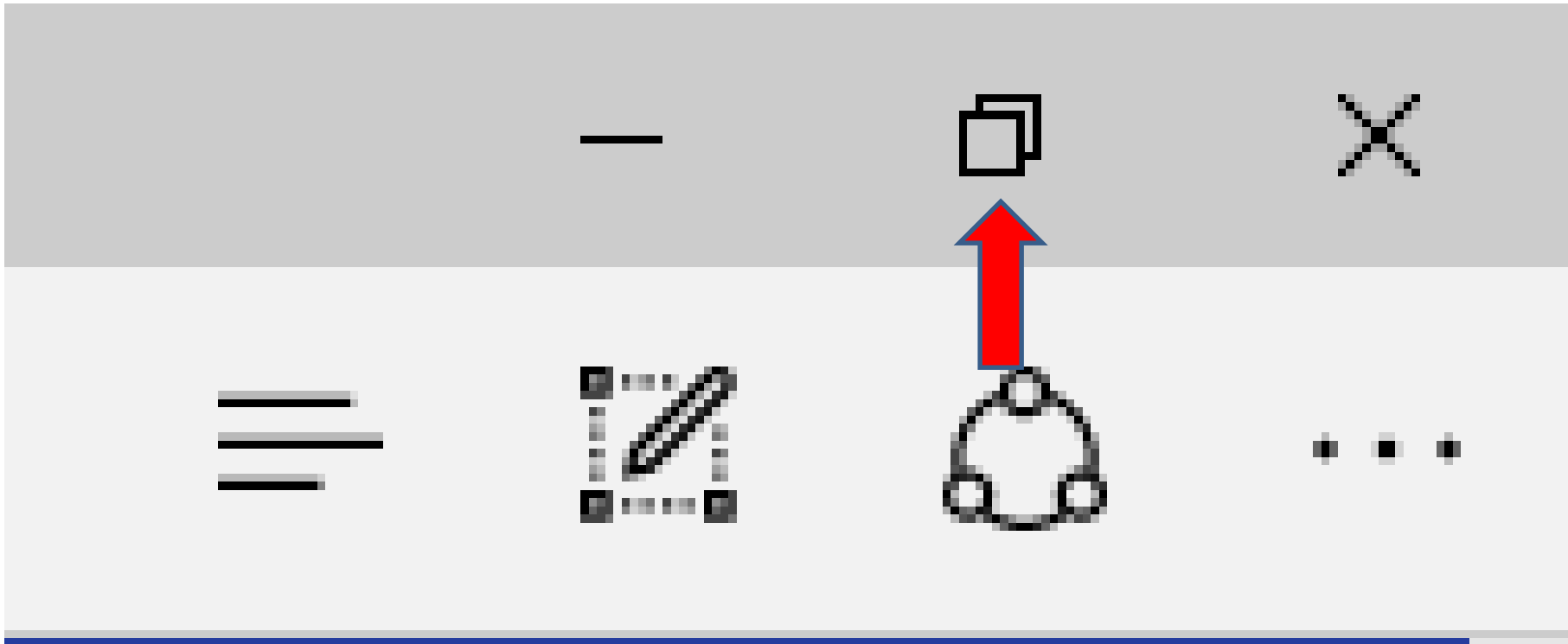



Tip - How to view PDF and Movie Maker

- Depending on what browser and PDF reader you are using, PDF file opens in a new tab or new window.**
- If you have Movie Maker and know how to open it, you can use this Tip. If you don't know you have Movie Maker, do Step 1 first to find and open Movie Maker. If you can't find it, use Step 2 to download it.**
- Because you are in the Tip – PDF file, you can follow the same process that I will show you. Next is a sample of open the Tip in the on-line training with Google Chrome Browser.**

**In the upper right, click on the
Restore Down Icon**



You then left click on hold down at the top and drag it to the right.

