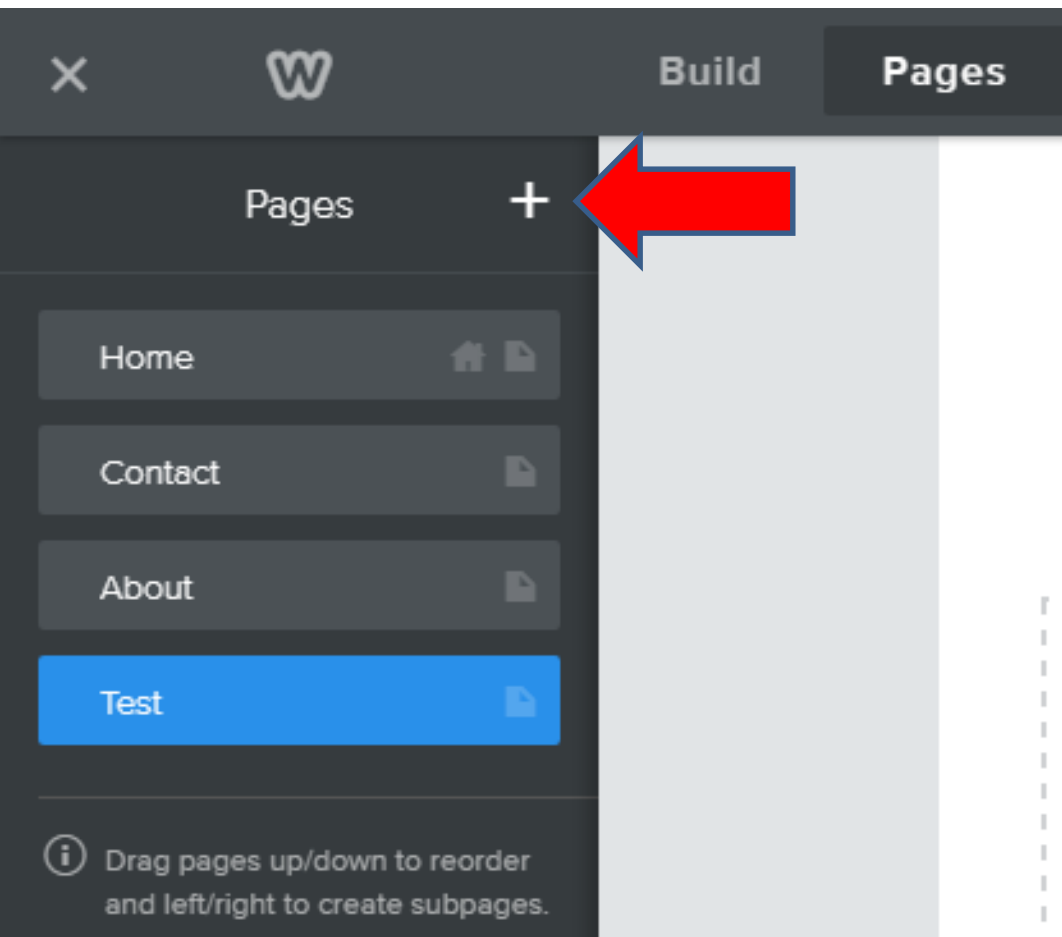
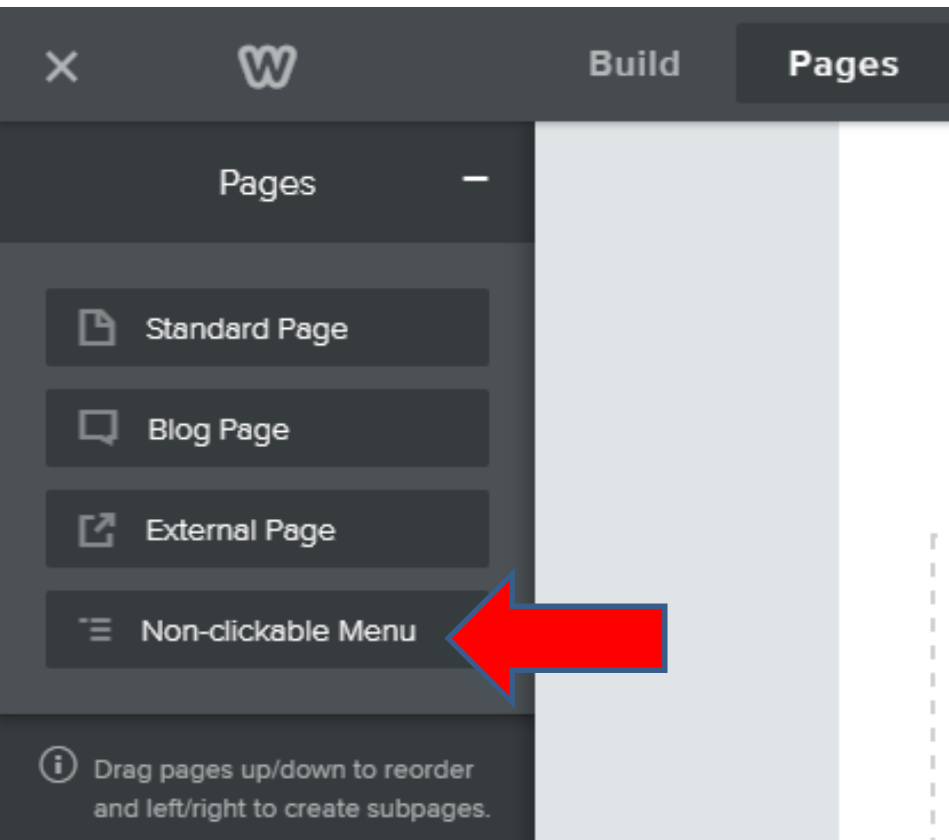


