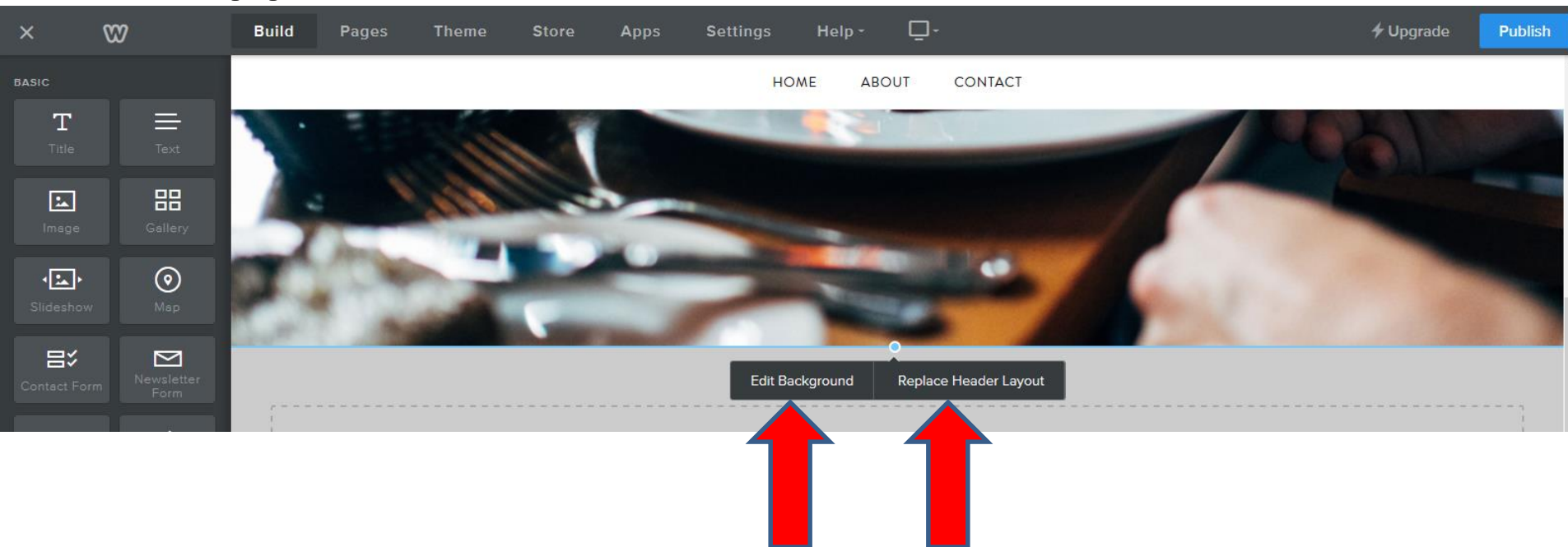


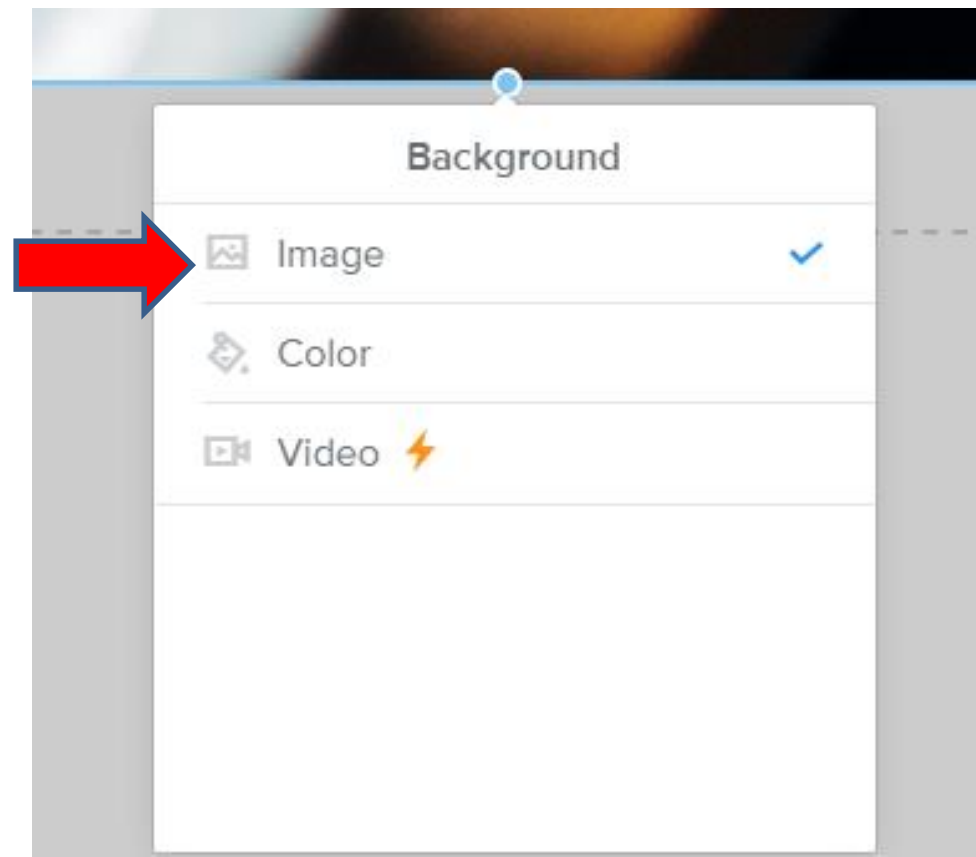
Step 3 – Layout – Part 3 – Edit Header

- I will show you how to change Background on the Header with another image. I will also show you how to Edit the image.**
- After that I will also how to change the size of the Header.**
- Last, I will show you how to change Background Color vs. image.**

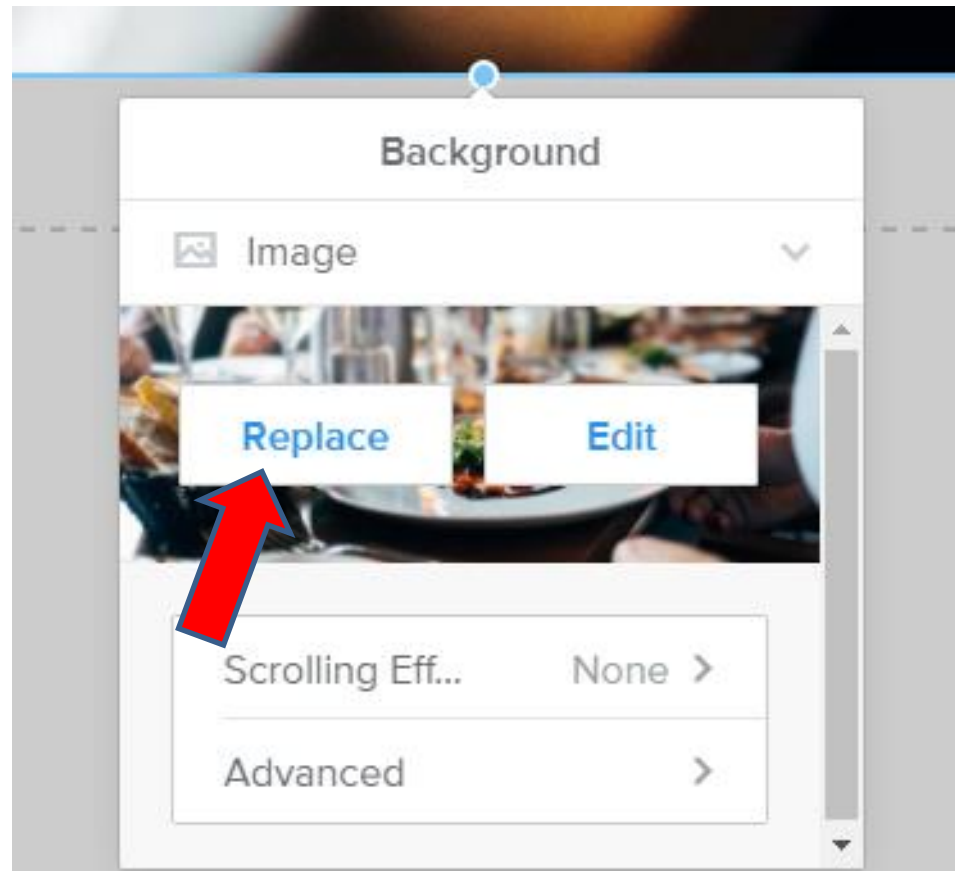
- If you don't see the bottom of the Header you have to scroll down and then click on it.
- Once you click on it, you see Edit Background and Replace Header Layout.
- Next click on Edit Background, which is what happens.



