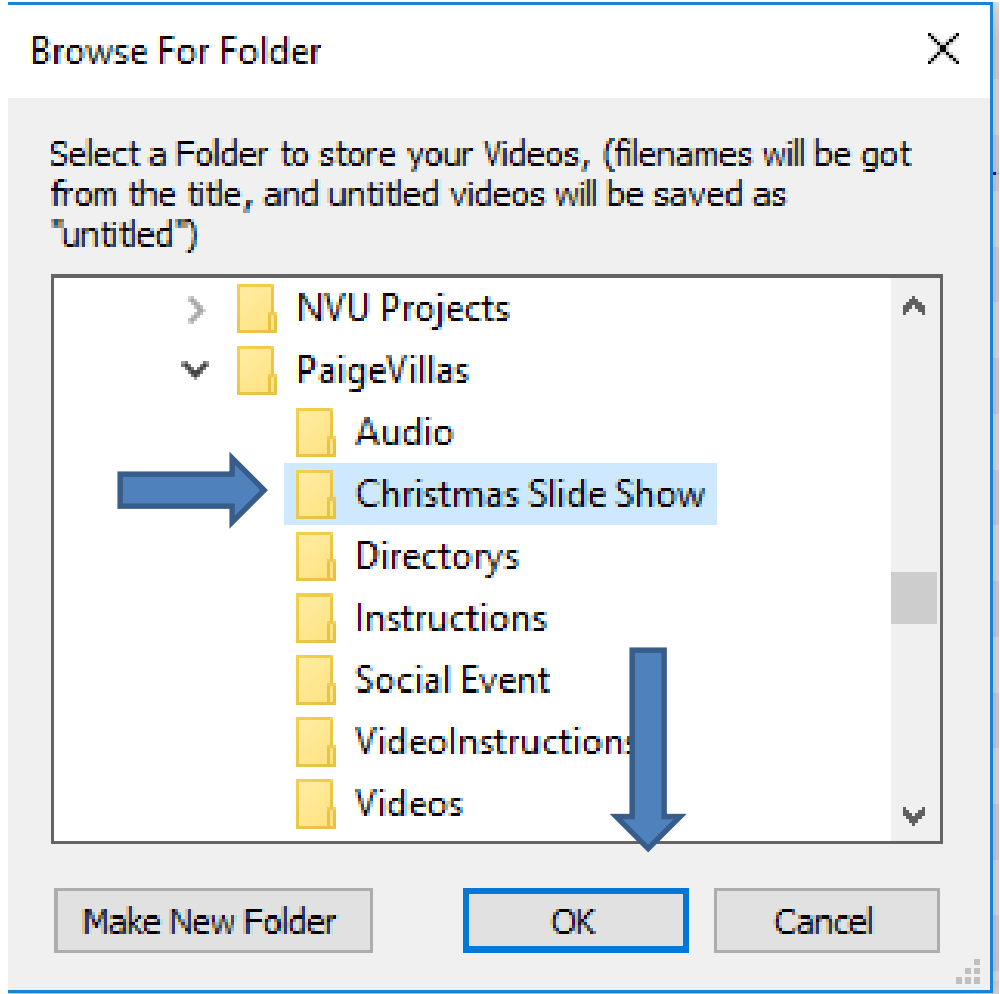

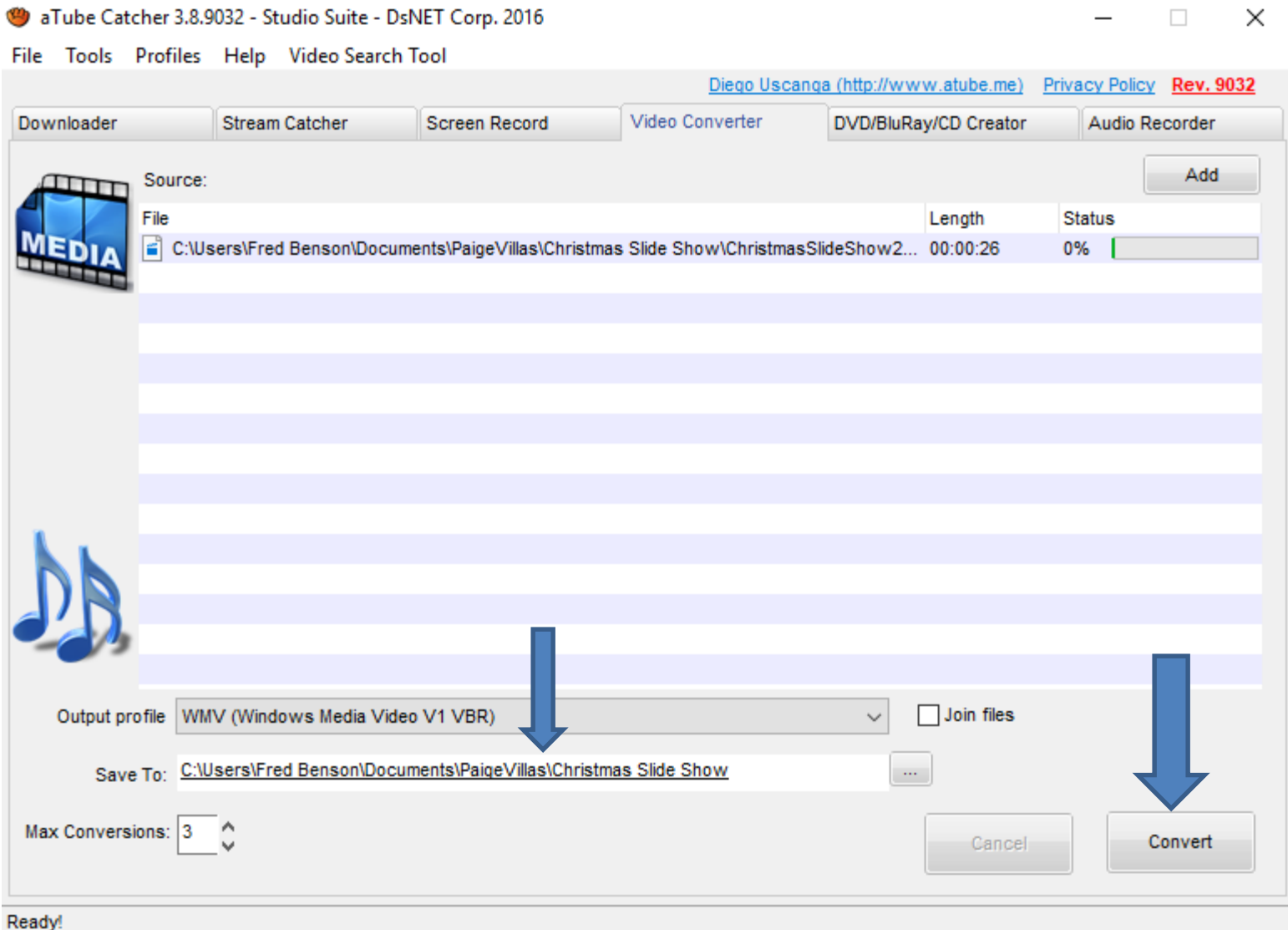
- You see the change. You then click on the icon on the right of Save to and a new window opens and you find the folder to save to, which is next.