Part 2 – Navigation (like Subpages).

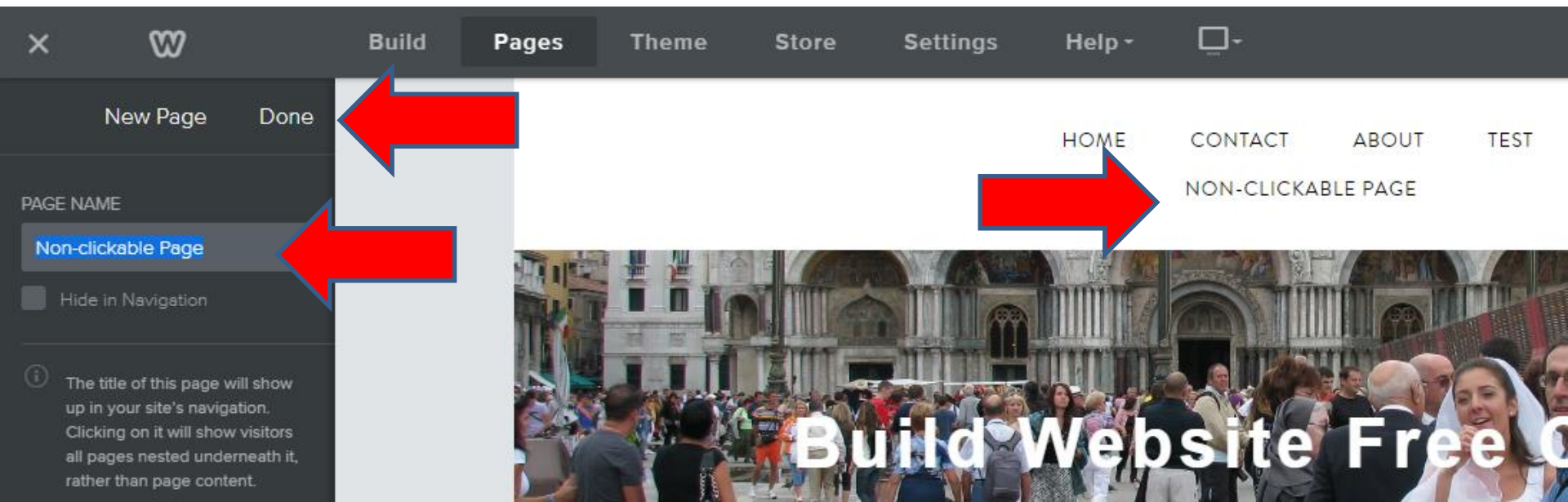
- I recommend you add the Non-clickable Menu as I mentioned before. First click on + again and next is what happens again.