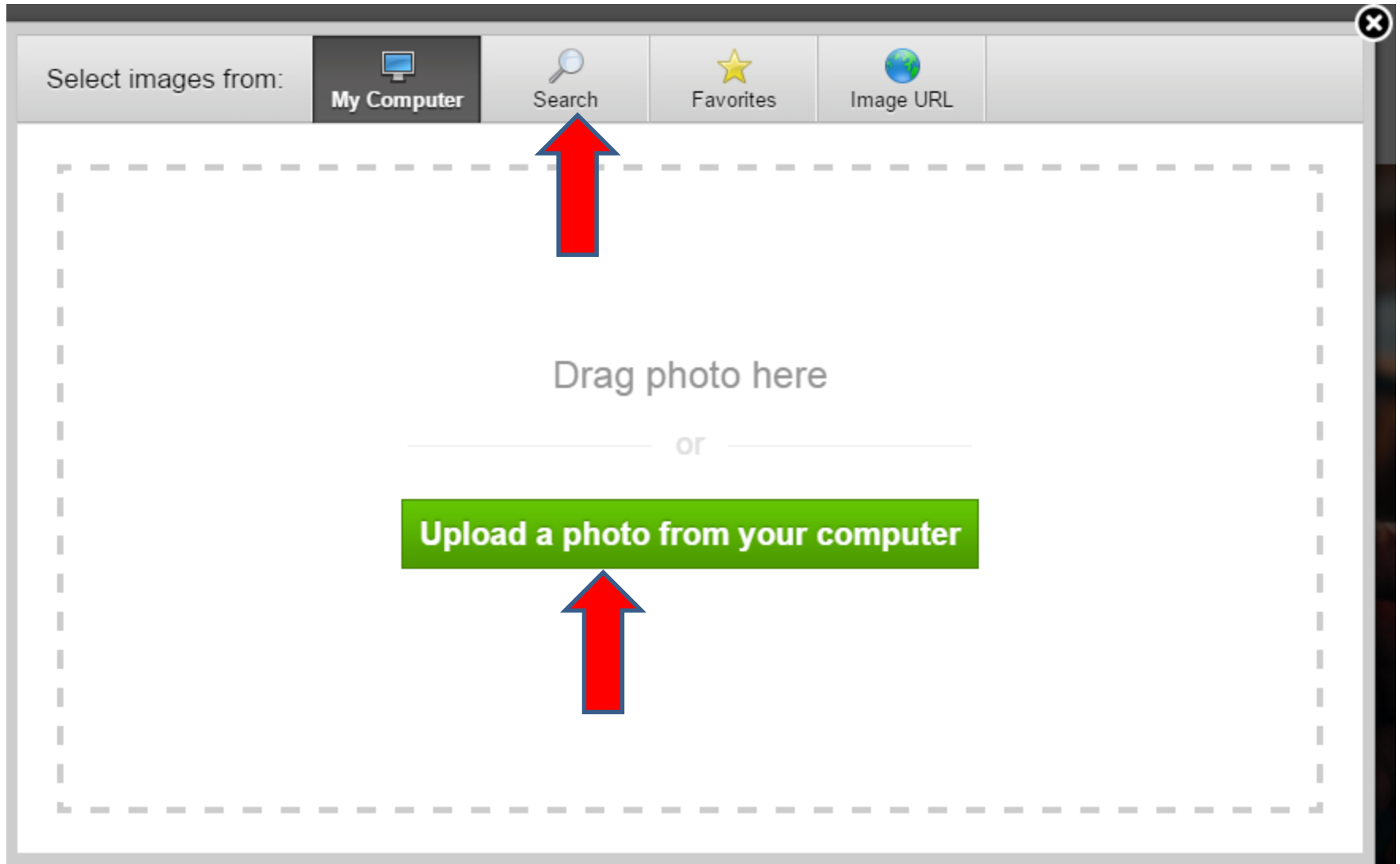
- **When you click on it, a new Window opens with 3 options.**
- **You have to have a Pro Version to do Video.**
- **First click on Image and next is what happens.**



- **Window changes and you see Edit options and I will show later.**
- **First click on Replace. Next is what happens.**

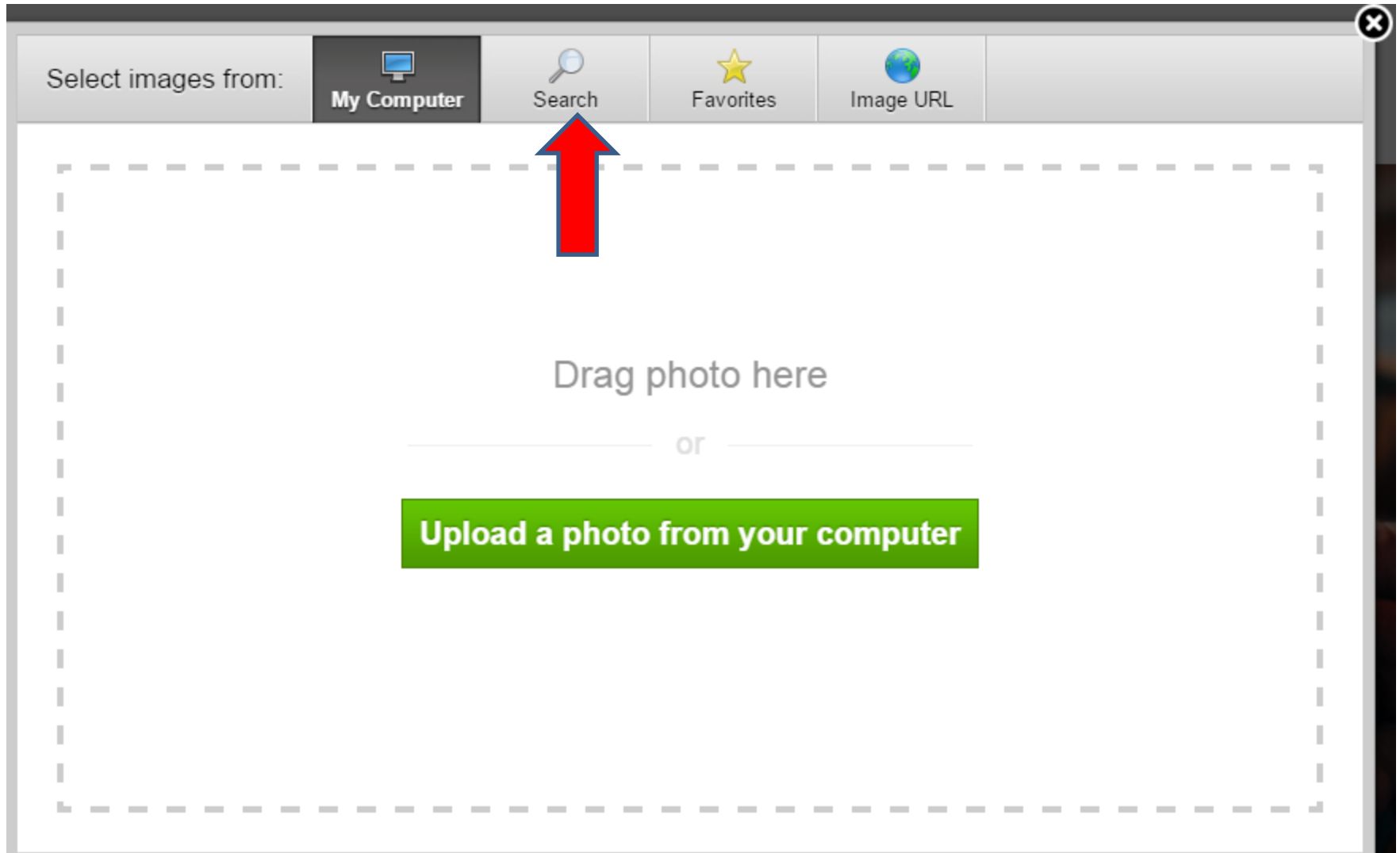


- **New Window opens and you have two options. You can Upload a photo from your computer. The second option is Search, next explains them.**

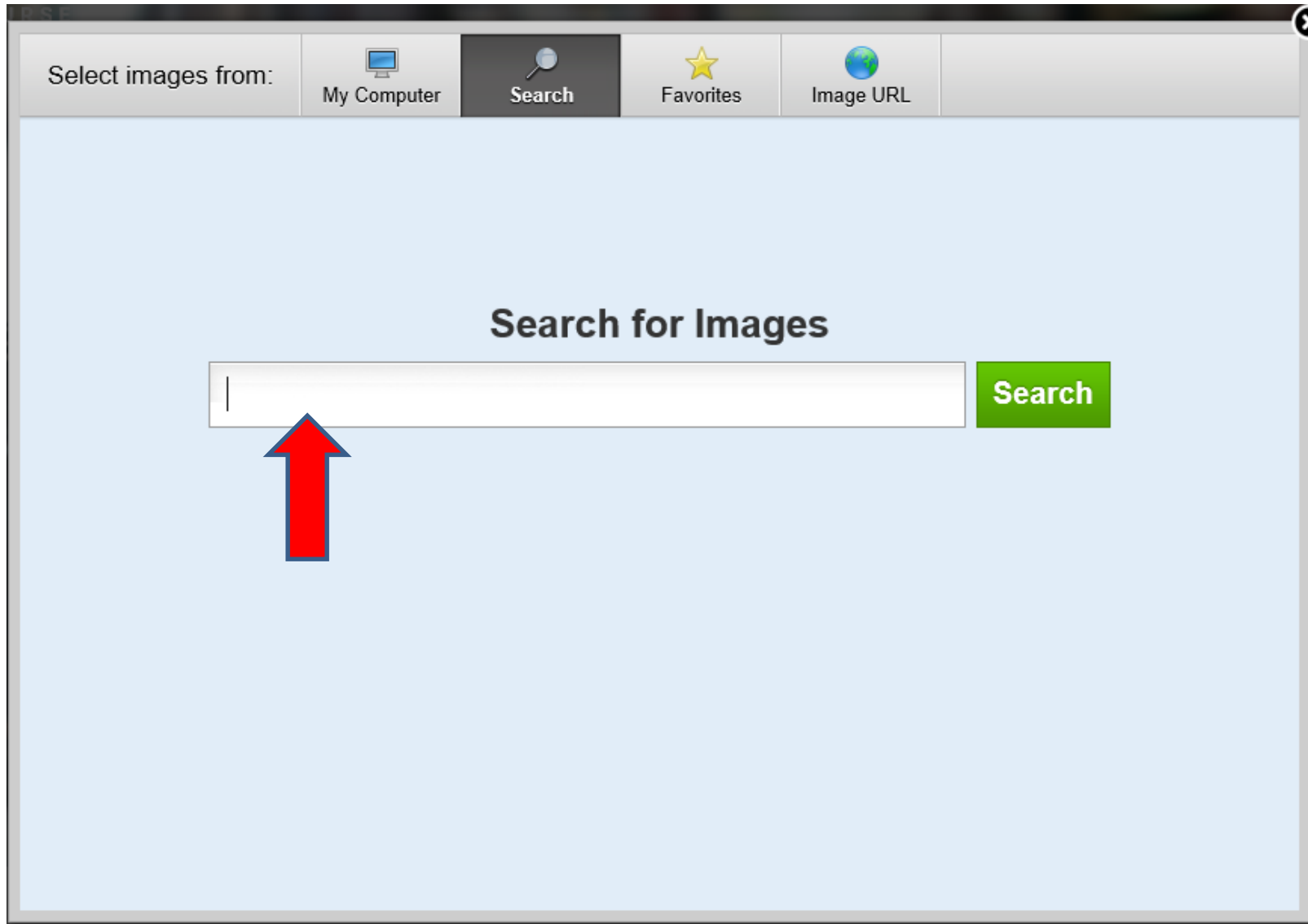


- **If you have a Photo on your computer that you want to add to the header, you click on Upload a photo from your computer.**
- **If you don't have a photo on your computer, you can click on Search. Once you Search, it shows on-line Photos that you can select.**
- **The third option is close the window and it shows you other Background images that you can select.**
- **First I will show you search.**