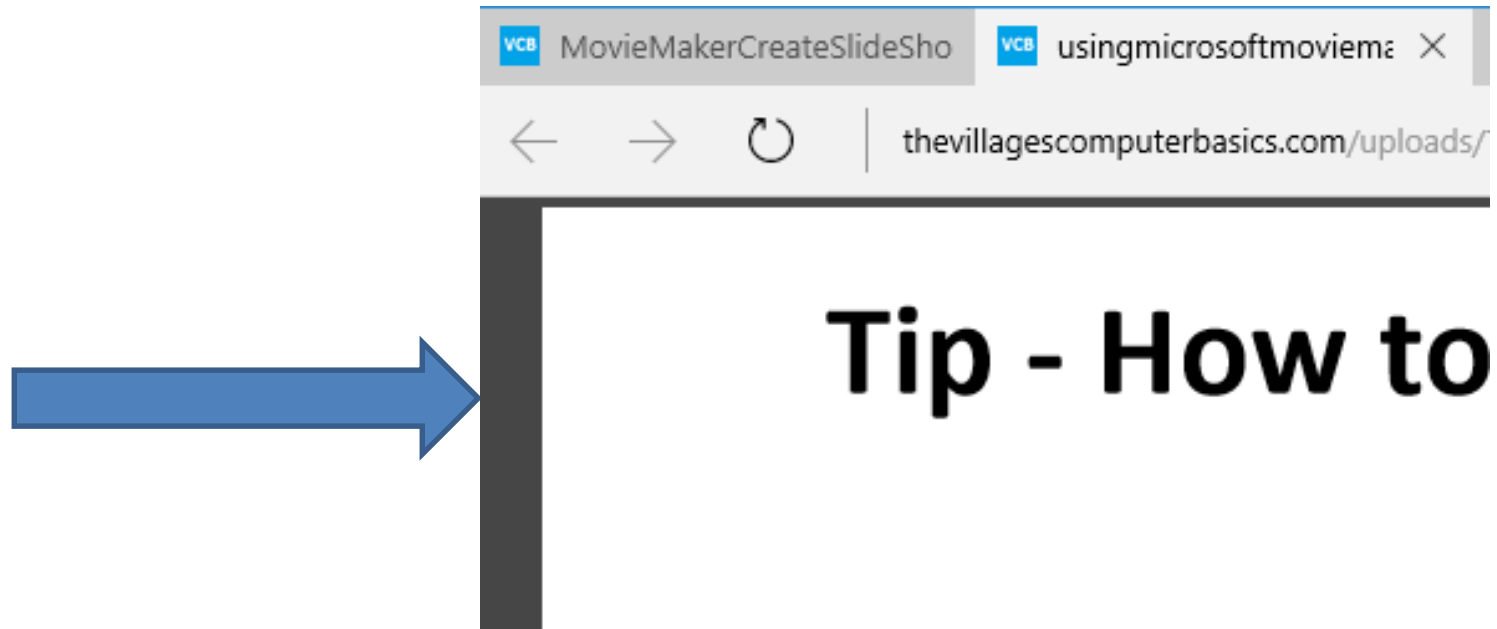

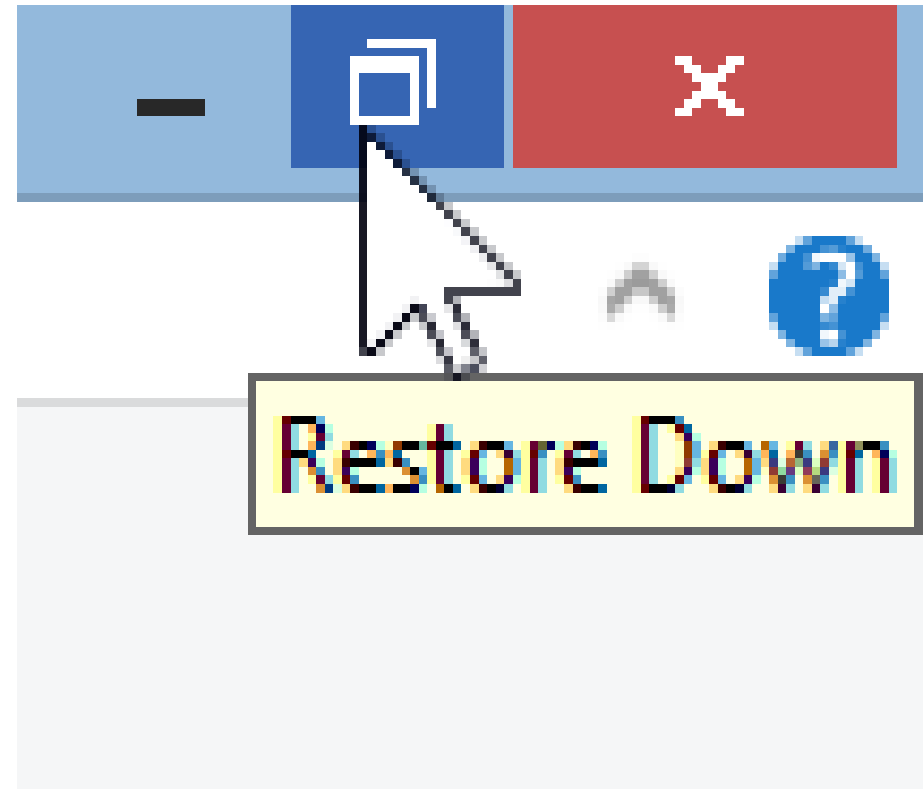
Note - Microsoft will no longer support Movie Maker in January 10, 2017 and at that time you can't download Windows Essentials. If you have Movie Maker before January 10, 2017, you can use it, but there may be some problems.