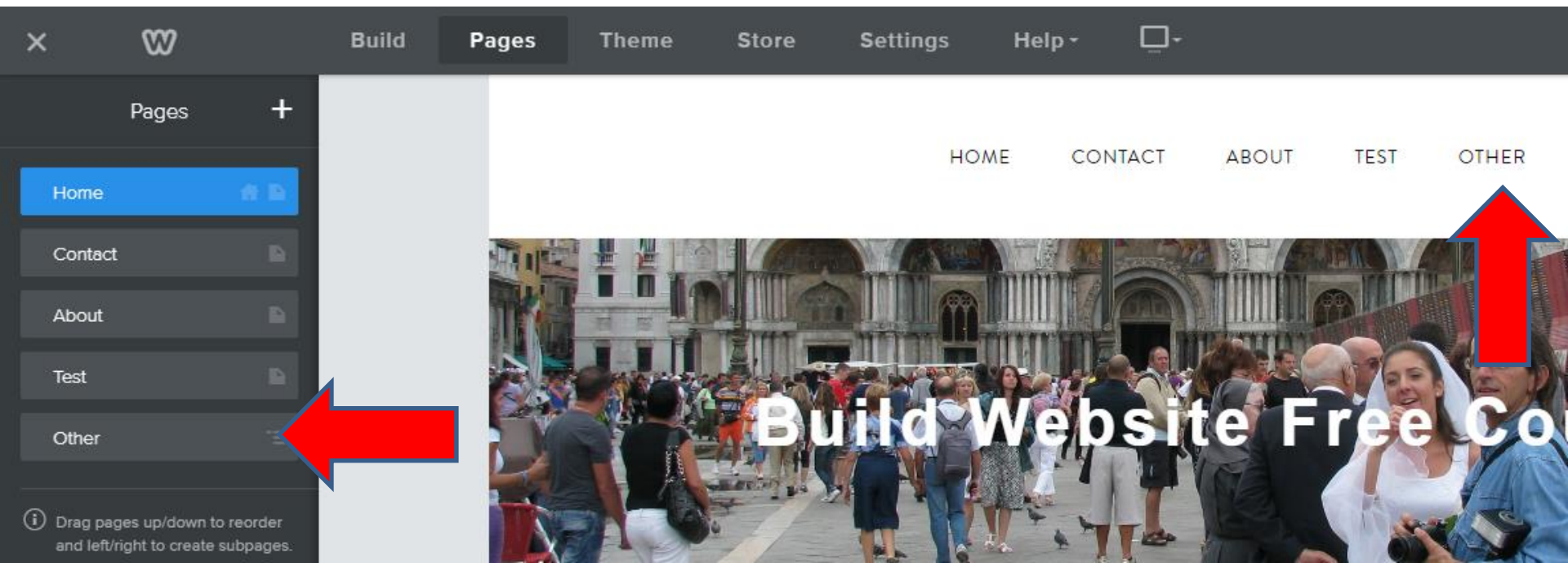
- You then see Non-clickable Menu and click on it.
- Next is what happens again.