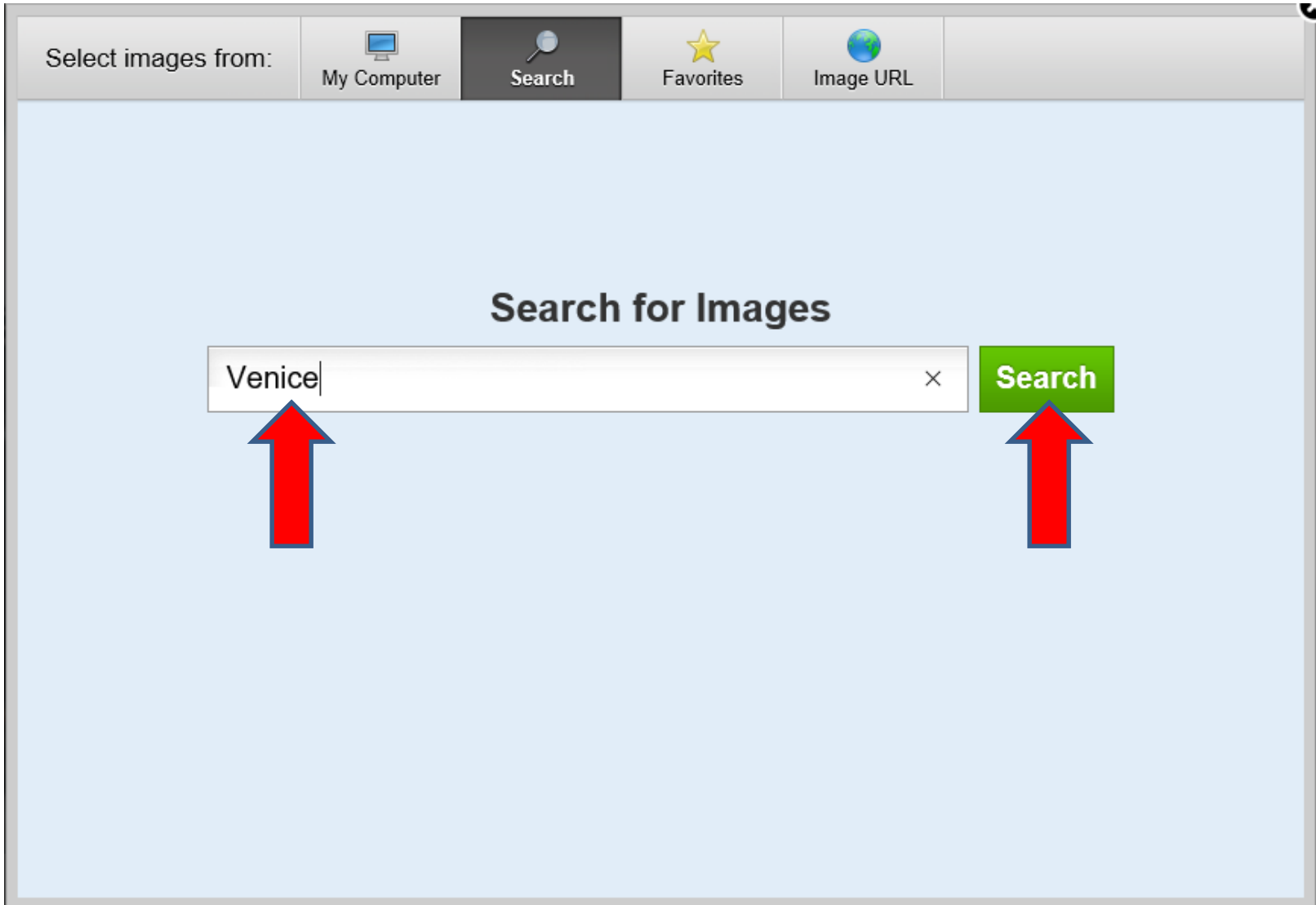
- You click on Search and next is what happens.







- **Window changes and you type in for search, like Venice and next is a sample.**




- Here is a sample. Once complete, click on Search.
- Next is what happens.



- You see a list of Professional Photos. I recommend you click on Free Photos and Next is what happens.

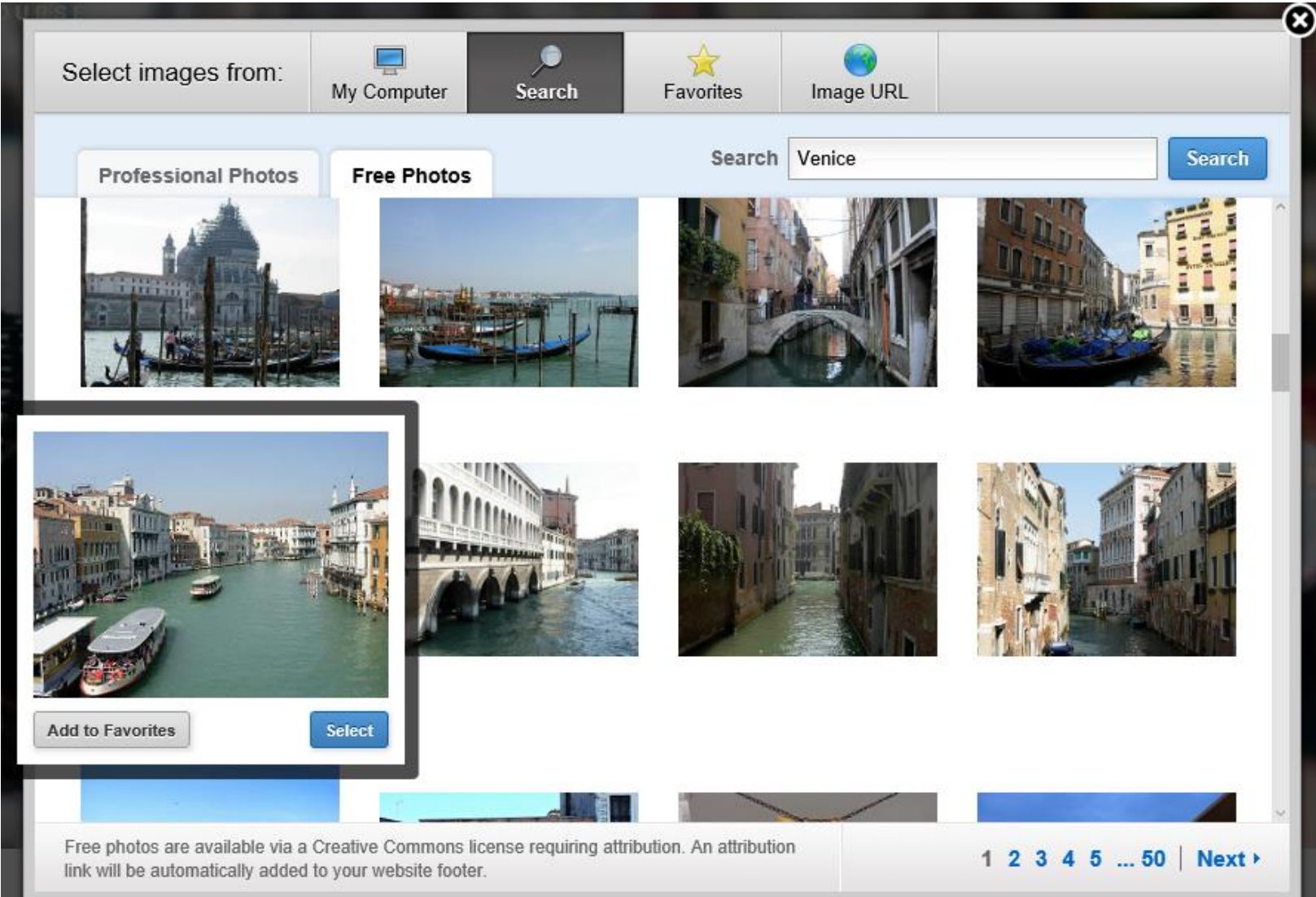

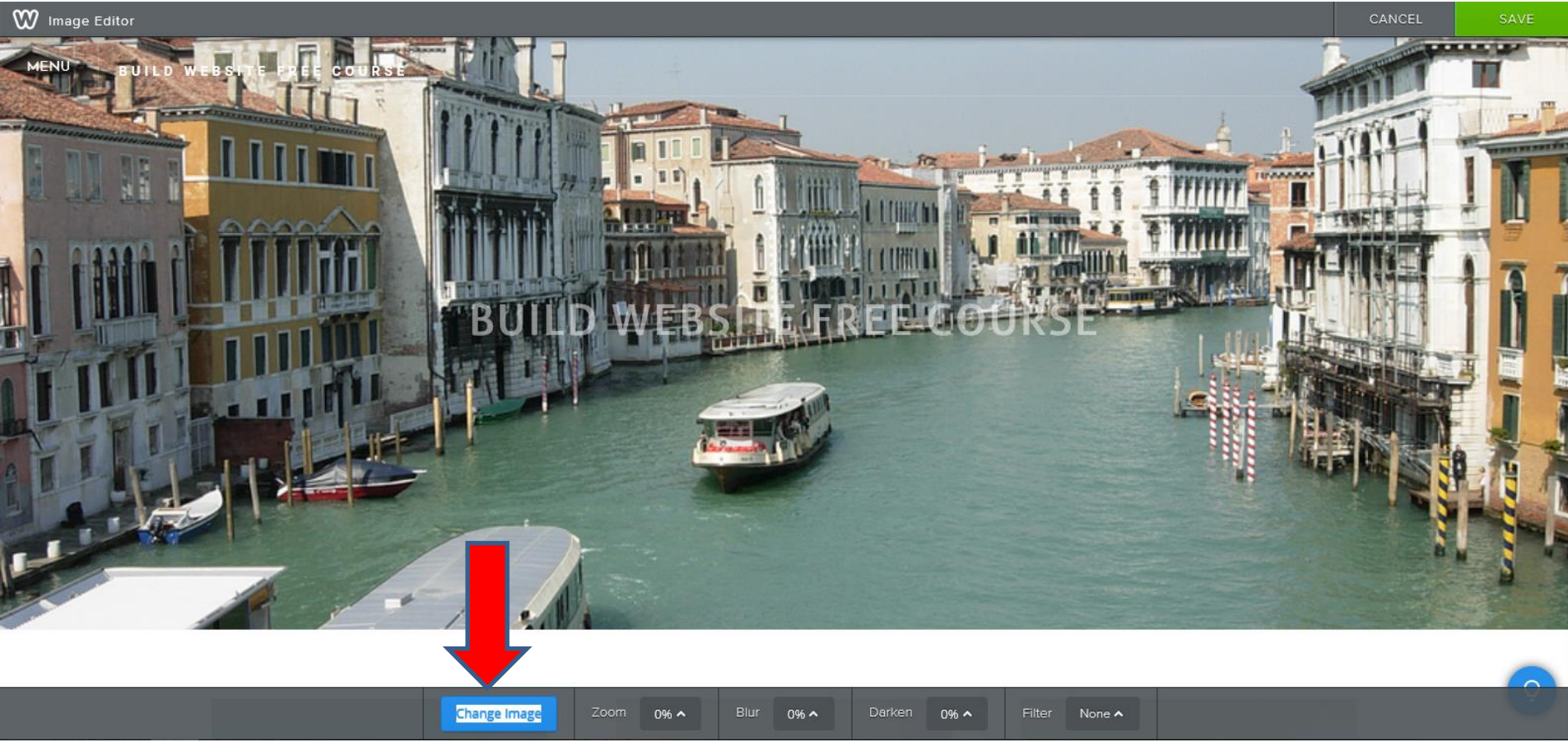
- You then see a list of Free Photos. Next is a sample when you find one and hover over it.