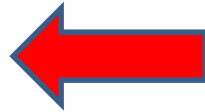
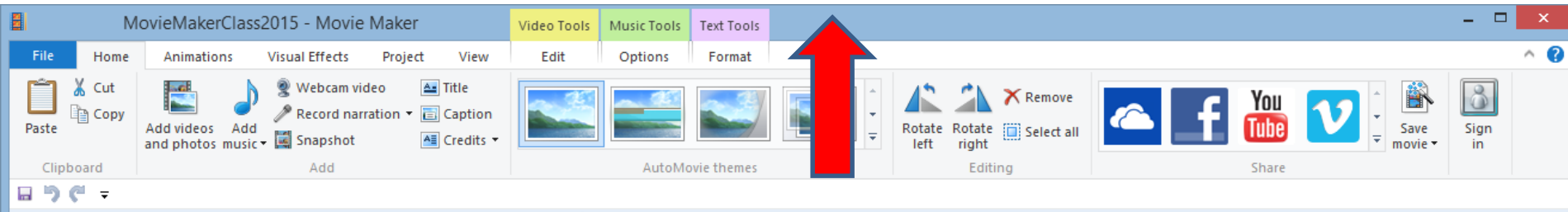
You then click on the left, hold it down and drag it to the right about half way.



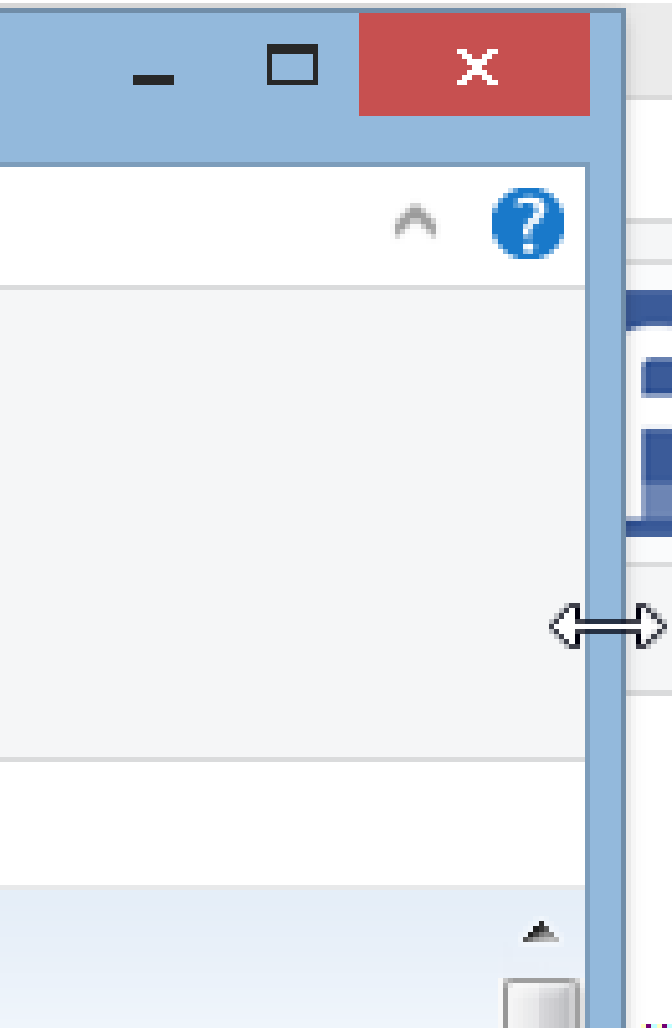
**Open Movie Maker and click on the

You then left click at the top and hold it down and drag it to the left.

