

Tip – Add your own Voice/Song with other programs

- To add your own Voice/Song in Smilebox, you have to use another program.**
- If you have Movie Maker, you can do Record narration as I showed you in my Movie Maker on-line training. You can add that file to Smilebox.**
- If you don't have Movie Maker, there is another program, which is next.**

- **aTube Catcher is free and you have to download it as I showed you in the other Tip.**
- **If you already have aTube Catcher, open it and forward to page 5 in this PDF file. If not, next is how to download aTube Catcher.**
- **Note – If you have a Laptop and it does not allow voice, you need a Microphone.**

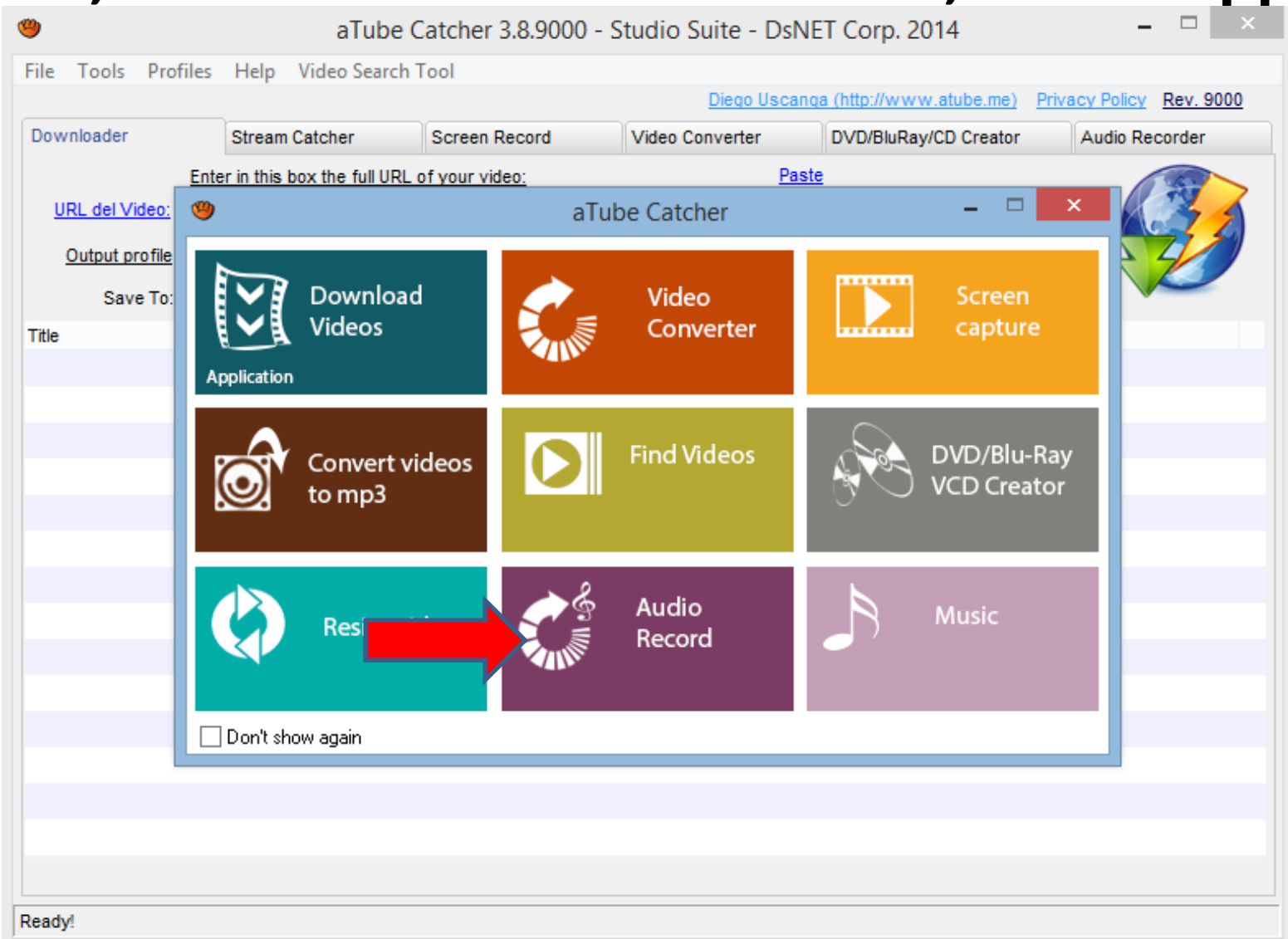
- **Step 6 – Part B shows you how to Download aTube Catcher. I will show you again in case you have not done Part B.**

Download Music using aTube Catcher

- Download aTube Catcher from this site

- Once you download it, you will see this icon on your desktop. Double click on it to open it. You can Pin to Taskbar, like I showed you in other Steps.