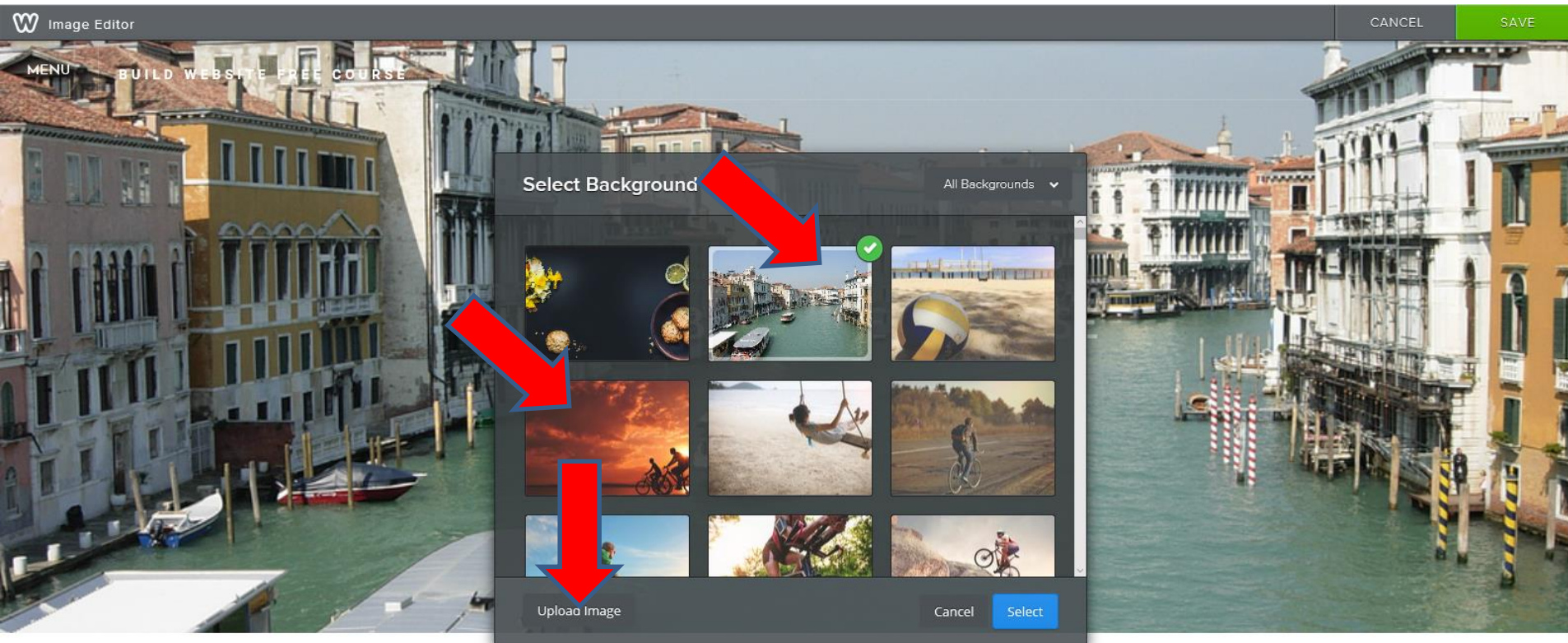
- Here is a sample when you hover over it. A new window opens and you click on Select. Next is what happens.



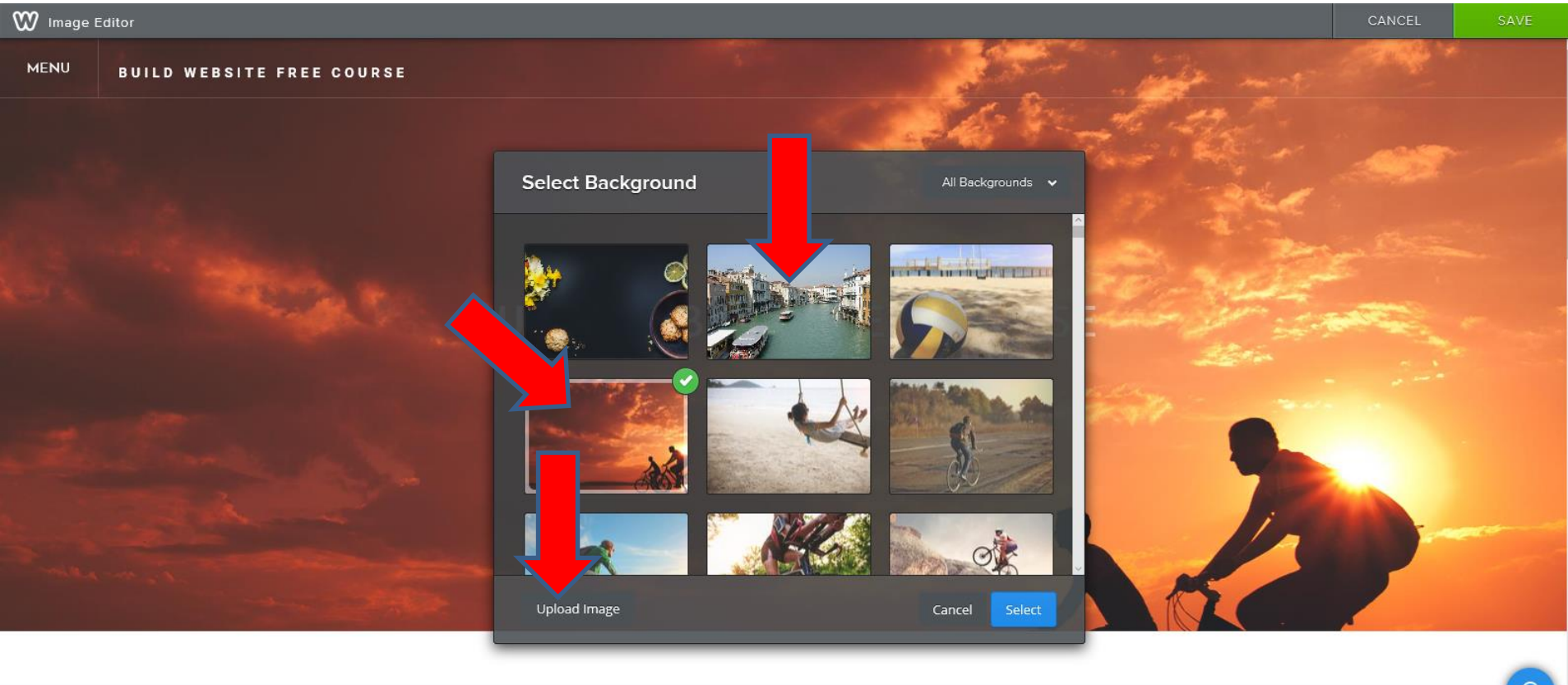
- **Window in the middle closes and you see the Photo. If you don't like it, you can click on Change Image at the bottom. Next is what happens.**



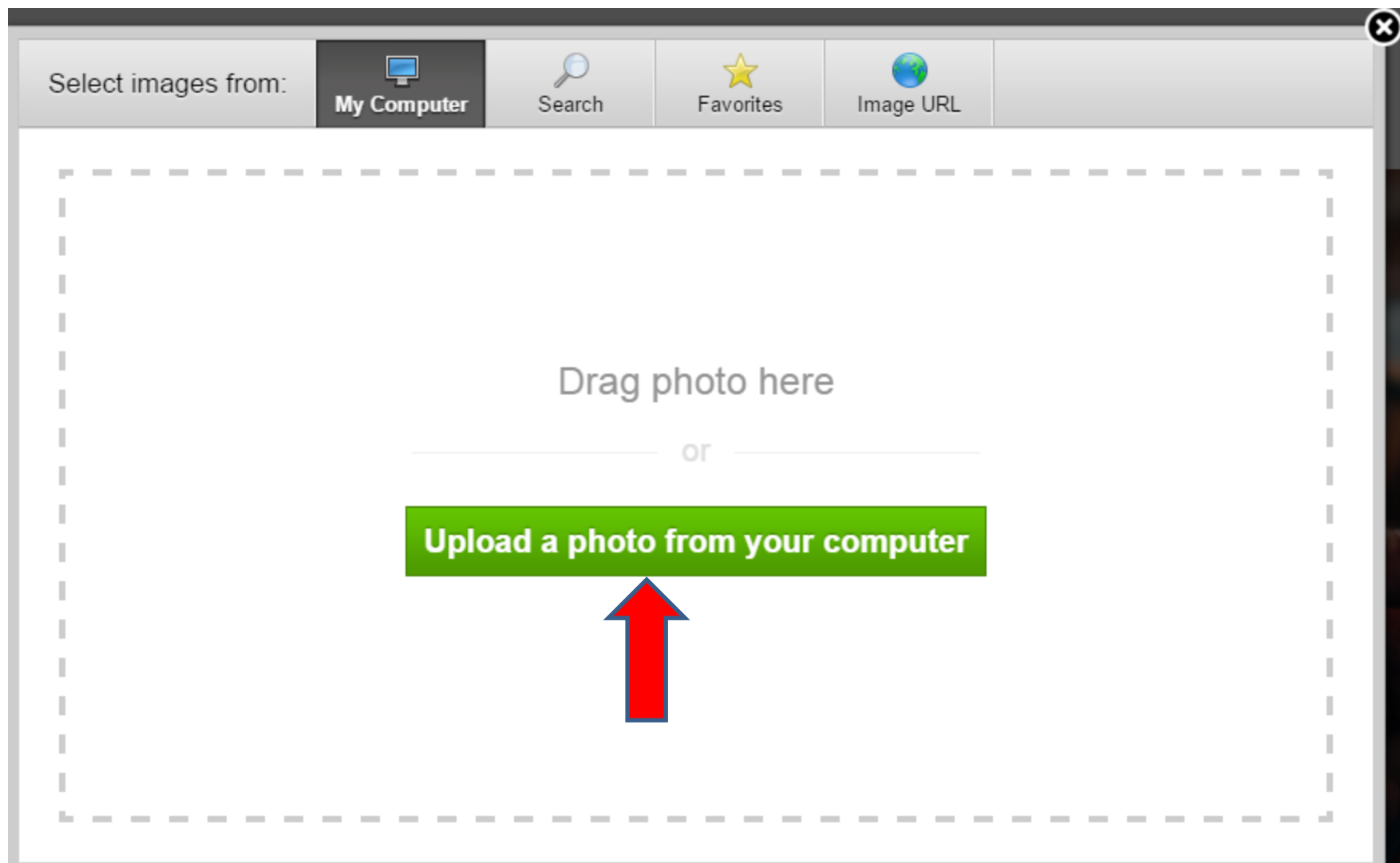
- **Window in the middle opens and you see the Photo highlighted. You can select another one in the Window or you can Upload Image. Next is a sample of clicking on another one as I showed you in the course.**



