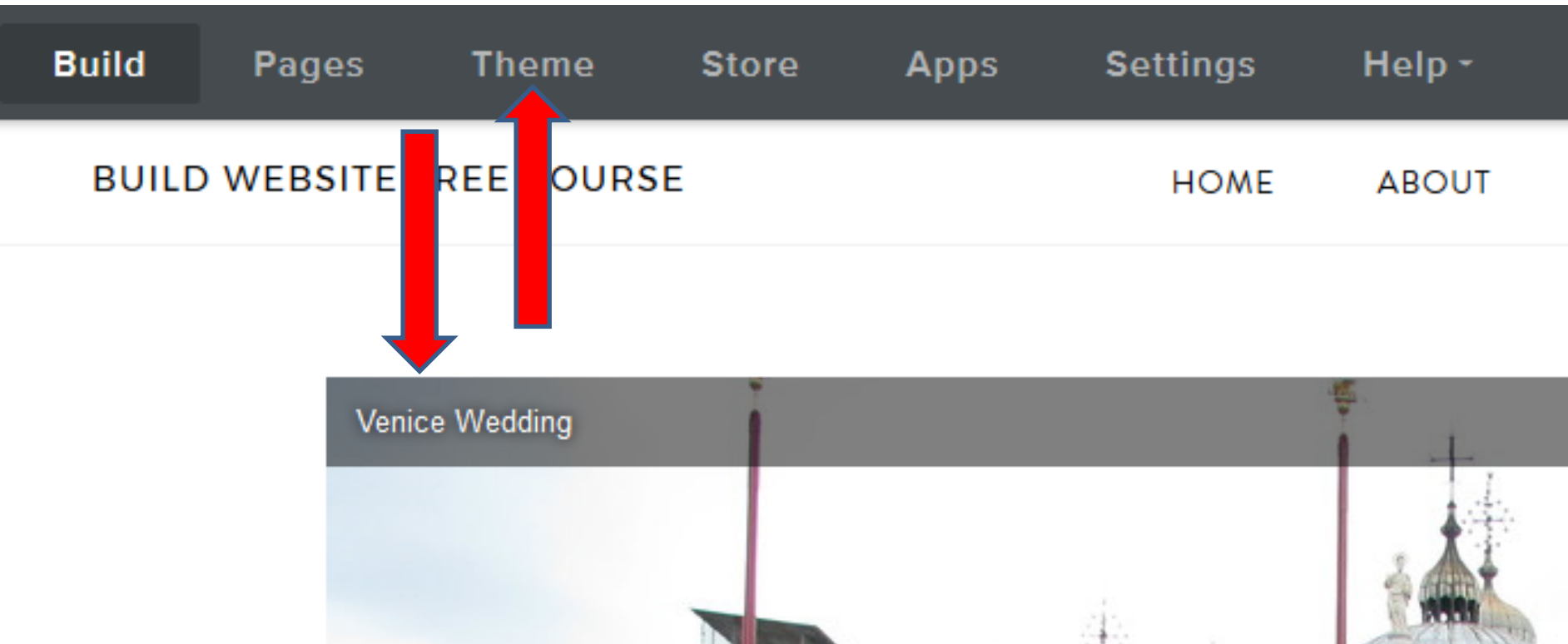

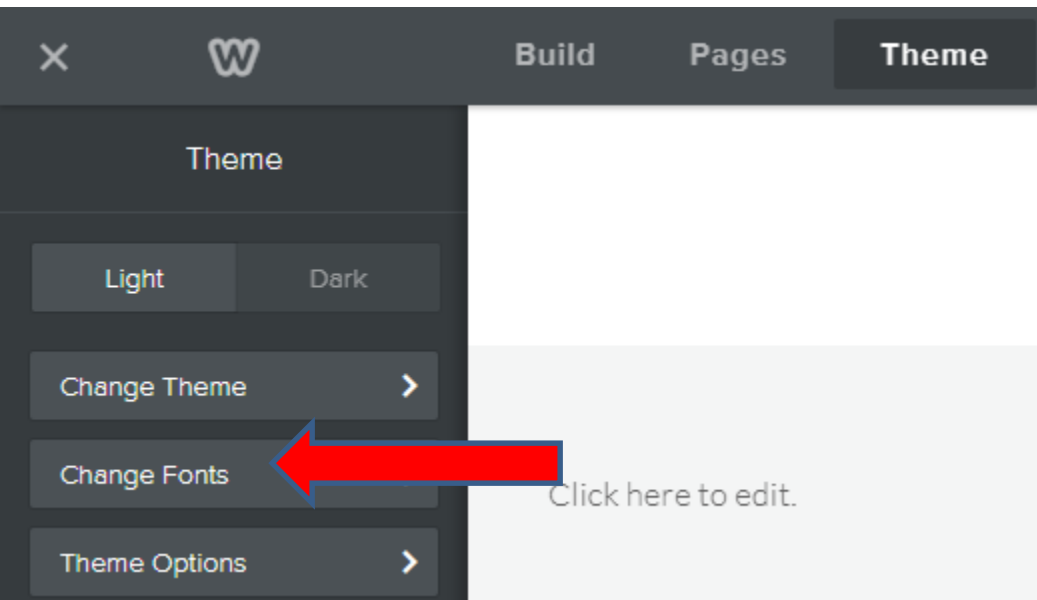
- You can put it on the Top vs. Bottom.
- Next is a sample.

