


Tip – What happens when you move photos on your computer.


- **Photos are not inside Movie Maker. They are just a link. But, they are inside Kingsoft Presentation.**
- **So, if you have photo on Movie Maker and move the same photo from one folder to another one, they will not show on Movie Maker. You will see an error when you close and open your Project.**
- **Next explains more.**

- **After either option to save project as we did in Step 9 and close Movie Maker and open Movie Maker again, next is what happens when you move Photo(s).**
- **First open Movie Maker.**




- Then, click on **File** in **Movie Maker** and you see recent projects that the one we saved.
- Click on it.

- **You then see an error, if you moved the Photo to a different folder on your computer.**
- **Next is how to fix it.**



Hover over the error icon.

- You see the former location and it tells you to Double-click to fix. I will show you that, but don't do it here. I will show you second option later.







You then see a new window.

- If you don't want the picture, you can click on Remove. To find the new location, click on Find. Note – as I mentioned don't do it here. Next is what happens.



File Explorer opens.



- You then find the new folder that you moved the Photo. Click on the folder and then click on Open.

You then see it in Movie Maker

- Next is the second option.



Second option is to Move Picture back to original folder.

- **Open File Explorer again and Move the Picture from FreePhotoEditing Folder to PicturesForRoom.**
- **Close Movie Maker.**
- **Open Movie Maker and click Recent Project and you will not see the error.**
- **Next is what happens when you edit photo.**

What happens when you edit a photo?

- When you edit a photo using a program like Photo Gallery or PicPick and save it, the change does not show on Movie Maker.**
- But, if you save the project and close Movie Maker and open the project, it will show the change.**
- Also, if you save as Movie, the change will appear in the Movie.**