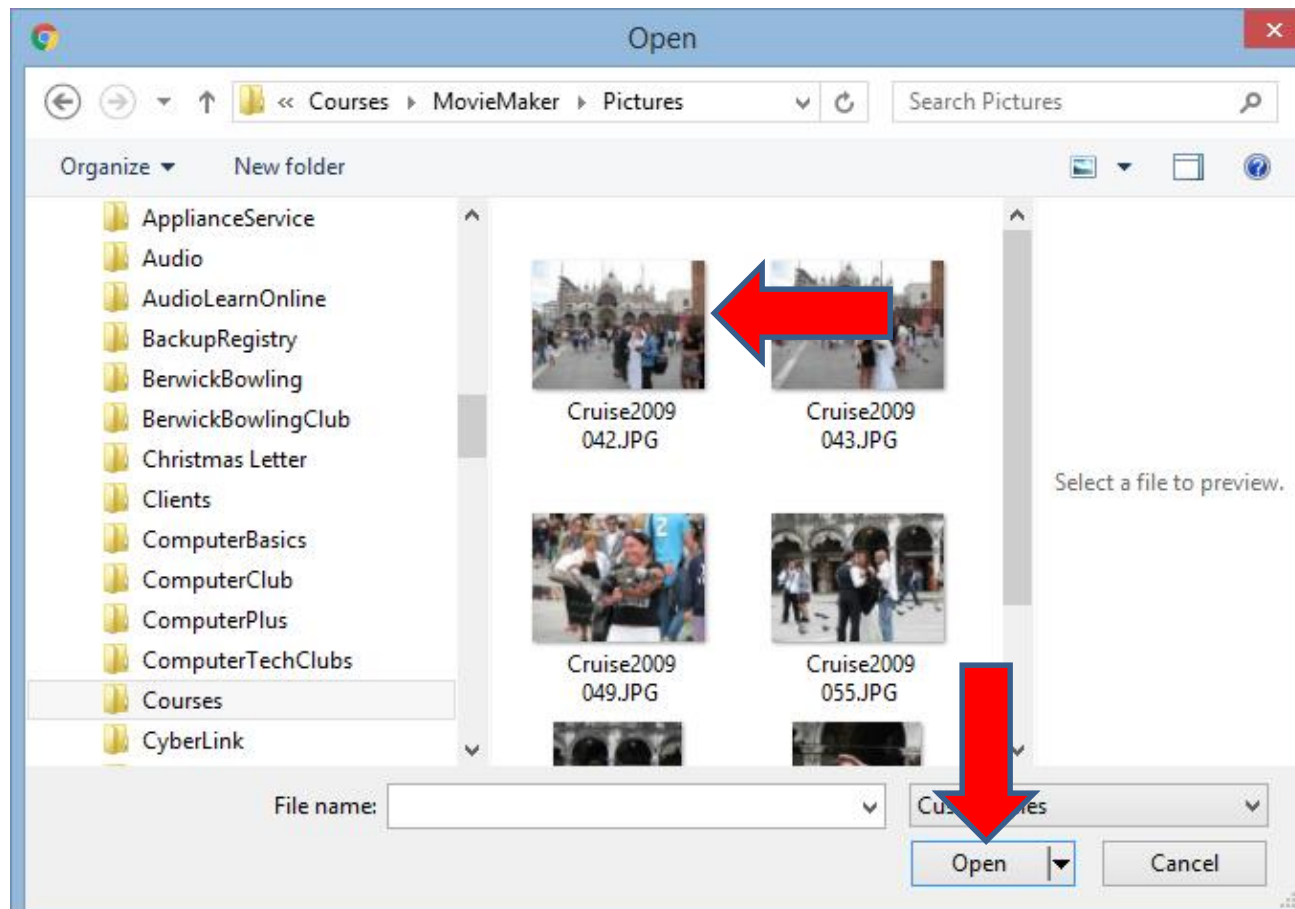
- Here is a sample of clicking on another one and you see it highlighted. You can always click on the one you uploaded.
- If you have a Photo on your computer that you want, click on Upload Image. Next is what happens.



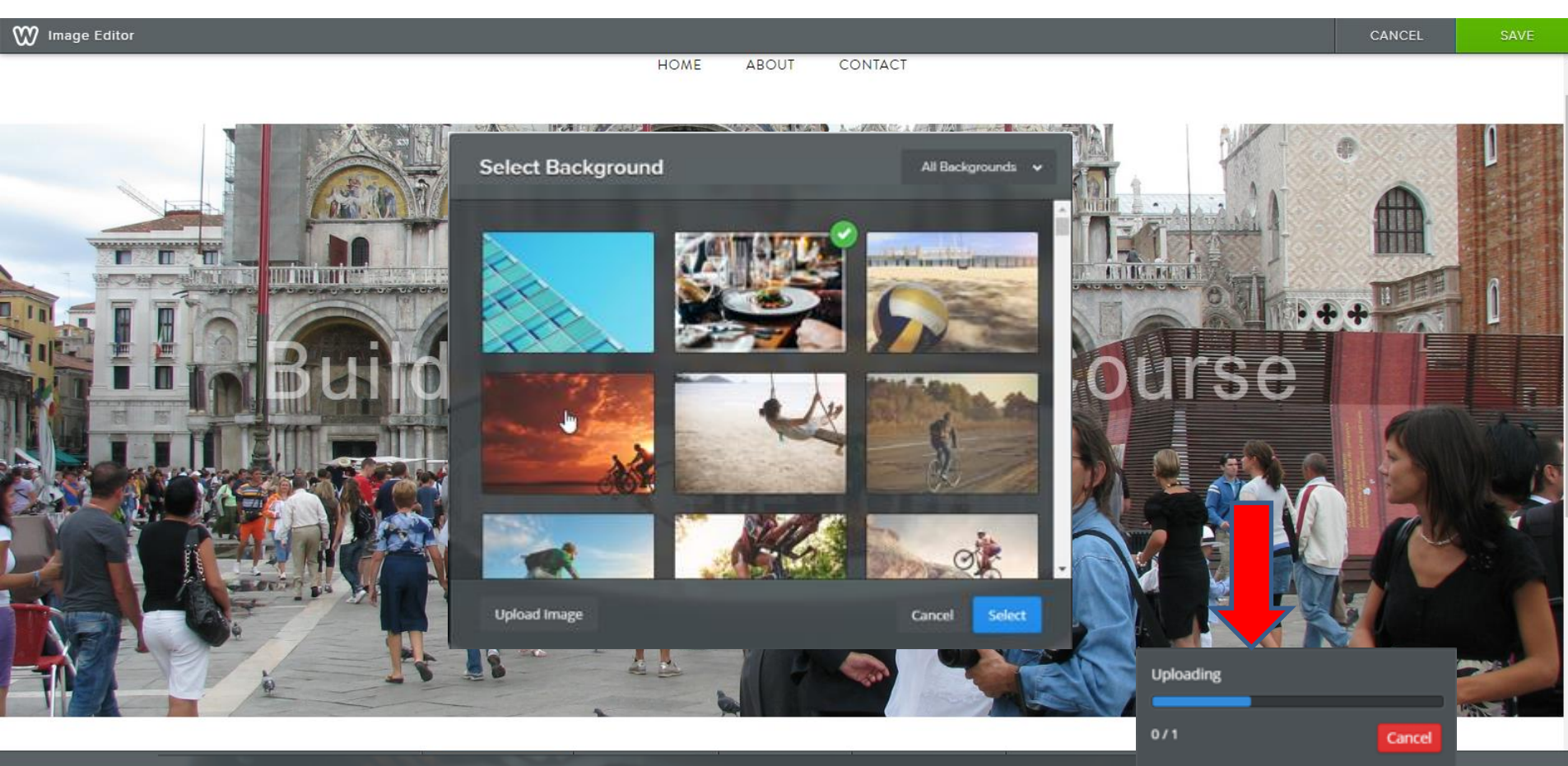
- **New Window opens and click on Upload a photo from your computer.**
- **Next is what happens.**



