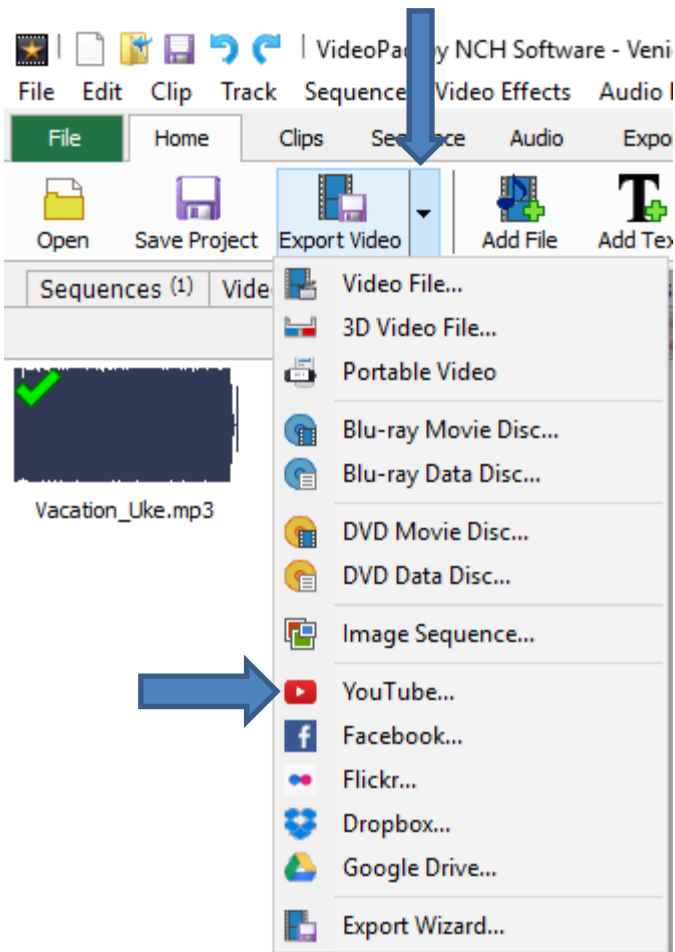


Step 11 – Share Video

- You have lots of options to Share Video.**
- You can share on YouTube, Facebook, Flickr, Dropbox, Google Drive, OneDrive or a Disc/DVD.**
- You have some options on how to Share.**
- One option is using VideoPad.**
- Second option is when you save the Video from VideoPad or one from your camera, you can upload.**
- Third option is Disc/DVD which is Step 12.**
- Next is how to share using VideoPad.**

- **Note – to share on YouTube, Facebook, Flickr, Dropbox, Google Drive, OneDrive, you will need an account.**
- **When you use VideoPad to export a Video to one of them, except OneDrive, you have to sign-up or create an account.**
- **That’s why I like just do upload vs. using Export with VideoPad.**
- **Next is how to do it with VideoPad, that is not good and after that is to Upload. Note – I will only show YouTube, that I like.**



- **First click on the dropdown on the right of Export Video and you see a list.**
- **Next I will show when you click on YouTube.**



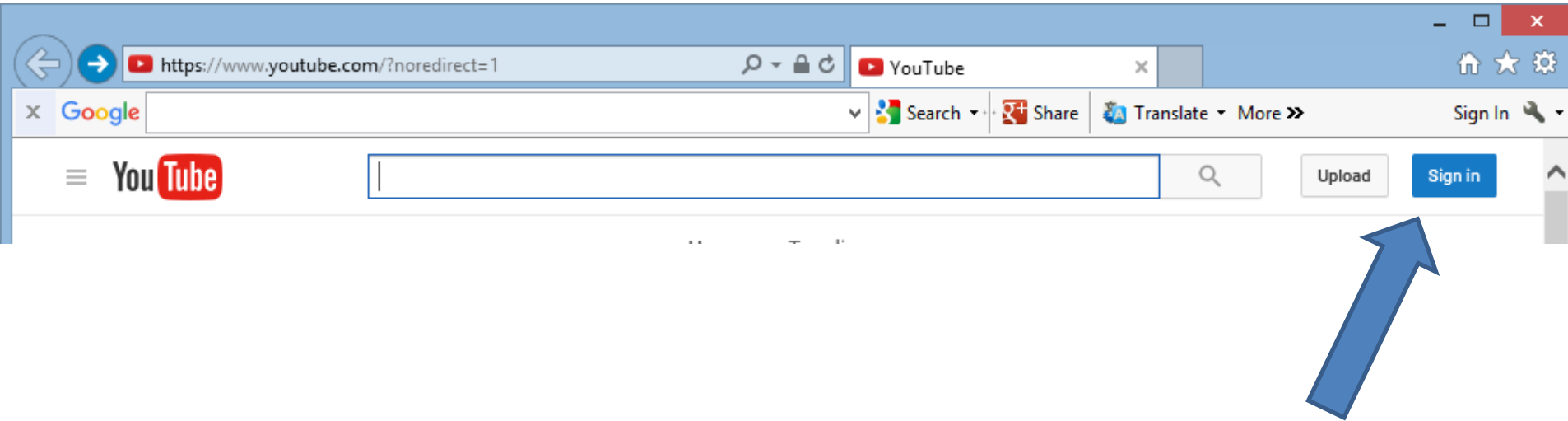


- **When I clicked on Deny, it does not upload it to YouTube. It works the same with the others.**

What is Unlisted or Private vs. Public?