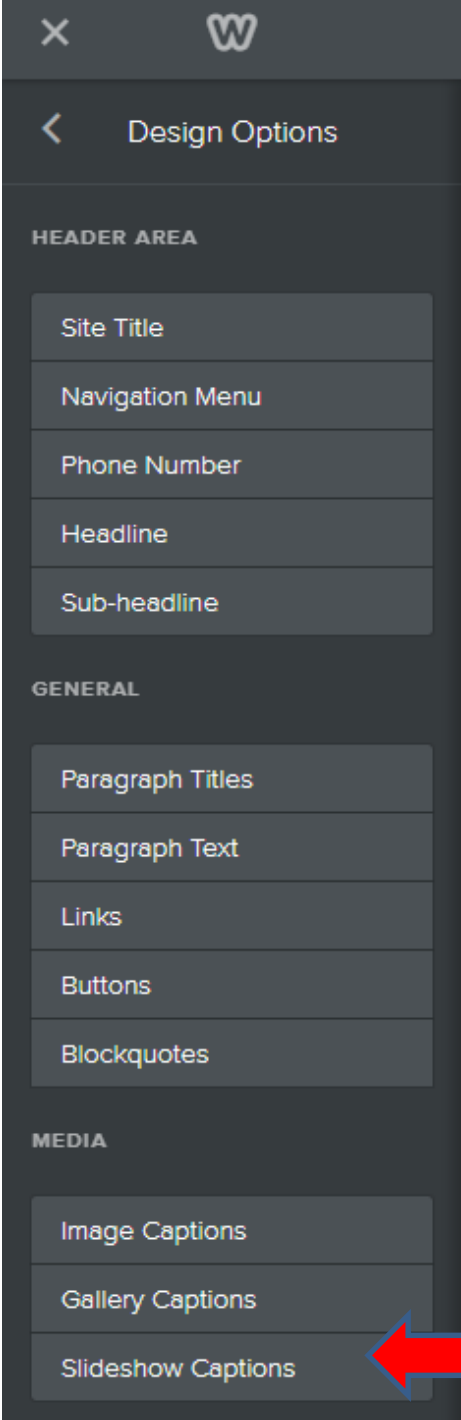
# You see it at the Top.

- Then click on Theme, as we did in Step 6 and next is to change the caption.



- **Once you click on Theme, click on Change Fonts again.**





- You then click on Slideshow Captions and follow the same process in Step 6.
- Next is a sample of making changes.

- Here is sample of changing Font to Lemon, Italic and change size to 23.
- You click on the Image in the slide show and next is Transition Style.