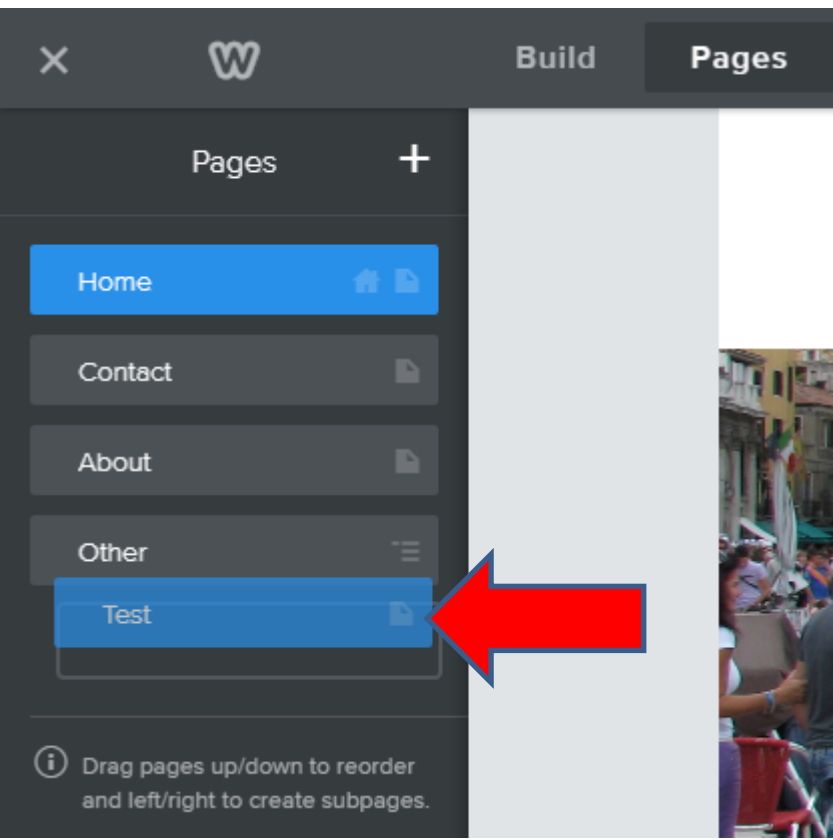
- You see Non-clickable Page highlighted and you see it below the Navigation. Depending on the Theme it may be not be on the bottom and next to TEST.
- Then type in text, like Other and then click on Done.
- Next is what happens again.



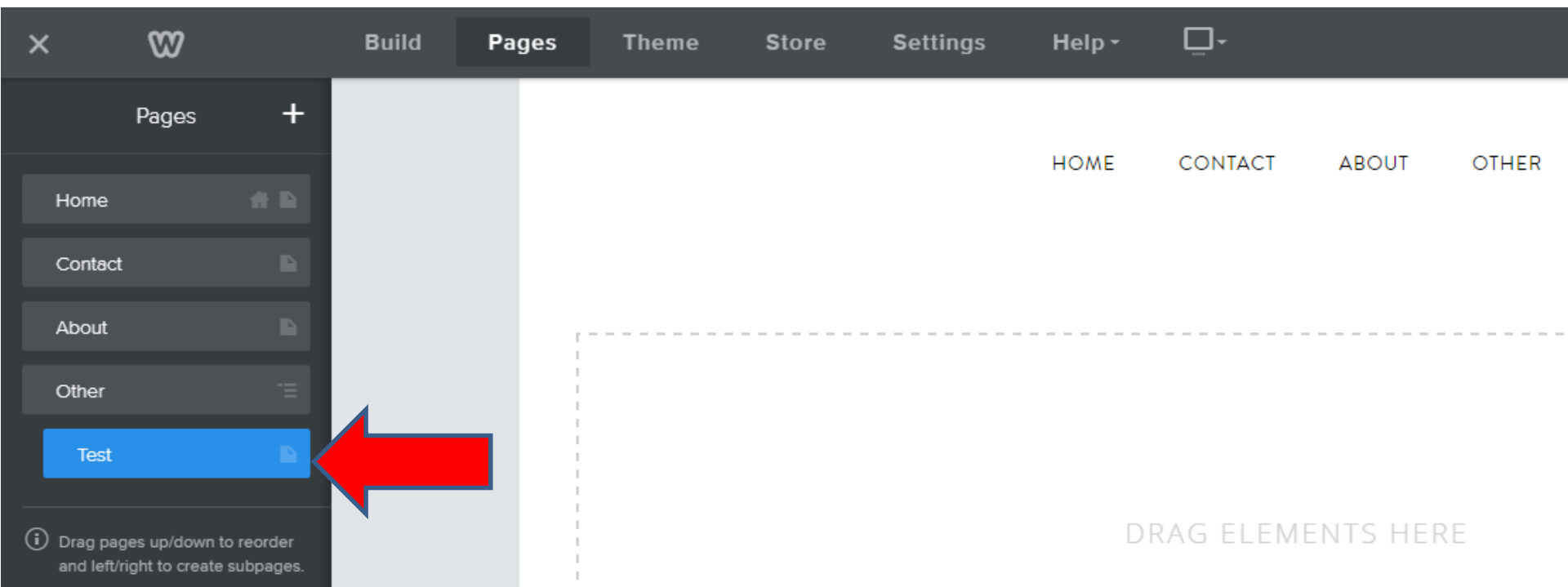
- It goes back to the Home page and you see **OTHER** next to **TEST**. Note – if it was Other Pages, it would show under the Navigation like when first added it.
- Next is to add Subpages under the Other.