- If it is **Public**, and people search on YouTube, they may find your video.
- If it is **Unlisted**, people will not find it when they search. But, if you share it with the link, people can send the link.
- If it is **Private**, and you want to share it with only some people, they will have to have a Google account.
- Next is change the name.

- I changed it to Unlisted and you see Done vs. Public.
- You then highlight the Name and make a change, which is next.



How to enable Custom thumbnail and increase the size to upload a Video?

- As I mention before, Page 29 shows you how to increase the size longer to upload a Video.**
- Once you do it, it also enables the Custom thumbnail.**
- Note – I do Custom thumbnail to add a Title photo. Page 48 shows that.**
- Next is what happens when your done.**

- You see the change in the upper left.
- It tells you to Click “Done” to confirm, so click on it and next is what happens







- Next is how to make the Video Upload longer and show Custom thumbnail.

- **As I mentioned before it only allows 15 minutes on the Video.**
- **You can make it longer. When you make it longer, the maximum file size that you can upload is 128 GB or 12 hours, whichever is less. They changed the limits on uploads in the past, so you may see older videos that are longer than 12 hours.**
- **To make it longer, and when you are in your Browser with your YouTube account, I recommend you add a new tab and type in youtube.com/verify and click on the Enter Key. Next is what happens and how to make it longer.**

- This is a sample of the youtube.com/verify page. I recommend you click on the Box left of Call me with automated voice message and next is what happens.

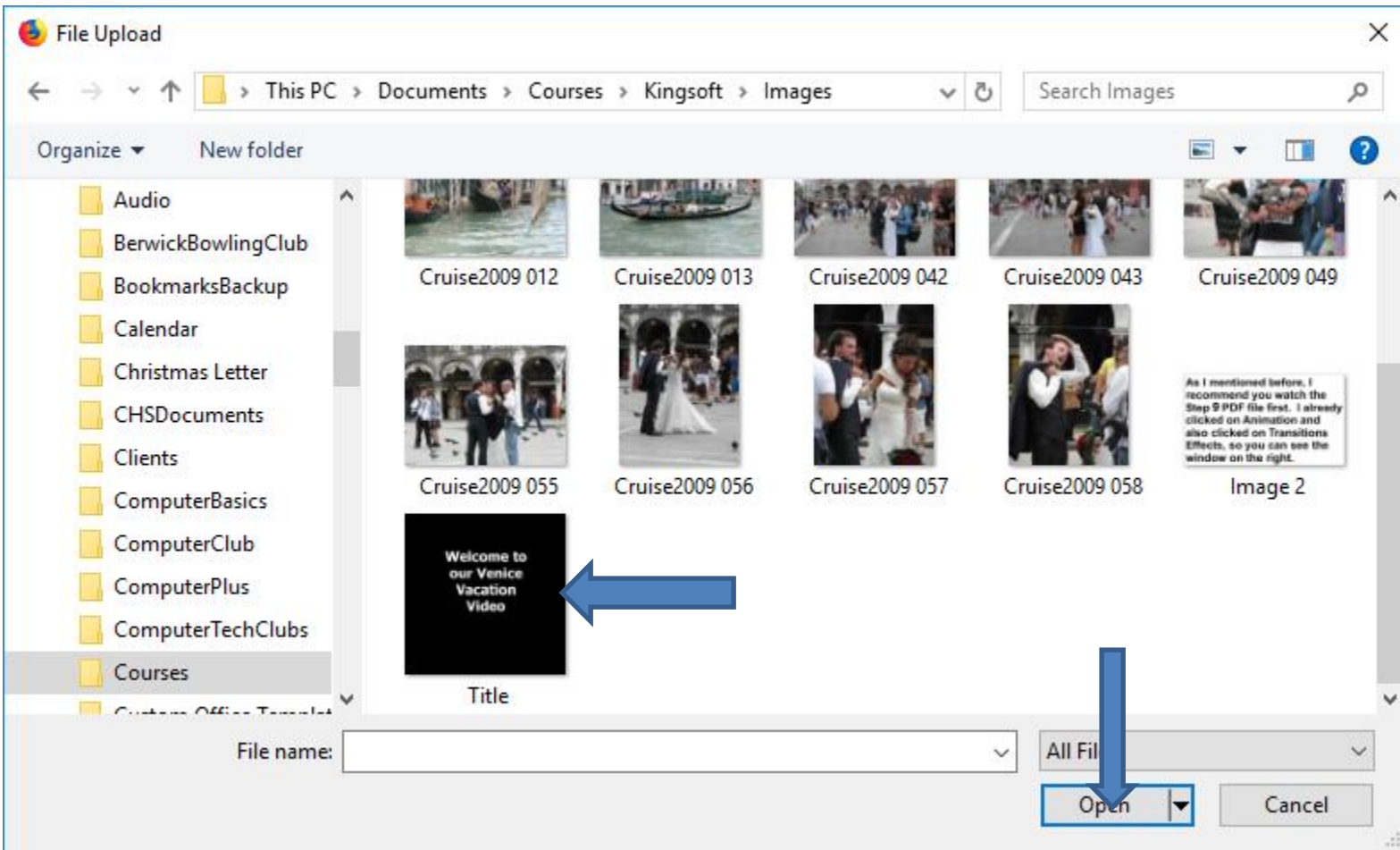