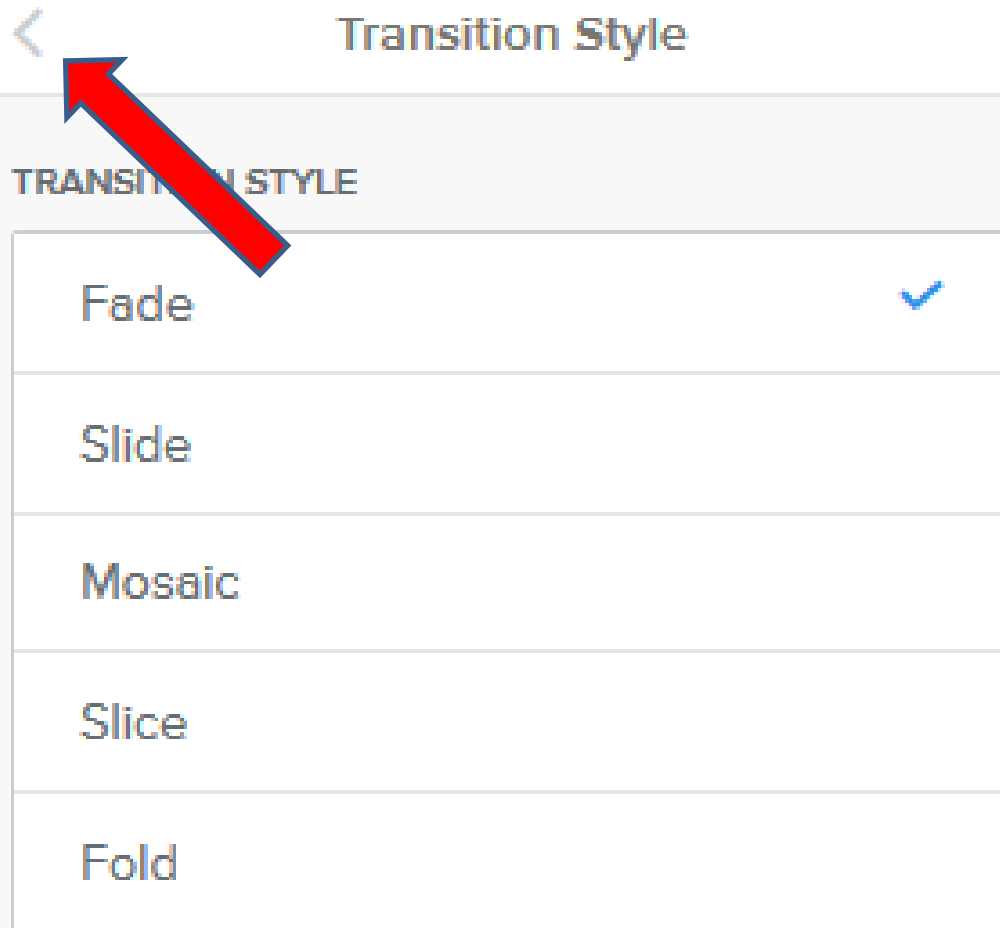

- Click on it and next is what happens.

