
Part C - DVD Styler for Windows 8 or 10




- Download DVD Styler shows you in Step 1 – Part B.
- Once you download, Double click on Desktop or single click on Taskbar.

DVD Styler for Windows 8 or 10




- When you start it, it shows new project and you can change the label.
- Then click on OK


A new window opens to select a Template for the




Once you select, it then appears. Here is a sample.
Click on Disc Title.




New window opens to change Title.




You change it to something like Cruise 2009 and then click on OK



You then see the change.



Then click on File browser on the left.



You then go to the folder that has the videos you want. Click on one of them and drag it to the bottom.



Repeat with two other videos. Note – to drag, you left click and hold it down and then drag it and let go.



You can add buttons. Click on button tab and then click on a button and drag it to the right, like the arrow one.



Next is Burn to DVD.

- I will show you how to do it.


Next click on Burn in upper left


Once complete, you can Open the Disc with the VCL Media Player