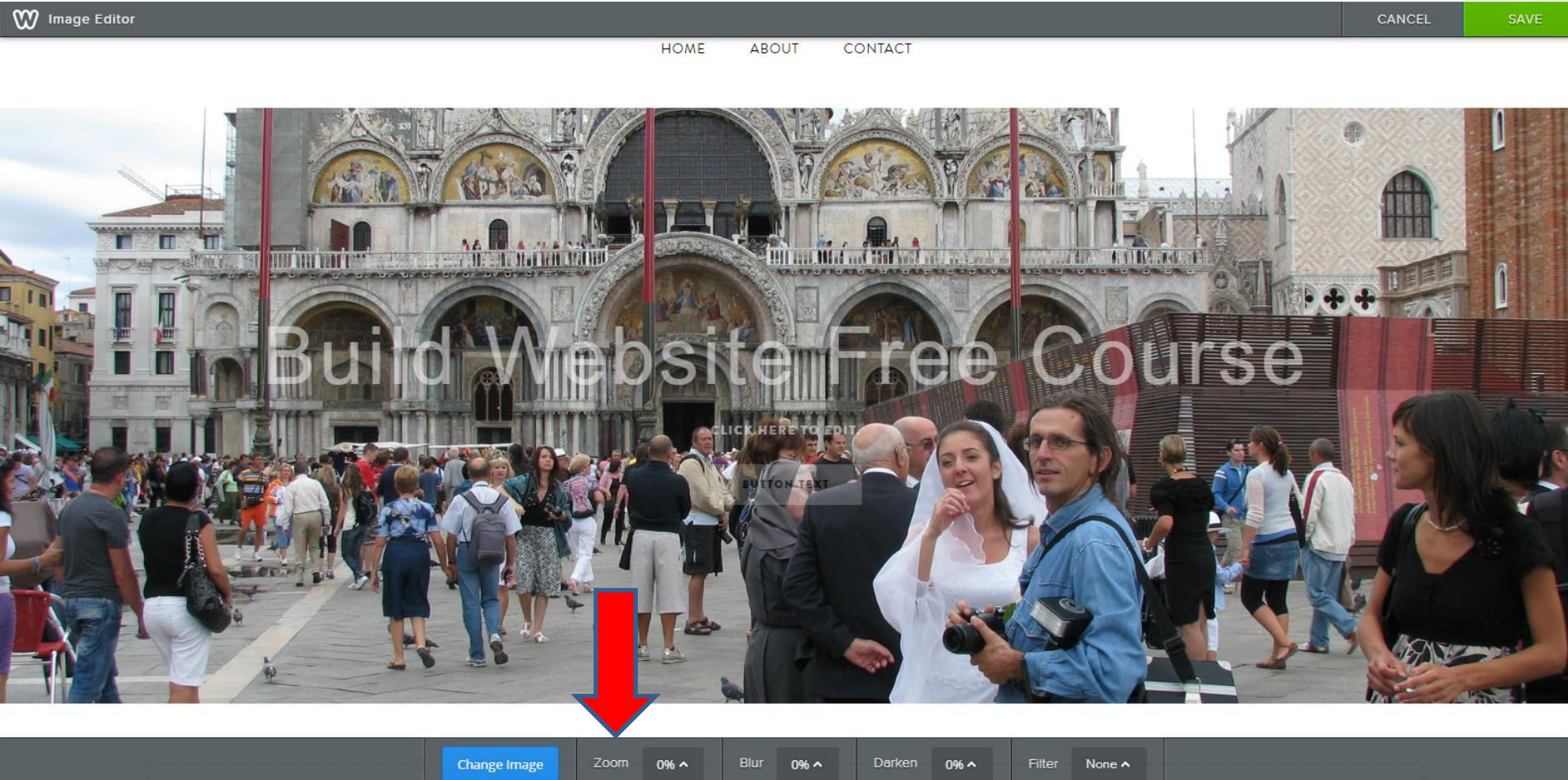
- **File Explorer opens. Find the folder with a Photo you want. Click on one and then click on Open. Next is what happens with my Photo.**



- You see it Uploading in the lower right.
- Next is what happens when it is complete.



- Once complete you see it and at the bottom you see Edit options.
- Next I will show you the Edit Options.



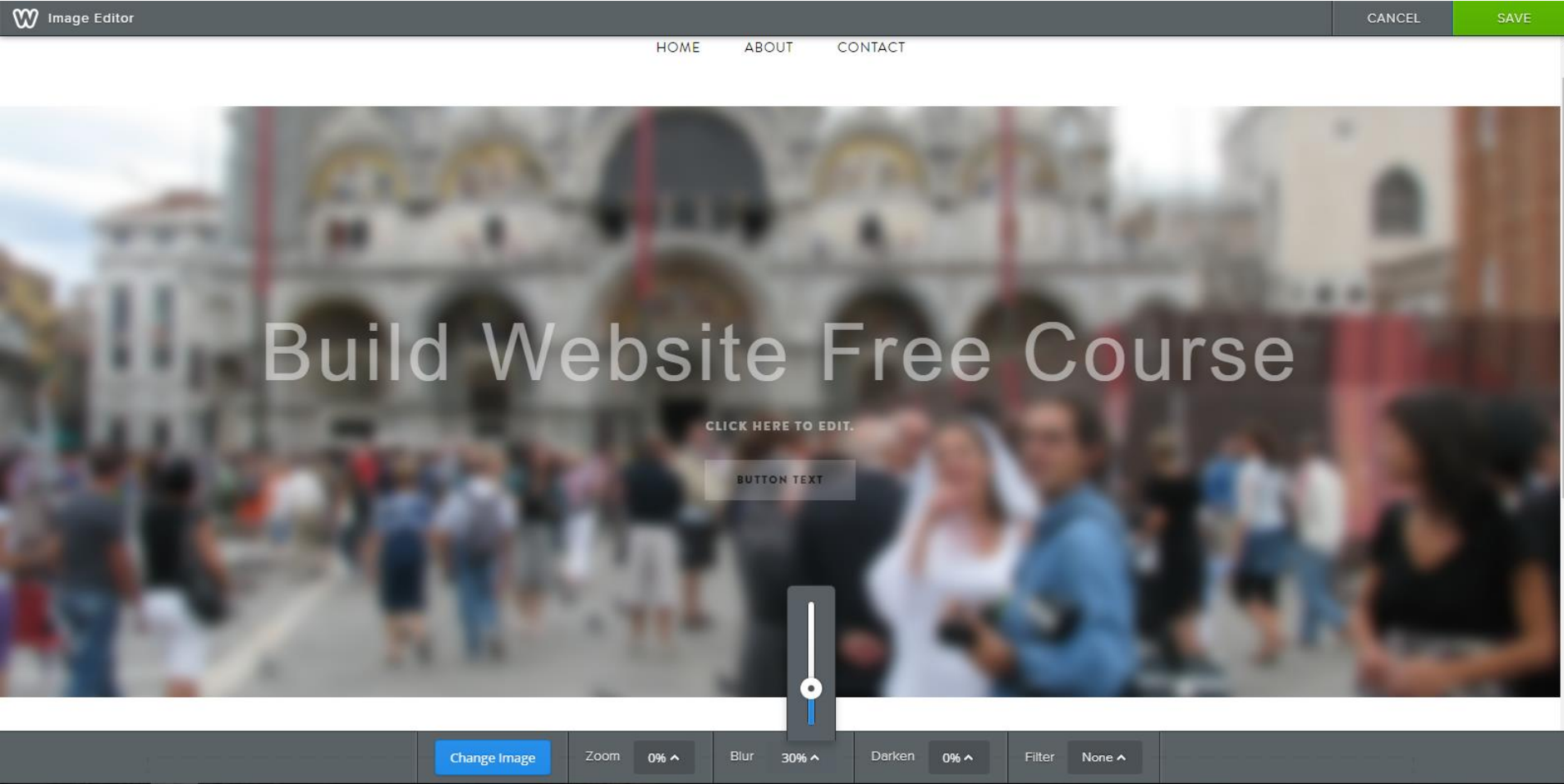
- You can Change Image, same process as before.
- You can Zoom.
- You can Blur.
- You can Darken.
- You can Filter.
- I will show you samples and you can practice if you want.



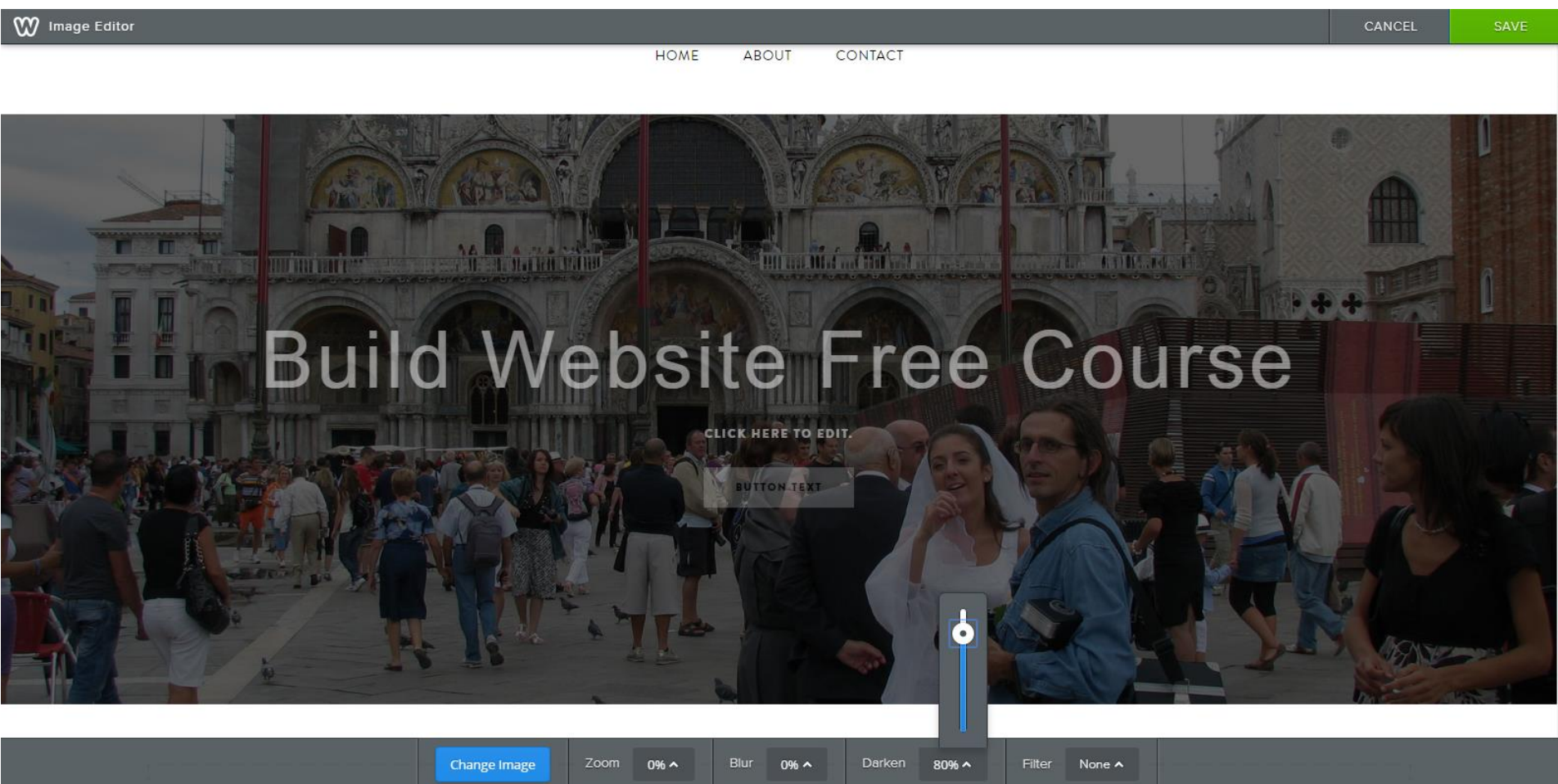
- Here is a Zoom sample of 100%.
- Next is Blur and I changed Zoom back to 0%