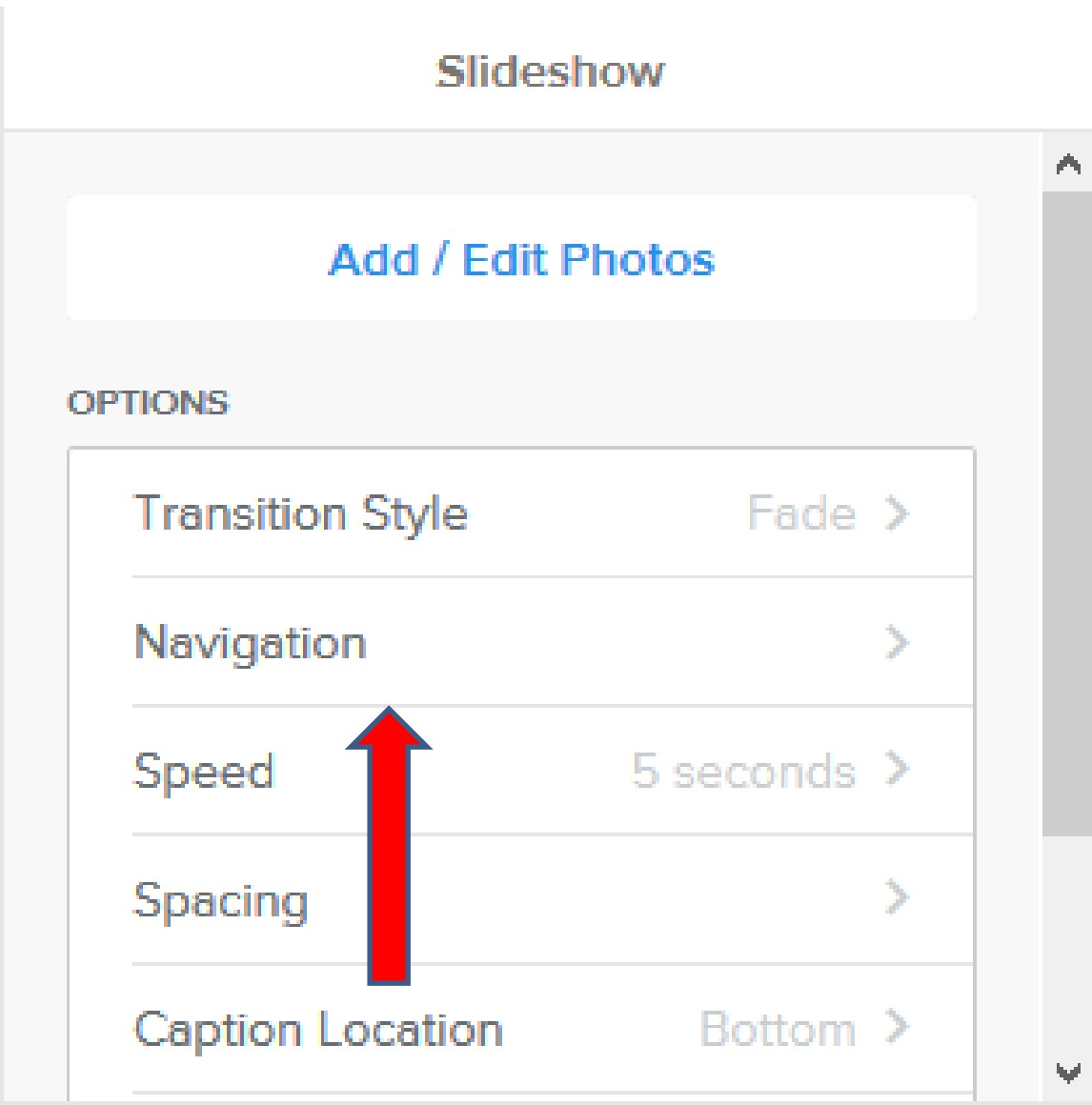


# Page changes and you see options



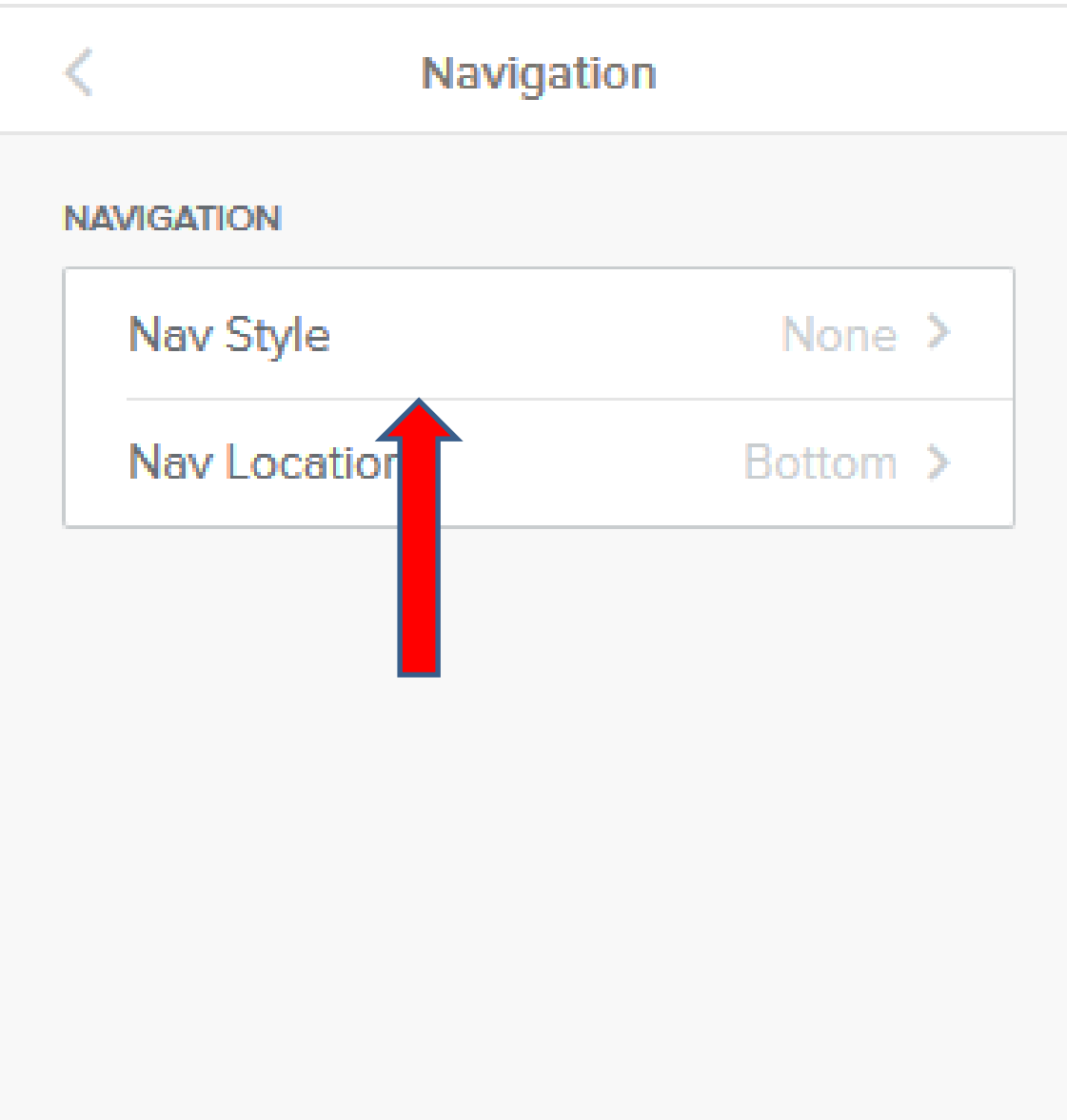
- When you select one, you see the slide style changes. Note – I can't show it, but you may want to try each one to see the difference.
- Once you finish, click on < to go back and next is Navigation.