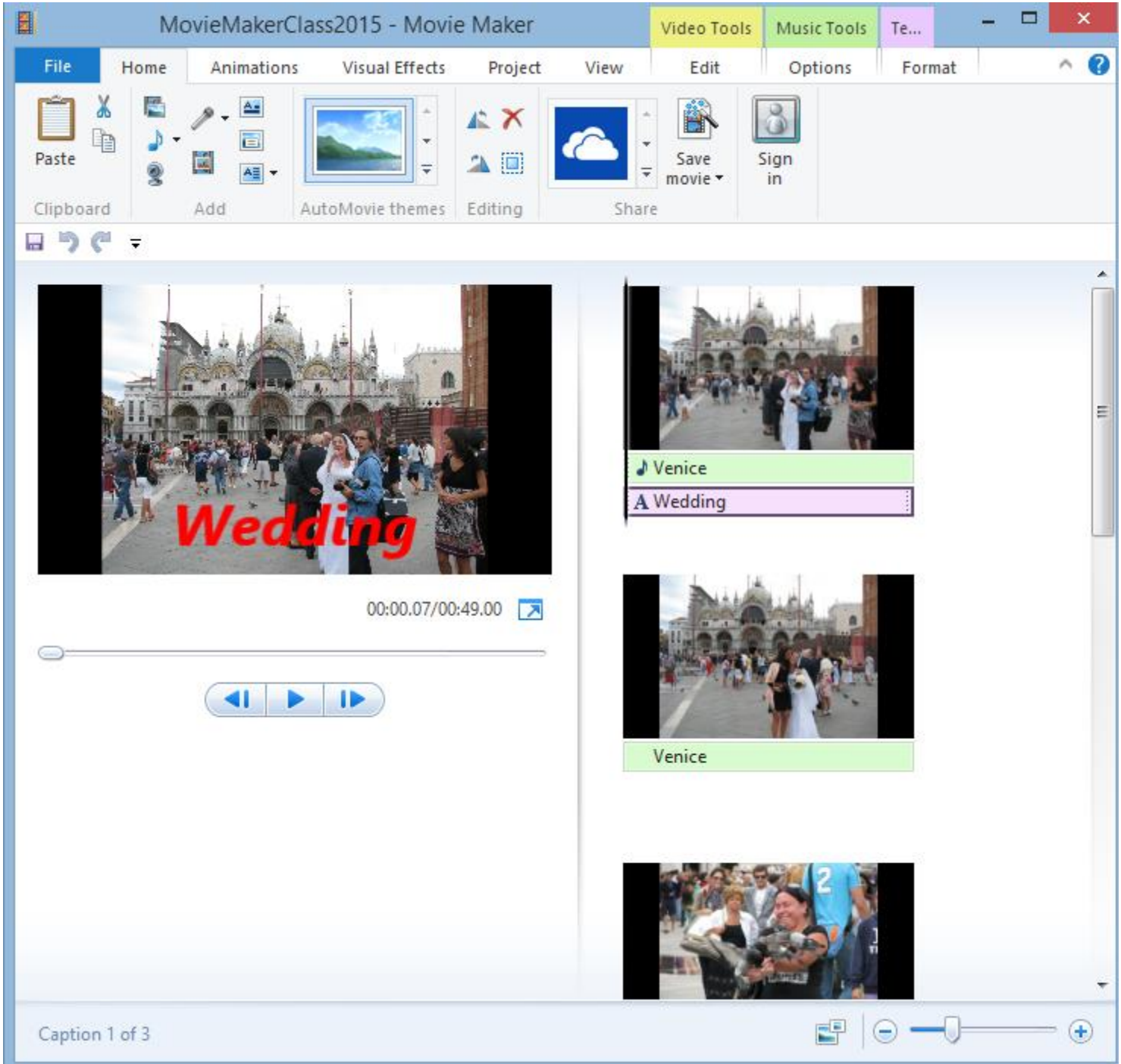


You then click on the right and drag it to the left a little or have way.