- After you download and open it, this is what it looks like with the features. To create your own voice, click on Audio Record. Next, what happens.




- You see Audio Recorder. Next is to change the location, called Target path. Next, I will zoom in.




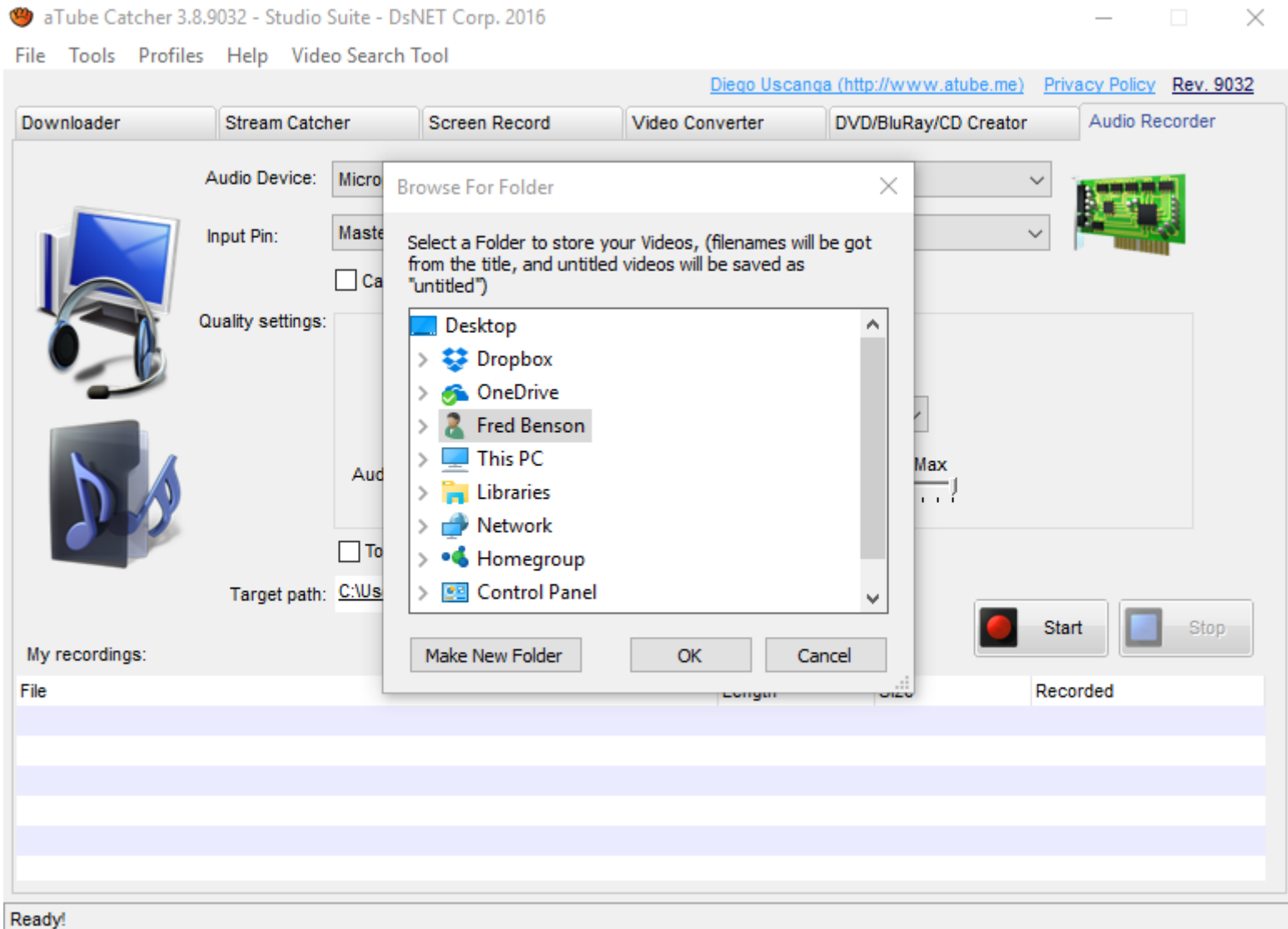

- You then see the location depending on you open aTube Catcher. To change the location, you click on the . . . Icon. Next is what happens.