# Navigation



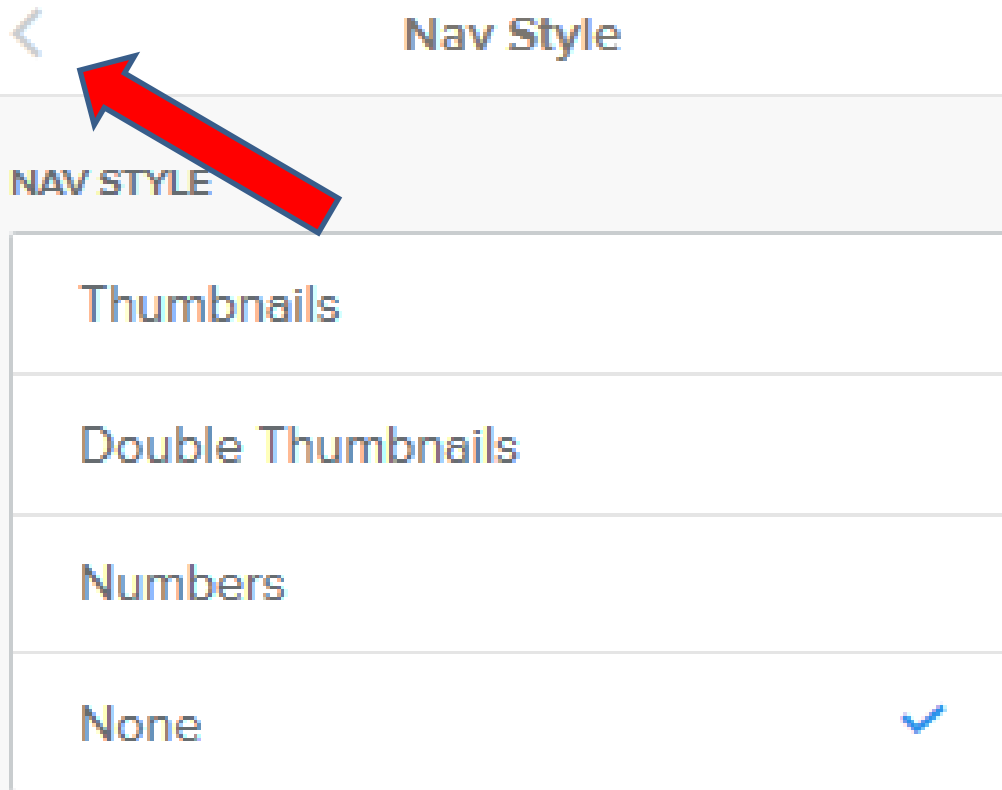
- Click on Navigation and next is what happens.