- **Note – if you drag it have way, you may not see all items on the top. Also, the layout is different on the bottom. Next is a sample.**

- **I recommend you just drag it a little.**



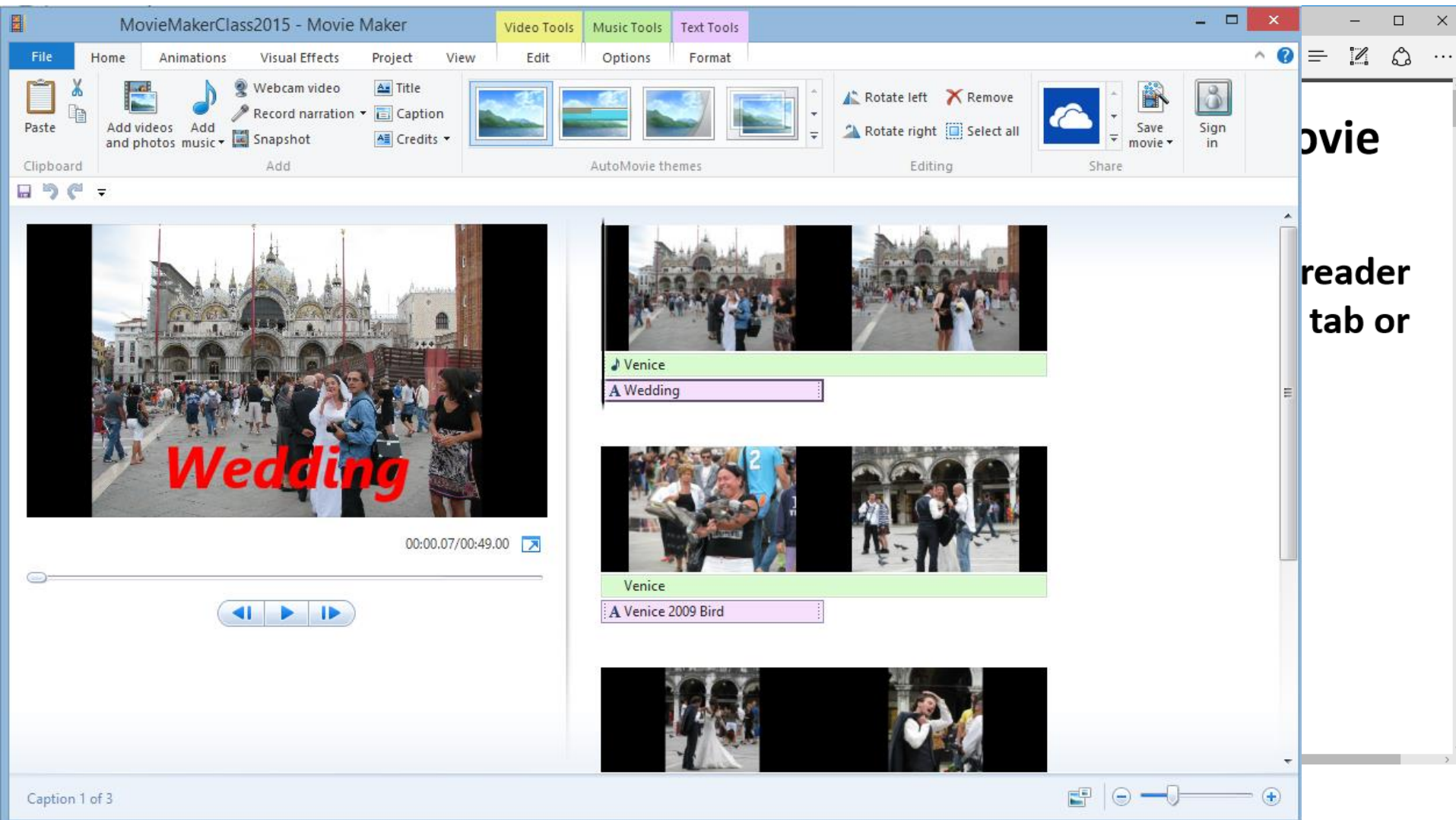

- **Once you see the step you have to do on Movie Maker, you then click on Movie Maker.**