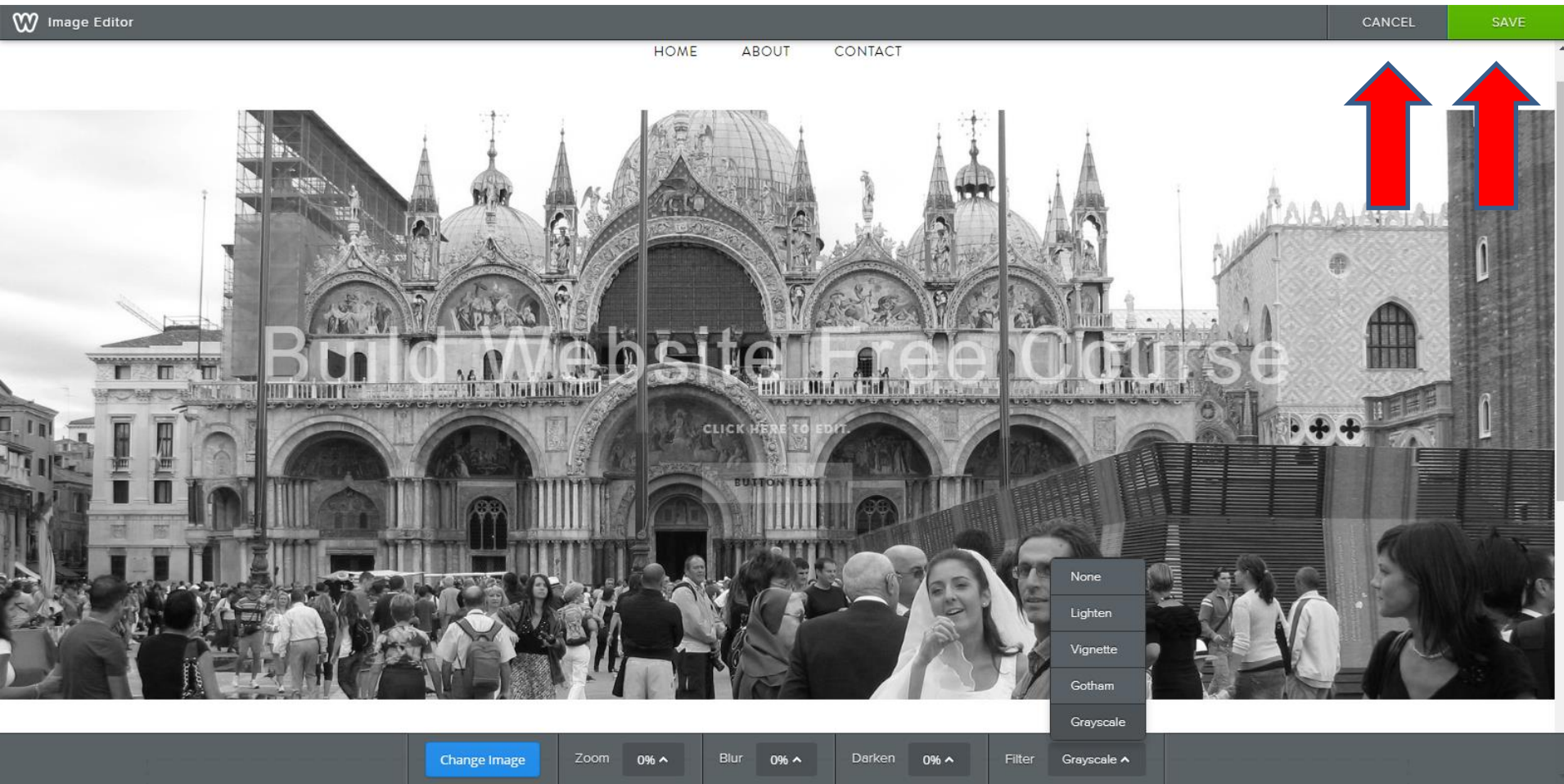
- Here is a Blur sample of 30%. Note – I don't like doing it.
- Next is Darken and I changed Blur back to 0%



- Here is a Darken sample of 80%. Note – It works if the Photo is light.
- Next is Filter and I changed Darken back to 0%




- Here is a Filter sample of Grayscale. It works like black and white and I changed Darken to 0. Once complete, you click on Save in the upper right or you can Cancel next to it. Next is Save.

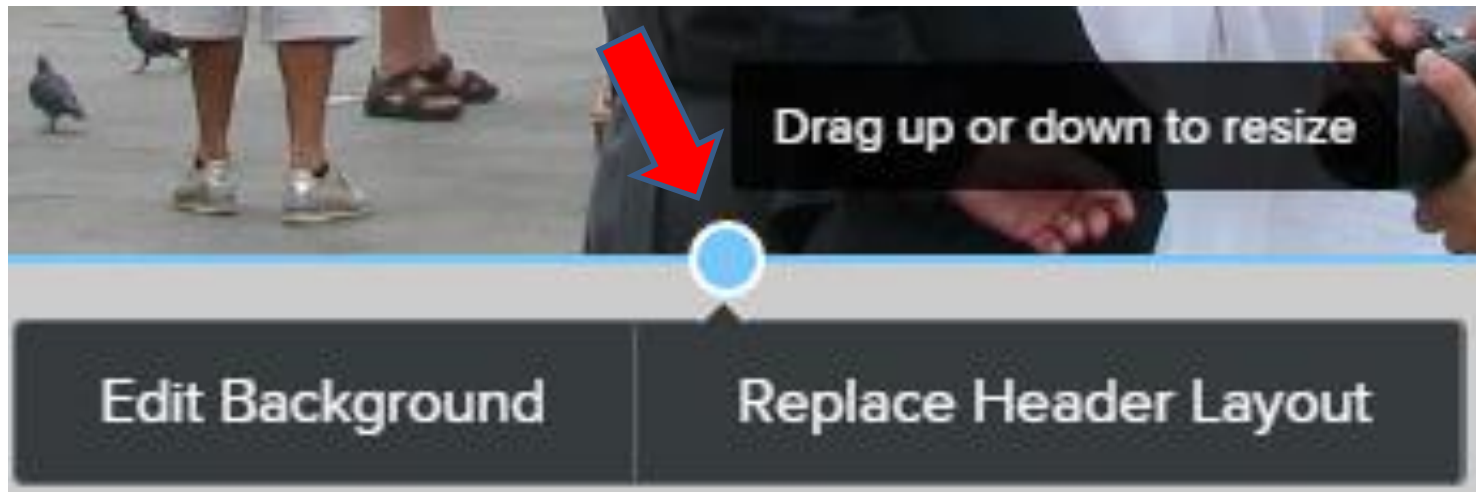


- You see it on the Build tab. Note - I changed Filter back to None.
- Next I will show you how to make it smaller.

- Next it is smaller when you delete them.

- When you hover over **CLICK HERE TO EDIT** you see **X** in the right to delete it. When you do that it asks you to confirm it.
- Next it is smaller when you delete the first one.



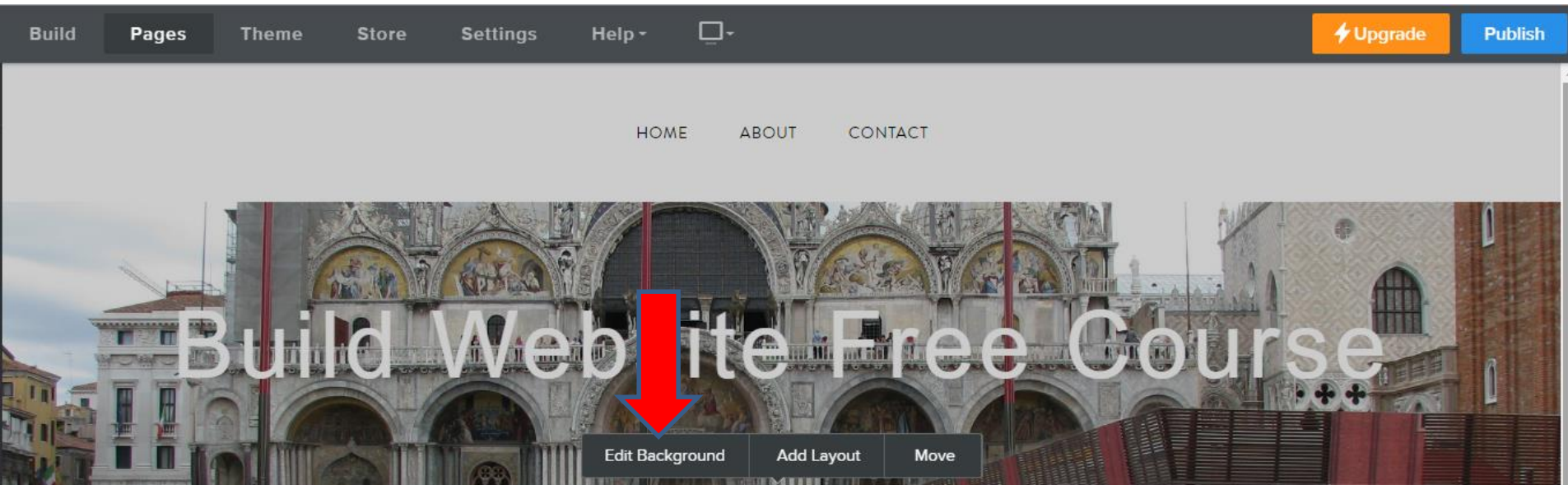
- You see it smaller. When you hover over **BUTTON TEST** you see **X** again in the right to delete it. When you do that it asks you to confirm it.
- Next it is smaller when you delete it.