# Navigation



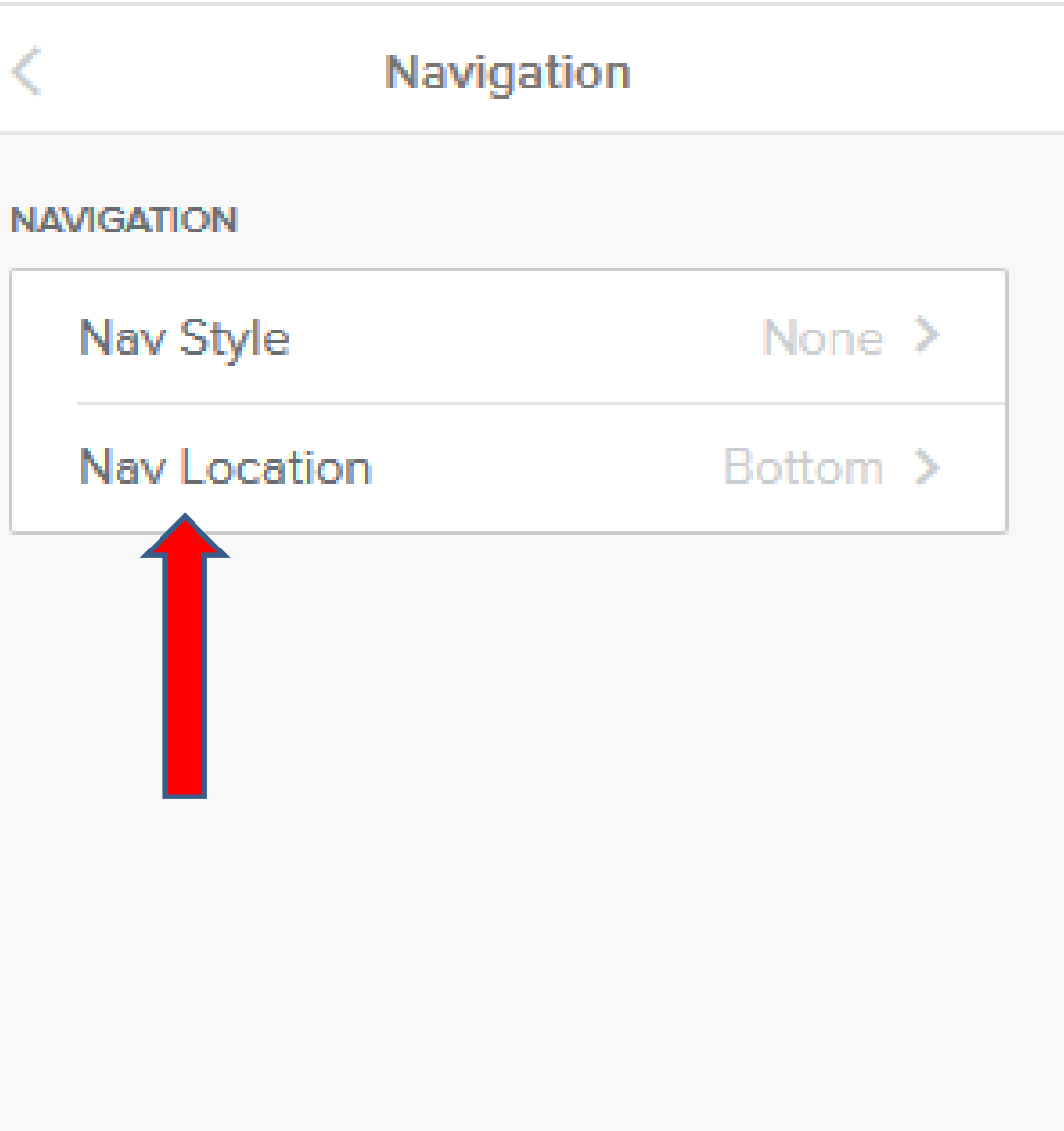
- Page changes and you see Nav Style and Nav Location.
- Click on Nav Style and next is what happens.