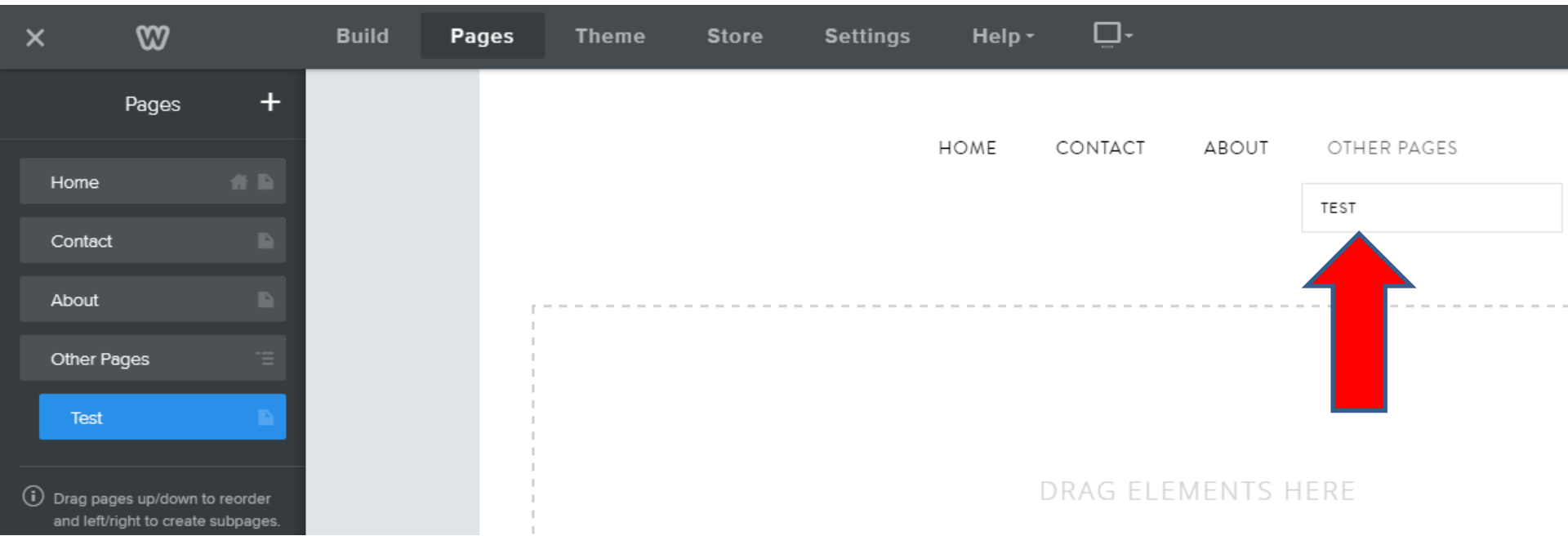
- You left click on hold down on Test and drag it under Other to the right, which is next.