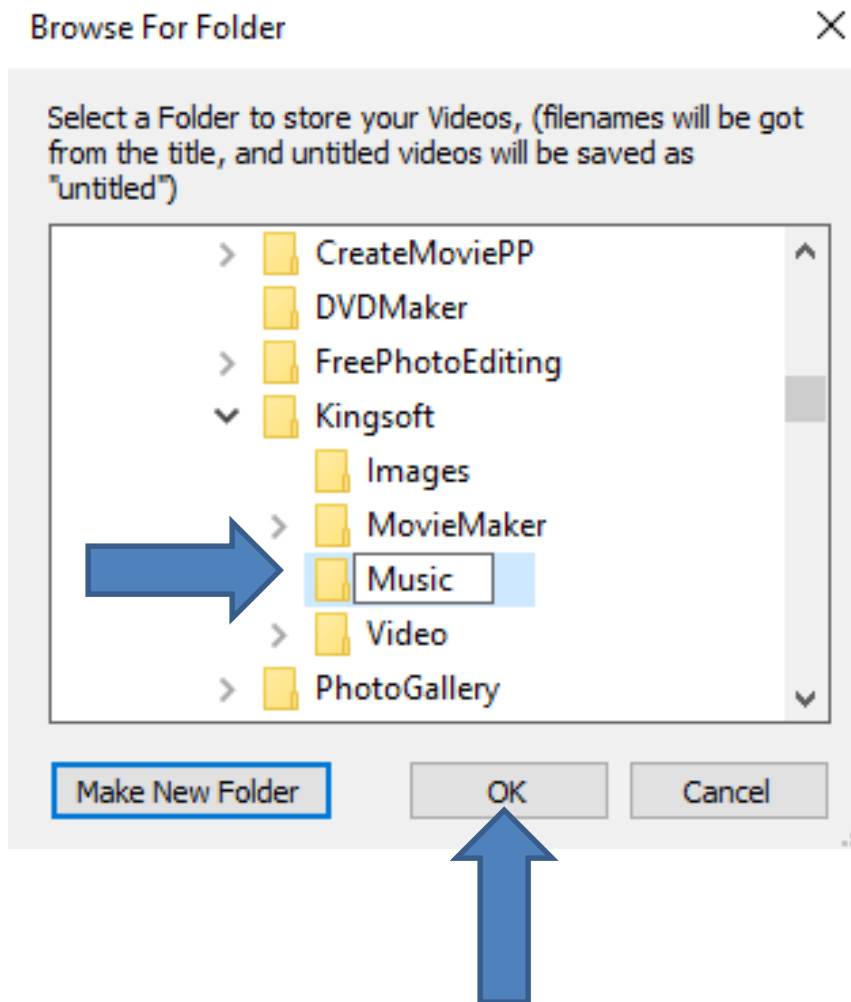

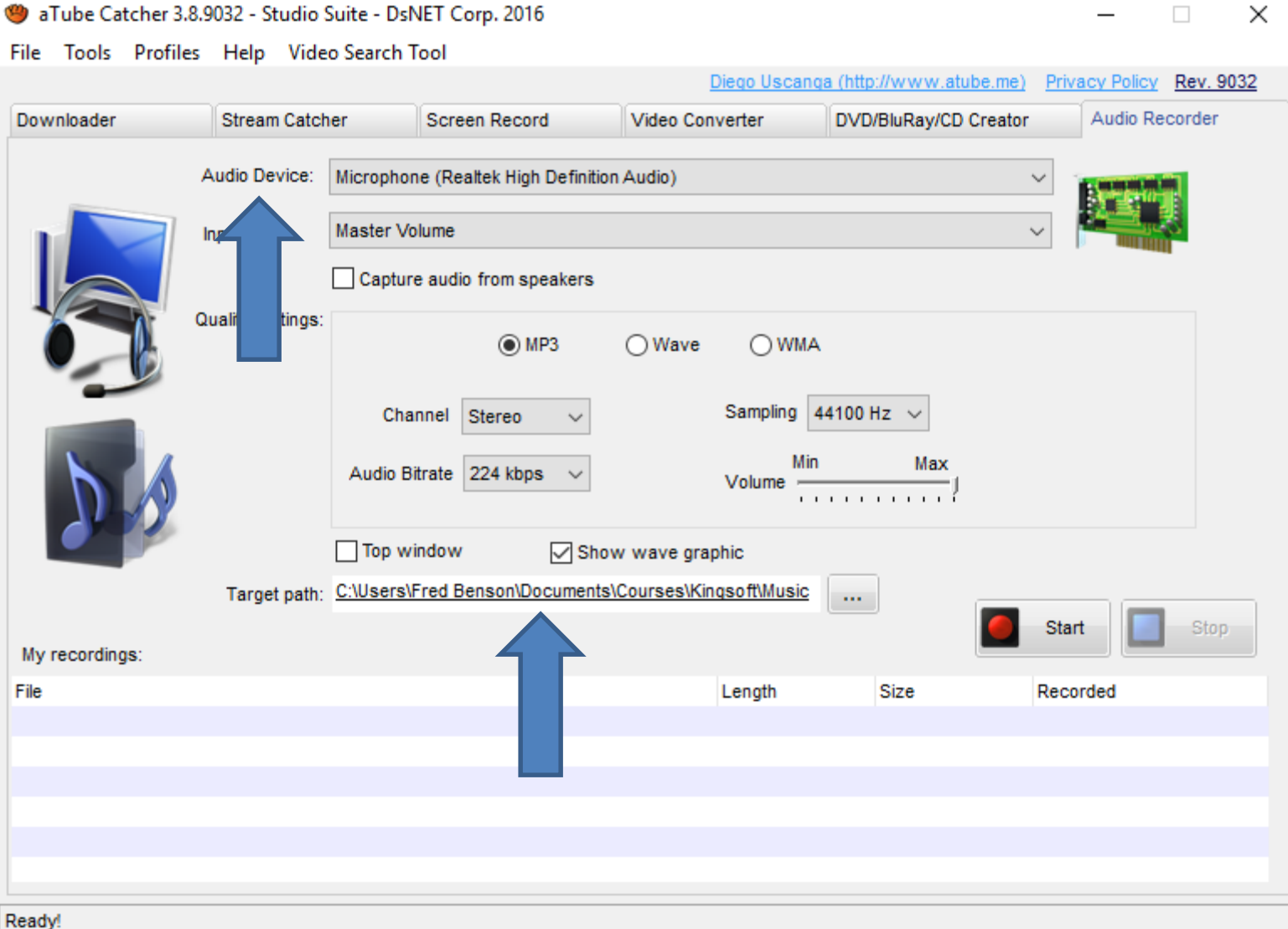
- A new window opens and find the folder you want and you can Make New Folder. Next is a sample.



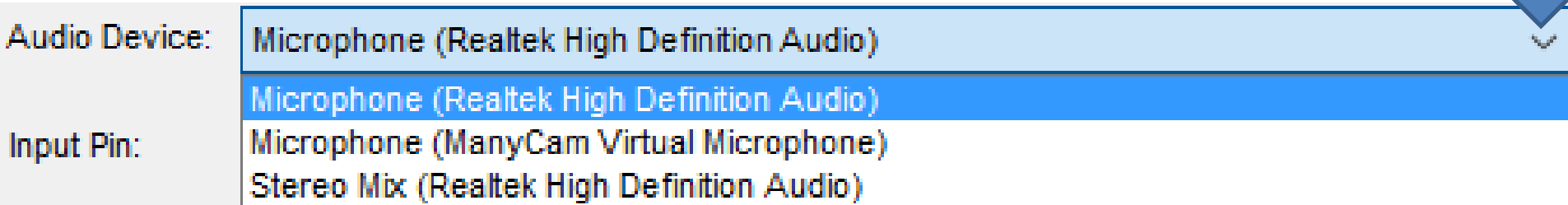
- Here is a sample of finding a folder and adding a New Folder, called Music. Once complete, click on OK. Next is what happens.