# Navigation



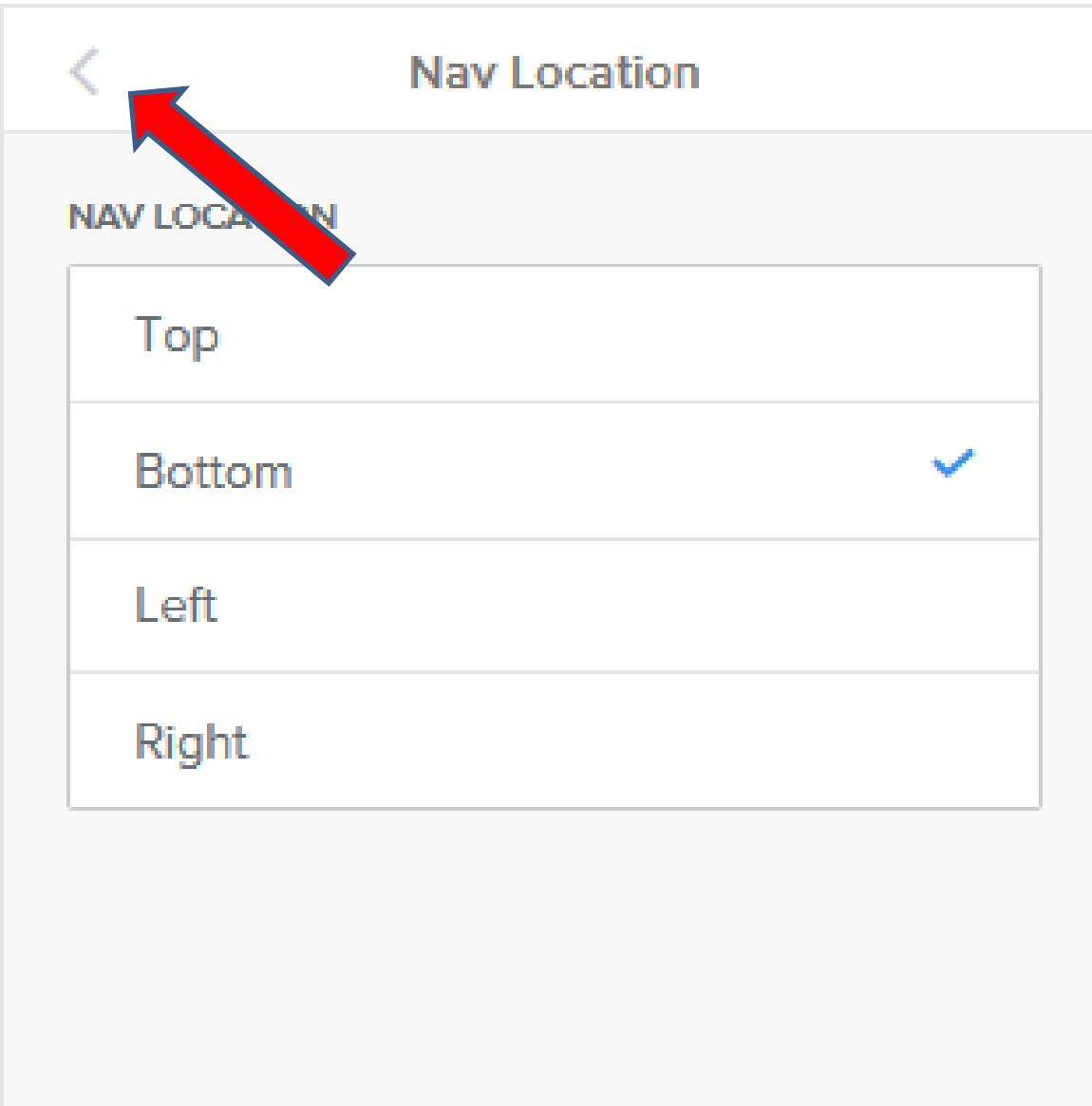
- Page changes and default is typically **None**.
- You see options, like showing **Thumbnails, Double Thumbnails, or Numbers**. You can test them.
- Click on **<** to go back to make other changes.