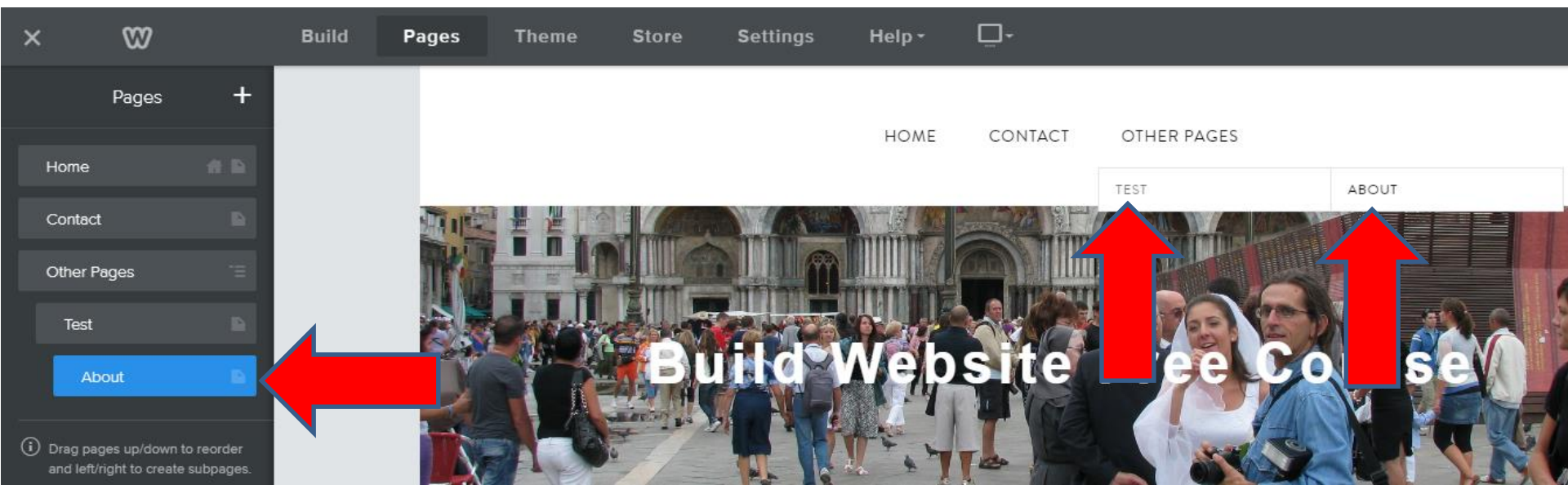
- You see it under Other and you don't see it on Navigation.
- Next is what happens when you hover over or click on Other.



- You see TEST when you hover over or click on it.
Note – I changed Other to Other Pages and it shows on the Navigation because Test is under it.
- Next is to put About under Test.



- Here is a sample of dragging About under Test. When you click or hover over OTHER/OTHER PAGES, you see TEST and when you hover over TEST, you see ABOUT.
- You almost don't need to do it that way.
- Next I will explain how to change the Navigation pages location?



Page Location

- **You can also drag and drop a page above another page to change location on the Navigation Bar.**
- **Note – Home is default, so don't drag and drop it to another location.**
- **Next is a sample.**

- I dragged About above Contact that you can test.
- When copy pages or add pages at home, you can follow the same process to change location.
- This is the End of Step 4 – Part 2.