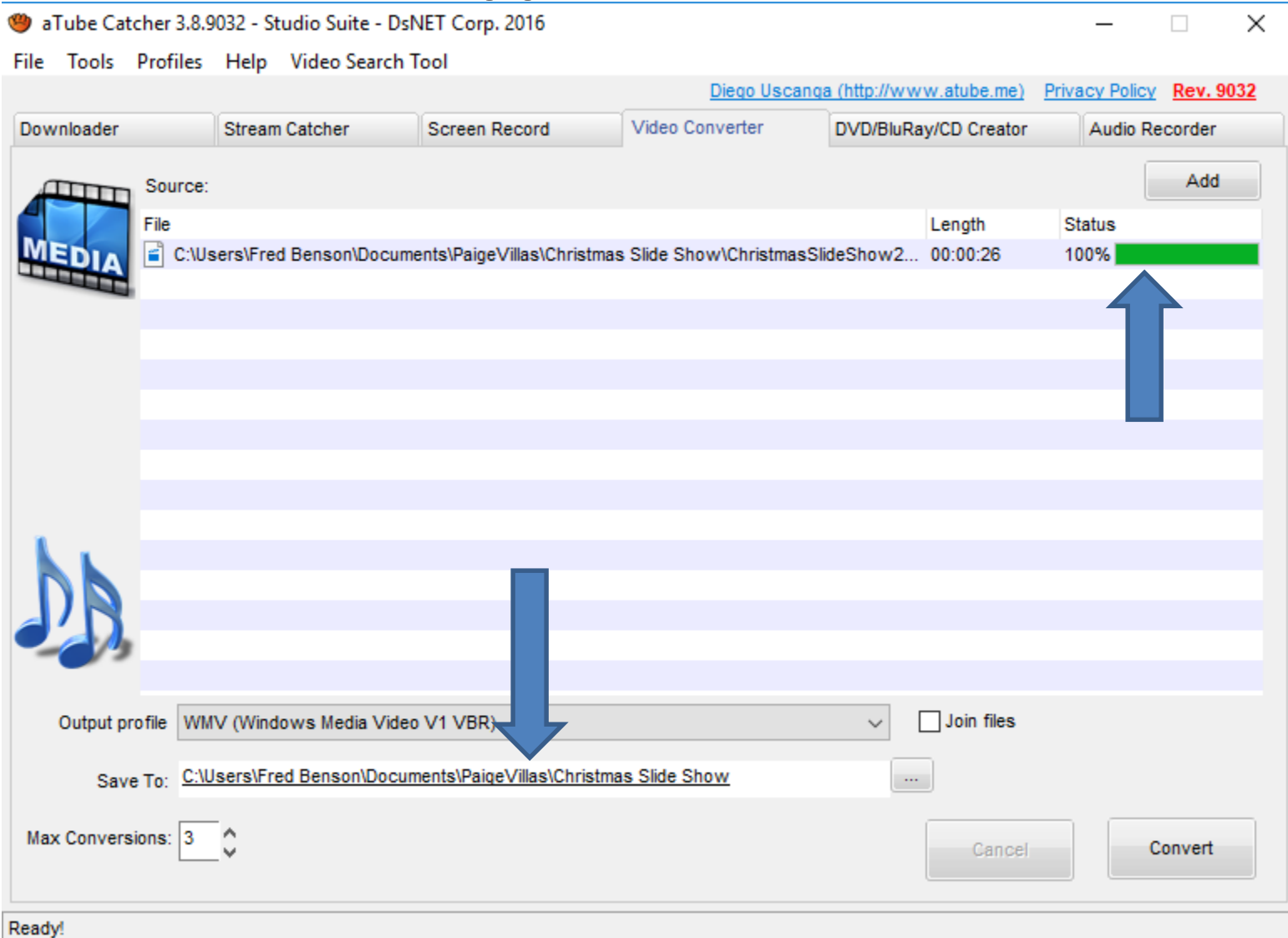
- Here is a sample of finding the Folder. You click on the Folder and then click on OK. Next is what happens.



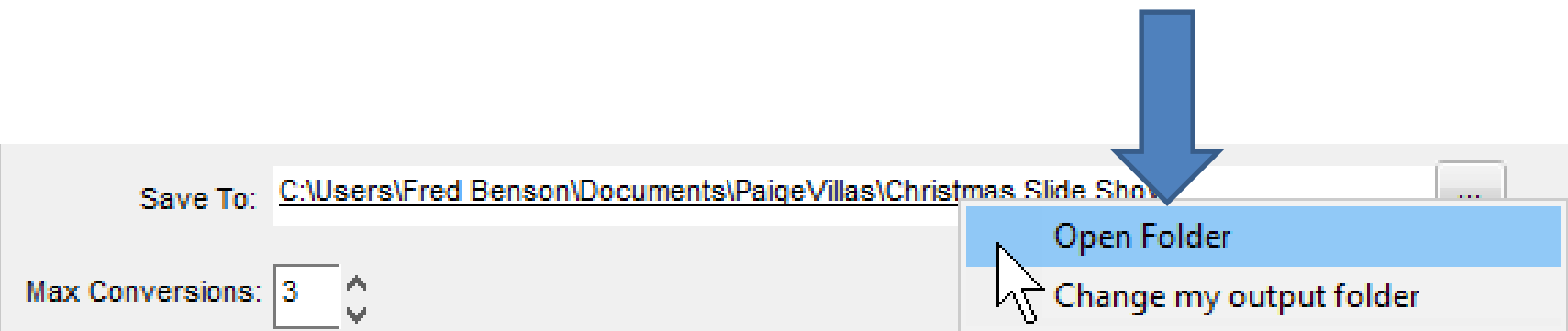
- Window closes and you see the Save to Folder is changed. You then click on Convert and next is what happens.



- It starts to convert and when it is complete, you see it is 100%. You then click on the Save To file and next is what happens.



- **A new window opens and you click on Open Folder and next is what happens.**



- **File Explorer opens and when you hover over a Video, it shows WMV File. You can then add it to Smilebox as I did in Part 4. This is the End of the Tip.**