# Navigation



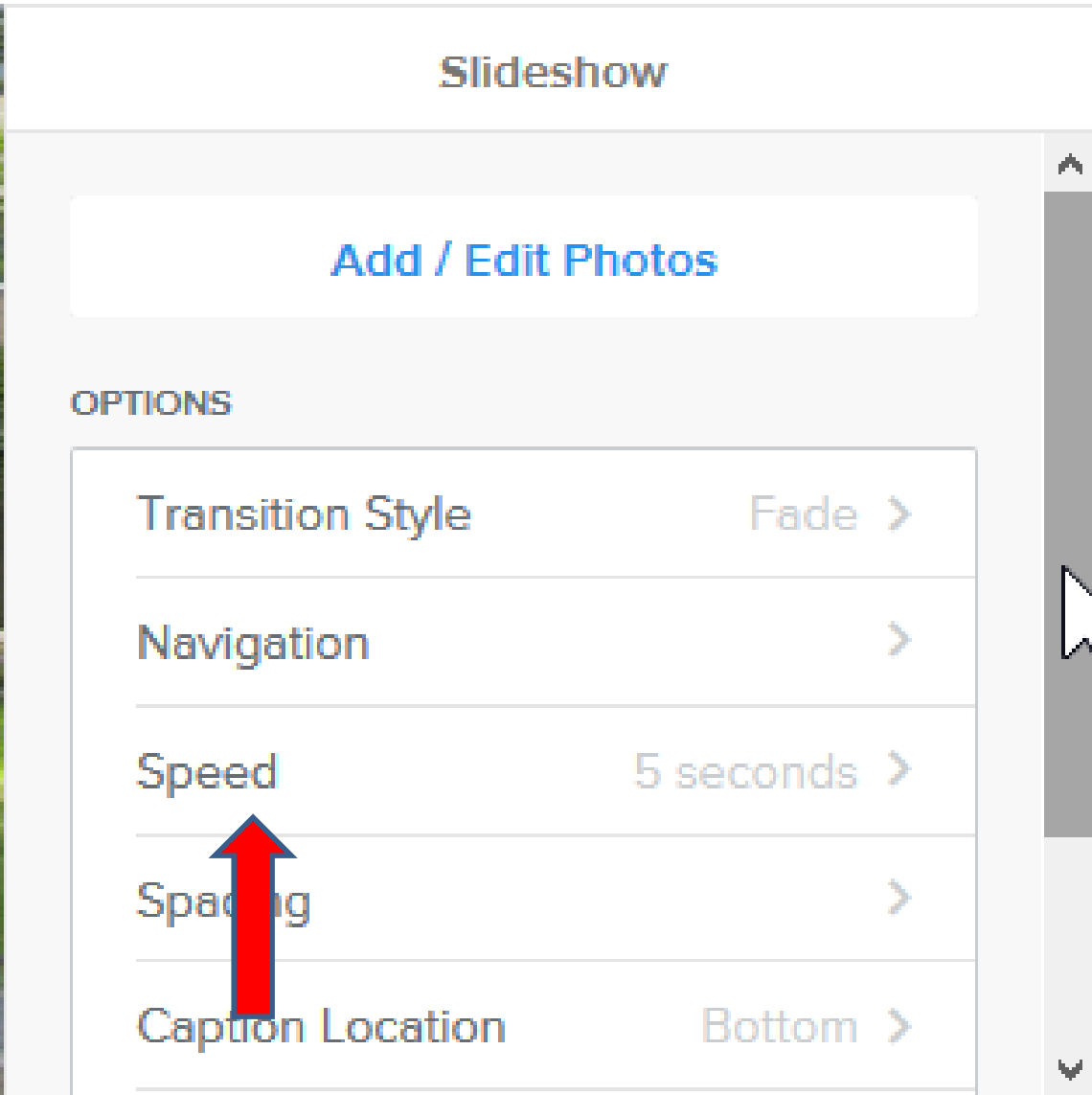
- Then click on Nav Location and next is what happens.

# Navigation



- Page changes and you see the options. Bottom is the default, which I recommend. You can test another one if you want.
- Click on < to go back and next is Speed.

# Speed



- When you click on Speed, it changes page and shows the Speed options, which is next.

- **Default is 5 seconds which I recommend.**
- **You can do 3 seconds or others and scroll down to 9 seconds.**
- **Go back again and next is Spacing.**

- Scroll down to see Advanced.
- When you click on Advanced, it changes page and shows the Other options, which is next.
- Note – I recommend you don't make changes.

- You can turn Autoplay off.
- You can turn Show Controls to no.
- You can change Starting Position from Beginning to Random.
- You can change Aspect Ratio, which is size of Slide Show.