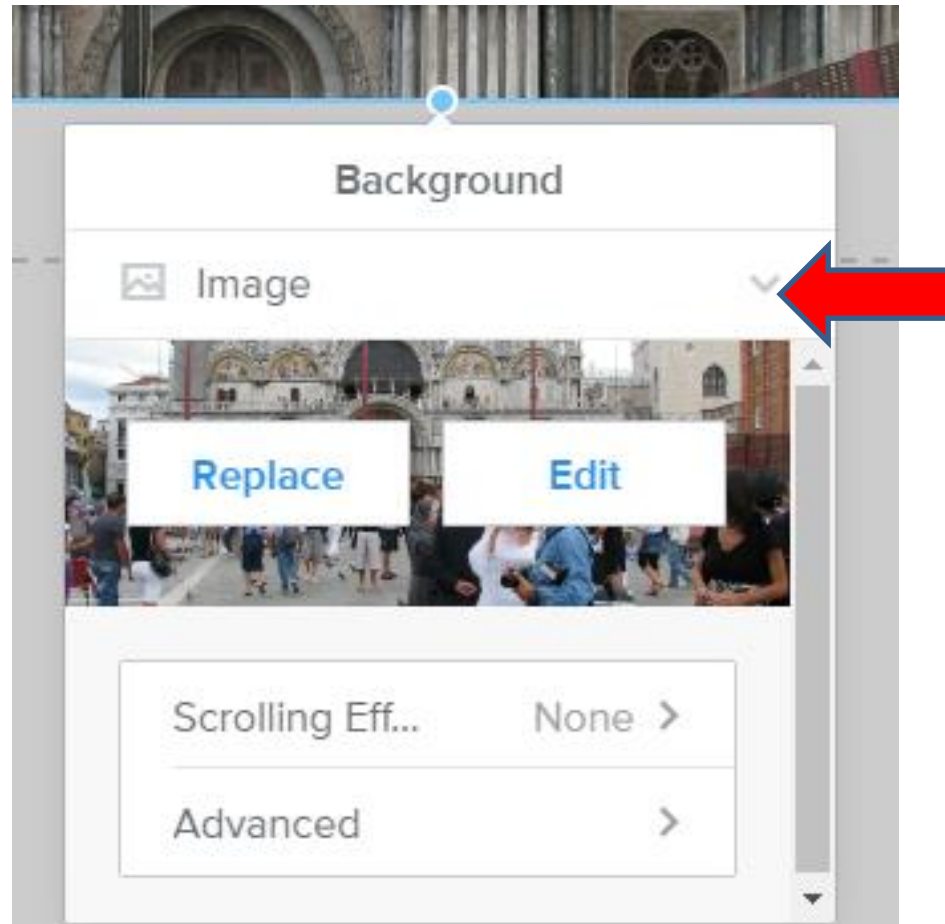
- You see it smaller.
- Next is to change background with Color vs. Image.

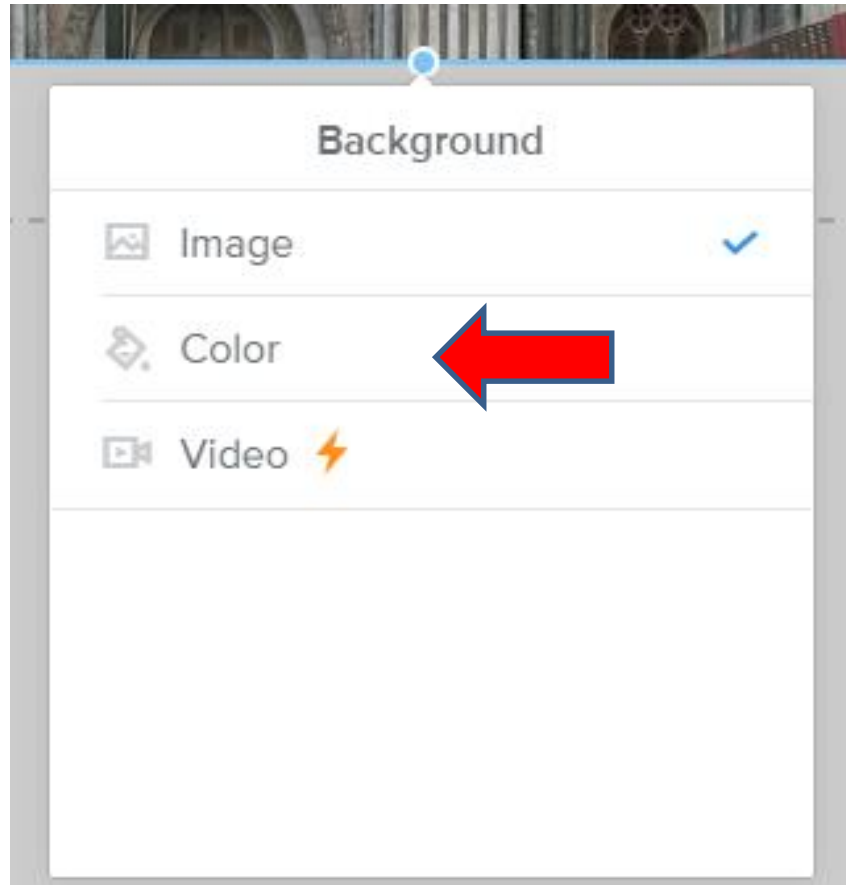
- You follow the same process as before. You click on the Header image and you see Edit Background again and click on it.
- Next is what happens.



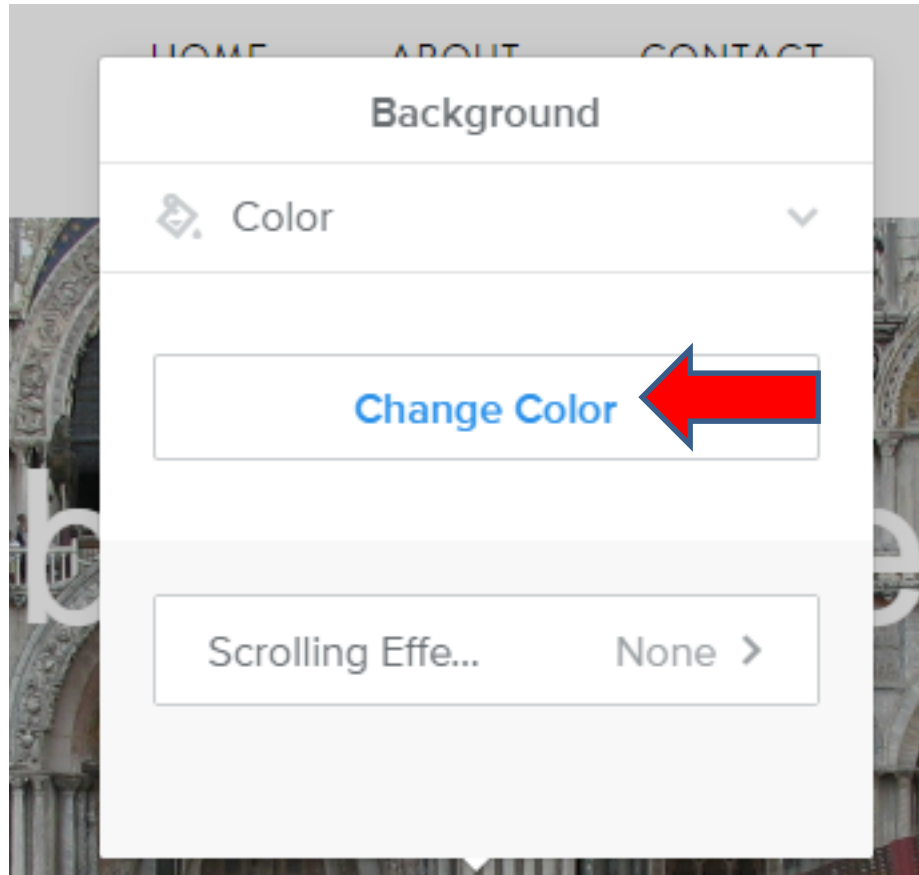
- A new window opens and you have to click on the drop down next to image.
- Next is what happens.



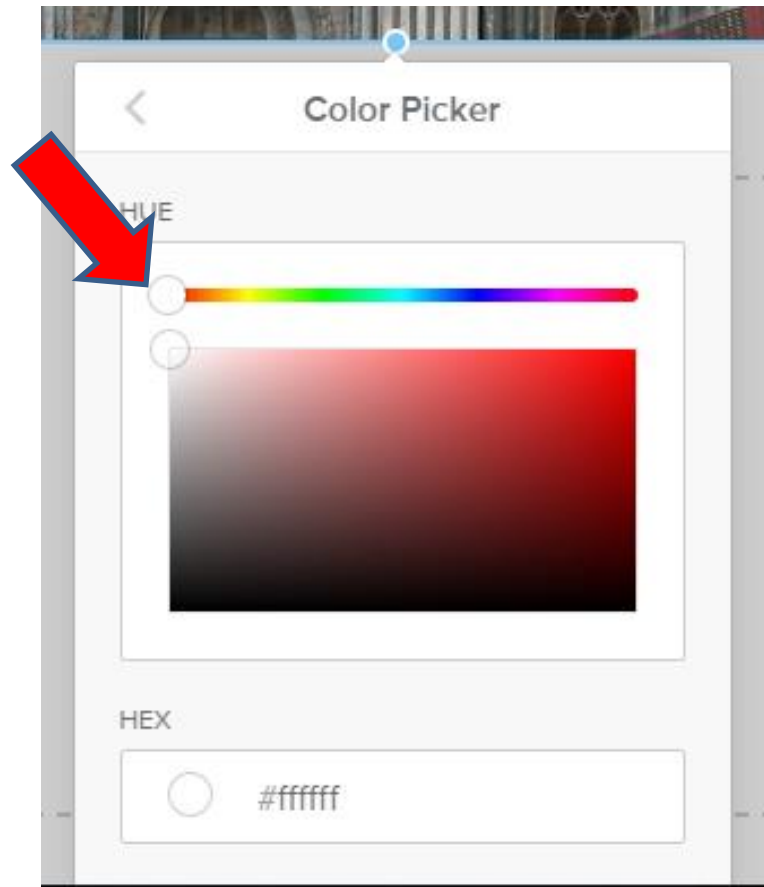
- You then see **Color**.
- Click on it and next is what happens.



- The window changes and you see **Change Color**.
- Click on it and next is what happens.



- The window changes again and you Color Picker.
- You can select Color or use code under HEX on the bottom. Part 2 Online training shows that.
- To select Color, first drag the top on to the right, which is next.



- You then see type of Blue.
- You then click on the icon below it and drag it to the color you want.
- Next is what happens.



- You then see the background color on the Header.
- You click outside of the window to close it.
- This is the end of Step 3 – Part 3.