Practice a Step

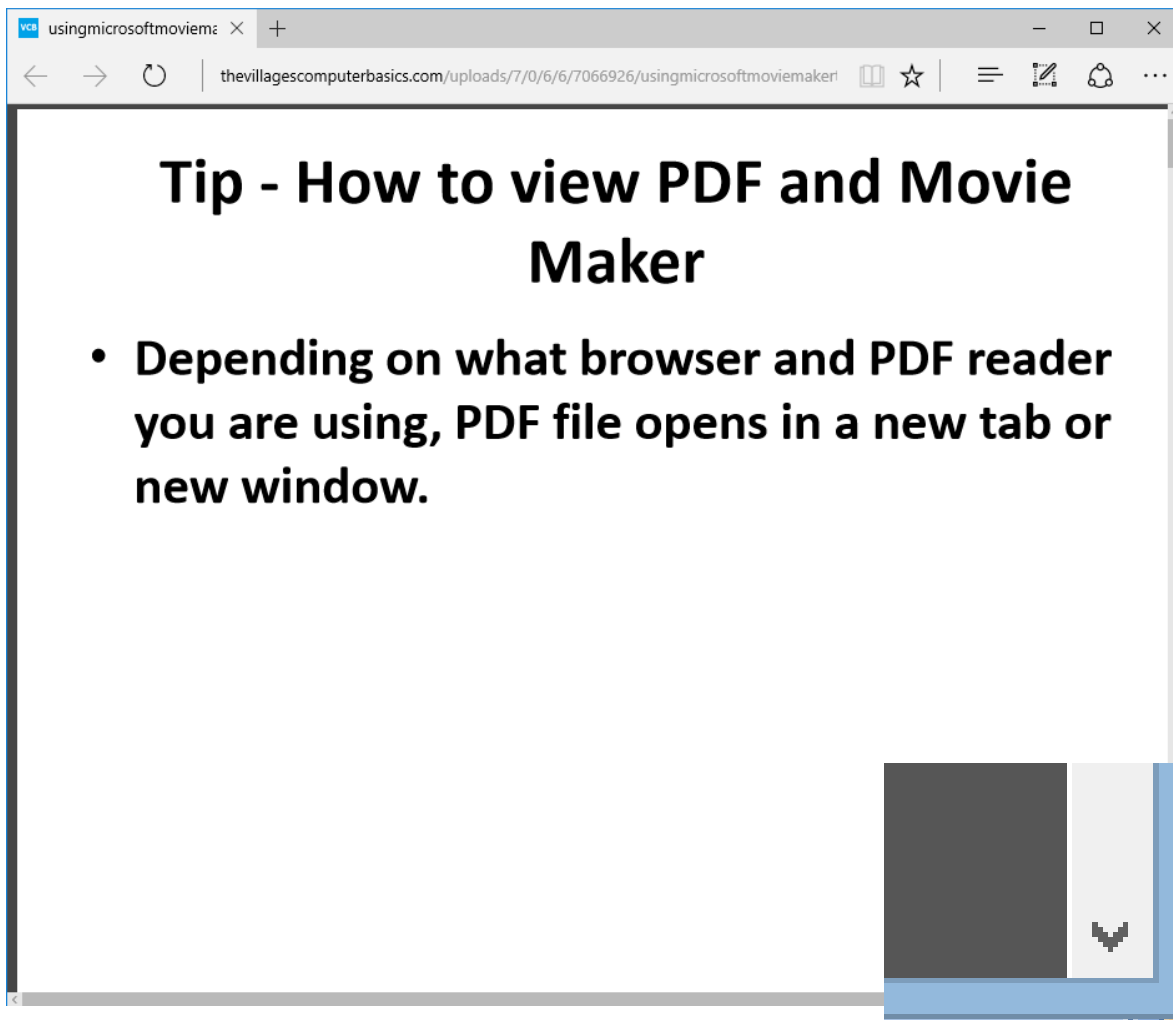

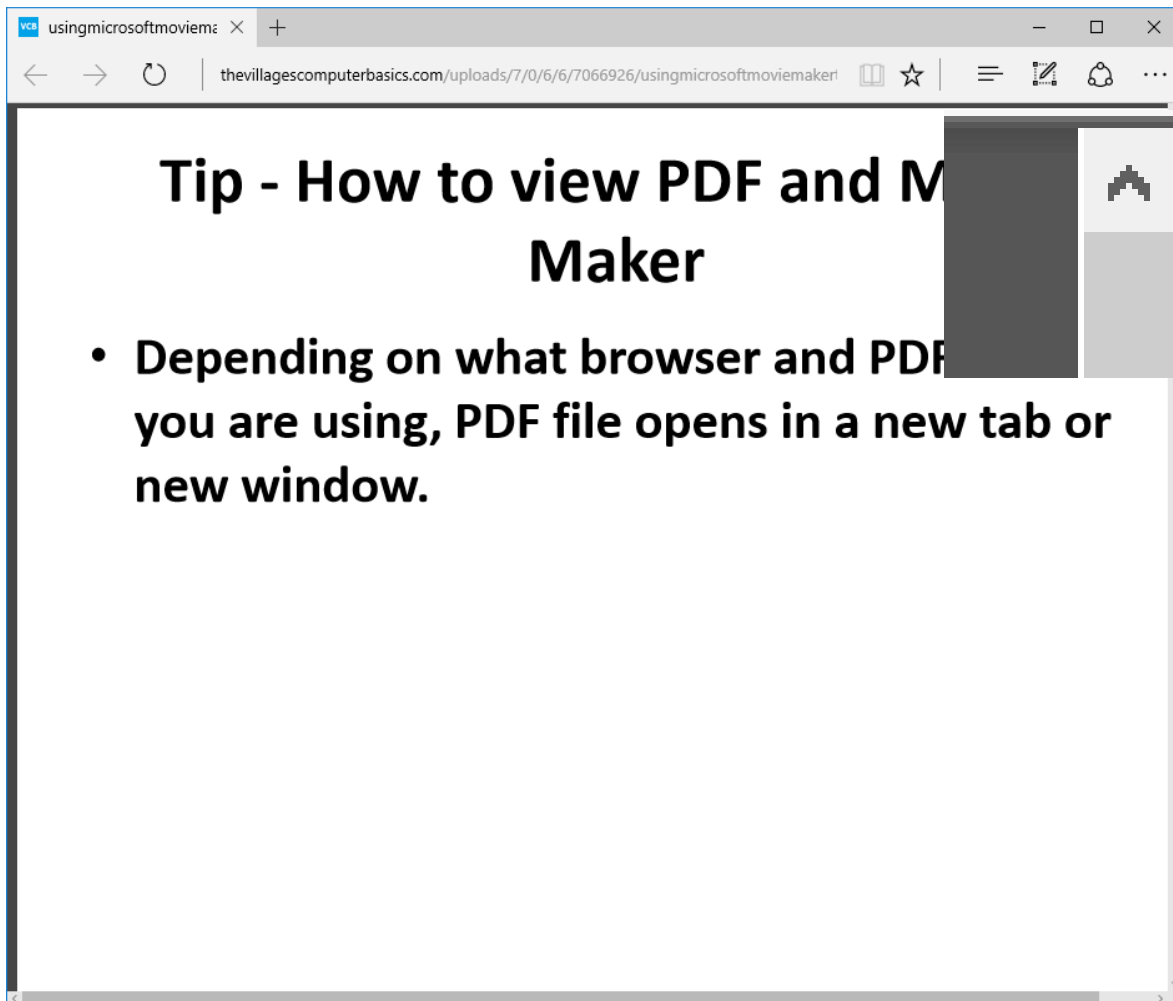

Reason for this process.

- You can view the PDF steps and follow the process on Movie Maker.**
- You can follow same process to use Photo Gallery to organize and photo editing, which is Steps 3 and 4.**
- Next shows you how to go to each page on PDF. It depends on the PDF Reader.**



- **Click on the V icon in lower right to go to the next page**



- Click on the icon  upper right to go to the previous page.