- Once you click on OK, the window closes and you see the new location. Next is about Audio Device.



- I zoomed in, so you can see it. You click on the drop down at the end of Audio Device and you see a list depending on what devices you have on your computer. You click on one that you want.
- Next is what type of Music file your want.




- The default is MP3, which I recommend. If it is not, I recommend you click on that box. Next is how to record.

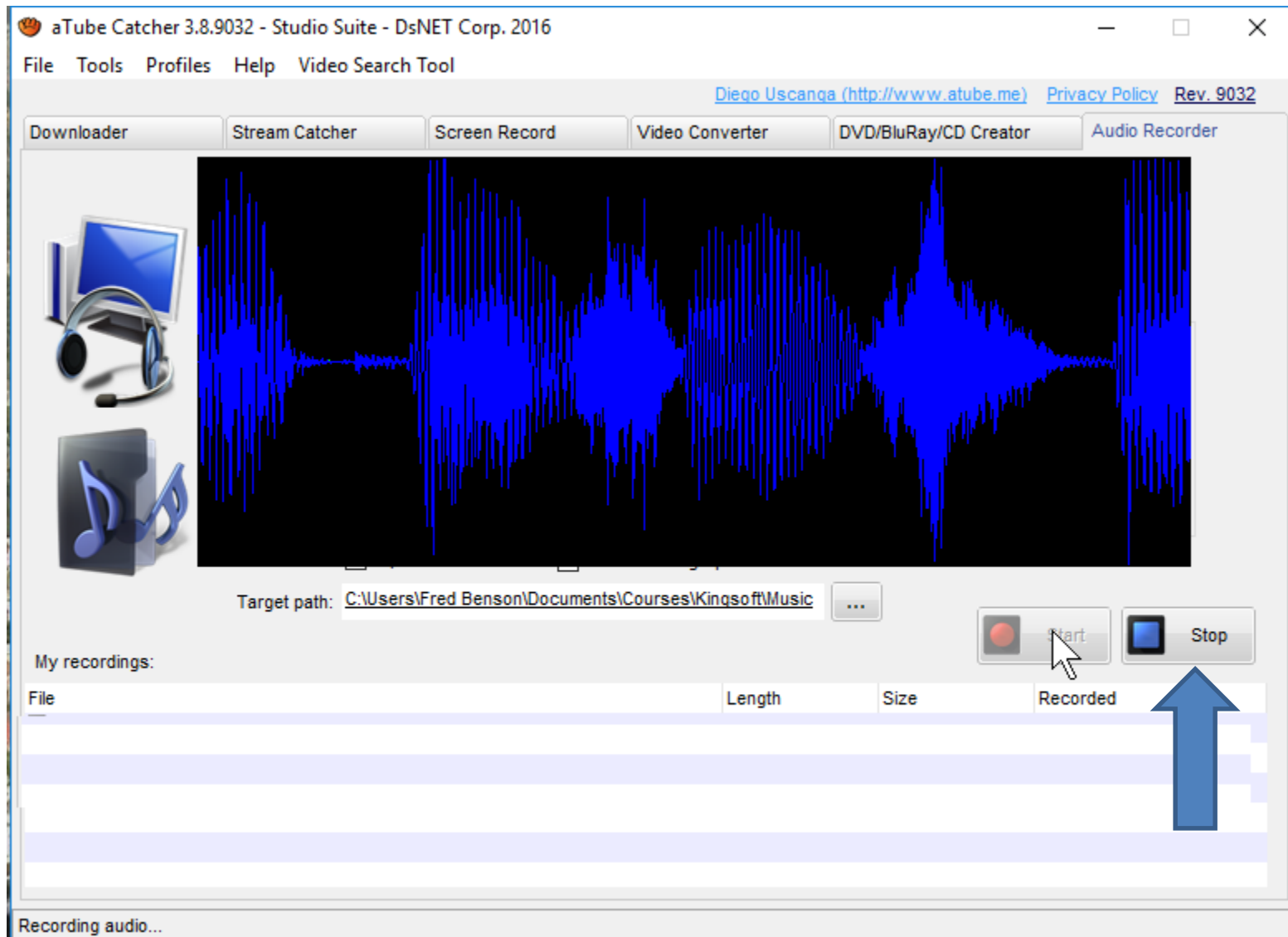
